The Indian Institutes of Management (IIM) opened the CAT 2024 application correction window on September 27, 2024. Candidates who wish to make changes to their Common Admission Test (CAT) 2024 application form can do so via the official IIM CAT website at [iimcat.ac.in](http://iimcat.ac.in). Applicants have until September 30, 2024, to make edits to their photograph, signature, and city preferences. This option is only available to those who successfully completed their registration and paid the application fee within the given timeline. As per the official announcement, the edit window is open from September 27 (10:00 AM) to September 30 (5:00 PM), 2024. How to Make Changes in the CAT 2024 Application Form:

- The CAT 2024 admit card will be available starting November 5, with the exam scheduled for November 24, 2024. The test will be conducted in three sessions across approximately 170 cities, and candidates can select up to five preferred cities.

Along with the application submission, the payment window for the application fee will also close by the end of the day.

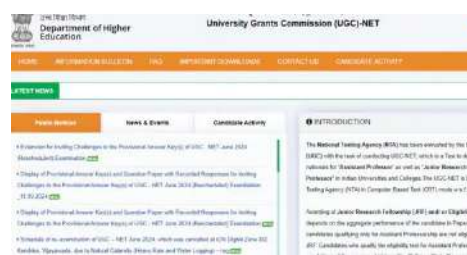

  - The exam will be conducted in various test centers, and candidates must ensure they have selected their preferred center while applying

## Rhodes Trust Introduces Sixth Scholarship for Indian Students

The Rhodes Trust, in partnership with the Radhakrishnan-Rajan family, has announced the addition of a sixth Rhodes Scholarship exclusively for Indian students. The first scholar under this new scheme is expected to commence studies at the University of Oxford in 2026, bringing the total number of annual scholarships available to Indian applicants to six.

Eligibility Criteria for the Rhodes Scholarship Applicants must be Indian citizens, holding an Indian passport or valid proof of Indian citizenship.

Candidates must have completed at least four of the last ten years of formal education at an Indian institution and must either:

Have completed a school-leaving examination (10th or 12th grade) at a school in India, or Be in the final year of, or have completed, an undergraduate degree at a university in India.

For medical students or doctors who are currently completing or have finished their one-year internship (CRR), the age limit is extended by one year.

Eligible candidates can apply for the scholarship via the Rhodes Trust website at [www.rhodeshouse.ox.ac.uk](http://www.rhodeshouse.ox.ac.uk) under the scholarships section. The application must include the following documents:

Birth certificate confirming the applicant's age eligibility.

A valid passport copy (with translation, if necessary) to confirm citizenship.

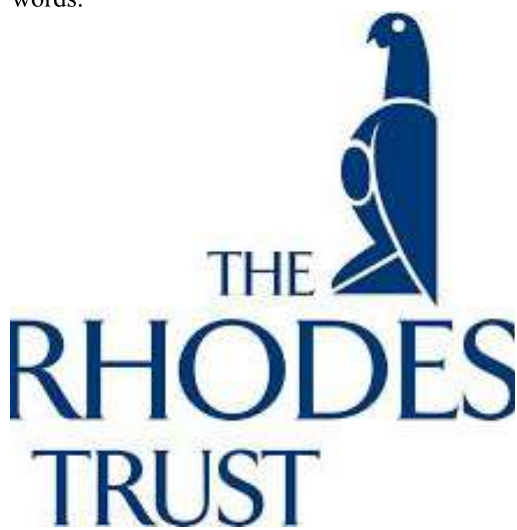
An official transcript from the applicant's university, detailing academic performance.

If the candidate is not a graduate or in the final year of undergraduate studies in India, proof of formal study at an Indian institution for at least four of the last ten years, as well as evidence of a completed school-leaving exam (10th or 12th standard), is required.

A comprehensive curriculum vitae (CV) listing academic achievements, leadership roles, work experience, involvement in extracurricular activities, and accomplishments in cultural, musical, or sporting fields.

A recent color photograph (head-and-shoulders) in jpg format.

A personal statement not exceeding 1,000 words.



## Maharashtra Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis Accelerates Approval of Foreign Scholarships for OBC Students

In a significant step to support students from backward classes, 75 deserving students from Maharashtra have been awarded scholarships to pursue higher education abroad for the 2024-25 academic year. The state government issued this decision on September 26.

After representatives from OBC organizations raised the issue with Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, an immediate meeting was held, and eligible students were selected. Under Fadnavis' leadership, the approval process was completed within three days, a decision that has been met with satisfaction by the OBC organizations.

The Foreign Scholarship Scheme, in place since 2019-20, is designed for meritorious students from VJNT, OBC, and SBC communities to pursue studies overseas. For the 2024-25 academic year, 75 scholarships were allocated. Applications for the scholarship were invited earlier in the year, and the Directorate of OBC Welfare, led by its director, formed a committee

to meticulously review and address any discrepancies in the applications. The list of eligible candidates was finalized and submitted on September 10.

Following this, a second committee headed by the Principal Secretary of the OBC Welfare Department met on September 23 and finalized the selection of 75 students. These students, from various academic disciplines, will now pursue their higher education at prestigious international universities.

Along with the scholarship approval, the government emphasized that students are expected to use their acquired knowledge and skills for national service upon completion of their studies. Recipients are required to sign an agreement committing to this.

This scholarship program is a significant opportunity for OBC students, aiding their academic and professional development abroad. The OBC organizations have expressed their appreciation for the swift and positive action taken by the state government.

### 3. GRE (Graduate Programs)

Required for many master's and doctoral programs, especially in the US and Canada, the GRE tests analytical, verbal, and quantitative skills. When to take it: At least 6 months before application deadlines.

### 4. GMAT (Business Programs)

If you're planning to pursue an MBA or other business-related graduate degrees, the GMAT is essential. It evaluates your analytical, writing, and reasoning skills. When to take it: 6-12 months before the application submission.

In a landmark decision that will positively impact hundreds of visually impaired students, the Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC) has waived the 65% minimum marks requirement for blind students under two major educational aid schemes.

This change follows years of advocacy by disability rights groups, particularly the Prahar Organization, which had been pushing for more inclusive policies. The PMC operates two key educational aid programs for meritorious students in grades 10 and 12: the Lokshahir Annabhau Sathe Educational Assistance Scheme and the Bharat Ratna Abul Kalam Azad Educational Assistance Scheme. Previously, these schemes required students to achieve a minimum of 65% marks to qualify for the aid, which was a significant hurdle for many blind students.

The PMC's Social Development Department has now proposed eliminating this marks requirement for blind students, ensuring that all who pass their exams can access the scholarships. For other students with disabilities,

including those who are deaf, mute, or physically handicapped, the marks requirement has been reduced from 65% to 55%, offering them greater access to these schemes.

Under these programs, grade 10 students receive ₹15,000, while those in grade 12 are awarded ₹25,000. Eligibility criteria differ across general, backward classes, and disabled student categories. The revised proposal, which is awaiting final approval from the Standing Committee, is expected to benefit a larger number of students, especially those who are fully blind and face considerable academic challenges.

Annually, around 5,500 to 6,000 students benefit from these schemes, but with the removal of the marks requirement, this number is expected to rise significantly. As a result, the PMC anticipates a doubling of the financial outlay for these programs and is seeking additional funding through green bonds and other sources to accommodate the expanded beneficiary base, including adult learners.

## ICSE Extends Mathematics Exam Duration to Three Hours Starting 2025, No Change in Paper Format

The Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE) has announced a key change for the ICSE (Class 10) Mathematics examination, extending the exam duration from 2.5 hours to 3 hours, beginning in 2025. This extension will provide students with more time to complete the 80-mark paper, as part of efforts to reduce exam-related stress and improve the quality of assessments.

Previously, the duration of the Mathematics paper was set at 2.5 hours, while the majority of other subjects, excluding second languages, have a two-hour exam window. The second language exams are also three hours long. However, with this revision, Mathematics will now join the list of subjects with an extended exam time, giving students an additional 30 minutes to solve the paper.

The council officially communicated this decision through a circular addressed to the heads of affiliated schools, confirming that the extended time frame is aimed at accommodating the increasing weightage of competency-based questions. These questions are designed to evaluate not just the students' memorisation skills, but also their problem-solving abilities and understanding of mathematical concepts.

Joseph Emmanuel, the Chief Executive and Secretary of CISCE, elaborated on the change in an official statement to the media, explaining that the move was made to maintain standardised timings across all subjects and ensure a more balanced assessment process. "With the inclusion of more competency-focused questions in the curriculum, the extended duration allows students to better manage their time during the exam, reducing stress and ensuring they can demonstrate their full understanding of the subject matter," Emmanuel said.

Despite

the extension, CISCE has confirmed that there will be no alterations to the number of questions or the overall structure of the Mathematics paper for the 2025 exams. Students can expect the same format as in previous years, which includes a mix of short-answer and long-answer questions aimed at testing a range of mathematical skills.

The council's decision is part of a broader push to refine the evaluation process and reduce the pressure on students during high-stakes exams. Extending the exam duration is seen as a practical step towards achieving this, as it allows students to approach the paper with a clearer focus and more time to work through complex problems.

While the mathematics paper is the primary subject to see an increase in duration for the 2025 exams, CISCE has indicated that this could be part of a wider trend to reassess exam timings across various subjects, as the education system in India continues to shift towards competency-based learning. By providing more time for these critical subjects, the council hopes to encourage a deeper understanding of the material and a fairer assessment of student abilities.

This change is expected to positively impact thousands of ICSE students nationwide, who now have the opportunity to demonstrate their mathematical knowledge and skills with reduced time pressure. Schools and educators have largely welcomed the decision, viewing it as a step in the right direction for reducing exam stress while maintaining academic standards.

## CBSE Makes CCTV Mandatory in Exam Halls, 44 Lakh Students to Appear in 2025

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has mandated the installation of CCTV cameras in all exam centres for the upcoming Class 10 and 12 board examinations in 2025. This move aims to enhance the integrity and fairness of the exam process. Approximately 44 lakh students are expected to take the exams across India and 26 other countries. Around 8,000 schools will be designated as exam centres to accommodate this large number of candidates.

The CBSE has developed a detailed CCTV policy outlining the requirements for camera placement and coverage within exam halls. Schools lacking CCTV systems will be required to install them in line with the guidelines. This initiative is part of CBSE's broader effort to ensure transparency, prevent cheating, and maintain a safe environment for students.

The board exams for the 2024-25 academic session will begin on February 15, 2025, with the official date sheet expected to be released on December 12, 2024. Students can download the date sheet in PDF format from the official CBSE website (cbse.gov.in).

As in previous years, separate date sheets for practical exams will also be released. Practical exams for Class 10 will be conducted by school instructors, while an external examiner will oversee practicals for Class 12.

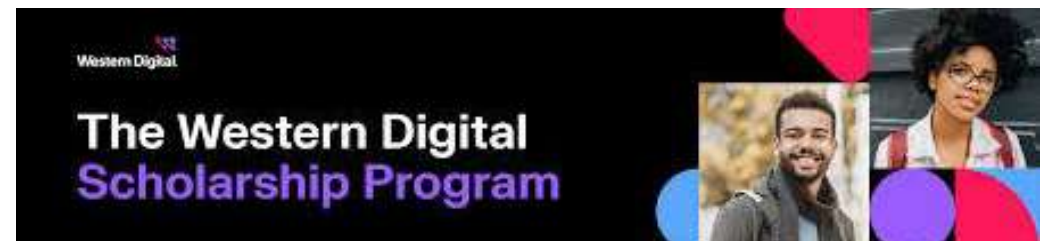

### Factors and Multiples

#### What are Factors?

A factor of a number is an exact divisor of that number, meaning it divides the number completely without leaving a remainder. In simple terms, if one number (the divisor) divides another number (the dividend) exactly, then the divisor is considered a factor of the dividend. Every number has at least two common factors: 1 and itself.

For example, 4 is a factor of 24 because 24 divided by 4 equals 6, leaving no remainder. Similarly, 6 is also a factor of 24. The complete list of factors of 24 includes 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 12, and 24.

If a natural number has only two factors, 1 and itself, it is called a prime number. For example, 2 is a prime number since its only factors are 1 and 2.

#### What are Multiples?

A multiple of a number is the result of multiplying that number by any natural number. For instance, the multiples of 2 are 2, 4, 6, 8, and so on, meaning they can be found in the multiplication table for 2.

#### Examples of multiples:

- Multiples of 2: 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, etc.
- Multiples of 3: 3, 6, 9, 12, 15, etc.
- Multiples of 5: 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, etc.

In the example  $3 \times 4 = 12$ , 3 and 4 are factors of 12, and 12 is a multiple of both 3 and 4.

The multiples of 20 are 20, 40, 60, 80, 100, 120, ...

Because

$$20 \times 1 = 20$$

$$20 \times 2 = 40,$$

$$20 \times 3 = 60$$

$$20 \times 4 = 80$$

$$20 \times 5 = 100, \text{ and so on}$$

#### Example 3

Find the factors of 36.

Solution: The factors of 36 are 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 9, 12, 18, and 36. These numbers divide 36 exactly without leaving any remainder.

#### Example 4

Find the multiples of 7.

Solution: The multiples of 7 are: 7, 14, 21, 28, 35, 42, 49, 56, 63, and so on. This is because:

$$\bullet 7 \times 1 = 7$$

$$\bullet 7 \times 2 = 14$$

$$\bullet 7 \times 3 = 21$$

$$\bullet 7 \times 4 = 28$$

$$\bullet 7 \times 5 = 35, \text{ and so on.}$$

#### Example 5

Find the multiples of 9.

Solution: The multiples of 9 are: 9, 18, 27, 36, 45, 54, 63, 72, 81, 90, and so on. This is calculated as:

$$\bullet 9 \times 1 = 9$$

$$\bullet 9 \times 2 = 18$$

$$\bullet 9 \times 3 = 27, \text{ and so forth.}$$

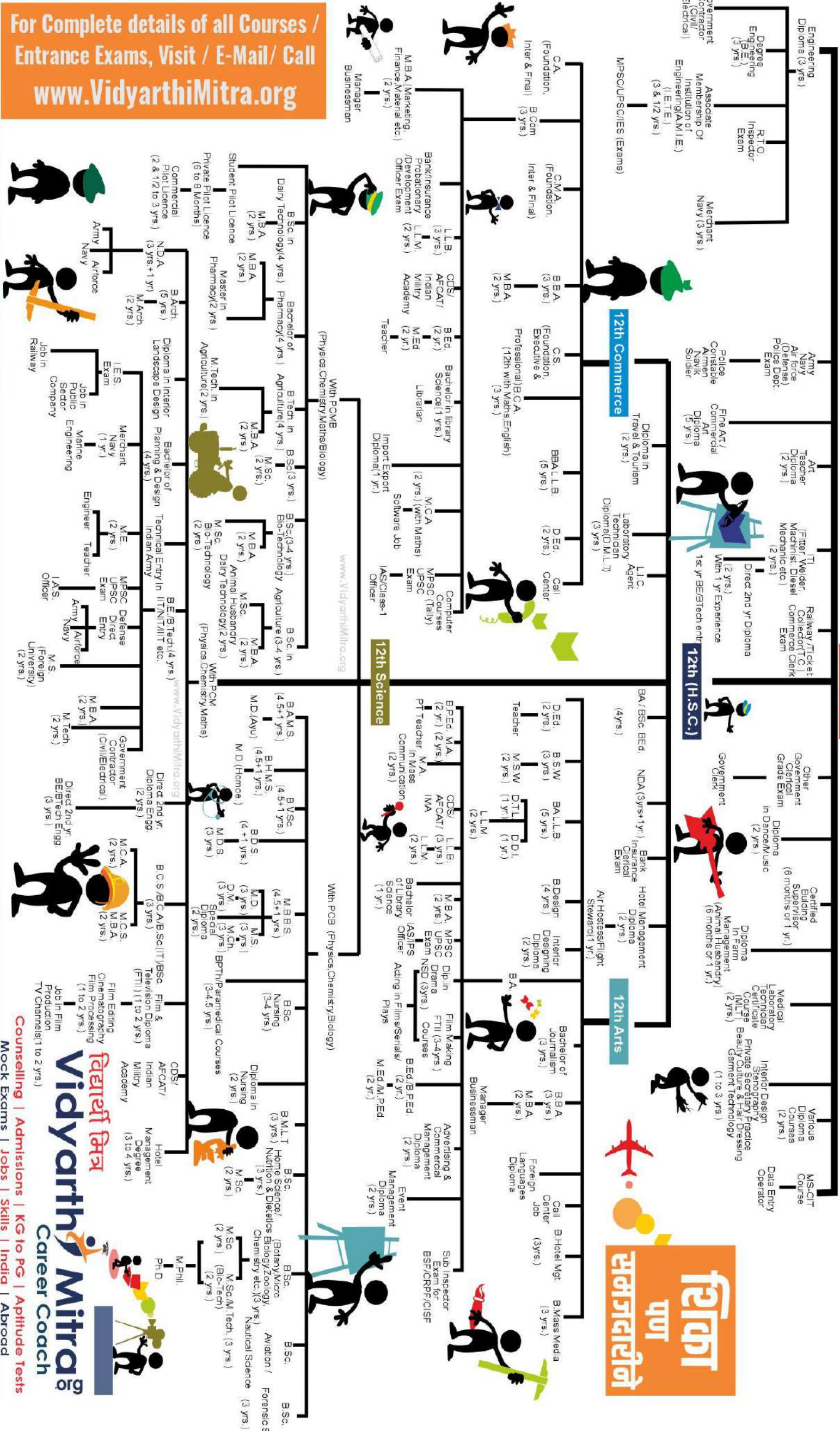
