

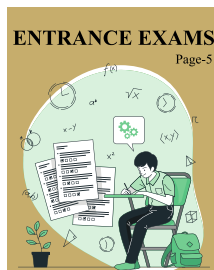

## CBSE 2024 Result Declared

On Monday, CBSE declared the 12th exam results on their official website, cbse.nic.in. Over 24,000 candidates scored above 95%, while more than 1.16 lakh candidates scored above 90%. This year, a staggering 35 lakh students registered for the 10th and 12th board exams. Girls outperformed boys by 6.40%; more than 91% of girls passed the exam.

## Haryana Board Class 10 Results 2024: Pass Rate Surges to 95.22%

The Haryana Board Class 10 results for 2024 show a notable increase in the pass percentage, reaching 95.22%. The results were released after the evaluation process concluded on May 8. Students can check their results by entering their roll numbers on the official Board of School Education Haryana website, bseh.org.in. The exams, conducted from February 27 to March 26, had about 2.8 lakh participants and were held in a single shift from 12:30 PM to 3 PM. To pass, students need at least 33% in each subject and overall. Girls achieved a higher pass rate of 96.32% compared to 94.22% for boys. Panchkula was the top-performing district, while Nooh had the lowest performance. In contrast, the previous year's pass rate was 65.43%, with girls at 69.81% and boys at 61.41%. Government schools had a pass rate of 57.73%, and private schools had 75.65%, with Rewari district leading at 89.02%. In 2022, 73.18% of students passed, with government schools at 63.54% and private schools at 88.21%. The pass rate was 100% in 2021, with 2.27 lakh students appearing for the exams.

### Maharashtra Approves Guidelines for Cluster Universities to Enhance Higher Education

The Maharashtra government has sanctioned the creation of cluster universities, which will consolidate multiple colleges into single entities. This strategy aims to enhance higher education by improving resource distribution, fostering academic partnerships, and streamlining administrative processes. By uniting institutions, the initiative seeks to boost educational quality and efficiency, providing a more integrated academic experience for students and faculty alike. This move is expected to address educational disparities and elevate academic standards across the state.



## Karnataka Announces SSLC Exam 2 Timetable and New Examination Policy

The Karnataka School Examination and Assessment Board (KSEAB) has published the schedule for the second Karnataka SSLC exam of 2024. This exam is set to be held from June 7 to June 14 in a pen-and-paper format. From the 2023-2024 academic year, the state has discontinued the SSLC and PUC Supplementary Exams. Under the new system, students will participate in three annual exams: exam 1, exam 2, and exam 3. This approach is intended to reduce stress by allowing students to retain their best scores across these exams instead of taking supplementary exams to pass.

The Karnataka SSLC 2024 results were announced on May 9. The exams took place from March 25 to April 6, resulting in a pass rate of 73.40%, down from 83.89% in 2023. Ankita Basappa Konnur from Bangalokote achieved the top score with 625 marks. Of the 436,138 boys who took the exams, 287,416 passed, with a pass rate of 65.90%. For girls, 343,788 out of 423,829 passed, achieving a pass rate of 81.11%. Students are advised to visit the official KSEAB website for more details and to view the complete timetable.

## JEE Advanced Resumes International Expansion with Three New Exam Centers Post-Covid Hiatus

According to the exam city list for JEE Advanced 2024 released by IIT Madras, three additional exam centres have been incorporated overseas, in addition to the existing 229 centres in India. Abu Dhabi, Kathmandu, and Dubai are the new international centres included. This marks the resumption of conducting JEE Advanced exams abroad after a hiatus caused by the pandemic. Before 2020, the IIT entrance exam was held in various foreign countries, including Addis Ababa (Ethiopia), Colombo (Sri Lanka), Dhaka (Bangladesh), Dubai (UAE), Kathmandu (Nepal), and Singapore.

To facilitate easier participation for students residing in specific regions, this year's selection of new centres for JEE Advanced has been strategic. This decision aims to eliminate the need for candidates to travel to India for the exam, thus reducing additional expenses. According to a spokesperson from JEE Advanced 2024, who spoke to Education Times, the addition of the three new centres is intended to address logistical challenges faced by foreign candidates. These cities were selected based on their past performance records. Additionally, the presence of an IIT Delhi campus in Abu Dhabi further supports the feasibility of establishing an exam centre in the city.

Foreign nationals refer to individuals who are not citizens of India or Persons of Indian Origin (OCI/PIO) who have obtained their OCI/PIO card on or after March 4, 2021. These individuals, when registering for JEE Advanced 2024, are exempt from taking JEE Main 2024 and can directly register for JEE Advanced 2024 provided they meet other eligibility requirements. Foreign national candidates will be considered separately from the 2,50,000 Indian national candidates who qualify for JEE Advanced 2024."

"All seats designated for foreign national candidates will be considered supernumerary, limited to a maximum of 10% of the total seats available in each course. These candidates are excluded from the reservation of seats under the GEN-EWS, OBC-NCL, SC, ST, and PwD categories/sub-categories as outlined in the JEE Advanced 2024 Information Brochure. There are no additional supernumerary seats or sub-categories for females among the foreign national supernumerary seats."

## Proposed Adjustment to School Start Times for Younger Students in Response to Developmental Needs

The state government is reviewing a new proposal aimed at adjusting school start times for young students. Specifically, this change would involve setting the start time for schools catering to children up to Class 2 to no earlier than 9 AM. This initiative is driven by the recognition of the unique needs and developmental stages of young children, emphasizing the importance of aligning school schedules with their natural rhythms and health requirements. By starting school later, the proposal aims to provide a more conducive learning environment, potentially improving attention spans, reducing morning rush stress, and supporting better overall academic performance and wellbeing among young learners. This shift is seen as a step towards educational reforms that consider the physiological and psychological well-being of students at a foundational level.

## Study Overseas: UK University Grants Scholarships Valued at £7,500, Verify Eligibility

**"The scholarship targets individuals from social science or dentistry backgrounds who intend to pursue a Master's degree in Dental Public Health (MDPH) at the University of Sheffield."**

A prominent UK institution, the University of Sheffield, is extending scholarships worth £7,500 (equivalent to approximately Rs 7.86 lakh) to international students. These scholarships, known as the Professor David Locker Scholarship, target students with backgrounds in social sciences or dentistry intending to pursue a Master's degree in Dental Public Health (MDPH) at the University of Sheffield. To qualify, Applicants must possess an offer to study MDPH Public Health at the University. Interested individuals meeting the criteria are encouraged to apply for this scholarship via the official website.

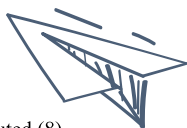

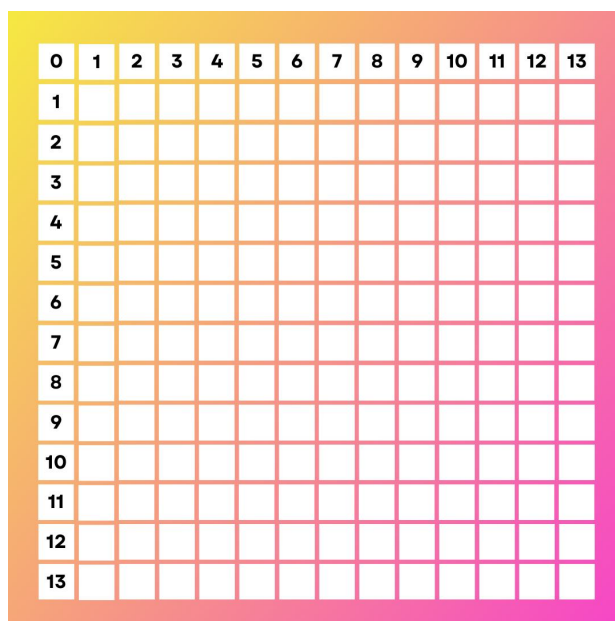

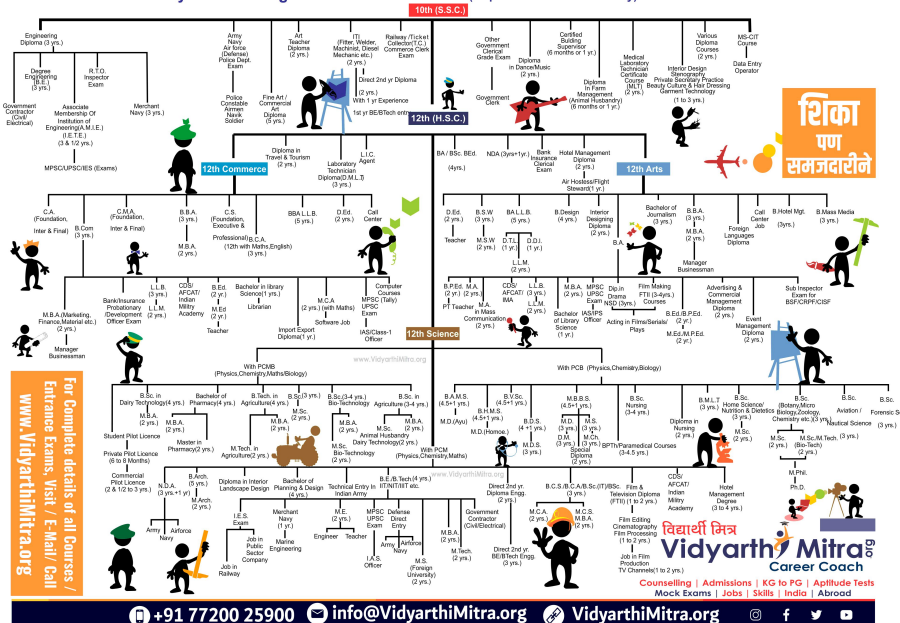
