Maharashtra Govt Grants Final Approval To New College For Academic Year 2025-26

The Maharashtra government's Higher and Technical Education Department on Monday granted final approval for the establishment of a new college, "Narmada College of Science and Arts," located in Mohadi, in Bhandara district, for the academic year 2025-26. The decision follows a court order in relation to a writ petition filed by Saujanya Education Society against the rejection of the final approval for the institution.

The newly approved college will offer two undergraduate courses: Bachelor of Arts (BA) and Bachelor of Science (BSc), with a total intake of 240 students. The BA programme will be taught in Marathi, while the BSc programme will be conducted in English. Both courses will follow the curriculum as prescribed by Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University.

As per the conditions of approval, the college will operate on a permanently unaided basis, meaning it will not receive financial support from the government for salaries or other expenses related to teaching and non-teaching staff. The institution is also required to submit an affidavit, confirming that no future grant demands will be made.

The GR issued on Monday stipulates that the university will not grant affiliation to the college until the required compliance documents are submitted. Additionally, the college must work towards obtaining National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) accreditation within the prescribed time frame.

Furthermore, the resolution mandates strict adherence to the approved student intake, and universities will be responsible for conducting periodic review of newly approved institutions to ensure compliance



with the established norms. Should the college fail to enroll at least 50% of the approved intake, the recognition could be revoked.

The unaided status means the institution must sustain itself financially, which could be a challenge, but it also ensures independence in operations. Also, the requirement for NAAC accreditation and periodic reviews will help maintain academic quality.

This is a significant development for higher education in Maharashtra! The approval of Narmada College of Science and Arts will provide new educational opportunities for students in Mohadi, Bhandara district. Since the BA program will be in Marathi and the BSc in English, it caters to a diverse student base.

At 27th position, ISB leaves IIMs behind to rank in FT's MBA B-School Rankings 2025

The Indian School of Business (ISB), Hyderabad is the best management college in India and 27th globally in the Financial Times (FT) rankings of MBA 2025. Of the total 100 B schools, 8 of them are from India. Last year, only 6 Indian business schools secured a spot in the FT rankings of MBA.

The rank of the ISB has improved this year as against 31 in 2024 and 39 in 2023. The three-year average rank of the Institute is 32. It stood at 4 for the alumni network.

In the ranking, the top spot was achieved by the University of Pennsylvania, Wharton campus followed by Columbia Business School, both of them US universities. The third spot was with IESE Business School, followed by Insead, SDA Bocconi School of Management and MIT's Sloan campus.

The famous London Business School was ranked 7. Other institutes that secured spots are IIM-Ahmedabad at 31, IIM-Bangalore at 57, IIM-Calcutta at 61, and IIM Lucknow which ranked 71.

Interestingly, IIM Kozhikode's programme in Post Graduate Programme in Business Leadership has debuted in the Financial Times (FT) Global MBA Rankings 2025. IIMs, especially IIM Ahmedabad, Bangalore, and Calcutta, have traditionally dominated Indian management education. However, ISB's one-year PGP program, global faculty, and industry-aligned curriculum seem to be making a strong impact internationally.

This achievement reinforces ISB's position as a global business education leader, setting new benchmarks for management excellence in India.

Maharashtra To Fill 666 Vacant Teaching Posts In Government Medical Colleges

The recruitment process to fill 666 out of the 1,600 vacant teaching posts in government medical colleges across the state has started through the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC), said sources from the Directorate of Medical Education and Research (DMER).

"These posts include 428 lecturers, 167 associate professors and 71 professors for government medical colleges. Even as it does not cover all vacant posts yet, it is a major relief for government medical colleges currently managing with contractual teachers," said an official from the DMER while adding that this includes vacant posts in existing government medical colleges along with additions from the nine new ones which started in the state in this academic year.

In the current academic year, nine new government medical colleges have opened

across the state, adding 900 new student seats. This increase has also led to a rise in total vacant teaching positions.

Details of 666 posts have been sent to MPSC for recruitment which will include a thorough process.

"All new government medical colleges saw full admission in the first year itself. This proves the demand for government medical colleges among aspirants as it is a more affordable choice than learning medicine in private medical colleges. Deans of the new government medical colleges are currently given authority to appoint contractual teachers to meet needs," the official added. This initiative aims to improve teaching standards, ensure better training for future doctors, and strengthen the state's healthcare system. The recruitment drive will focus on filling vacancies across various specializations, addressing a long-pending issue in public medical institutions.

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CUET-UG 2025 Application Process Begins

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has officially announced the commencement of the application process for the Common University Entrance Test for Undergraduates (CUET-UG) 2025. CUET-UG serves as a gateway for students seeking admission to various undergraduate programs in central, state, and participating universities across India.

Key Dates and Schedule:

- Application Start Date: February 2025
- Application End Date: March 2025
- Correction Window: March 2025 (exact dates to be announced)
- Admit Card Release: May 2025
- Exam Dates: May 15 to May 31, 2025

Exam Mode and Structure:

Candidates can choose subject combinations based on the requirements of the universities they wish to apply to.

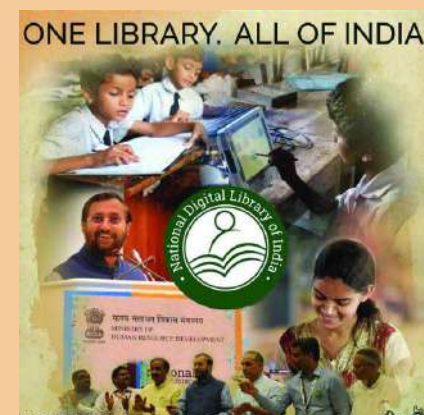

CBSE refutes paper leak claims as 'baseless' and warns against panic-mongering

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) refused rumours claiming paper leaks of Class 10 and 12th board exams. The board emphasised that these claims are baseless and are designed to incite unnecessary anxiety among students and their parents.

CBSE also assured strict action has been taken to ensure fair and secure administration of the ongoing examinations.

CBSE addresses misinformation on paper leaks

CBSE issued an official statement about misleading claims about alleged paper leaks circulating on multiple social media platforms like YouTube, Facebook, and X (formerly known as Twitter).

In its official statement, CBSE said, "The Board has made comprehensive arrangements to ensure the smooth and fair conduct of the examinations. It has come to the Board's attention that certain unscrupulous elements are spreading rumours on YouTube, Facebook, 'X' (formerly Twitter), and other social media platforms regarding paper leaks or claiming access to the 2025 examination question papers. These claims are baseless and are intended to create unnecessary panic among students and parents."

CBSE also assured strict action has been taken to ensure fair and secure administration of the ongoing examinations.

Legal actions against unscrupulous elements

Any individual, including students, will face consequences as per CBSE's Unfair Means (UFM) regulations along with potential legal action under the Indian Penal Code (IPC), the notice said.

CBSE's advisory to students, parents, and stakeholders

CBSE requested all the parents and their children not to believe this unverified information. The board advised students and other stakeholders to rely on CBSE's official communication channels including its website, i.e., cbse.gov.in for authentic information.

Delhi HC urges Centre to review 75% attendance rule for college students

Delhi HC Urges Centre to Reevaluate Mandatory 75% Attendance Rule for College Students

The mandatory 75% attendance requirement has long been a concern for college students across India. In a recent development, the Delhi High Court has called for a reconsideration of this rule for undergraduate and postgraduate students, highlighting its impact on mental health.

A division bench comprising Justices Pratibha M Singh and Amit Sharma made these observations while hearing a suo motu PIL following the suicide of a law student from Amity University. The plea alleged that the student faced harassment from faculty members due to low attendance and was forced to repeat a year in his BA (LLB) course, which contributed to his tragic decision.

The court noted that students today view attendance differently, particularly in the post-pandemic era, where online learning has become more prevalent. It stressed the need for a balanced and student-friendly attendance framework rather than a system that penalizes shortages by barring students from exams. The bench also suggested analyzing global educational practices and consulting both teachers and students to develop fair attendance policies.

In response, the court has issued notices to the Centre, the National Medical

Commission, the Department of Education, and other stakeholders, seeking their views on mandatory attendance norms. The next hearing is scheduled for September 9.

Maharashtra's overall GER stands at 35.3, with male GER at 37.1 and female GER at 33.3, revealing a gender disparity despite a relatively high female literacy rate of 75.9%.

Undergraduate education dominates student enrolment, with 4.2 million students pursuing studies across different levels. However, female representation remains lower than male participation across all categories, pointing to the need for targeted interventions to close the gap.

Maharashtra Launches Fellowship Programmes in Management for Private Colleges

The Government of Maharashtra has approved the introduction of fellowship programmes in management at select private unaided institutions, beginning in the academic year 2024-25. This initiative aligns with the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) guidelines and aims to enhance higher education and research opportunities in the state.

Institutional Participation and Seat Allocation
Prominent institutions such as Dr DY Patil B School and Indira School of Business Studies in Pune have been granted approval to offer these fellowship programmes. Dr DY Patil B School will commence with an initial intake of 10 seats, while Indira School of Business Studies will offer 20 seats. These fellowships will operate under a non-aided framework and will be strictly regulated to ensure adherence to AICTE standards.

Infrastructure and Admission Process

Participating institutions are mandated to maintain high academic standards by providing well-equipped libraries, advanced laboratories, and other necessary infrastructure. Admissions will be based on merit, following AICTE regulations, and institutions must ensure transparency by publicly displaying admission processes, fee structures, and course details on their official websites.

Fee Structure and Compliance

The Maharashtra government has stipulated that the fee structure for these fellowships should be in line with the fees for Postgraduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) courses. Any institution found charging fees beyond the approved limits will be subject to penalties under the Maharashtra Educational Institutions Act, 1987.

Exclusion of Government Scholarships and Reservations

Unlike other academic programmes, these fellowships will not be eligible for government scholarships, fee concessions, or quota-based admissions, including those under the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and Jammu & Kashmir (J&K) categories. This policy ensures that the fellowship programme remains strictly merit-based and self-funded.

Higher Education Reduces Post-Marriage Job Dropout Rates Among Women in India

A recent World Bank report, Education, Social Norms, and the Marriage Penalty: Evidence from South Asia, sheds light on a crucial issue—13% of employed women leave their jobs after marriage. However, it also presents a key insight: women with higher education, particularly those with qualifications equal to their spouses, are far less likely to drop out of the workforce post-marriage. This demonstrates that education is not just a tool for skill development but also a powerful means to challenge traditional gender norms and drive societal change.

Key Findings on Gender Disparity in Education and Employment

The World Bank report reveals major disparities in education and workforce participation, particularly highlighting the role of higher education in reducing job attrition among married women.

Marriage Penalty in South Asia: Women's employment rates drop by 12 percentage points after marriage, even in the absence of children, indicating a "marriage penalty" that can last up to five years.

Employment Trends Among Men: While marriage negatively impacts women's employment, men experience a 13 percentage point increase in job opportunities post-marriage, though this advantage diminishes over time.

Impact of Higher Education: Women with post-secondary education are significantly less likely to leave their jobs after marriage. Education beyond high school nearly halves workforce dropout rates among married women.

Education vs. Social Norms: Higher education provides women with better job opportunities and reduces the constraints imposed by traditional gender roles. While a husband's education can influence household norms, it does not directly impact his wife's career decisions.

Marriage vs. Childbirth Impact: The data indicates that marriage alone causes a more significant decline in women's employment than childbirth, reinforcing the role of societal norms in limiting women's careers.

Need for Social Reform: While education plays a critical role, changing deeply ingrained gender norms is also essential. Policies that encourage gender equality in households and workplaces can further reduce women's workforce attrition post-marriage.

Gender Disparity in Higher Education in India
India continues to struggle with gender equality, as reflected in the Global Gender Gap Report 2024 by the World Economic Forum (WEF). Ranked 129th out of 146 economies, India's position has declined, particularly in women's education. At the current rate of progress, full gender parity is projected to be achieved only by 2158—far beyond the 2030 Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) target.

Despite these challenges, some progress has been made. According to the All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2021, the gross enrollment ratio for women in higher education (aged 18-23) has risen to 28.5%, surpassing that of men. Over the last decade, female enrollment has increased by 28.3%, with women now constituting 49% of the total student population, up from 45% in 2014-15.



Haryana Shuts Schools for Classes 5 and Below Due to Worsening Air Pollution

The Haryana government has ordered the temporary closure of schools up to Class 5 due to worsening air pollution levels in the region. The Directorate of School Education has issued a directive to all District Deputy Commissioners, urging them to assess the air quality situation and take necessary measures, including shifting to online classes, to safeguard students' health.

The directive states that given the severe Air Quality Index (AQI) levels in Delhi and surrounding areas, physical classes may be discontinued,

and online learning should be arranged for young students in both government and private schools.

"The concerned Deputy Commissioners shall assess the prevailing situation (as per the GRAP) in view of the severe AQI levels in Delhi and surrounding regions and may discontinue physical classes and issue necessary directions for holding online classes for up to Class 5 in schools in the interest of the health and safety of the students," the order reads.
