No NEET Re-Exam, Supreme Court Says "Can't Conclude Sanctity Breached"

New Delhi: There Will Be No Re-Test For The 2024 NEET-UG Exam, The Supreme Court Ruled On Tuesday. The Court Stated That There Is No Evidence Of A "Systemic Breach" Or That The "Sanctity" Of The Examination Was Compromised, Despite Two Localized Leaks Of The Question Paper. Chief Justice DY Chandrachud Acknowledged That The Question Paper Leak In Jharkhand's Hazaribagh And Patna In Bihar Was Undisputed. However, He Stated There Is No Material On Record To Conclude That The Exam Results Were Affected Or That There Was A Systemic Breach Compromising The Exam's Integrity. No Systemic Leak Detected

The Court Emphasized That The Available Data Does Not Indicate A Widespread Leak That Would Undermine The Exam's Integrity. Thus, Ordering A Re-Test For 23.33 Lakh Aspiring Medical Professionals Would Have Significant Repercussions.

Consequences Of A Re-Test

The Bench, Led By Chief Justice Chandrachud, Pointed Out The Far-Reaching Consequences Of Ordering A Fresh Exam. It Would Disrupt The Admission Schedule, Impact Education, And Affect The Availability Of Medical Professionals In The Future. The Court Also Noted The Potential Disadvantage To Marginalized Students.

While Delivering The Order, Chief Justice Chandrachud Referred To The Undeniable Fact That The Question Paper Had Been Leaked At Two Exam Centers In Jharkhand And Bihar. The Central Bureau Of Investigation (CBI) Identified The Hazaribagh Leak As 'Ground Zero' In Their Investigation Of A Nationwide 'solver Gang' Racket. Multiple Arrests Have Been Made, Including Rakesh Ranjan, Alias Rocky, The Alleged Mastermind.

The National Testing Agency (NTA), Which Conducts The NEET-UG And Other Competitive Exams, Faced Scrutiny. The Controversy Also Triggered A Significant Political Row, With Opposition Parties Criticizing The Government.

Karnataka to Abolish NEET, Introduces State-Specific Medical Entrance Exam

In a significant policy shift, the Karnataka Cabinet, led by Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, has approved a resolution to abolish the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) for medical admissions. Instead, the state plans to introduce its own entrance exam. This decision, made during a late-night Cabinet meeting, is driven by growing dissatisfaction with NEET, which is seen as disadvantageous to students from state education boards.

Deputy Chief Minister D K Shivakumar, a vocal opponent of NEET, has been advocating for states to have the autonomy to conduct their

own entrance exams tailored to local educational contexts. "The NEET exam has created numerous challenges for our students. It's time for Karnataka to take charge and ensure a more equitable and contextually appropriate assessment for medical aspirants," Shivakumar stated.

This decision is expected to intensify the national debate on the fairness and effectiveness of a centralized medical entrance system, as Karnataka aims to set a precedent for other states considering similar moves.

CUET UG 2024 Answer Key Released by NTA

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has released the answer key for the Common University Entrance Test Undergraduate (CUET UG) 2024, which was held on July 19. Here are the key details:

They will need to select their preferred universities and courses, fill out necessary forms, and participate in online counseling sessions. Seats will be allotted based on the final scores and preferences.

The Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) has initiated the final phase of web options entry for the Andhra Pradesh Engineering, Architecture, and Pharmacy Entrance Test (AP EAPCET) 2024, starting today, July 24. Candidates who qualified for the AP EAPCET 2024 exam can enter their web options through the official website, eapcet-sche.aptonline.in/EAPCET/. According to the official notice, various candidates, including those who have not secured seats, those seeking better options despite reporting, and those whose allotments were cancelled, can participate in this final phase.

To log in and exercise the web entry option, candidates will need to enter their hall ticket number and date of birth. The AP EAPCET 2024 web options entry window will remain open until July 26. The option to change entered choices will be available on July 27. The APSCHE will announce the

seat allotment results on July 30, 2024. Candidates must self-report at their allotted colleges between July 31, 2024, and August 3, 2024.

AP EAPCET Counselling 2024: Eligibility Criteria

Candidates who have passed Intermediate, Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE), National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), or Andhra Pradesh Open School Society (APOSS) with the required pass percentages in mathematics, physics, and chemistry are eligible. The required pass percentages are 44.5% for other castes (OCs) and 39.5% for reserved categories, including backward classes (BC), scheduled castes (SC), and scheduled tribes (ST).

Candidates who did not pay the processing fee during the first phase can do so by July 25, 2024, through the official website. The processing fee is Rs 1,200 for OC and BC candidates and Rs 600 for SC and ST candidates.

Govt to launch scheme to provide internship opportunities to 1 crore youth over 5 years

In an effort to create job opportunities for the youth, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced on Tuesday the launch of an ambitious scheme to provide internship opportunities in 500 top companies to 1 crore youth over a five-year period.

The scheme will offer an internship allowance of ₹5,000 per month, along with a one-time assistance of ₹6,000. "As the 5th scheme under the Prime Minister's package, our government will launch a comprehensive scheme for providing internship opportunities in 500 top companies to 1 crore youth in five years," Sitharaman stated in her Budget speech.

These internships will give the youth 12 months of exposure to real-life business environments, various professions, and employment opportunities. Sitharaman also mentioned that companies will cover the training costs and 10 percent of the internship costs from their CSR (corporate social responsibility) funds.

According to the Companies Act 2013, certain profitable organizations are required to allocate at least 2 percent of their three-year average annual net profit towards CSR activities each financial year.

Delhi University to raise funds by allowing donors to name its capital assets, found scholarships

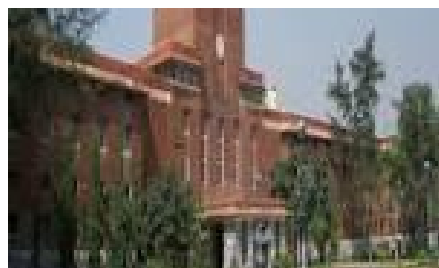

New Delhi: Philanthropists may soon be able to name and rename Delhi University infrastructure through donations, per a new policy proposal.

Donors can name new or existing buildings, hostels, labs, teaching blocks, libraries, and auditoriums. Contributions of ₹5 crore or more will secure naming rights for 33 years, ₹2 crore to ₹5 crore for 20 years, and ₹1 crore to ₹2 crore for 10 years.

The proposal, now before the Executive Council, includes guidelines from a four-member panel for naming capital assets and structures, as discussed on April 16. The committee also addressed the need for new scholarships and awards, which haven't been updated for years. They proposed sustainable guidelines for these.

Naming a floor, room, or building requires



donors to cover at least 60 percent of construction costs. New scholarships and awards can be established by various entities, including government bodies, NGOs, corporate houses, and individuals, with a minimum of ₹5 lakh for 10 years and ₹10 lakh for 20 years. No scholarships or awards can exceed 20 years. All donations need approval from a committee appointed by the Vice-Chancellor.

CBSE Directs Schools to Approve Hosting of NIOS Exams by July 31

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has issued a notification instructing its affiliated schools to consent to hosting the upcoming National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) exams scheduled for October-November 2024. CBSE-affiliated schools must log into the NIOS portal and provide their consent for conducting the public examinations by July 31, 2024.

The NIOS exams are held twice a year, in April-May and October-November. The notification states: "NIOS, Department of School Education, Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India conducts public examinations two times in a year, i.e., in April-May and October-November for secondary (Class 10), senior secondary (Class 12), and vocational courses. Every year, NIOS uses the services and infrastructure of CBSE-affiliated schools to conduct its examinations. The October-November examination of NIOS is scheduled to commence in October 2024. We request you to kindly extend your cooperation and give your consent for the conduct of public examinations in October-November 2024 on

the NIOS portal (<http://exams.nios.ac.in>) by July 31, 2024." The notification emphasizes the importance of this cooperation, noting, "Your assistance will not only help NIOS in holding public examinations for candidates from the most disadvantaged groups of society but also help CBSE comply with the directions of the Ministry of Education, Government of India."

The NIOS public examination for secondary and senior secondary courses is expected to begin in the first week of October 2024.

The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), formerly known as the National Open School (NOS), was established in November 1989 as an autonomous organization under the National Policy on Education 1986 by the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India. NIOS offers a variety of vocational, life enrichment, and community-oriented courses, in addition to general and academic courses at the secondary and senior secondary levels. It also provides elementary-level courses through its Open Basic Education Programmes (OBE).

Haryana Schools Launch 'Shiksha Saptah'

The Haryana education department has begun a week-long series of programs in schools to commemorate the fourth anniversary of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The initiative, called 'Shiksha Saptah', aims to foster collaboration and innovation among students, educators, and policymakers. Each day of the

week will feature a different theme, from teaching-learning materials to foundational literacy, sports, cultural activities, skill education, and a community plantation drive. The initiative highlights the state's commitment to an innovative and inclusive educational environment in line with the NEP's vision.

TOP EDUCATION UPDATES GIVEN IN UNION BUDGET 2024:

The Union Budget 2024, announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, brings significant focus on education, skill development, and employment. This budget introduces a series of comprehensive schemes aimed at transforming the landscape of education and job opportunities in India, with a substantial central outlay of ₹1.48 lakh crore.

MAJOR ANNOUNCEMENTS AND SCHEMES:

• Allocation towards various schemes and government institutions:

1. Allocations for certain school education schemes have increased, including the PM-POSHAN scheme, the school meal program. In this year's Union Budget, the allocation for PM-POSHAN has been raised by Rs 867 crore, bringing the total to Rs 12,467 crore compared to Rs 11,600 crore in 2023-24.
2. The PM-SHRI scheme, which focuses on establishing "exemplar schools" to demonstrate aspects of the National Education Policy 2020, has received a budget increase of approximately Rs 2,050 crore. 4. In higher education, the budget allocation for the University Grants Commission (UGC) has been reduced by Rs 2,860 crore compared to the previous year. The UGC's allocation dropped from Rs 5,360 crore in the 2023-24 Budget to Rs 2,500 crore in the current year's Budget.
5. The allocation for Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) has been reduced from Rs 300 crore last year to Rs 212.21 crore this year.
6. Central universities have received a boost in the Budget allocation, which has increased by Rs 4,400 crore, from Rs 11,258 crore last year to Rs 15,658 crore this year.
7. The allocation for IITs has been increased by Rs 663 crore, rising from Rs 9,661 crore last year to Rs 10,324 crore in this year's Budget.
8. The research and innovation section, which encompasses schemes such as the Scheme for Promotion of Academic and Research Collaboration, has received an increased allocation of approximately Rs 144 crore. This raises the budget from Rs 210.61 crore in 2023-24 to Rs 355 crore this year.

• Employment Linked Schemes:

1. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced incentives for 30 lakh young job seekers, with the government contributing one month's provident fund (PF) for each.
2. Plans to establish working women hostels across the country to boost women's workforce participation.
3. The MGNREGA (Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee) scheme is designed to offer 100 days of wage employment each fiscal year to at least one adult member from every household that seeks manual work.

• Boost to Education Loans:

1. Students not eligible for any existing government schemes will now have access to education loans of up to ₹10 lakh. This initiative will greatly enhance access to higher education for numerous students.
2. Each year, 1 lakh students will receive e-vouchers that provide a 3 percent interest subvention on their loans.

• Job Creation in Manufacturing:

The Job Creation in Manufacturing scheme aims to incentivize additional employment in the manufacturing sector. This scheme is expected to benefit 210 lakh youths, creating robust job opportunities in this critical sector of the economy.

• Upgradation of Industrial Training Institutes:

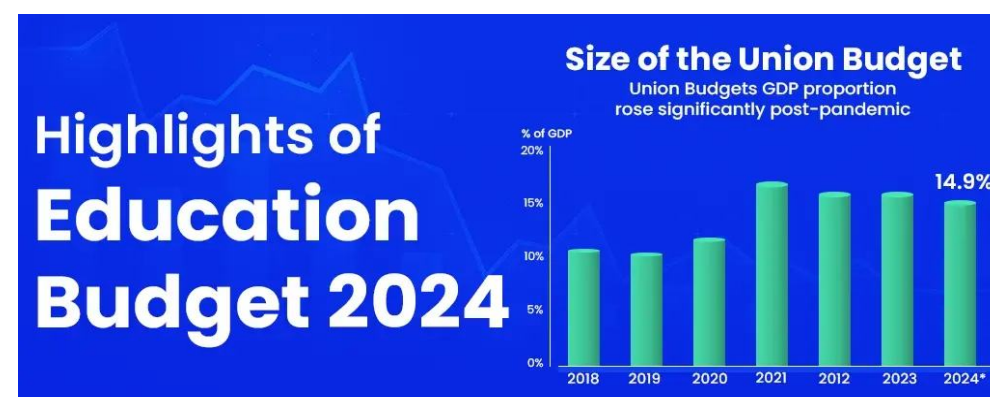
A total of 1,000 industrial training institutes will be upgraded, and the Model Skilling Loan Scheme will be revised to support 25,000 students annually.

• Mudra Yojana:

The government has boosted support for the MSME sector by increasing the MUDRA Yojana loan limit from Rs 10 lakh to Rs 20 lakh. This increased limit applies to MSME owners who have previously taken out these loans and successfully repaid them.

• Skill Development Programmes:

1. Under a new centrally sponsored scheme, 20 lakh youth will be skilled over the next five years. This program will focus on equipping young Indians with the skills needed to thrive in a rapidly evolving job market.
2. Women-specific skilling programs will be introduced, along with measures to increase workforce participation through the establishment of working women hostels and creches.

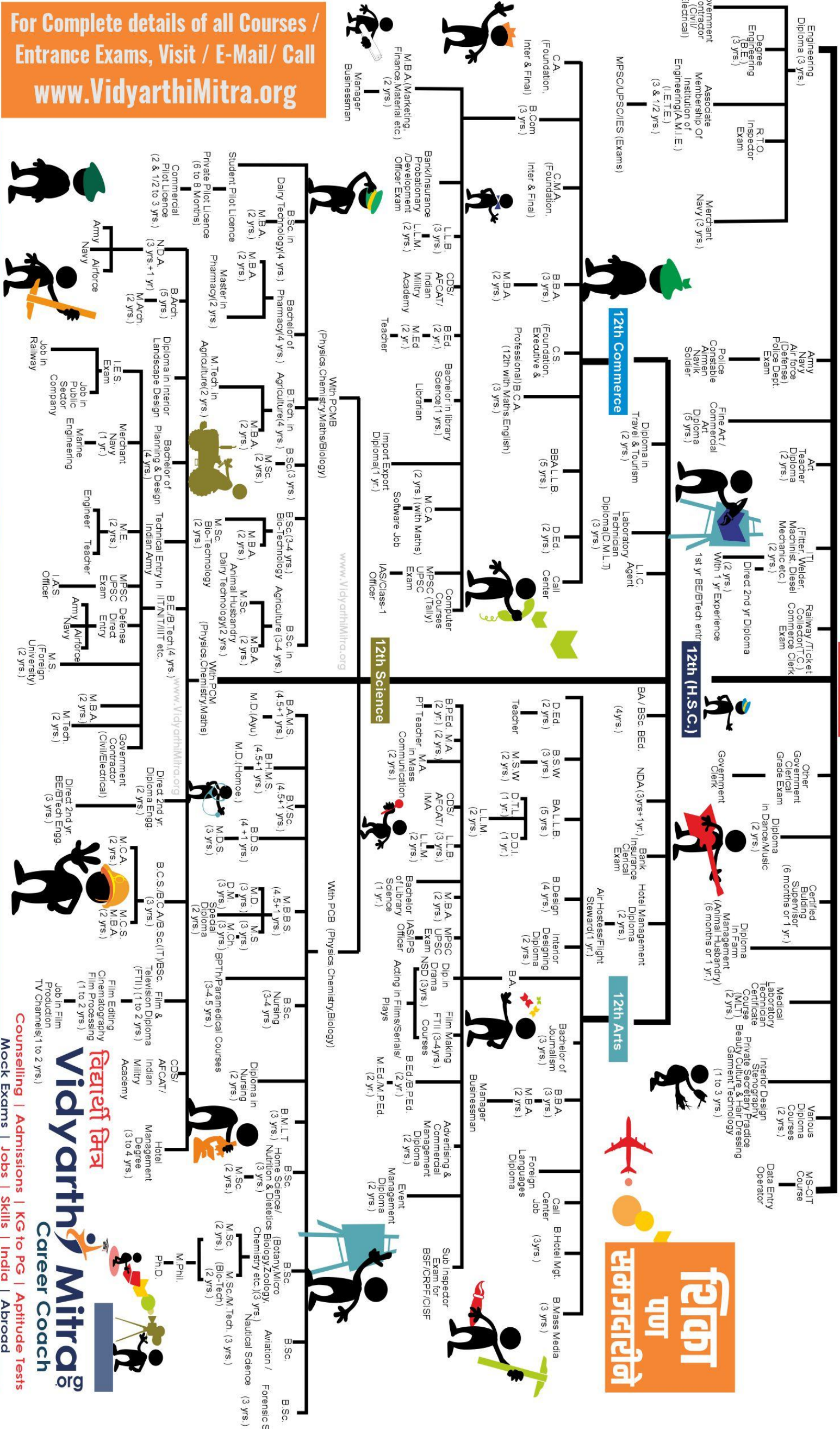
