GATE 2025 registration date extended, apply by October 11

The registration deadline for the Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) 2025 has been extended once again. Initially, the deadline was set for September 26, then pushed to October 3, and now it has been further extended to October 11, 2024. Candidates interested in appearing for GATE 2025 can complete their registration by visiting the official website gate2025.iitr.ac.in.

According to the official notice, this extension comes in response to several requests from applicants. The registration period will now remain open until 11:59 PM on October 11, 2024, but a late fee will apply. GATE 2025 is being conducted by IIT Roorkee and will take place in February 2025 as a computer-based test (CBT).



This year's exam includes 30 test papers, covering both full and sectional papers. The registration fee is Rs. 900 for female, SC, ST, and PwD candidates, while for other candidates, including foreign nationals, the fee is Rs. 1,800. Candidates who do not register by the October 11 deadline will have to wait until next year to apply.

UGC NET Results 2024: Websites to check scorecards

The University Grants Commission (UGC) is expected to announce the results of the National Eligibility Test (NET) 2024 June session re-exam soon. Once declared, candidates will be able to check their results on the official UGC NET website -ugcnet.nta.ac.in. To access the results, candidates must enter their application number and date of birth, along with the correct security code.

This year's June session of UGC NET was rescheduled and held between August 21 and September 4, 2024. Initially, the exam was scheduled for June 18 but was cancelled due to concerns about the paper being allegedly leaked on the darknet prior to the test. While the investigation suggested that the exam might have been compromised, it was later found that the leak had not occurred.

When the provisional answer keys were released, many candidates raised concerns, claiming that there were significant errors in the answer keys. Some disciplines reportedly had over 30 incorrect answers out of the 150 questions.UGC NET is conducted twice a year, in June and December, to determine the eligibility of Indian candidates for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF), Assistant Professorship, and PhD admissions across Indian universities. The exam consists of two papers—Paper 1, which is common to all

candidates, and Paper 2, which is subjectspecific, with 83 different papers—Paper 1, which is common to all candidates, and Paper 2, which is subject-specific, with 83 different subjects offered. These include languages such as Hindi, English, and Marathi, as well as subjects like labour welfare, communication, journalism, and more.

The total duration of the two papers is three hours, and both must be completed in a single session without any breaks. Candidates are asked a total of 150 multiple-choice questions, with 50 questions in Paper 1 and 100 questions in Paper 2. Notably, there is no negative marking in the exam.

Once the results are released, successful candidates will be eligible for positions in academic and research fields, including qualifying for JRF and Assistant Professorships in universities across India.



Govt to set up 10 new ESIC medical colleges

The Union government has announced a series of important decisions aimed at strengthening the infrastructure and medical services of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC). The Labour and Employment Ministry, in a recent meeting led by Minister Mansukh Mandaviya, revealed plans to establish 10 new ESIC medical colleges across India. This move aligns with the government's broader goal of creating 75,000 new medical seats over the next five years, a commitment made by Prime Minister Narendra Modi during his Independence Day speech in 2024.

In addition to this, the Atal Beemit Vyakti Kalyan Yojna (ABVKY), an unemployment allowance scheme for ESI Corporation members will be extended by another two years, from July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2026. The scheme, originally launched in 2018, provides financial assistance to insured individuals who are temporarily unemployed





Moreover, under a convergence program with Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY), medical care for ESIC beneficiaries will be expanded nationwide. Notably, ESIC beneficiaries will face no expenditure limit when receiving treatment in empanelled hospitals under PMJAY, ensuring wider access to healthcare services.

These decisions reflect the government's continuous effort to enhance healthcare accessibility for workers and strengthen social security measures. The combination of new medical colleges and extended unemployment benefits promises to improve the overall welfare of ESI members while contributing to the nation's healthcare infrastructure development.

Schools were previously instructed to submit accurate student data, including subject choices, and today marks the final day for submissions with the normal fee. Once the LOC is submitted, no changes to subjects will be allowed. Students will have the option to sit for the subjects listed in the LOC during the main exams, but CBSE will declare results according to the Examination Bye-Laws. Any subject changes will only be permitted after the main examinations, and students wishing to modify their subject choices will need to appear for the corrected subject during the Supplementary exams.

CBSE has directed school principals to obtain confirmation of the successful submission of the LOC to ensure compliance with the board's instructions. Additionally, the board has released a set of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) to help schools navigate the LOC submission process smoothly. Following the guidelines will ensure accurate LOC data, which is crucial for the efficient organization of the CBSE Class 10 and 12 Board Examinations for 2024-2025.
