CBSE to Hold Class 10 Board Exams Twice a Year from -VidyarthiMitra News Desk 2026

Starting from the academic year 2026, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) is introducing a major change: Class 10 board exams will now be conducted twice a year. This new format is designed to give students more flexibility and reduce the pressure that comes with high-stakes exams.

Two Chances, One Goal: Better Outcomes for Students

Here's how the exam schedule will work:

- First session: February 17 to March 6,
- Second session: May 5 to May 20, 2026

Students can choose to appear for either one or both sessions. If they're satisfied with their performance in the first round, they can skip the second. But if they feel they can do better, they'll have a second shot just a few months later.

Why This Change?

The main goal is to reduce exam-related stress. Many students find the pressure of a single board exam overwhelming. By offering two sessions, CBSE hopes to create a more supportive environment that gives students room to grow and learn from their mistakes.

Feedback, Concerns & What's Next

While the idea has been well received by many, not everyone is fully on board yet.

- The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Education has raised a few concerns, especially about the possibility of higher exam fees and the challenges of organising exams twice a year.
- To address these, CBSE opened up the proposal for public feedback, accepting suggestions and opinions until March 9, 2025. These responses are now under review as part of the final policy.

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Imperial College London to open global hub in Bengaluru

Scheduled to open in May 2025, this pioneering initiative marks a milestone in UK-India academic relations, aiming to strengthen scientific, educational, and technological ties between the two countries. The Bengaluru hub will act as a liaison office, strategically positioned to facilitate meaningful partnerships between Imperial College and India's top academic and research institutions. By serving as a centralized platform for co-created research, the hub is designed to bring together brilliant minds across disciplines to collaboratively address pressing global challenges. Furthermore, it is envisioned as a bridge that connects universities, governments, industries, and innovation ecosystems from both nations, paving the way for impactful discoveries, scalable solutions, and sustained development.

Imperial College has long held a strong presence in India through various academic and research collaborations. This new hub seeks to formalize and expand those ties, offering a structured space for cooperation and idea exchange. The college's strategic partnership with the Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru, stands as a prime example of its commitment to fostering innovation through collaboration.

Joint projects already span a broad range of scientific disciplines, and Imperial's ongoing engagement with institutions such as AIIMS, IIT Bombay, IIT Delhi, IIT Kharagpur, and the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research underscores the depth of its academic footprint in India. Dr Dieckmann is engaged in groundbreaking research to upcycle waste solar panels into architectural materials, showcasing how sustainable innovation can be both practical and environmentally transformative. Both leaders will be spending substantial time in India to personally oversee the hub's operations and foster stronger academic relationships. The Uttarakhand Subordinate Service Selection Commission (UKSSSC) has officially released the Group C Recruitment Notification 2025, inviting applications for a total of 416 vacancies in various departments. The recruitment aims to fill crucial positions such as Village Development Officer, Patwari, Lekhpal, and other administrative posts. As per the official notice, the registration process will begin on April 15, 2025, and continue until May 15, 2025, offering eligible candidates ample time to apply. A correction window will also be made available from May 18 to May 20, 2025, in case any modifications are needed in the submitted applications. The written examination for these posts is scheduled to be held on July 27, 2025, and further instructions regarding exam centres and admit cards will be shared in due course on the UKSSSC website.

Interested individuals are encouraged to review the detailed notification, which includes specific eligibility criteria such as age limits and educational qualifications, to ensure that they meet the requirements for their desired positions. The registration process will begin on April 15, 2025, and continue until May 15, 2025, offering eligible candidates ample time to apply.

To apply, candidates belonging to the Unreserved and OBC categories of Uttarakhand must pay an application fee of ₹300, while candidates from the SC, ST, EWS, and DIVYANG categories are required to pay ₹150. The Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Higher Secondary (MSBSHSE) has officially reopened the registration process for private candidates planning to appear for the July-August 2025 SSC (Class 10) and HSC (Class 12) board examinations. This fresh registration window comes as a significant relief for students who missed the earlier deadline for the February-March 2025 exams, which has traditionally been the only opportunity for private candidates to enroll. The Board acknowledged that many eligible students fail to complete their applications in time, leading to the loss of an academic year. In a first-of-its-kind initiative, the MSBSHSE has now introduced a supplementary registration opportunity for the mid-year session, ensuring that no student misses out on their academic progress due to administrative deadlines. This initiative aims to provide a second chance to candidates and reduce the number of students facing academic setbacks because of missed deadlines.

As per the official circular issued by the Maharashtra Board, the online registration process will begin on Tuesday, April 15, 2025, and will remain open until Thursday, May 15, 2025. Eligible students must complete Form No. 17 via the official website, mahahsscboard.in. Once the form is filled, students must take a printout of the

application form, the online fee acknowledgment, and submit them with original supporting documents to the school or junior college mentioned in their form. The Board has clarified that even those who have passed Class 5 or Class 8 through the Maharashtra State Open School Board are eligible to apply as private candidates for the SSC examination. Upon successful completion of the registration, candidates will be issued a digital registration certificate, which will allow them to proceed with filling the actual exam form and completing the payment process as per Board protocols.

All schools and junior colleges designated for private candidates are available for enrollment in line with the Board's rules and regulations. The MSBSHSE has urged students, institutions, and parents to contact their respective divisional board offices for any clarification or assistance related to the process. - 1. Over 300 Student Visas Revoked by Trump Administration: In recent weeks, the Trump administration has revoked more than 300 student visas of international students across the United States. Prestigious universities such as Harvard, Stanford, UCLA, and Ohio State University have reported cases where students were either deported or denied re-entry into the U.S. This marks a sharp increase in visa enforcement, raising alarm among academic institutions and advocacy groups. The revocations have caught many institutions off guard, as they were often informed only after students were detained or denied boarding at airports.
- 2. Visa Cancellations Made Without Warning or Explanation: Many of the affected students and their universities were not notified in advance about the visa revocations. In several instances, students only discovered their visa status had changed when attempting to travel or access school systems. The lack of formal communication and transparency has left universities scrambling to support their students and understand the basis for the government's actions. Legal experts argue that this lack of procedural transparency undermines due process.
- 3. Protest Participation and Minor Violations Among Causes: While some students lost their visas due to pro-Palestinian participation in demonstrations.

- 4. DHS Deploys "Catch and Revoke" AI Surveillance Program: The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has introduced an artificial intelligencepowered program called "Catch and Revoke." This system monitors social media activity for language deemed supportive of antisemitic terrorism. Posts flagged by the AI could lead to a student's visa being denied or canceled. While the DHS claims the system aims to prevent national security threats, civil liberties groups warn that it could criminalize free speech and open the door to mass surveillance of international
- 5. High-Profile Detentions Raise Alarm: Two cases have drawn national attention: Mahmoud Khalil, a former Columbia University student, and Rumeysa Ozturk, a Ph.D. candidate at Tufts University, were detained under allegations of supporting organizations such as Hamas which is designated as a terrorist group by the U.S. government. Both were removed from the country without formal charges being filed. Advocacy groups argue these cases demonstrate how students can be penalized based on suspicion rather than concrete evidence.
- 6. Universities Alarmed by Lack of Due **Process:** Institutions of higher education have voiced concern over what they describe as arbitrary visa enforcement. In many instances, they only became aware of a student's revoked visa through internal record checks or when a student failed to return to campus. University officials have called for clearer communication from federal agencies and respect for academic independence and international mobility.

For Indian students, this program is especially vital. Many of them use OPT

- Students would no longer be allowed to work in the U.S. after their graduation.

453 schools in Pune district denied reimbursements under RTE Act over arbitrary reasons, say associations

Issue at Hand:

- The Maharashtra Education Department has denied fee reimbursements under the Right to Education (RTE) Act for 453 schools in Pune district.
- Cited reasons include technical discrepancies and arbitrary demands for documentation, which school associations claim are unwarranted.

Technical Issues Cited:

- The Executive Parent Teachers' Association (EPTA) resolution lacks specific mention of "tuition fees."
- School bank accounts are not in proper institutional names.
- Address documents show slight discrepancies.
- · Lease agreements are unregistered.
- Online documents submitted by schools are blurred.

School Associations' Arguments:

- Represented by the Maharashtra Rajya Shikshan Sanstha Mahamandal and the Independent English Schools Association (IESA), schools argue:
 - These technical issues were not considered problematic during the RTE admission process.
 - · It is unfair to retroactively demand compliance with new documentation

Legal Concerns:

- The July 2023 GR required only 10 key indicators for self-accreditation.





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
