## MH CET LLB 5 year and LLB 3 year 2025 registration deadline extended

The State Common Entrance Test (CET) Cell, Maharashtra, has issued a notice regarding the extension of the registration deadline for MH CET 3-year LLB and MH CET 5-year LLB. As per the notice, candidates can now register until March 17, 2025. Interested and eligible candidates can visit the official website, i.e., [cetcell.mahacet.org](http://cetcell.mahacet.org), to complete the registration process.

The official notice reads, 'State CET Cell office received request from candidates and parents regarding extension to the form filling of CET 2025 for the course mentioned below. Hence, considering the academic interest of the candidates, CET CELL has decided to give extension for online Registration and Application Form Filling for the course'.

As per the information, earlier, the registration deadline for the MH CET 3-year LLB was February 28, 2025. The MH CET 5-year LLB 2025 exam is scheduled to be held on April 28, 2025, and MH CET 3-year LLB 2025 is scheduled to be held on May 3 and 4, 2025.

MH CET Law 2025 - The CET Cell has revised the MH CET Law 3-year LLB Programme Exam Date. The Maharashtra Common Entrance Test Cell has rescheduled the MH CET Law 2025 exam for the 3-year LLB program to May 3 and 4, 2025, to prevent conflicts with Mumbai University examinations. Previously, the exam was slated for March 20 and 21, 2025. MH CET Law 5-year LLB exam date is April 28, 2025.

## CBSE's draft scheme for two Class X exams creates confusion

The National Council of CBSE Schools (NCCS) is undertaking a nationwide initiative to consolidate state-wise feedback on the proposed two-exam policy, said Indira Rajan, secretary general, NCCS.

CBSE's draft scheme for two exams for Class X has raised doubts and created confusion. As per the draft scheme, two exams will be conducted for Class X to enable students to improve their performance. However, according to stakeholders, the draft scheme doesn't consider various factors.

One major concern raised by parents is the schedule for the two exams. "As per the tentative date sheet, it can be seen that the exams extend to May and the results would only come in by the end of May or early June. However, in Kerala and most of the southern states, the admissions to Class XI under state boards start in May and finish by June. Hence, students from CBSE who want to join the state boards would find themselves in a difficult situation," said a teacher of a CBSE school in Kochi.

Earlier, on the day the draft scheme was published on the CBSE website, the non-inclusion of certain regional and foreign languages led to widespread confusion, and protests erupted from various quarters. However, later the CBSE issued a clarification saying that the list of subjects contained in the draft date sheet had been given only as an example. "All subjects and languages offered will be continued in the academic year 2025-26," clarified CBSE. Meanwhile, the National Council of CBSE Schools (NCCS) is undertaking a nationwide initiative to consolidate state-wise feedback on the proposed two-exam policy, said Indira Rajan, secretary general, NCCS. "This initiative considers key factors such as student well-being and academic pressure, operational and administrative challenges, evaluation criteria and student performance, integration with higher education and career opportunities, as well as varied climatic conditions and regional challenges during this period.

## Centralised online admissions for First-Year Junior Colleges extended to entire Maharashtra

In a significant move aimed at streamlining the admissions process, the Maharashtra government has announced that starting from the 2025-26 academic year, admissions to First-Year Junior Colleges (FYJC) will be conducted through a centralized online system across the entire state. Previously, the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) was limited to urban regions such as the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR), Pune-Pimpri Chinchwad, Nagpur, Nashik, and Amravati. This expansion seeks to enhance transparency and accessibility for students and parents statewide.

The Government Resolution (GR) issued on Saturday outlines the implementation of the online CAP, which will function similarly to the existing system in urban areas. A notable feature of this system is the 'Open-To-All' admission round, conducted after four regular rounds. During this phase, vacant seats across colleges will be displayed online, allowing students to apply within a specified timeframe. If the number of applicants exceeds available seats, admissions will be allocated based on merit; if fewer students apply, all applicants will be granted admission.

However, the sudden extension of this centralized system to rural areas has raised concerns among parents and activists. They fear potential technical issues and delays in the admission process, given the shorter timeframe for implementation. One parent expressed apprehension, stating that even in regions where the system has been operational for over a decade, problems persist, and expanding it statewide might lead to complications.

In response to these concerns, government officials have acknowledged the challenges but remain optimistic about the implementation. They emphasize that there is sufficient time to address technical and logistical issues, with plans to extend the existing software to include rural colleges. Training videos and workshops will be provided to assist students and parents in navigating the new system, aiming to ensure a smooth transition and equitable access to educational opportunities across Maharashtra. This initiative represents a significant step toward modernizing the educational admission process in Maharashtra, with the potential to benefit a vast number of students.

## Maharashtra State Board Schools to Implement New Academic Session Dates

In a significant move towards aligning with national education standards, the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (MSBSHSE) has announced a major shift in the academic calendar. Starting from the 2026-27 academic year, schools affiliated with the Maharashtra state board will commence their academic session on April 1 instead of the traditional June start.

This decision is part of broader educational reforms aimed at standardizing academic calendars, synchronizing examination schedules, and enhancing student learning outcomes in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

### Key Reasons for the Change:

1. Aligning with National Academic Calendar for smoother transitions.
2. Better syllabus distribution to reduce last-minute pressure.

3. Minimizing weather disruptions during the monsoon season.
4. More efficient board exams and college admissions process.

- April 1, 2026: New academic schedule officially begins.

The shift to an April 1 start for Maharashtra state board schools marks a significant step toward modernization in the education system. This change is expected to benefit students, teachers, and institutions by providing a more structured, efficient, and nationally synchronized academic framework. This reform aims to enhance learning outcomes, reduce academic stress, and streamline education timelines, benefiting students and schools across Maharashtra.

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## Delhi High Court sets guidelines for student smartphone use, no complete ban

The Delhi High Court has ruled against a complete ban on smartphones in schools, stating that such an approach is neither practical nor desirable. Instead, the court has framed guidelines to regulate and monitor student smartphone use, balancing educational benefits with potential risks.

Justice Anup Jairam Bhambhani pointed out that technology has become an essential part of education, making a total ban on smartphones unrealistic. The court also noted that smartphones help students stay connected with their parents, adding to their safety and security. At the same time, the court acknowledged the risks of excessive screen time, social media exposure, and misuse of smartphones. Instead of banning them outright, the focus should be on responsible usage, it said.

### GUIDELINES FOR SMARTPHONE USE IN SCHOOLS

To ensure smartphones are used responsibly, the Delhi High Court laid down these key principles for schools:

- Where possible, students should deposit their smartphones during school hours.
- Smartphones should not be used in classrooms, school vehicles, or shared spaces.
- Schools must educate students on responsible online behaviour, digital manners, and ethical smartphone use.
- Students should be made aware of the risks of excessive screen time, including anxiety, reduced attention span, and cyberbullying.

- Smartphones can be used for connectivity and safety but not for entertainment or recreational purposes.
- Policies should be developed with input from parents, teachers, and experts.
- Schools should have the flexibility to create policies that suit their unique environments.
- Clear and reasonable consequences should be set for rule violations, ensuring consistent enforcement without being overly harsh.

Kendriya Vidyalaya had requested guidelines on smartphone use, and the court's ruling provides a framework that schools can adapt based on their requirements.

The court also suggested that schools could confiscate smartphones as a disciplinary measure when necessary.

A copy of the court's order has been sent to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), the Directorate of Education, Government of NCT of Delhi, and Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan. These organisations are expected to implement the guidelines and ensure schools enforce responsible smartphone use policies. This ruling balances the benefits of technology in education with the need to manage its risks, ensuring that students can use smartphones safely and effectively in schools.

## Discrepancy found in this important Class 10 paper. Check details here

Odisha Board of Secondary Education (BSE) has accepted a mistake in the Science question paper of the Class 10 examination. It was detected while the exam was held on Saturday at 3,111 centres in the state.

The discrepancy was found by the candidate and teachers after distributing the question papers to candidates. In Set-C of Science paper, the marks were 96 and not the required 100. The other three sets, however, included questions on the complete marks.

Responding to the issue, BSE President Srikant Tarai promised that proper remedial action would be taken to prevent students from being prejudiced. A four-mark question was absent from the Set-C paper. The board is enquiring into this, and students will not lose out because of this mistake. Appropriate steps will be taken while evaluating," he said.

The BSE has not specified the remedial measure in detail yet but has assured examinees that their performance will not be affected negatively due to the disparity.

Besides this, 11 students were caught resorting to malpractices while appearing for the Science examination. Their matter will be decided by a disciplinary committee, which will determine the action against such students involved.

The matriculation examination held annually is a crucial milestone for thousands of students across Odisha, as it plays a significant role in shaping their academic and professional futures. Given the high stakes involved, any irregularity in the examination process—such as errors in question papers, logistical issues, or administrative lapses—can cause unnecessary stress and anxiety among the candidates. Such disruptions not only impact students' performance but also raise concerns about the fairness and credibility of the examination system.

In this context, the prompt recognition of errors by the examination board is of utmost importance. By acknowledging any lapses and taking swift corrective measures, the board can reassure students, parents, and educators that the integrity of the examination process remains intact. Furthermore, the board's commitment to an impartial and transparent evaluation ensures that no student is unfairly disadvantaged due to administrative mistakes. These proactive steps help in maintaining public trust in the education system and upholding the sanctity of the matriculation examination.

## Delhi School Admissions for Economically Weaker Sections to be Fully Computerised

## No Class 10 certificate without Punjabi? Punjab vs CBSE controversy explained

After Punjab declared Punjabi language a compulsory subject in schools, in all boards -- CBSE, ICSE, IB or regional -- on Wednesday, the rift between the Central government and the AAP-led state government seems to have widened.

The controversy arose after the CBSE draft scheme was released on Tuesday announcing two Class 10 board exams yearly from 2025-26. The draft document did not list Punjabi among its list of "Regional and Foreign languages group" of subjects, which led to State Education Minister Harjot Bains raising questions on the commission.

CBSE later issued a clarification on Wednesday stating that the subjects listed in the draft policy were only "indicative" -- meaning the list wasn't final -- and that the board exam subject list would remain unchanged for the 2025-26 academic session.

In an official notification, CBSE stated, "It is clarified that the list of other subjects and languages included in the draft datesheet is only indicative and that all the subjects and languages currently offered shall continue to be available for the 2025-2026 academic year as well."

According to CBSE, in addition the languages mentioned in Point 8 of the draft policy under the "Regional and Foreign Languages" group, the following languages shall continue to be offered: Punjabi (004), Russian (021), Nepali (024), Limboo (025), Lepcha (026), Sindhi (008), Malayalam (012), Odia (013), Assamese (014), Kannada (015), Kokborok (091), Telugu (007), Arabic (016), and Persian (023).

CBSE's clarifying notification included 14 languages it had not mentioned in its draft policy, including Punjabi and Telugu.

### PUNJAB'S STANCE ON THE CBSE DRAFT POLICY

State Education Minister Harjot Bains, in response to the CBSE draft policy, had posted a video on X on Wednesday morning, where he wrote, "Punjabi must be designated as the main language in Punjab and further be included as a regional language in CBSE for rest of the nation, as it is spoken and read across multiple states."

After this issue was raised, CBSE released a notification, clarifying that the list of subjects in the Class 10 board exam draft policy wasn't final.

Speaking to ANI after CBSE's clarification was issued, Bains said, "The group of regional foreign languages has Punjabi missing from it... BJP Punjab tweets from its official handle that there was a clerical mistake..."

"I have written a strong letter to Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan. I said that this was not a clerical mistake and we wanted action against the officer who did this. Every Punjabi is hurt with this," he added.

He went on to say that every board will need to ensure Punjabi is a main subject in Class 10, without which the board certificate will be considered null and void.

Bains questioned why the primary language of the state was not being included as a main subject in CBSE Class 10 board exams.

## Delhi High Court Regulates Smartphone Use in Schools, Rejects Total Ban

The Delhi High Court has ruled that completely banning students from using smartphones in schools is neither practical nor desirable. Instead, it has framed guidelines to regulate their usage [Y V vs. Kendriya Vidyalaya & Ors].

Justice Anup Jairam Bhambhani highlighted the evolving role of technology in education, stating that a total ban on smartphones would be an impractical approach. The Court acknowledged that while smartphones can be misused, they also play a crucial role in student safety and communication with parents.

The case arose from a petition filed by a minor student at Kendriya Vidyalaya, seeking permission to use a smartphone. In response, the school requested the Court to provide guidelines on smartphone use in schools. The Court emphasized that while students should not be barred from bringing smartphones, their usage must be monitored and controlled.

Key Guidelines Issued by the Court:

- Schools should arrange for safekeeping of smartphones, requiring students to deposit them during school hours.
- Smartphone use should be prohibited in classrooms, school vehicles, and common areas.
- Schools must educate students on responsible online behavior, digital etiquette, and ethical smartphone usage.

- Students should be counseled on the risks of excessive screen time, including anxiety, reduced attention span, and cyberbullying.
- Policies should allow smartphone use for safety and communication but prohibit entertainment and recreational use.
- Rules should be developed in consultation with parents, educators, and experts.
- Schools should have the flexibility to tailor policies to their specific needs.
- Clear and fair consequences for policy violations should be established, with confiscation suggested as a disciplinary measure.
- Policies should be regularly reviewed and updated to address emerging technological challenges.

The Court directed that a copy of its order be sent to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Directorate of Education, Government of NCT of Delhi, and Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan for implementation. Advocates Ashu Bidhuri, Swapnam Prakash Singh, Hemant Baisla, Shabana Hussain, and Satyansh Gupta represented the minor student. Advocates S Rajappa, R Gowrishankar, and G Dhivyasri appeared for Kendriya Vidyalaya, while Advocates Anuj Tyagi and Akshita Agarwal represented the Delhi Commission for Protection of Child Rights.

## Experts raise Concerns Over Budget Cuts in Higher Education at PAU Conference

The two-day event saw participation from university and college teachers from across the country, who highlighted how government policies are gradually withdrawing support from public institutions. Arun Kumar, national general secretary of AIFUCTO, criticized the new UGC draft, stating that it severely limits benefits for teachers and restricts the democratic rights they fought for over the years. He warned that the appointment process of vice-chancellors is now being dictated by restrictive policies, further curbing academic freedom. AIFUCTO president M Nagarjuna strongly opposed the National Education Policy (NEP)

arguing that it threatens the democratic and secular nature of higher education. Vinay Sophat, AIFUCTO vice president and conference organising secretary, criticized Punjab’s lack of implementation of either the old or new pension schemes, making it the only state in this situation. He also raised concerns over reduced funding for aided colleges, where the grant has been cut from 95% to 75%, whereas many other states still provide full financial support. The conference was attended by prominent dignitaries, including PAU vice-chancellor Satbir Singh Gosal, Punjab Agro Industries chairman Mangal Singh, and Management Federation president Rajinder Mohan Singh Chhina.

## AP, Telangana Higher Education Councils Discuss Collaboration for Academic Growth

Key Areas of Focus:

1. Research and Development (R&D) Collaboration
- Recognizing the importance of research in

in areas like artificial intelligence, biotechnology, sustainable energy, and healthcare. Special funding mechanisms and research grants may be introduced to facilitate cross-state research partnerships.

3. Faculty and Student Exchange Programs

To enhance academic quality, the councils proposed faculty exchange programs, where professors and lecturers from AP and Telangana could teach in each other's institutions for specific periods. Similarly, student exchange programs would allow learners to experience different academic environments, fostering a broader perspective.

Potential Challenges and Solutions

While the collaboration presents immense opportunities, certain challenges need to be addressed, including:

- Regulatory Framework: Establishing common policies for academic partnerships and ensuring smooth implementation of inter-state programs.
- Financial Considerations: Allocating necessary funds to support joint initiatives, including scholarships and faculty development programs.
- Administrative Coordination: Creating dedicated committees to oversee collaborative projects and ensure efficiency.
