Goa Medical College will now have 200 MBBS seats from this year

The National Medical Commission (NMC) has approved an increase in MBBS seats at Goa Medical College and Hospital (GMCH) to 200 for the academic year 2024-25, according to state Health Minister Vishwajit Rane. Previously, GMCH, the largest government hospital in Goa, had approval for 150 MBBS seats.

In a media statement, Rane highlighted that this expansion, from 150 to 200 seats, is a significant milestone in GMCH's journey to provide high-quality medical education and healthcare services. This increase in capacity will enable more students to pursue medical education, helping to meet the growing demand for skilled healthcare professionals in the region.

Additionally, the NMC has approved the expansion of several postgraduate MD/MS programs at GMCH. The number of seats for MD (Radiodiagnosis) has been increased from 6 to 7, MS (General Surgery) from 6 to 15, MS (Obstetrics and Gynaecology) from 6 to 8, MD (Pharmacology) from 4 to 6, and MD (Paediatrics) from 7 to 10. Rane emphasized that these increases reflect the government's commitment to promoting medical excellence and addressing the healthcare needs of Goa and the surrounding regions.

RBI Clarifies: OCI Cardholders Eligible for Education Australian Universities Divided Over Cap on International Loans for Studies Abroad if Residing in India

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has informed banks that Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) cardholders residing in India are eligible for education loans to pursue studies abroad. This clarification came after lenders sought guidance on the Model Education Loan Scheme.

According to sources, the RBI's response, issued last month, also specified that OCI cardholders living outside India can only secure education loans from Indian banks for studies within India. The matter was addressed after concerns were raised about the applicability of the Liberalised Remittance Scheme (LRS) for OCI borrowers residing in

A banking executive explained that there was uncertainty over whether loans granted to OCIs in India should fall under LRS, which allows resident individuals to remit up to \$250,000 per financial year for permissible loans granted to OCIs is not available. transactions, including

Visa Challenges in Key Destinations:

Canada: In 2024, student visas are capped at 360,000, a 35% reduction from 2023. Proof of living expenses has increased to \$20,635, and staffing shortages in consulates are delaying processing. The approval rate was 72% in

USA: Approval rates have dipped to 64% for F-1 visas in 2023 from 74.6% in 2019. Stringent interviews and limited slots are also complicating the process.

UK: Although the visa approval rate was 98% in 2023, stricter rules regarding financial proof and dependents, along with high application fees, make it tougher for students.

Australia: Recent policy changes have increased visa fees to AUD 1,600, and the approval process has become more rigid, especially for English language and financial requirements. Visa rejection rates hover around 15%.

Germany: Though Germany has a 90% visa approval rate, the processing time has lengthened, and the financial requirement for blocked accounts is now EUR 11,208.

Student Enrollments for 2025

Australia has announced a cap on international student enrollments, limiting the number to 2.70 lakh by 2025. The decision, aimed at controlling migration levels, has sparked controversy among universities, students, and other stakeholders.

In a report titled "Migration Strategy," released by the Australian government in December 2023, it was noted that migration levels are set to return to near pre-pandemic figures by the next financial year. During the pandemic, migration had sharply declined, but with the reopening of borders, there was a significant influx of both temporary and permanent migrants, temporarily boosting numbers.

For the period from January to May 2024, 7,17,587 international students were studying in Australia, marking an 18% increase from the previous year. However, post-pandemic growth in international education has partly been attributed to non-genuine students and questionable education providers exploiting related visa concessions like unrestricted work hours for international students.

In response, the Australian government decided to impose a limit on the number of incoming international students each year. This move has received mixed reactions. Some universities, such as the University of Melbourne, have criticized the cap, arguing that it diverts attention from more pressing issues in the education sector. Vice-Chancellor Professor Duncan Maskell expressed strong opposition, stating, "The University remains firmly against the cap on international student enrollments. It is astonishing that this debate continues while major reforms, such as abolishing Job Ready Graduates and improving teaching funding, are ignored." He also called for greater focus on research funding reforms, pointing out that universities are forced to subsidize both teaching

and research.

International students play a crucial role in Australia's economy, contributing \$30 billion annually, making education the country's fourth-largest export. They also fill vital roles in the labor market, particularly in retail and hospitality, and represent the largest segment of Australia's temporary migration system after New Zealand citizens.

Some Indian students studying in Australia fear that the cap may create an unwelcoming environment. A second-year Management student in Melbourne said, "When I arrived a year ago, Australia seemed very open to international students because they needed us for their workforce and economy. Now, with the post-Covid recovery, are we no longer welcome?" Despite these concerns, he noted that locals remain friendly toward international

On the other hand, some experts see the cap as a positive change. University of Wollongong's Interim Vice-Chancellor, Professor John Dewar, believes the new system will be fairer for international students, replacing a visa process that had become burdensome.

However, prospective students like 17-year-old Rudraaksh from Harvana are reconsidering their options. "I've applied to several Australian universities for next year, but now I'm thinking of applying to New Zealand as a backup," he said.

Universities are making efforts to reassure prospective students. Dr. Stacey Farraway, Deputy Vice-Chancellor of La Trobe University, emphasized that they are continuing with their usual enrollment process despite the proposed changes.

While Indian students hope the cap will not have significant consequences, some worry about its long-term impact. One recent graduate remarked, "This is how things started changing in Canada and the UK, leading to more hesitation in studying there. We hope Australia doesn't follow the same path."

The School Education Department has agreed to meet approximately 12 demands put forward by the Tamil Nadu Elementary Organisations-Joint Teachers Action Committee (TETO-JAC).

In a recent press release, it was noted that TETO-JAC had presented a total of 31 demands to the department and had conducted protests to advocate for these changes. They had planned a State-wide protest on September 10 in various districts, followed by a three-day demonstration in Chennai starting September 29. To avert these protests, the department has conceded to several of the demands.

Among the concessions, the department has appointed 6,000 administrators to handle data entry tasks previously managed

by teachers. These administrators will oversee certificates, attendance, and administrative work, which had previously taken time away from teaching. They will also be responsible for the primary schools in their vicinity.

Additional agreements include conducting Ennum Ezhuthum assessments on a weekly basis instead of daily, and not requiring teachers to act as facilitators for various training events unless they volunteer. The department also committed to not disciplining teachers who participated in the JACTO-GEO protest of 2019. Furthermore, it was agreed that School Management Committee meetings can be held as needed rather than mandatorily once a month.

Education Launched by Ministry of Education

The Ministry of Education has introduced the National Scheme of Incentive to Girls for Secondary Education to encourage the enrollment of girls aged 14 to 18 years at the secondary level. The scheme targets girls who have completed class 8 but may drop out due to socio-economic challenges, with the aim of retaining them in school until class 12.

In the academic year 2004-05, the dropout rate for girls was alarmingly high, with 50.8% leaving school between classes 1 and 8, and 64% dropping out by class 10. The initiative seeks to address this issue by offering financial support to help parents afford the cost of their daughters' education.

Scheme Benefits

Under this scheme, a sum of ₹3000/- will be deposited in a term or fixed deposit account in a public sector bank or post office in the name of each eligible girl. The deposit will mature when the girl reaches 18 years of age, and no premature withdrawal is permitted.

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for the scheme:

The applicant must be a girl child.

She must belong to a Scheduled Caste (SC) or Scheduled Tribe (ST).

She must have passed class 8 from a Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV), regardless of caste or tribe.

She must be enrolled in class 9 in a State/UT Government, Government-aided, or local body school from the academic year 2008-09 onwards.

Exclusions

Married girls.

Vectors are an essential mathematical tool used to represent quantities that have both magnitude (size) and direction. This unique property of vectors makes them invaluable in various fields, where it is important to understand not just how much of something exists, but also in which direction it acts. Let's delve deeper into the practical applications of vectors across different domains, particularly in physics, engineering, computer science, and more.

Applications in Physics

- Physics is one of the primary fields where vectors play a significant role in representing and analyzing physical quantities. Several important concepts in physics involve vectors to describe forces, movements, and fields:
- Force and Motion: In mechanics, vectors are used to represent forces acting on objects. For example, when multiple forces act on a single object, such as gravity pulling it downward and friction acting against its motion, vectors help in determining the net force and resulting acceleration. By using vector addition, engineers and physicists can predict the object's movement or whether it will remain stationary.
- Velocity and Acceleration: Both velocity (speed with direction) and acceleration (change in velocity) are vector quantities. In real-life scenarios like car driving, airplanes flying, or sports activities, it's important to know not only how fast something is moving but also in which direction. Vectors allow for accurate calculations and analysis of these movements.
- Projectile Motion: In projectile motion, like the path of a thrown ball, vectors represent the components of the object's velocity both horizontally and vertically. This allows physicists to predict how far the object will travel, how high it will go, and when it will land.
- Electromagnetism: Vectors are used to represent electric and magnetic fields in electromagnetism. For instance, the direction and strength of electric fields around charged particles are described by electric field vectors. Similarly, magnetic fields are described using magnetic field vectors, which help in understanding the behavior of charges in the presence of magnetic forces.

Applications in Geometry

- 1. Representation of Points, Lines, and Planes
- Points: A point in space can be represented as a position vector from the origin. For instance, a point P(x,y,z)P(x,y,z) can be expressed as the vector $OP = \langle x,y,z \rangle \vee \langle OP \rangle = \langle x,y,z \rangle$ where OOO is the origin.
- Planes: A plane in 3D can be represented using the normal vector.
