## CAT Answer Key 2024 Live Updates: Where to check IIM CAT response sheet

The Indian Institutes of Management (IIM), Calcutta, has officially released the provisional answer key for the CAT 2024 exam. While the answer key link has yet to be made publicly available on the official CAT website ([iimcat.ac.in](http://iimcat.ac.in)), candidates have reported that they are able to access it through their individual login credentials on the portal. This is a crucial development for the 2.93 lakh candidates who appeared for the exam, as they now have the opportunity to verify their responses and calculate their probable scores.

### CAT 2024 Exam Overview

This year's Common Admission Test (CAT) included a total of 68 questions, divided across three sections. The Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension (VARC) section consisted of 24 questions, testing candidates' reading and comprehension skills, as well as their ability to understand and interpret written material. The Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning (DILR) section had 22 questions, challenging students on their ability to analyze complex data sets and solve problems logically. Lastly, the Quantitative Ability (QA) section, which also had 22 questions, focused on mathematical skills, including algebra, geometry, number systems, and other quantitative reasoning tasks.

### CAT 2024 Participation Statistics

This year, a total of 3.29 lakh candidates had registered for the exam, but only about 2.93 lakh candidates appeared for it. This reflects an impressive attendance rate of approximately 89%, according to the data shared on the official CAT website.

Among the candidates who took the exam, 1.07 lakh were female candidates, representing a significant proportion of the



test-takers. In contrast, 1.86 lakh were male candidates, while a small group of five transgender candidates also participated in the exam, highlighting the increasing inclusivity of the CAT process.

### Answer Key and Next Steps

With the provisional answer key now accessible, candidates can log in to their CAT accounts to compare their responses with the official answers provided. The answer key release is an important step in the admission process, as it allows candidates to estimate their performance and raise objections, if necessary, to any discrepancies or errors they might have noticed in the key. Candidates will typically have a limited window to submit objections, after which the final answer key will be released, and the results will be announced accordingly.

The CAT score is used for admission to various MBA programs offered by the IIMs, as well as other prestigious business schools across the country. Therefore, the release of the answer key is a pivotal moment in the admissions cycle, giving candidates a glimpse into their chances of securing a place at one of India's top management institutes.

## IIT Placement Process: A Timeline from Onboarding to Interviews in December

The IIT placement season officially kicks off on December 1, but the process actually begins months earlier, starting in July. For students planning to join an IIT in the coming years, here's a detailed guide to the placement procedure:

When does the placement process start?

Although the formal placement season starts in December, preparations begin as early as July. From July onwards, IITs begin onboarding companies for the upcoming recruitment cycle, followed by student registration in the second week of July. Students are required to submit their resumes by the third week of August.

- Pre-Placement Offers (PPOs): These are typically rolled out by mid-September.
- Recruitment Tests: The testing phase generally starts in the last week of September, followed by interviews beginning on December 1.

### Step-by-Step Breakdown of the IIT Placement Process:

1. Company Onboarding: The IIT placement office appoints a designated point of contact for each company and sends out invitations for participation in the placement season.
2. Company Registration: Recruiters interested in hiring can create an online account on the IIT placement portal to begin the registration process.
3. Payment of Registration Fee: Companies complete their registration by making the necessary payment as per the placement office's guidelines.
4. Job Posting: Once the payment is confirmed, companies can post job openings (or internships) on the IIT portal, including all relevant job details.
5. Verification of Job Details: The placement office verifies the job details, including remuneration and other specifics, to ensure everything is accurate and clear.
6. Job Availability: After verification, the job listing is made available to students on the portal as per the placement office's schedule.
7. Student Applications: Students interested in a position can apply through the portal to express their interest in the recruitment process.
8. Shortlisting by Companies: Companies review the resumes of applicants and shortlist students based on their criteria.
9. Tests & Screening: Shortlisted candidates undergo tests and other screening processes, which are scheduled in coordination with the placement office.
10. Final Interviews: Companies select candidates for the final round of interviews.
11. Interview Scheduling: The placement office allocates interview dates for each organization based on availability and preferences.
12. Confirmation of Dates: Companies confirm their interview dates with the placement office.
13. Offer Letters: After the interviews, companies submit a list of candidates they wish to offer positions to.
14. Student Acceptance: The placement office notifies companies of students who have accepted their job offers.
15. Offer Letters Sent: Final offer letters, along with job details, are sent to the selected candidates.

This structured process ensures a smooth and organized recruitment cycle, with opportunities for students to engage with top companies in their respective fields.

## UGC approves flexible UG degree completion norms; students can now extend, delay programme duration

### UGC Approves Flexible Accelerated Degree Programs for Undergraduate Students

Undergraduate students may soon have the option to either complete their degree earlier or extend their study period beyond the usual duration. The University Grants Commission (UGC) recently approved a Standard Operating Protocol (SOP) for Accelerated Degree Programs (ADPs) during its meeting on November 13. The SOP is expected to be made public for feedback shortly, according to UGC officials.

The introduction of the National Credit Framework (NCrF) will allow students to progress through their degree programs at a pace that suits their learning abilities, either faster or slower than the standard duration. Students will earn credits based on their individual learning speeds, providing more flexibility in how they complete their degree requirements.

### Key Features of the New System:

- Accelerated Degree Programs (ADPs): Students will have the option to fast-track their degrees by earning additional credits per semester, allowing them to complete a three-year or four-year degree in a shorter time frame.
- Extended Degree Programs (EDPs): Conversely, students can choose to spread out their coursework over a longer period, completing fewer credits each semester.

UGC Chairman M. Jagadesh Kumar explained that these programs would give students the flexibility to adjust their academic timelines according to their capabilities. "ADPs allow students to finish their degree in less time by completing extra credits, while EDPs allow for a more extended timeline with a reduced credit load," he said.

The SOP also provides guidance for Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in designing the academic structure, credit allocation, assessment methods, and the process for awarding degrees under these flexible programs.

### Eligibility and Implementation:

- HEIs will form committees to evaluate student eligibility for ADPs and EDPs, ensuring that students' academic progress aligns with the chosen program duration.
- Degrees awarded under both ADPs and EDPs will be equivalent to those completed within the standard duration, making them valid for employment and further academic pursuits.
- The UGC has proposed that HEIs allocate up to 10% of their student intake to ADPs. Institutions will also form committees to review applications from students in the first or second semester to determine their suitability for accelerated or extended timelines. These committees will assess students' academic performance and recommend adjustments to the number of courses and credits based on the chosen program duration.

## Woxsen University Admission 2025: Registration Ongoing for UG Courses Till Dec 15; Check Courses Offered

## Telangana to Launch Online Admissions for Junior Colleges from Next Year

In a significant move aimed at streamlining the admissions process and curbing high fees charged by private and corporate junior colleges, the Telangana state government has announced that it will implement an online admissions system for junior colleges starting next year. This new centralized portal will allow students to apply to junior colleges including government, corporate, and private institutions —through a single platform. The current admission system, which involves individual processes for different colleges, has often been criticized for being cumbersome and complicated for students and parents. The online admissions initiative aims to address these issues, making the process more transparent

and accessible for all students. One of the key factors that hindered the implementation of an online admissions system so far was the grading system used in the SSC public exams. Under the existing grading system, students receive grades instead of marks, making it challenging to fairly compare and rank students for admission purposes.

To overcome this hurdle, the Telangana government has decided to scrap the grading system and replace it with a marks-based system. The new approach will award students 100% marks based on external exams, allowing for easier ranking and the establishment of merit-based selection for admissions.

## Delhi Nursery Admission 2025-26: Age, application, documents – answers to all FAQs

The Delhi government's Department of Education (DoE) will start the admission process and make the forms available for admission to nursery, KG and Class 1 in private unaided recognised schools on November 28.

There is a 25 per cent reservation of seats for the economically weaker sections (EWS) and disadvantaged group (DG) students and children with disabilities in the private schools. A separate list will be released for them.

First-time parents must be worried about their children on how they can get admission to Delhi's private and unaided schools. Here are some answers to frequently asked questions (FAQs) to get things simplified:

Question: What is the age for LKG admission in Delhi? Answer:

For admission in pre-school (nursery), pre-primary (KG) and Class-1, the minimum age as on March 31 should be three years,

four years and five years respectively, according to the Directorate of Education. Pre-school, pre-primary and Class-1 are classified as entry-level classes and the upper age limit for admission is less than four years, less than five years, and less than six years, respectively.

Question: Is buying of prospectus mandatory? Answer: Buying of prospectus is not mandatory along with the admission form and only Rs 25 can be charged as the registration fee from the parents. Question: What if tie occurs during shortlisting? Answer: In the event of a tie among applicants for admission to nursery, KG and Class 1, a draw of lots will be conducted, either using a computerised system or by drawing slips in the presence of parents. The circular stated that the draw will be videographed and the school will retain the footage.

## Admissions Open for International Students at the National University of Singapore for 2025/2026

The National University of Singapore (NUS) has started accepting applications from international students for the academic year 2025/2026.

Admissions are based on a comprehensive evaluation process. Applicants are assessed on academic excellence, subject prerequisites, and their readiness, interests, and aptitude for the chosen undergraduate program.

While interviews or tests are not mandatory for all programs, they are required for courses such as Dentistry, Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Industrial Design, Music, Nursing, Law, Medicine, and Philosophy, Politics, and Economics (PPE).

To apply, students need to select a course and complete the online application. Applicants can track their application status through the portal and attend interviews or tests if needed. Once selected, they must accept the offer to secure their admission at NUS.

Eligibility Criteria for Indian Students: Candidates must complete high school by July 2025. Students

currently in their final year of high school are also eligible to apply.

Acceptable qualifications include:

Completion of Class 12 under Central, ISC, State, or other boards.

For students from state or other boards, standardized test scores (Advanced Placement, ACT with Writing, SAT, or SAT Subject Tests) are required. Those from Central and ISC boards are exempt from this requirement.

No English proficiency tests are required for Indian applicants.

The official guidelines emphasize the timely submission of actual examination results for Indian students appearing for the 2025 CBSE/ISC exams. Results must be updated via the Applicant Portal within three calendar days of release. Applicants are instructed to include their full name and application number on submitted documents to avoid delays in processing.

It is important to note that Indian students are not eligible to apply for Dentistry, Law, Medicine, or Nursing courses at NUS.



## RMIT University, Australia, Announces Scholarships for International Students Covering Tuition Fees

RMIT University, one of Australia's leading institutions, has announced the Foundation Academic Scholarships to provide financial support to international students. ## Indian Students Lead as the Largest International Group in Uzbekistan's Universities

Similar to trends in the US and UK, Indians constitute the largest group of foreign students in Uzbekistan's higher education institutions. The Statistics Agency of the Republic of Uzbekistan reports that 5,733 Indians are studying in the 2023-2024 academic year, followed by students from Pakistan (1,358) and Turkmenistan (904).

According to the Ministry of External Affairs, 4,100 Indian students were pursuing higher education in Uzbekistan as of January 1. Other countries with significant student populations include the Russian Federation (904), Kazakhstan (537), Tajikistan and Kyrgyz Republic (285 each).

Additionally, 196 students from Afghanistan, 182 from China, 176 from Korea, and 124 from Canada are enrolled in Uzbek institutions. The report also mentions that students from other unspecified countries make up a total of 312.

### Top Courses for Foreign Students in Uzbekistan

Uzbekistan is a favored destination for foreign students due to its affordable and high-quality educational programs. Popular courses include medicine, engineering, business management, agriculture, and information technology, which cater to a wide range of academic and career aspirations.

Meanwhile, Indians also form the largest cohort of international students in the US, as per the latest Open Doors 2024 report. For the 2023-24 academic year, 3.31 lakh Indian students were enrolled in the US, accounting for 25.4% of all international students in the previous year. Similarly, the UK has also reported a steady rise in the number of Indian students.



## USCIS Updates F-1 Study Abroad Policy to Resolve Confusion Among International Students

The US Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) has revised its F-1 visa policy for study abroad programs following significant confusion sparked by an earlier policy manual update on August 27. The initial changes stated that F-1 visa holders studying abroad for more than five months could not remain actively enrolled in a certified institution and would require a new Form I-20 to regain student status upon return.

On November 26, USCIS issued a "technical correction" to address the issue. The controversial paragraph was replaced with guidance referring students to the Department of Homeland Security's Study in the States webpage for information on study abroad requirements. However, the manual still includes a provision stating that F-1 students who leave the US for over five months and are unable to maintain enrollment at their ICE SEVP-certified school would lose their student status.

While the Study in the States homepage lacks explicit details about study abroad policies, additional resources on the site affirm the longstanding understanding: F-1 students can maintain active SEVIS status for programs longer than five months if they remain enrolled at a certified US institution.

### Stakeholder Response and Policy Revision

The revision followed advocacy efforts by organizations such as The PIE, Minerva University, NAFSA, immigration advisers, and letters from various institutions urging USCIS to reconsider the policy. Fragomen immigration partner Aaron Blumberg expressed relief, stating, "We can all rest easy knowing that USCIS did the right thing and made the correction. The future of study abroad remains intact as an integral part of an F-1 student's education."

The revision was particularly urgent given the upcoming presidential administration change on January 20, 2025, which could usher in stricter immigration compliance. Blumberg noted during a November 1 webinar that, "We may suddenly find ourselves in a more compliance-focused, heightened scrutiny landscape."



### Impact on Students and Institutions

The initial update created widespread uncertainty, forcing many international students to alter their study plans. At Minerva University, where students rotate globally during their undergraduate program, the institution began flying 150 students back from Berlin to the US to protect their F-1 status and Optional Practical Training (OPT) eligibility.

The conflicting advice offered by USCIS and the Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) during this period only added to the confusion, with immigration lawyers calling for better coordination between the two agencies.

### Broader Implications

For some stakeholders, the incident highlights the complexities of navigating the US immigration system. Ben Waxman, CEO of Intead, remarked, "USCIS is staffed and led by smart, well-meaning people ... but these kinds of conflicts between goals and policies happen all the time."

The prolonged correction process underscores the challenges faced by international students and institutions in adapting to frequent and sometimes unclear policy changes. However, with the revision in place, the F-1 visa framework continues to support study abroad programs as a vital component of international education.



## West Bengal Government to Distribute New School Uniforms in January for Over 1.15 Crore Students

In a significant shift, the West Bengal government has announced that school uniforms for over 1.15 crore students from Classes I to VIII will be distributed in January 2025, aligning with the start of the new academic session. Traditionally, uniforms have been distributed in March or April, often causing delays and logistical issues.

The directive comes from Chief Secretary Manoj Pant, who recently held a meeting with officials from the School Education, Self-Help Groups, and MSME (Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises) departments to coordinate the project.

### Reason for the Change

A senior government official explained that the current schedule, which provides the first set of uniforms in March-April and the second set later in the year, frequently led to schools receiving the second set as late as December. This prompted the administration to revise the schedule, ensuring timely distribution starting from 2025.

### Locally Sourced Materials

The MSME department has played a pivotal role in the initiative. According to an MSME official, the state is now self-reliant in producing the fabric for school uniforms, eliminating the need to source materials from other states like Gujarat.

The official added, "The uniform design has already been finalised in collaboration with the National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT), and fabric distribution began this week. We aim to produce the first set of uniforms by mid-January."

### Collaboration Between Departments

The MSME department is responsible for supplying the required cloth.

The Self-Help Groups department is tasked with stitching and assembling the uniforms.

The School Education department will handle the distribution to primary, secondary, and higher secondary schools.

Chief Secretary Manoj Pant has instructed all departments to ensure uniform distribution for the upcoming academic session is completed by November 2024.

### Meeting of Key Officials

Last week, the Chief Secretary convened a meeting with top officials, including Finance Secretary Prabhat Misra and Education Secretary Binod Kumar, to streamline the implementation of this project.

This initiative marks a significant improvement in the state's ability to manage school uniform distribution efficiently and demonstrates West Bengal's progress toward self-sufficiency in resources.



## ICSE & ISC 2025 Exam Insights: Exam Pattern, Marking Scheme, and Preparation Strategies

$$ax^2 + bx + c = 0$$

1. Standard Form: The quadratic equation is always expressed as  $ax^2 + bx + c = 0$ .

### Methods to Solve Quadratic Equations

#### 1. Factorization

- Break the middle term ( $bx$ ) into two terms such that their product equals  $a \cdot c$ .
- Rearrange terms and factorize the equation.
- Example: Solve  $x^2 + 5x + 6 = 0$ :

$$\begin{aligned} x^2 + 2x + 3x + 6 &= 0 \\ x(x+2) + 3(x+2) &= 0 \\ (x+2)(x+3) &= 0 \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} a &= 2, b = -3, c = -2 \\ D &= (-3)^2 - 4(2)(-2) = 9 + 16 = 25 \\ x &= \frac{-(-3) \pm \sqrt{25}}{2(2)} = \frac{3 \pm 5}{4} \end{aligned}$$

Roots:  $x = 2, x = -\frac{1}{2}$ .

### Graphical Interpretation of Quadratic Equations

The graph of a quadratic equation  $y = ax^2 + bx + c$  is a parabola:

- If  $a > 0$ : The parabola opens upwards.
- If  $a < 0$ : The parabola opens downwards.
- Roots: Points where the parabola intersects the x-axis.

### Special Cases

1. Perfect Square Quadratic:
  - Example:  $x^2 + 4x + 4 = 0$

### Line Graph

Uses of Line Graph

The important use of line graph is to track the changes over the short and long period of time. It is also used to compare the changes over the same period of time for different groups. It is always better to use the line than the bar graph, whenever the small changes exist. For example, in a company finance team wants to plot the changes in the cash amount that the company has on hand over time. In that case, they use the line graph plotting the points over the horizontal and the vertical axis. It usually represents the time period of the data.
