NEET UG Counselling 2024 Live: MCC counselling dates awaited at mcc.nic.in

The National Testing Agency (NTA) released the revised results for the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) UG 2024 on July 26. The results are available on the NTA's official website, nta.ac.in. Following the release, candidates are now anticipating the online counselling process for undergraduate medical admissions, which will be conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) and state counselling bodies. Notifications and schedules for All India Quota (AIQ) and state quota medical counselling are expected to be announced soon. In an official notice dated July 26, the NTA mentioned that details and schedules for counselling would be posted on the websites of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Medical Education Directorates of various states.

The MCC has not yet released specific dates for the counselling schedule. When available, the schedule will be posted on the MCC's official website at mcc.nic.in. The MCC conducts NEET UG counselling for 15 percent of All India Quota seats, 100 percent of seats in deemed universities, central universities (DU, AMU, BHU), ESIC, AFMC, IP University, AIIMS, and JIPMER institutions, as well as for BSc Nursing at central institutions. The counselling process includes three rounds, followed by a stray vacancy round.

NEET PG 2024 exam city allotment

The National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS) will announce the exam city allotments for NEET PG 2024 on July 29. This information will be sent to candidates via their registered email IDs and will not be posted on the official website (natboard.edu.in). According to an official statement, the test city details will be communicated through email on July 29, 2024, while the exact test centre within the allocated city will be specified in the admit cards, which will be available on the NBEMS website on August 8, 2024.

NEET PG 2024 is scheduled for August 11, after being postponed from its original date of June 23. The NBEMS had previously released a list of 185 cities where the exam would take place and asked candidates to select four preferred test cities.

In cases where fewer than four test cities are available in a candidate's state or Union Territory of correspondence, or if the demand for testing seats exceeds the available capacity, candidates will be offered options from nearby states or UTs. The board mentioned that the allocation of test cities would be done randomly based on the candidates' preferences.

If a candidate's preferred cities are overbooked or unavailable due to capacity, logistical, administrative, or security reasons, they may be assigned to a test centre in the nearest available location. In situations where no test centre is available within the candidate's state of correspondence or nearby, the NBEMS will allocate a test centre in any available location across the country.

CUET-UG results 2024:

The National Testing Agency (NTA) announced the results of the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) UG 2024 on Sunday. This marks the beginning of the admission process for undergraduate courses, which was delayed this year due to controversies over alleged irregularities in competitive exams, including NEET-UG and UGC-NET.

According to the NTA, the highest number of full marks scorers in the CUET-UG 2024 were in Business Studies, with 8,024 students achieving this feat. Political Science had 5,141 full marks scorers, History had 2,520, English had 1,683, and Psychology had 1,602.

The General Test saw the highest number of participants, with 709,000 students, but only one scored full marks. This year, the NTA did not disclose the number of hundredth percentile scores in different subjects, unlike last year, where there were 22,836 such scores, up from 21,159 in 2022.

The NTA had previously released the provisional answer keys for CUET-UG 2024 on July 7. A retest was conducted on July 19 for over 1,000 candidates whose grievances were validated by the agency. Candidates were able to challenge the provisional answer keys from July 7 to July 9, resulting in 9,512 challenges, of which 1,782 were unique. After reviewing feedback and making necessary

changes, the final answer keys were used to prepare the results. The merit lists will be compiled by the 283 participating universities based on the scores provided by the NTA, and each university will conduct its admission counselling sessions accordingly.

Other subjects with notable full marks scorers include Biology/Biological Studies/Biotechnology/Biochemistry (835 students), Economics/Business Economics (430), Chemistry (398), Geography/Geology (373), and Agriculture (180). Five students scored full marks in Mathematics/Applied Mathematics, 17 in Legal Studies, and one each in Telugu, French, Japanese, and Russian.

Initially scheduled for June 30, the CUET-UG results were delayed due to the NTA's investigation into allegations of paper leaks in other exams. The CUET-UG was conducted in a hybrid mode for the first time in May. The exam was canceled in Delhi the night before the scheduled date due to logistical issues but was held later. The NTA had announced that the third edition of the CUET-UG would be completed in seven days, with no score normalization, as all exams were conducted in a single shift.

ICAI CA Foundation Result 2024 Live Updates: ICAI June exam result today at icai.nic.in

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) is scheduled to release the results for the CA Foundation exam for the June 2024 session on July 29. The results will be accessible on the official websites, icai.nic.in and icai.org. The CA Foundation exams were conducted on four separate dates: June 20, 22, 24, and 26.

Candidates who took the exam can check their results by logging in to the official ICAI websites using their registration numbers, pin numbers, and roll numbers. To pass the CA Foundation June 2024 exam, candidates must secure at least 40 marks in each individual paper and a minimum of 50 percent in the aggregate across all four papers. Additionally, candidates who score 70 percent or above

will receive a "pass with distinction" status. The CA Foundation exam is an entry-level examination for students aspiring to become Chartered Accountants. It tests candidates on subjects such as Principles and Practice of Accounting, Business Laws, Business Mathematics, Logical Reasoning, and Statistics, as well as Business Economics and Business and Commercial Knowledge. The results will include the candidates' scores in each subject and their overall percentage. Those who pass the exam will be eligible to enroll in the next level of the CA program, the Intermediate course. Candidates are advised to keep their registration details handy and check the official websites for the latest updates and information.

IIM Calcutta releases CAT 2024 notification; registration from August 1

The Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Calcutta has announced the details for the Common Admission Test (CAT) 2024. The notification was released in newspapers and on IIM Calcutta's official LinkedIn account. CAT 2024 will be a computer-based exam, scheduled for November 24, and will be held in three sessions. The test will be conducted at centers across approximately 170 cities. Candidates can choose up to five preferred test cities during registration, though the final list of cities may be

adjusted at the discretion of the CAT authorities. The registration process for CAT 2024 will start at 10 am on August 1 and will close at 3 pm on September 13. Interested candidates can register on the official IIM CAT website, iimcat.ac.in. It is essential for candidates to maintain a valid and unique email address and mobile phone number throughout the selection process.

Upon completing registration, admit cards will be available from November 5 to 24. The results for CAT 2024 are expected to be announced in the second week of January 2025.

The registration fee for CAT 2024 is Rs 1250 for candidates from SC, ST, and PwD categories, and Rs 2500 for candidates from all other categories. It's important to note that candidates need to pay the registration fee only once, regardless of the number of institutes they are applying to. The registration fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

Government Proposal: Include Class 9-11 Marks in Class 12 Report Card

A recent report submitted by PARAKH, an assessment unit established under NCERT, to the Education Ministry has proposed significant changes in how student performance is evaluated in Indian schools. According to the proposal, a student's academic performance in Classes 9, 10, and 11 should be factored into their final marks at the end of Class 12. This move is intended to standardize assessments across various school boards in line with the National Education Policy.

Key Recommendations and Details:

1. Weightage Distribution:

- Class 9: Performance in Class 9 should account for 15% of the final marks in the Class 12 report card. This score would be derived from 70% formative assessments (ongoing classwork, projects, and assignments) and 30% summative assessments (end-of-term exams).
- Class 10: 20% of the final marks should come from Class 10 performance, equally divided between formative (50%) and summative (50%) assessments.
- Class 11: The weightage increases to 25%, with 40% from formative assessments and 60% from summative assessments.
- Class 12: The largest share, 40%, will be based on Class 12 performance, with 30% from formative assessments and 70% from summative assessments.

2. Rationale and Objectives:

- The proposal aims to create a more holistic and consistent evaluation system across the country. By including formative assessments, it acknowledges the importance of regular coursework and continuous learning rather than relying solely on final examinations.
- The system also seeks to reduce the pressure on students by diversifying the sources of their final grades, thereby encouraging consistent performance throughout their secondary education years.

WBJEEB ANM, GNM 2024 admit card out; exam on August 4

The West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board (WBJEEB) has issued the revised admit card for Auxiliary Nursing and Midwifery (ANM) and General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) 2024 exams today, July 29. The ANM, GNM 2024 exam is scheduled to be held on August 4 in a single shift from 12 pm to 1:30 pm. Candidates who filled out the WBJEEB ANM, GNM 2024 application form can download the admit card by visiting the official website, wbjeeb.nic.in or wbjeeb.in. The exam, initially scheduled for July 14, was subsequently postponed by the board.

“Due to unavoidable circumstances relating to natural calamity in some areas of the State, ANM, GNM Examination (earlier

scheduled to be held on 14.07.2024) is being re-scheduled and will now be held on 04.08.2024 (Sunday),” the board informed earlier through the official notice. Candidates will have to enter their login credentials, such as application number and date of birth to download the WBJEEB ANM, GNM 2024 admit card. Candidates should carry a valid government-issued ID proof, like Aadhaar card, voter ID card, PAN card, or passport, along with their admit card to the exam centre. The WBJEEB ANM and GNM entrance exam will have five sections, totalling 100 questions. Each section is divided into two categories. Category 1 includes 85 questions, each worth one mark, while Category 2 includes 15 questions, each worth two marks.

CAT 2024 Notification Released: Key Changes and Important Dates

The Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Calcutta, has announced the Common Admission Test (CAT) 2024 via a newspaper notification on July 28, 2024. The exam date and other significant details have also been disclosed. The CAT 2024 exam will be held on November 24, 2024, across 170 test cities. The exam will take place in three shifts: Shift 1 from 8:30 am to 10:30 am, Shift 2 from 12:30 pm to 2:30 pm, and Shift 3 from 4:30 pm to 6:30 pm.

The CAT 2024 registration process will commence on August 1, 2024, at iimcat.ac.in and will close on September 13, 2024. Eligibility criteria include a bachelor's degree with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks (45% for reserved category candidates).

Notable Changes in CAT 2024:

The application fee has increased to Rs 2500 for general category candidates and Rs 1250 for reserved category candidates.

The number of test cities has increased from 167 to 170.

Candidates can now choose five test cities while filling out the application form.

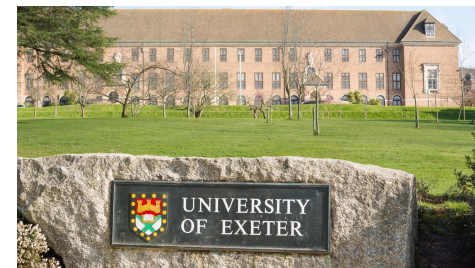

Upcoming SAT on August 24, 2024: Registration Open

The College Board is gearing up for the upcoming Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) session scheduled for August 24, 2024. Registration for this critical exam, essential for students aspiring to enroll in undergraduate programs in the United States and Canada, is now open.

Prospective test-takers must register by August 9, 2024. They can also make changes, cancel their registration, or opt for late registration until August 13, 2024. The standard registration fee is USD 68 (approximately INR 5,692), with an additional regional fee of USD 43. Late registration incurs a USD 34 fee, while changes to the test center or cancellations each cost USD 29. The College Board has also announced future SAT dates: October 5, November 2, December

7, 2024, and March 8, May 3, and June 7, 2025. Registration for these dates is already open, allowing students to plan according to their academic schedules and readiness.

The SAT 2024 exam includes sections on math, reading, writing, and language. Scores range from 400 to 1600, with scores above the average being favorable for admission to many colleges and universities.



Increase in Australia Visa Fees: Impact on International Students

International students considering Australia as a study destination will encounter new challenges due to recent policy changes by the Australian government. Two significant developments—an increase in the student visa fee and a rise in the Temporary Skilled Migration Income Threshold (TSMIT)—are expected to affect international students.

Since July 1, 2024, the fee for international student visas has risen from \$710 to \$1,600, representing a 125% increase. This change means students must now pay an additional \$890, raising the total visa fee to \$1,600. Dr. John Lodewijks, Vice President – Academic & Professor of Economics at SP Jain School of Global Management, commented, "Although this substantial fee increase might deter some budget-conscious students, it could

also encourage them to seek diverse funding options and scholarships, promoting financial resourcefulness."

The TSMIT has also been raised from \$70,000 to \$73,150, effective for nomination applications lodged between July 1 and June 30, 2025. Additionally, new rules have been introduced, including a shorter duration for Temporary Graduate Visas and a reduction in the age eligibility, among other changes.

These measures may make Australia less attractive to prospective students and skilled workers, potentially affecting its reputation as a desirable destination for higher education and employment. There is a need for policies that balance affordable education with quality, ensuring that Australia remains competitive and appealing to international students.

UCAS to Implement New Personal Statement Questions Starting September 2025

The Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS), a central body facilitating applications between prospective students and UK universities, is set to introduce a new format for personal statements, effective from the 2026 academic year.

Personal statements have long been a key part of the application process for UK universities. Traditionally, the format and focus of these statements have remained consistent, but UCAS is now making changes to better support students. The organization aims to simplify the process, making it less stressful and more accessible.

According to UCAS, a survey of 2022 applicants revealed that 89% of students understood the purpose of the personal statement, with many finding it helpful for decision-making. However, 83% reported finding the process stressful and heavily reliant on external support to ensure they included the necessary information.

The new format will include the following structured questions:

Why do you want to study this course or subject?

How have your

qualifications and studies prepared you for this course or subject?

What additional experiences outside of formal education have prepared you for this course, and why are they valuable?

These changes aim to provide clarity and guidance, reducing inequities in access to support and advice, particularly benefiting international students. The personal statement will continue to have a character limit of 4,000 characters, including spaces, but will now be organized into three distinct sections.

Manuel Barcia, Dean of Global Engagement at the University of Leeds, stated, "This change aims to give every student a fair opportunity to express their unique journey, aspirations, and potential." Dr. Jo Saxton, chief executive at UCAS, added, "The new structured questions are designed to give students and their advisors greater confidence in articulating their ambitions and securing their desired course."

This revised format will be implemented starting in September 2025 for those applying for entry in 2026.

Govt Proposal: Class 9-11 Performance to Be Included in Class 12 Report Cards

UN Report: Majority of School Students Lack Access to Adequate Physical Education

A recent report by UNESCO, titled "Global State of Play," reveals that the majority of the world's school children do not have access to the minimum required physical education. This first-ever Global Status Report on Quality Physical Education highlights significant disparities in the provision of physical education across countries.

The report shows that only 58% of countries have made physical education mandatory for girls, and just 7% of schools worldwide offer equal physical education time for boys and girls. Additionally, two-thirds of secondary school students and over half of primary school students

globally do not receive the minimum weekly physical education.

An expert involved in the report informed PTI that less than half of primary school teachers have received specialized training in physical education. Funding disparities are also evident, with two-thirds of countries allocating less than 2% of their education budget to physical education, while only 10% of countries dedicate more than 7%.

The report underscores the importance of Physical Education (PE) for supporting learning and promoting holistic student development. However, opportunities for professional development in PE are limited, with

only 33% of countries offering in-service training and continuous professional development to PE teachers every five years, far from the recommended annual frequency.

The report also highlights the issue of inclusion, noting that while 58% of countries report policies for mainstreaming girls and students with disabilities in physical education, significant regional disparities persist. There is a notable gap between policy and practice, as evidenced by the fact that while 54.5% of countries claim to have policies for equal PE time for boys and girls, only 7.1% of schools actually implement this.

UNESCO developed

the concept of Quality Physical Education (QPE) to differentiate it from traditional PE, emphasizing factors such as frequency, inclusivity, and value content. The report stresses the need for ongoing professional development for teachers to ensure that PE is inclusive and meets diverse student needs.

UNESCO calls for increased investment in physical education, recommending improvements in teacher training, infrastructure, and curriculum development. The report provides ten indicators for assessing the quality of physical education and identifying areas for improvement at local and national levels.

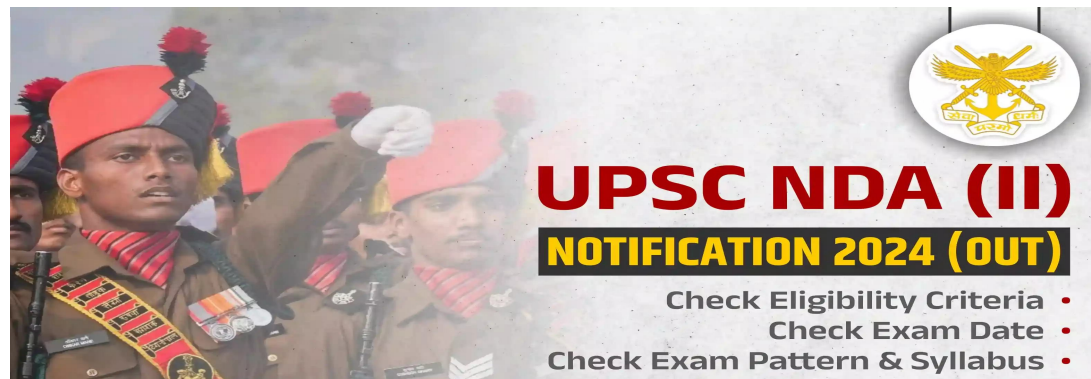

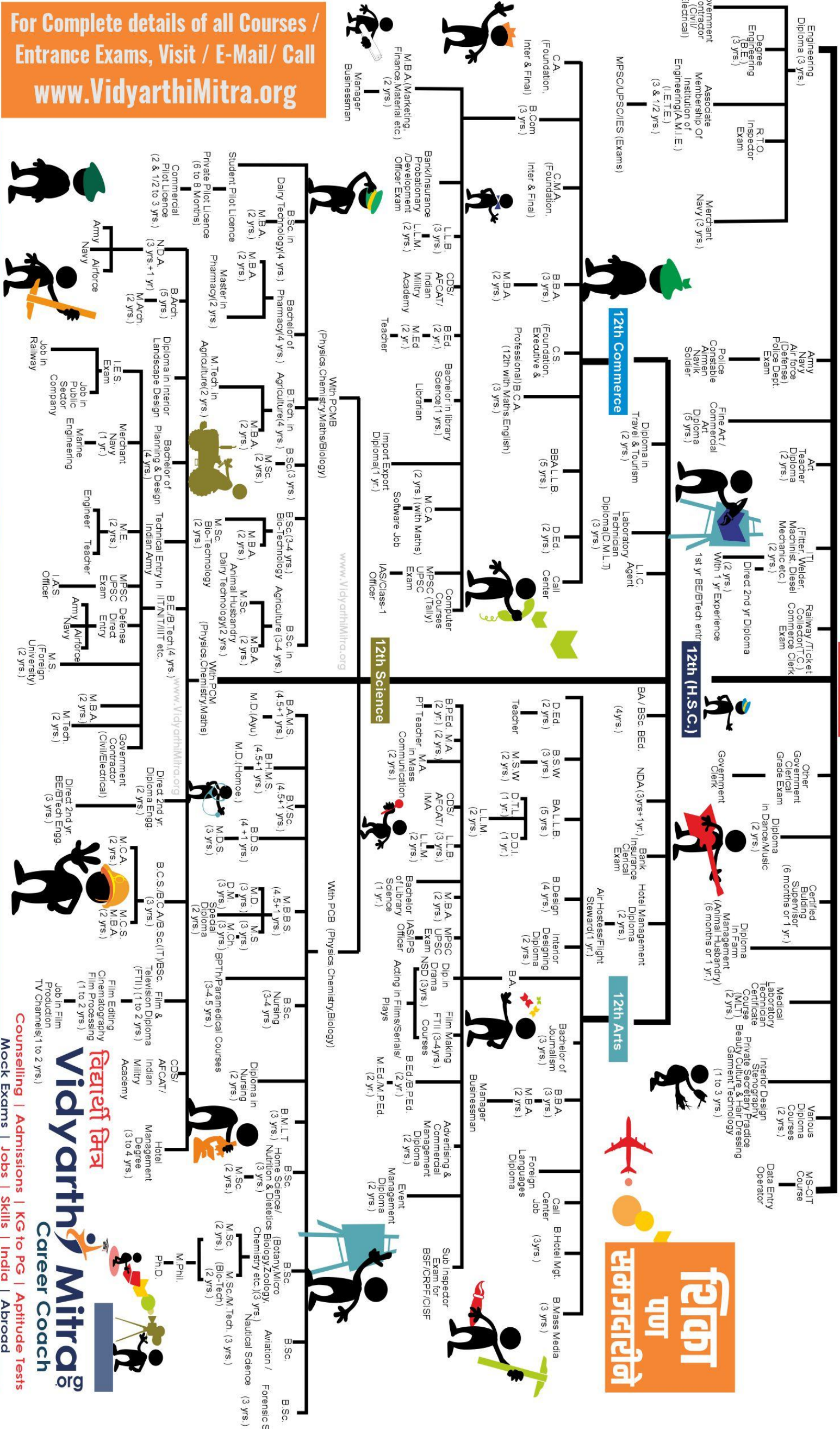
