UGC Discontinues CARE Journal List: Odisha Scholars React Positively

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has announced the discontinuation of the UGC-CARE (Consortium for Academic and Research Ethics) list of journals, aiming to decentralize the evaluation of research publications. This strategic move is intended to empower individual institutions and researchers in selecting appropriate publication avenues, thereby enhancing academic integrity and transparency.

Why is the UGC-CARE List Being Discontinued?

- The UGC-CARE list was introduced to help scholars publish in legitimate, high-quality journals while avoiding predatory publications.
- However, over time, concerns were raised regarding Manipulation and unethical practices by some journal publishers to retain their CARE accreditation.
- To address these issues, UGC has decided to abolish the centralized CARE list and instead provide suggestive parameters for faculty and students to evaluate journals themselves.

Impact on Researchers and Institutions:

- **Increased Academic Autonomy:** Universities, colleges, and research

institutions will now have more independence in selecting peer-reviewed journals for research publications.

Rise in Research Standards: With the removal of the CARE list, researchers will need to focus on publishing in globally recognized, high-impact journals rather than journals merely included in a prescribed list.

Next Steps & UGC's Future Plans:

- The UGC will soon introduce a framework to help researchers and faculty assess the quality and credibility of journals.
 - The framework will likely include guidelines on journal impact factors and citation details and international database recognition (such as Scopus, Web of Science, etc.).
- Higher education institutions will be encouraged to form internal committees to evaluate and recommend journals for faculty and student publications and this will help to maintain uniformity and credibility in research publication decisions.

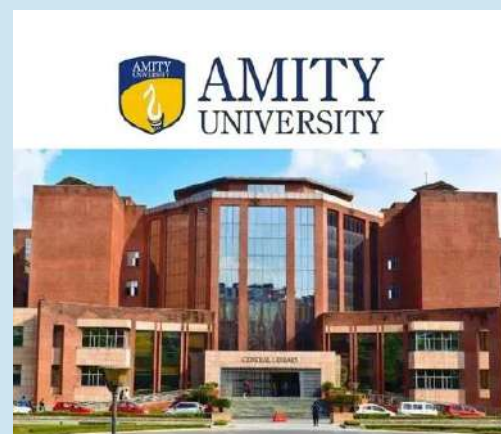

Emphasizing the deep-rooted ties between the two nations, President Trump and Prime Minister Modi acknowledged the significant role of the Indian diaspora and international students in the US. They highlighted that over 300,000 Indian students contribute more than \$8 billion annually to the US economy, generating substantial direct and indirect employment while boosting economic growth.



Both leaders recognized that the movement of students, researchers, and professionals benefits both countries by fostering academic exchange and economic development. Discussions also covered initiatives such as joint and dual degree programs, twinning arrangements, and the creation of joint Centres of Excellence to strengthen academic collaboration.

India encouraged the US to take advantage of its ongoing education sector reforms and establish offshore campuses of leading American institutions.

Furthermore, both nations pledged to streamline legal pathways for students and professionals, facilitate short-term business and tourist travel, and address concerns related to illegal immigration and human trafficking.

Education Divide: Why Southern India Outpaces the North in Higher Learning

India's Higher Education Divide: Why the South Leads While the North Struggles:

India's higher education landscape highlights stark regional disparities, as revealed in the Annual Status of Higher Education (ASHE) 2024 report, jointly published by Deloitte and the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII). The report underscores a widening gap between northern and southern states, with Tamil Nadu, Kerala, and Karnataka demonstrating strong Gross Enrolment Ratios (GER) and robust educational infrastructure, while Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, and Rajasthan continue to lag behind due to lower enrolment rates and inadequate facilities.

The data speaks volumes—Tamil Nadu boasts a GER of 47%, far surpassing the national average of 28.4%, whereas states like Uttar Pradesh (24.1%) and Bihar (17.1%) struggle to keep pace. The challenge is particularly acute in rural northern regions, where a lack of qualified educators and poor infrastructure severely limits access to higher education. These disparities not only widen the educational divide but also reinforce structural inequities, making it difficult to achieve balanced educational opportunities nationwide.

GER Disparities: A North-South Divide:

GER serves as a crucial measure of higher education accessibility. While Tamil Nadu (47%) and Kerala (41.3%) lead the way, northern states like Uttar Pradesh and Bihar remain well below the national average.

Institutional Density and Infrastructure:

The availability of higher education institutions (HEIs) per capita is another crucial factor in determining educational access. Southern states have a higher institutional density, ensuring better opportunities for students. In contrast, despite their vast populations, many northern states suffer from a lack of colleges and universities per capita, further exacerbating the education gap.

Faculty Shortages and Pupil-Teacher Ratios (PTR):

Southern states maintain favorable PTRs, ensuring better faculty availability and enhanced learning experiences. In contrast, northern states like Bihar and Uttar Pradesh face chronic faculty shortages, leading to overcrowded classrooms and reduced academic engagement.

Kamlesh Vyas, a partner at Deloitte, acknowledged these challenges in an interview with TOI, emphasizing the urgent need to fill vacant faculty positions while also leveraging technology-driven teaching solutions. He suggested that online lectures from expert professors could supplement local faculty, alleviating shortages. Additionally, long-term industry-academia collaborations and faculty development initiatives like the Madan Mohan Malaviya Faculty Development Programme were recommended to improve teaching standards and curriculum relevance.

NEP 2020: Bridging Regional Disparities in Higher Education:

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 serves as a blueprint for addressing regional inequalities in India's higher education system. With a strong focus on infrastructure, inclusivity, and innovation, the policy aims to ensure equitable access to education across all regions. Here's how NEP 2020 is tackling these challenges.

Expanding Institutional Density: Increasing Access to Higher Education:

A major hurdle in northern states is the low availability of higher education institutions (HEIs). To resolve this, NEP 2020 emphasizes the establishment of multidisciplinary HEIs in underserved regions. This involves upgrading existing colleges to universities and ensuring that every district has at least one multidisciplinary HEI by 2030.

Kamlesh Vyas, a partner at Deloitte, highlighted the issue, stating that institutional density remains a critical concern in many backward districts, particularly in the North. He explained, "Some districts still lack universities, and one of NEP's key objectives is to establish at least one university per district, bringing education closer to students."

By focusing on states like Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, and Rajasthan, where the college-per-capita ratio remains low, this initiative aims to improve accessibility and encourage enrolment, particularly in rural and semi-urban areas.

Boosting GER: Aiming for 50% by 2035:

NEP 2020 sets an ambitious target of increasing India's Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) to 50% by 2035, up from the current 28.4%. Speaking to TOI, AR Ramesh, CEO of the TeamLease Degree Apprenticeship Programme, dismissed concerns over this goal being unrealistic. He asserted making education more modular and accessible.

Key Government Strategies to Improve GER:

- Expanding online and distance education to reach students in remote areas while improving awareness of its career relevance.
- Integrating vocational programs to attract students interested in skill-based learning rather than traditional degrees.
- Implementing flexible credit systems to allow students to complete education in stages across multiple institutions, reducing dropout rates. This will be particularly beneficial in low-GER states like Bihar and West Bengal while sustaining progress in Tamil Nadu and Kerala.

Leveraging Digital Initiatives for Local Impact:

Given the lack of physical infrastructure in rural and underserved regions, NEP 2020 leverages technology-driven solutions to expand access to education.

Key Digital Initiatives:

- Development of digital platforms like the National Digital Library and e-learning resources to provide widespread educational support.
- Hybrid learning models, combining online and offline education, to overcome infrastructure constraints and extend learning opportunities.

These digital initiatives are particularly beneficial for states like Rajasthan and Jharkhand, where traditional educational infrastructure is still developing, making technology-driven solutions a crucial alternative.

Rethinking Higher Education: Why India Needs a Unique Approach, Not a Western Blueprint

India stands at the threshold of a major economic transformation, with one of the world's largest working-age populations. The country's demographic advantage—characterized by a low dependency ratio—offers immense potential, but realizing this opportunity requires a departure from blindly emulating Western models of higher education.

While American universities are often seen as the gold standard, their structure is becoming outdated. The widespread adoption of this system in other nations ignores two critical issues: its declining effectiveness in the U.S. and its impracticality in the Indian context. Higher education in the U.S. was historically expanded to promote democracy, economic mobility, and workforce readiness. However, it now struggles to deliver on these promises. Despite increasing college completion rates—from 5% in 1947 to 38% in 2021—political dysfunction, income inequality, and job underemployment persist. A college degree no longer guarantees economic mobility or a well-informed society, with many graduates facing stagnant wages and misaligned job opportunities.

For India, replicating this model is not only outdated but also unfeasible. Economic theories suggest that expanding higher education drives GDP growth, but the reality is more complex. With 43 million students currently enrolled and a projected college-age population exceeding 200 million within six years, scaling up higher education infrastructure at such a pace is unrealistic. Moreover, India's labor market dynamics further complicate the situation—over half of the working-age population is unemployed, 90% of jobs exist in the informal sector, and even degree-holders face high unemployment and skill gaps. Increasing credentials alone will not create more jobs but will elevate expectations, potentially leading to frustration and social unrest.

A more pragmatic approach is needed. Instead of prolonging education as a prerequisite for employment, India must embrace innovative, skills-based learning pathways tailored to its unique socio-economic landscape. True progress lies in reimagining, not replicating, outdated systems.

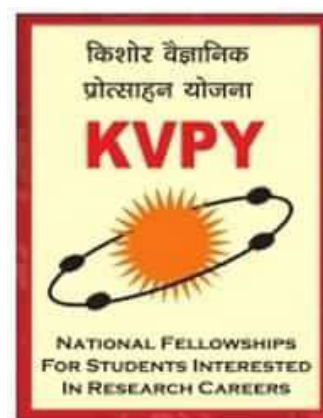
