NITI Aayog formed a committee to transform AIIMS Delhi into a top medical research institution.

Led by V.K. Paul, it will analyze systems and recommend reforms to enhance medical education, research, and patient care. Government think tank NITI Aayog has formed a committee to create a roadmap aimed at transforming AIIMS, New Delhi, into a premier institution for medical research and practice.

The mandate of the committee led by NITI Aayog member V K Paul involves thoroughly examining the existing systems and processes at AIIMS and proposing significant reforms along with specific timelines for their implementation, the Aayog said in its annual report 2024-25.

The Terms of Reference include identifying ways to streamline patient inflow, developing Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) to ensure optimal clinical, academic, and research outcomes, enhancing governance and transparency, and recommending strategies for financial prudence, sustainability, and self-sufficiency in managing AIIMS. NITI Aayog, in partnership with the Centre for Social and Economic Progress (CSEP) Research Foundation, has been examining strategies from various countries to achieve Universal Health Coverage (UHC). This collaborative effort aims to gather valuable insights and policy recommendations tailored to India's specific needs. UHC focuses on providing access to quality health services without causing financial hardship to individuals.

In the management of Sickle Cell Disease, a syrup formulation of Hydroxyurea is also under the process of approval, aiming to provide more accessible treatment options for patients.



A draft paper from this initiative proposes a range of multifaceted approaches addressing both supply-side and demand-side financing. The goal is to enhance healthcare delivery, accessibility, quality, and affordability across the nation. This ongoing work involves extensive consultations with government bodies and stakeholders to identify potential pathways suitable for India's unique context. Over the years, India has made significant progress by transitioning from a selective approach to health service delivery to a comprehensive primary healthcare system. This system is seamlessly integrated with secondary and tertiary care through existing infrastructure. The Ayushman Bharat scheme, launched in 2018, has played a pivotal role in reducing financial burdens for families by providing substantial healthcare coverage. MHT CET 2025: Registration Deadline Extended till February 27

The State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra, has extended the registration deadline for the Maharashtra Common Entrance Test (MHT CET) 2025. Candidates now have until February 27, 2025, to apply, with a late fee of Rs 500. The MHT CET is a state-level entrance examination conducted by the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Mumbai, for admission to Engineering, Technology, Pharmacy, B.Planning, M.Planning (Integrated), and Agricultural Education courses in Maharashtra. Every year, thousands of students take this exam, making it one of the most crucial entrance tests in the state.

The MHT CET 2025 will be conducted for two groups: PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) for medical and pharmacy aspirants and PCM (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics) for engineering and technology aspirants. The exam pattern follows a 20% weightage from the Class 11 syllabus and an 80% weightage from the Class 12 syllabus. One significant advantage for students is that there will be no negative marking. The difficulty level of Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics will be comparable to JEE Mains, while Biology will

be on par with NEET, making thorough preparation essential for aspirants.

The MHT CET 2025 will be conducted in Computer-Based Test (CBT) mode at designated examination centers across Maharashtra. Students must be familiar with the online test format to perform efficiently. The eligibility criteria for MHT CET 2025 require candidates to be Indian citizens, and they must have passed Class 12 with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (for Engineering) or Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Mathematics (for Pharmacy and Agriculture courses). Students appearing for their Class 12 board exams in 2025 can also apply.

With the registration deadline extended, candidates who haven't applied should take advantage of this opportunity and complete their applications before February 27, 2025. The MHT CET 2025 is a crucial gateway to securing admissions in top institutions for Engineering, Pharmacy, Planning, and Agricultural Sciences. Aspirants should maintain a strategic study plan and dedicate themselves to consistent practice and revision to maximize their chances of success in the exam.

No Candidate Clears Odisha District Judge Written Exam

The Odisha District Judge Recruitment Examination 2024 has resulted in a shocking outcome, as none of the 366 shortlisted candidates managed to qualify. The Orissa High Court published the results, confirming a zero success rate, leaving all 45 district judge vacancies unfilled.

The recruitment was conducted under two advertisements:

- Advertisement No. 11 for Direct Recruitment from the Bar
- Advertisement No. 12 for the Limited Competitive Examination

For Direct Recruitment, 283 candidates competed for 31 vacancies. The exam had three papers of 100 marks each, requiring a minimum of 45% per paper and 50% overall to qualify for the interview stage.

As per the official notification, none of the candidates met these criteria. The eligibility requirements included at least seven years of continuous legal practice, and candidates had to be between 35 and 45 years old as of April 1, 2024.

The positions offered a pay scale of ₹1,44,840 to ₹1,94,660 along with usual allowances. The unprecedented failure rate has raised concerns about the difficulty level of the exam and the preparation standards of candidates. For Direct Recruitment from the Bar, 283 candidates were shortlisted to compete for 31 vacancies. The exam comprised three papers of 100 marks each, and candidates had to secure a minimum of 45% in each paper and 50% overall to qualify for the interview stage.

Similarly, the Limited Competitive Examination for Judicial Officers, conducted under Advertisement No. 12, aimed to fill 14 vacancies. A total of 83 aspirants were shortlisted for the exam, which consisted of two papers of 75 marks each.

Candidates needed at least 45% in each paper and 50% overall to proceed to the interview stage, but none of them qualified. However, the positions of both categories offered a pay scale of Rs 1,44,840 to Rs 1,94,660 along with usual allowances.

IIT-Bombay announces two new courses set to begin from July 2025

The announcement was made by IIT Bombay's Director, Prof. Shireesh Kedare, during the interim session of its 63rd Convocation on Saturday.

The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bombay has announced two new courses set to begin in July 2025: a four-year Bachelor of Science program in Applied Geophysics and a Master of Technology (M.Tech) program in Climate and Sustainability. The announcement was made by IIT Bombay's Director, Prof. Shireesh Kedare, during the interim session of its 63rd Convocation on Saturday.

In his address, Prof. Kedare emphasised IIT Bombay's continued growth as one of the most sought-after destinations for undergraduate and postgraduate studies. "As in the past several years, IIT Bombay continues to make forays into newer territories pertinent to education in today's rapidly-evolving world," he said.

The interim session of the 63rd convocation, held at the institute's convocation hall, also saw the conferring of degrees to students who completed their academic requirements between August 2024 and January 2025. A total of 354 degrees were awarded, including 219 PhD degrees. The chief guest for the event was Abhishek Singh, IAS, Additional Secretary at the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India. In addition, 135 degrees were awarded across various other programs, including 36 Executive MBA (E-MBA) degrees and 6



Master in Development Practice (MDP) degrees in CTARA. The MDP degree was awarded for the first time, following the launch of IIT Bombay's unique online Master's in Development Practice program. "The first batch of students graduating from this program will receive their degrees during this convocation," Prof. Kedare shared. Reflecting on IIT Bombay's 66-year journey, Prof. Kedare highlighted the Institute's growth from 2,500 students in 1965 to nearly 14,000 today. He also noted IIT Bombay's expansion from core engineering disciplines to interdisciplinary fields like AI, quantum computing, and sustainable energy.

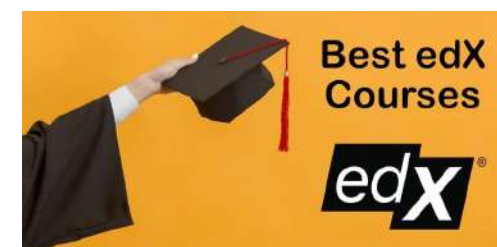

IIT Madras' Global Hyperloop Competition 2025 started

It is Asia's first international Hyperloop competition and is being held from 21st to 25th at 'Discovery,' IIT Madras' Satellite Campus located in Thaiyur, about 36 km from the main campus. GHC 2025 is set to position India at the heart of hyperloop innovation. It is aimed at uniting global talent, industry leaders, and researchers, fostering collaboration, innovation, and real-world implementation of hyperloop technology.

Hyperloop is the 5th mode of transportation, a high-speed train that travels in a near-vacuum tube. The reduced air resistance allows the capsule inside the tube to reach speeds of more than 1000 km/h. CBSE biannual exams will ease stress and improve academic performance

What was once a remote possibility, seems to be inching closer to reality. As per reports, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) will be conducting two board exams in 2026, for classes X and XII, but instead of the usually long schedule for both exams, the duration of the second exam is likely to be reduced to accommodate a two-exam system annually. This decision has been taken to mitigate students' stress with the best of two scores being used to declare their final results.

As the two-exam system comes into force, the schedule for one of the board exams at least would have to be shrunk and the gap between two papers considerably reduced to ensure all the results of the exam are released by June, just on time for the start of the admission season and the commencement of the new academic session, says a CBSE source, on condition of anonymity.

CBSE is in the process of putting together the guidelines for the two-exam system which is likely to be released soon, the source informed Education Times.

This comes in the wake of a recent meeting chaired by Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan with CBSE officials, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) and NCERT on conducting the board exams biannually.

This shift to a two-exam system where students' best score will be considered, could help them perform better academically as they would no longer be stressed by one high-stakes exam. Moreover, the system will particularly benefit special needs children as it will give them an additional chance to perform well," says Sudha Acharya, former chairperson, National Progressive School Conference (NPSC) and principal, IITL Public School, New Delhi, underscoring the exam system's inclusive and child-centric approach.

the board exams will continue to start in February even under the new scheme, since conducting tests earlier would be challenging in some parts of the country where winters are severe besides reducing teaching hours.



Punjab Government rolls out initiative to provide guidance support to class XII students

The board is organising a consultation meeting to create the ToR, which will outline the scope of work for consultants who will assist with this global expansion.

1. Curricular areas and syllabus content
2. Textbooks and TLM
3. Assessment practices
4. Training requirements
5. Outreach

SC directs NMC to submit progress report on new regulations for PwD to pursue MBBS

The Supreme Court (SC) bench of three judges has recently debunked the National Medical Commission's (NMC) regulations under the Graduate Medical Education Regulations (Amendment), 2019. And has issued a statement saying that the classification is over-broad and glorifies ableism. Further, the court has directed NMC to submit the progress report by March 3, 2024.

The bench of judges Justice Khanna, J KV Viswanathan and J Mishra of the SC in Anmol vs UOI. The judgement pronounced by J KV Viswanathan: "In our view, the prescription of, within quotation, both hands intact is completely antithetical to Article 14 under the Constitution, the principles enshrined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and the Salutory Provisions of the RPWD Act."

Further, the court said, "It also indicates a classification which is over-broad and glorifies ableism. It propagates that persons with typical abilities and with faculties similar to the majority may have some superiority. This is precisely what the relative principle of state policy is, the United Nations Convention on the RPWD Act of the whole. Both hands intact prescription has no sanctity in law as it does not admit of a functional assessment of the individual candidate, a matter which is so fundamental in protecting the rights of persons with disabilities.

Thereafter, we discussed the Omkar Gond and Om Rathod judgments, and we have rejected the report of the five AIIMS doctors because it is cryptic and has disclaimers suggesting a division of the policy. We have held that both hands intact also makes a mockery of the principle of reasonable accommodation."

Referring to a report submitted by Dr Satendra Singh, founder, Doctors with Disabilities: Agents of Change and Director-Professor, Physiology, UCMS and GTB Hospital, Delhi, the court said, "We have accepted the report because it fulfils the parameters of Omkar Gond and Om Rathod. We have noticed the direction to revise the guidelines in Omkar Gond and the assurance given in Omkar Rathod and while allowing the appeal and confirming the admission granted on 12-12, we have listed the matter on 3-3 for ascertaining the status of the revision of NMC guidelines. The appeal stands allowed in the abortions."

Discarding the decades-old 'both hands intact' requirement for aspiring doctors, SC said it "reeks of glorifying ableism" and directed the NMC to revise the outdated criteria to enable PwD to pursue MBBS."

Accepting Dr Singh's report favouring admission to a PwD candidate and rejecting the report of a five-member AIIMS medical board declaring him unfit to pursue MBBS, the bench asked NMC to report the progress in revising the eligibility criteria by March 3, 2025.



Maulana Azad National Scholarship for Minority Girls

The Maulana Azad National Scholarship is a government initiative aimed at supporting meritorious girls belonging to minority communities (Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, and Parsis) in continuing their higher secondary education (Class 11 and 12). It is implemented by the Maulana Azad Education Foundation under the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India.

This scholarship helps financially disadvantaged girls to continue their education and reduce dropout rates at the higher secondary level.

Eligibility:

- Girls belonging to minority communities.
- Must have secured at least 50% marks in Class 10.
- Annual family income should not exceed ₹2,00,000. Income proof needs to be provided through a valid income certificate issued by a competent authority (Tehsildar, SDM, or Municipal Officer).

Kanyashree Prakalpa (West Bengal)

Introduced in 2013 by the Government of West Bengal, the Kanyashree Prakalpa is a flagship welfare scheme aimed at preventing child marriage and promoting female education.

This initiative has gained international recognition, receiving the United Nations Public Service Award (UNPSA) in 2017 for its contribution towards gender equality and women empowerment. By offering financial assistance to school-going girls, the scheme has successfully reduced dropout rates and delayed early marriages in the state.

Benefits of the Kanyashree Scheme

There are two components to the scholarship:

1. Kanyashree K1 (Annual Scholarship)
 - INR 1,000 per year for girls aged 13 to 18 years who are in Classes 8 to 12.
2. Kanyashree K2 (One-time Grant)
 - INR 25,000 one-time grant for girls who turn 18, provided they are unmarried and pursuing education.

Eligibility Criteria:

To avail the Kanyashree Prakalpa benefits, applicants must meet the following conditions:

For K1 (Annual Scholarship)

- Must be a resident of West Bengal.
- Must be a girl student aged between 13 and 18 years.
- Must be enrolled in Class 8 to 12 in a recognized school/madrasah or technical/vocational institution.
- Annual family income should be INR 1.2 lakh or less (Income limit is waived for orphans, special-needs students, and girls in government homes).
- Must remain unmarried till 18 years of age.

For K2 (One-time Grant)

- Must be 18 years old on the date of application.
- Must be continuing education in school, college, or vocational training.
- Must be unmarried.

- Annual family income criteria apply, but exemptions exist for certain categories.

Application Timeline:

The application is open throughout the year, but most applications are processed between July and September as per the school admission cycle.
