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Maharashtra Government Schools to Adopt CBSE Curriculum from 2025, SSC Board to Continue

Maharashtra School Education Minister Dadaji Bhuse has announced that, starting from the academic year 2025-2026, government schools in the state will adopt the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) curriculum, beginning with Class 1. Despite this transition, Bhuse has assured that the Maharashtra State Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board (SSC Board) will continue to operate and is not slated for closure.

Implementation Plan:

The integration of the CBSE curriculum will occur in phases:

- 2025: Implementation in Class 1.
- 2026: Expansion to Classes 2, 3, 4, and 6.
- 2027: Inclusion of Classes 5, 7, 9, and 11.
- 2028: Full implementation up to Class 12.

Curriculum Development:

The State Council for Educational Research and Training (SCERT) is developing the new curriculum, aligning it with the National Curriculum Framework under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. Balbharti is tasked with creating textbooks for Class 1, ensuring they are available in Marathi by April 1. The curriculum aims to provide students with state, national, and global knowledge, emphasizing practical learning and technology integration.

Objectives:

Minister Bhuse highlighted that adopting the CBSE pattern is intended to:

- Enhance the quality of education in Maharashtra.
- Prepare students more effectively for national-level competitive exams such as JEE, NEET, and UPSC.
- Focus on continuous and comprehensive evaluation rather than solely on final examinations.
- Students soft skills, including communication, leadership, creativity, and stress management.

Preservation of State Board and Cultural Identity:

Addressing concerns about the potential impact on Maharashtra's educational traditions and cultural identity, Bhuse reassured that:

- The SSC Board will not be discontinued; instead, efforts will be made to strengthen it.
- The new textbooks will incorporate Maharashtra's history, geography, and Marathi language to preserve the state's rich heritage.

The Maharashtra government's decision to adopt the CBSE curriculum in state-run schools marks a significant shift aimed at enhancing educational standards and better preparing students for competitive examinations. By phasing in the new curriculum and maintaining the SSC Board, the state seeks to balance modernization with the preservation of its educational heritage.
