IIM Calcutta will soon close the registrations for the Common Admission Test (CAT) 2024. Interested and eligible candidates can visit the official website of the CAT 2024 to register for the exam. The deadline for registering for the entrance exam is September 13, 2024. IIM Calcutta will conduct the exam this year on November 24 across 170 cities. Admit cards are scheduled to be released on November 5.Candidates will be required to pay an examination fee of Rs 2,500 for general category candidates, while an examination fee of Rs 1,250 is required for reserved category candidates.CAT 2024 EligibilityBachelor's degreeCandidates having at least 50 per cent marks or equivalent CGPA; 45 per cent marks in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), and Persons with Disability (PwD) categories are eligible for appearing in the exam. Candidates appearing for the final year of the Bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results can also apply. CAT 2024: Steps to applyRegister to generate a unique user ID and password. Log in with the generated user ID and password to fill in the application form. Submit the application form after entering details and making online payment to complete the registration and application process. During registration, the mobile number and email address provided by the domestic candidates will be verified through an OTP sent to that mobile number and email address. Once the OTP is verified, the user ID and the password will be sent to the registered email address and to the registered mobile number to complete the registration process.

Overseas candidates will receive the OTP on their email address only. Once the payment is made and the application form is submitted, applicants will not be allowed to make any changes. Seat reservationAs requirements, 15 per cent of the seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC) candidates. Around 7.5 per cent for Scheduled Tribe (ST) candidates, 27 per cent of the seats are reserved for Other Backward Classes candidates belonging to the 'non-creamy' layer (NC-OBC). Up to 10 per cent of the seats are reserved for Economically Weaker Sections candidates.Exam patternThe exam will include three sections: data interpretation and logical reasoning, verbal and reading comprehension, and quantitative aptitude. The question paper will feature two types of questions: multiplechoice questions (MCQs) and type-in-theanswer (TITA), with a total score of 198 marks. For those pursuing an MBA, there are 21 IIMs and over 1,000 other MBA institutions that accept CAT scores. Notable non-IIM Bschools include FMS Delhi, SJMSoM IIT Mumbai, MDI Gurgaon, DoMS IIT Delhi, and SPJIMR Mumbai.



Canada to Introduce 24-Hour Work Limit for International **Students This Fall: IRCC**

Canada's Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) has announced that a new rule limiting international students to 24 hours of work per week will come into effect later this fall.

The IRCC issued a reminder on its official X account (formerly Twitter): "Eligible full-time students working off-campus can currently work up to 20 hours per week while classes are in session. A new rule to extend this limit to 24 hours per week is expected to take effect later this fall, as previously announced."

Back in May 2024, Minister of Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship, Marc Miller, announced the change, increasing the weekly work limit for international students from 20 hours to 24 hours.

The policy allowing students to work more than 20 hours per week off-campus ended on April 30. However, students on a scheduled academic break are still permitted to work unlimited hours.

This change aims to help international students prioritize their academic success while maintaining the opportunity to work part-time. "International students come to

Maharashtra Sees an 80% Surge in Accredited Colleges Assam Combines SEBA and AHSEC to Create Unified **Amid Push for Higher Educational Standards**

Maharashtra has witnessed a remarkable 80% increase in the number of accredited colleges since July last year, thanks to concerted efforts by the state's Higher and Technical Education Department to elevate the quality of higher education. As of July 2023, the number of colleges accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in the state has surged from 1,168 to 2,108, reflecting a significant push for accreditation in recent months.

A major factor driving this increase has been the state's initiative to link various benefits, including the ability to start new courses and divisions, to colleges obtaining accreditation. This move has especially encouraged many institutions to seek accreditation for the first time. Over 50% of these colleges are in their first cycle of NAAC accreditation, showcasing a newfound commitment to maintaining educational standards across the state.

Accreditation efforts in Maharashtra are not limited to NAAC, which accredits general colleges; technical institutions are also being urged to have their specific programs evaluated by the National Board of Accreditation (NBA). While NAAC focuses on assessing overall institutional quality, the NBA assesses technical courses offered at these institutions. Maharashtra currently leads the nation with the highest number of accredited colleges, significantly ahead of Karnataka, which ranks second with 858 accredited institutions.

The state's proactive measures began in March 2022 when the Higher and Technical Education Department mandated colleges to seek accreditation immediately or risk losing their affiliation. Additionally, the government has made NAAC accreditation a prerequisite for obtaining permission to start new programs, divisions, or postgraduate sections. For example, several law colleges were recently denied approval to launch LLM programs because they had not yet attained accreditation. Historically, law colleges in Maharashtra had not been accredited by NAAC, making this a new and significant shift. The manual for assessing legal education by NAAC is a recent development, and the state now boasts 25 accredited law colleges offering undergraduate degrees, with 12 institutions offering postgraduate programs.

An official from the state government emphasized that the push for accreditation aligns with the goals outlined in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, which aims to enhance the quality of higher education institutions across the country. "Accreditation is now tied to several benefits, such as launching new courses and expanding divisions. Additionally, we have seen an increase in colleges seeking NBA accreditation for their technical programs. Moving forward, the government intends to encourage even

broader participation in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF). While many state universities are already part of the NIRF, more focus will be placed on encouraging individual colleges to participate," the official stated.

This year, 545 colleges across Maharashtra participated in the NIRF, with 79 of them located in Mumbai. The participation in this national ranking system is expected to grow as more institutions understand the advantages of being ranked and recognized at the national

NAAC Chairman Anil Sahasrabudhe attributed the significant increase in accredited colleges to the proactive efforts of the Maharashtra government. "The substantial rise in accreditation numbers is primarily because the baseline was initially low. However, the government's push and the issuance of clear guidelines last year have had a positive impact. Wherever state governments have taken similar proactive measures, we have seen a corresponding increase in accredited institutions," he explained. Sahasrabudhe also noted that a large number of colleges across the country remain unaccredited, but he is hopeful that upcoming reforms will change

NAAC is preparing to introduce a new binary accreditation system, which will classify colleges as either "accredited" or "nonaccredited" without assigning them specific grades. This change is expected to encourage more colleges to seek accreditation, as it removes the fear of receiving a low grade, which has historically deterred some institutions from undergoing the evaluation

In conclusion, Maharashtra's focus on pushing colleges to seek accreditation and improve the quality of education aligns with the broader goals of the NEP 2020. The state has set a benchmark for others to follow, and with the introduction of new accreditation systems, the future looks promising for higher education across India.

Tamil Nadu School Education Department Agrees to **Exempt Elementary Teachers from EMIS Work**

The Tamil Nadu School Education Department held discussions with members of the Tamil Nadu Elementary Teachers Organisations-Joint Action Committee (TETO-JAC) following the committee's announcement of a protest for 31 demands, scheduled to begin on Tuesday.

During the talks, the department agreed to several demands, including relieving elementary teachers from Educational Management Information System (EMIS) duties and reducing the frequency of online assessments for elementary school students.

Despite these concessions, TETO-JAC leaders stated that a final decision on the protest is still pending. "We will engage in further discussions with education department officials and decide on our next steps," said a TETO-JAC representative.

The department provided a status update on 12 demands, stating that six had been fulfilled, two are under government consideration, two are delayed due to ongoing court cases, and one is awaiting a committee's report. A TETO-JAC member explained that although administrators were previously appointed to pay-related issues for headmasters who were handle EMIS tasks, they had not been promoted to graduate teachers. These maintaining the system in nearby primary schools. The department has now committed in writing to addressing these issues.

Additionally, the online assessments for Classes 1 to 5, previously held weekly, will now take place monthly. The department has also resolved longstanding headmasters had experienced discrepancies in their salaries after their promotions, but the matter has now been addressed to their satisfaction. Furthermore, the government is currently considering a proposal to introduce incentives and promotions for teachers who have pursued and completed higher education qualifications. Government to Offer EAPCET, NEET, and JEE Coaching for Junior College Students

The state government has approved the Department of Higher Education's initiative to conduct coaching classes for government junior college students preparing for competitive exams such as the Engineering Agricultural and Pharmacy Common Entrance Test (EAPCET), National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET), and Joint Entrance Examination (JEE).

In an order issued by Principal Secretary for Education, Burra Venkatesham, it was confirmed that these coaching classes will commence in the current academic year, providing students with much-needed support to excel in these entrance exams.

Establishment of Academic Guidance, Training, and Placement Cell (AGTPC)

In a separate development, the government has also established an Academic Guidance, Training, and Placement Cell (AGTPC) to enhance the overall academic framework. As per an order issued last week, AGTPC will take on specific responsibilities, including preparing academic calendars, conducting academic audits, and maintaining databases of staff, students, and courses for each institution. The cell will also monitor the introduction of new courses, plan

projects, and organize science exhibitions and field tours aimed at identifying and nurturing student talents.

Focus on Skill Development and Placements

The AGTPC's training, placement, and skill development wing will play a crucial role in organizing coaching classes for competitive exams, industry-institute meetings, and placement initiatives. It will also manage job fairs, MoUs, and fundraising activities, contributing to student training and placement opportunities.

Government Approves Staffing for AGTPC

To facilitate smooth operations at AGTPC, the government has granted permission for the Director of Intermediate Education to assign junior lecturers and data entry operators on an "onduty" basis until permanent staff are appointed. Three posts for junior lecturers—one for the general stream and two for the vocational stream—will be created, along with three data entry operator positions at the office of the Director of Intermediate Education.

This comprehensive initiative reflects the government's commitment to enhancing education and career opportunities for junior college students across the state.

Applications in Physics

- Physics is one of the primary fields where vectors play a significant role in representing and analyzing physical quantities. Several important concepts in physics involve vectors to describe forces, movements, and fields:
- Force and Motion: In mechanics, vectors are used to represent forces acting on objects. For example, when multiple forces act on a single object, such as gravity pulling it downward and friction acting against its motion, vectors help in determining the net force and resulting acceleration. By using vector addition, engineers and physicists can predict the object's movement or whether it will remain stationary.
- Velocity and Acceleration: Both velocity (speed with direction) and acceleration (change in velocity) are vector quantities. In real-life scenarios like car driving, airplanes flying, or sports activities, it's important to know not only how fast something is moving but also in which direction. Vectors allow for accurate calculations and analysis of these movements.
- Projectile Motion: In projectile motion, like the path of a thrown ball, vectors represent the components of the object's velocity both horizontally and vertically. This allows physicists to predict how far the object will travel, how high it will go, and when it will land.
- Electromagnetism: Vectors are used to represent electric and magnetic fields in electromagnetism. For instance, the direction and strength of electric fields around charged particles are described by electric field vectors. Similarly, magnetic fields are described using magnetic field vectors, which help in understanding the behavior of charges in the presence of magnetic forces.

Applications in Geometry

- 1. Representation of Points, Lines, and Planes
- Points: A point in space can be represented as a position vector from the origin. For instance, a point P(x,y,z)P(x,y,z)P(x,y,z) can be expressed as the vector $OP = \langle x,y,z \rangle \vee (OP) = \langle x,z,z \rangle \vee ($

This concept is essential in understanding angles between lines, planes, or surfaces in geometric spaces.

- Perpendicularity: Two vectors are perpendicular (orthogonal) if their dot product is zero, which is often used to check whether lines or planes are perpendicular.
- 4. Cross Product and Area
- Area of a Triangle: The area of a triangle formed by two vectors a vec {a}a and b vec {b}b can be found using the magnitude of their cross product: Area=12|a×b|vec {a} \times vec {b}|Area=21|a×b|


Figure reasoning is often overlooked in exam preparation, despite its importance. It involves skills like inference, visualization, and spatial understanding. In the "Completion of Figures" test, candidates are presented with incomplete drawings or figures that have missing parts.

This type of test assesses cognitive abilities such as attention to detail, observational skills, perception, and imagination. It covers key concepts like spatial awareness, orientation, visualization, and mental imagery.

In a non-verbal reasoning test focused on figure completion, candidates must use their powers of observation and analytical thinking to identify and fill in missing geometric shapes. This typically involves identifying gaps in incomplete drawings and connecting the shapes or lines in a logical manner.


These geometric shapes form the basis for solving various types of reasoning problems, and success in this test depends on the candidate's ability to visualize and complete the figure correctly.

Example -1 Identify the missing part of the given figure and select it from given answer figures.




Solution: (b) Here, all the three equal parts have similar design, if rotated in clockwise direction. So, we can obtain the answer figure for the missing portion by rotating the question figure by 90° clockwise.

Now, by comparing figure (X) with (X'), we get




Now, it is quite clear that option (c) will fill the incomplete part of the question figure (X). After completion, the figure will be look like




- <u>Note:</u> 1. In some of the questions, the correct option for the missing figure can be given in any rotated from, so candidate can rotate the figures to clock the correctness of option.
 - If answer figures contain similar figure but in rotated forms, then the correct answer figure is that figure which can be substituted at the missing part with least change in orientation.

Example - 3 Which of the answer figures given will complete the pattern of the question figure?



Solution: (b) Here, all the three equal parts have similar design, if rotated in clockwise direction. So, we can obtain the answer figure for the missing portion by rotating the question figure (X) by 90° in clockwise direction.



Clearly, option figure (b) completes the original figure which looks like as shown in the below figure



JNV-AT(Arithmetic Test)

Operations on Fractions

Fractions represent parts of a whole, and performing operations on fractions involves basic arithmetic functions like addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. Here's a breakdown of how to handle these operations:

- 1. Addition of Fractions
- To add fractions, they must have a common denominator (the bottom number of the fraction).
- If the denominators are different, find the least common denominator (LCD) and adjust the fractions accordingly.
- Once they share a common denominator, add the numerators (the top numbers) while keeping the denominator the same.
- 2. Subtraction of Fractions
- Like addition, fractions must share the same denominator before subtracting.
- If the denominators are different, convert them to the least common denominator.
- Subtract the numerators while keeping the denominator the same.

Example 1: Find $\frac{1}{8} + \frac{3}{5}$.

Solution:

Let's use equivalent fractions to rewrite the fractions with a common denominator.

8 is not a multiple of 5, so let us rewrite each fraction with a denominator which is LCM of 8 and 5 which can be found as :

$$8 \times 5 = 40$$

$$\frac{1}{8} + \frac{3}{5} = \frac{5}{40} + \frac{24}{40} \quad \text{Rewrite } \frac{1}{8} \text{ as } \frac{1 \times 5}{8 \times 5} = \frac{5}{40} \text{ and } \frac{3}{5} \text{ as } \frac{3 \times 8}{5 \times 8} = \frac{24}{40}$$

$$= \frac{5 + 24}{40} \quad \text{Solve } 5 + 24$$

$$= \frac{29}{40}$$

Example 2; Find $\frac{6}{7} - \frac{3}{4}$.

Solution

Let's use equivalent fractions to rewrite the fractions with a common denominator.

7 is not a multiple of 4, so let us rewrite each fraction with a denominator which is LCM of 7 and 4 which can be found as

$$7 \times 4 = 28$$

$$\frac{6}{7} - \frac{3}{4} = \frac{24}{28} - \frac{21}{28}$$
 Rewrite $\frac{6}{7}$ as $\frac{6\times4}{7\times4} = \frac{24}{28}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ as $\frac{3\times7}{4\times7} = \frac{21}{28}$

$$= \frac{24-21}{28}$$
 Solve $24-21$

- 3. Multiplication of Fractions
- Multiplication is straightforward: multiply the numerators together and multiply the denominators together.
- Simplify the fraction if possible.
- 4. Division of Fractions
- To divide fractions, multiply the first fraction by the reciprocal of the second fraction (flip the numerator and denominator of the second fraction).
- Simplify the resulting fraction if necessary.

Find: $\frac{1}{7} \times \frac{3}{4}$

Solution:

$$\frac{1}{7} \times \frac{3}{4} = \frac{1 \times 3}{7 \times 4}$$
 Multiply the numerator to the numerator and denominator to the denominator.
$$= \frac{3}{28}$$

When we divide a fraction by another, we need to multiply the dividend with the reciprocal of the divisor. We can observe the method of writing the reciprocal with this explanation.

Reciprocal of $\frac{a}{b}$ is $\frac{b}{a}$ For example: Reciprocal of $\frac{3}{7}$ is $\frac{7}{3}$ and Reciprocal of $\frac{9}{13}$ is $\frac{13}{9}$ If we notice closely the product of the fraction and its reciprocal is 1. For example: $\frac{3}{7} \times \frac{7}{3} = 1$ and $\frac{9}{13} \times \frac{13}{9} = 1$.

Note: Reciprocals are also called multiplicative inverses.

Now, let us see how reciprocals are used to perform division of fractions. Here are some examples
