## Maharashtra Moves to Boost Website Capacity for Exam Results

volume of simultaneous users more efficiently. The initiative also aims to shield these websites from potential cyber threats, ensuring that student data remains safe and the platforms remain accessible and functional.

With this initiative, the Maharashtra government hopes to provide students and their families a hassle-free, secure, and reliable online experience on result day—making the already emotional moment a bit smoother and stress-free.

To prevent technical glitches and ensure smooth access for students, the Maharashtra State Examination Board has taken proactive steps to enhance its website infrastructure ahead of upcoming result announcements. This move follows repeated complaints in previous years where heavy web traffic caused portals to crash or load slowly, leading to widespread student frustration.

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## NBEMS introduces mandatory time bound sections in exam

In a major move to enhance the security, fairness, and efficiency of medical entrance examinations, the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS) has introduced mandatory time-bound sections in the NEET MDS 2025 examination. This decision comes amid growing concerns over exam-related malpractices and unauthorized access to question papers. According to the NBEMS notification released recently, this new format will be implemented not just in NEET MDS, but across all major NBEMS exams, including NEET-PG, NEET-SS, FMGE, DNB-PDCET, GPAT, DPEE, FDST, and FET. All these exams are conducted in a computer-based mode, and the newly introduced system will ensure that each section of the question paper is attempted within a strict time limit. NBEMS clarified that this change, though not entirely new, is being reinforced with greater clarity and transparency in the 2025 cycle due to emerging challenges during the examination process. The measure is expected to act as a deterrent to malpractice and unauthorized communication during exams.

The structure of the NEET MDS 2025 question paper has been clearly defined in the notification. The exam will be split into two distinct parts — Part A and Part B. Part A will contain 100 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) and candidates will be given 75 minutes to attempt them. Part B, on the other hand, will have 140 MCQs with a time duration of 105 minutes.

The key point here is that candidates will not be allowed to switch between parts or revisit questions from a previous part once the allotted time has expired. This means once Part A is over, candidates cannot go back and change their responses — the system will automatically move to Part B. Similarly, Part B will commence immediately after Part A concludes, with no manual intervention. This automated, segmented format adds a layer of discipline and time-management for aspirants and requires careful attention during preparation and practice.

The rationale behind this change, as per NBEMS, is to protect the sanctity of the examination process. In recent years, the exam ecosystem in India has seen increasing threats related to digital fraud, leaks, and impersonation. By dividing the paper into locked, time-bound sections, the Board hopes to mitigate the risk of question-sharing during breaks or loopholes between sections. NBEMS has assured students that the change is not meant to increase the difficulty of the exam, but to ensure a fair and secure environment for all aspirants, especially in high-stakes medical entrance exams where competition is fierce. This move is also in line with international best practices followed in standardized tests, where section-based time limits are common. The notification emphasized that aspirants must be fully aware of this structural change and practice accordingly to perform optimally under the new constraints.

## Maharashtra SSC, HSC Exam Results 2025: Minister orders security of result websites

In a significant move to improve digital infrastructure and ensure smoother access to examination results, Maharashtra Information Technology Minister Ashish Shelar on Monday instructed officials to submit a comprehensive report within seven days on enhancing the capacity and cyber security of the state education board's websites. These platforms, which host the results for the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) exams, often witness massive traffic on result days. Recognizing the frustration and anxiety students face due to technical glitches and website crashes, Shelar emphasized the urgent need for technological upgrades and preventive action to avoid system failures during such crucial moments.

During a joint review meeting attended by officials from the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (MSBSHSE) and the Information Technology Department, Shelar expressed concern over the existing system's inability to handle the heavy load generated by lakhs of students logging in simultaneously. He instructed the departments to conduct regular load testing and implement capacity enhancement strategies to ensure that students are not hindered by slow loading or non-functional web pages when checking their examination outcomes.

Another critical issue highlighted in the meeting was cyber security, as the increasing digitization of education services makes these platforms more vulnerable to attacks. Shelar stressed that the safety of students' data is paramount and instructed officials to present a detailed cyber security report addressing existing vulnerabilities, potential threats, and recommended safeguards. The report is expected to outline robust measures for preventing data breaches, denial-of-service attacks, and other digital threats that could compromise the integrity of the results or the website itself. The minister made it clear that this report must be submitted within a strict timeframe of seven days for immediate action.

This high-level meeting reflects the Maharashtra government's broader push to modernize the education system, especially following its recent decision to introduce the CBSE curriculum starting from Class 1 in 2025, with plans to expand it to all grades by 2028. Present at the meeting were prominent officials including MSBSHSE chairperson Sharad Gosavi, School Education Department Deputy Secretary Tushar Mahajan, and IT Department Director Anil Bhandari, among others.

## IIM-Ahmedabad, UAE govt to offer full-time MBA programme at Institute's Dubai branch

Additionally, Asian countries such as Singapore, Japan, and Malaysia are emerging as viable options, offering cost-effective, industry-aligned programs. New Zealand is also becoming a preferred destination, thanks to its welcoming work-permit policies and high quality of life.
- The United States Remains a Top Choice:**  
Despite the growing interest in other countries, the United States continues to be a leading destination for Indian students, especially for those pursuing STEM and business programs. Concerns about political rhetoric and immigration policies have been noted, but Gupta emphasizes that the U.S. remains a hub for technology and innovation, with a consistent demand for skilled talent. He advises students to focus on gaining admission to quality institutions and to prepare thoroughly for standardized exams like the GRE, GMAT, SAT, and TOEFL/IELTS, which are prerequisites for U.S. universities.

- Addressing Rising Education Costs:**  
The financial aspect of studying abroad is a significant consideration. Countries like the UK have revised their financial requirements, with students in London now needing to demonstrate £1,483 per month for living expenses. To mitigate these costs, there is an increased availability of education loans and scholarships. Public sector banks and Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) in India have expanded their lending for study abroad purposes, offering extended repayment tenures. Notable scholarships such as the Fulbright-Nehru Fellowship, JN Tata Endowment, and the National Overseas Scholarship provide substantial financial support to eligible candidates.
- Evolving Program Structures:**  
There is a growing demand for hybrid learning models, short-term certifications, and job-oriented programs in fields like Artificial Intelligence (AI), fintech, and digital marketing. Students are increasingly opting for skill-based programs that enhance global employability. In response, international universities are incorporating project-based learning, industry internships, and enhanced mental health support into their curricula. This trend is particularly appealing to students from India's tier-II and tier-III cities, who are becoming more informed and ambitious in their educational pursuits.
- Future Outlook:**  
Foreign universities are actively seeking to attract Indian students due to their significant contributions to the international student community. This has led to the implementation of more student-friendly visa policies and a concerted push for internationalization.





Private schools fees: Know Delhi government plans to curb irregular hike

The Delhi government, under Chief Minister Rekha Gupta, has taken decisive steps to address the issue of irregular and exorbitant fee hikes by private unaided schools in the city. This action follows widespread complaints from parents, especially those from middle- and lower-income groups, about annual fee increases of up to 25-30% in recent years, particularly after the COVID-19 pandemic.

Key Actions Taken by the Government

- Inspection Teams Deployment
  - The Directorate of Education (DoE) has intensified its monitoring efforts by deploying inspection teams, including those led by district magistrates, to investigate complaints regarding fee hikes.
  - Schools found violating regulations under the Delhi School Education Act and Rules of 1973 will face strict action.
- Parental Concerns and Protests
  - Parents have protested outside prominent private schools like Delhi Public School, Dwarka, over significant fee hikes.
  - Complaints also included allegations of arbitrary fee increases and the mistreatment of students, such as isolating them for extended periods due to fee-related disputes.

- Government Warnings to Schools
  - The government has issued warnings to private schools about adhering to legal guidelines regarding fee structures.
  - Schools failing to comply with these rules may face penalties or further inspections.

Political Reactions

- AAP's Criticism
  - Leaders from the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) have accused the BJP-led administration of being complicit with private schools in allowing unlawful fee hikes.
  - AAP has demanded a probe into potential collusion between private schools and government officials.

Education Initiatives in Budget 2025

- CM Shri Schools
  - A budget of ₹100 crore has been allocated for the establishment of new CM Shri Schools under the New Education Policy to provide affordable, quality education.
- Smart Classes and Computer Labs
  - ₹50 crore has been dedicated to creating 175 new computer labs in government schools.
  - ₹100 crore has been allocated for smart classrooms to improve the learning environment in public schools.

NEET UG 2024: ‘Nothing survived in the case,’ says SC as it closes petition after Centre assures to implement panel suggestions

- Background
  - The NEET-UG 2024 examination faced allegations of a paper leak and irregularities in the results.
  - Multiple petitions were filed seeking redressal and reforms in the examination process.
  - To address the concerns, a seven-member panel was formed to investigate and provide recommendations.
- Supreme Court Proceedings
  - The central government assured the Supreme Court that it would implement all but one recommendation made by the panel.
  - The exception was the recommendation to transition NEET to an online examination format, which was not accepted for immediate implementation.
  - Based on these assurances, the Supreme Court declared that the case had been adequately addressed and closed the proceedings.
- Government’s Assurance
  - The Solicitor General, representing the central government, committed to adopting the panel’s suggestions to enhance the integrity and fairness of the NEET examination process.
- Key Outcomes
  - The implementation of the panel’s recommendations is expected to address past discrepancies and improve the transparency of the examination process.
  - Although the proposal for conducting NEET online was set aside, it remains a potential area for future consideration.
- Impact on Future NEET Exams
  - This resolution aims to restore confidence among aspirants and ensure a secure, fair, and credible examination process in upcoming editions of NEET.
  - The Supreme Court’s decision reflects its satisfaction with the government’s proactive steps to address the concerns raised in the NEET-UG 2024 examination.



Maharashtra SSC, HSC Exam Results 2025: Minister orders security of result websites, report on improving capacity

- Review Meeting
  - Maharashtra's Information Technology Minister, Ashish Shelar, held a joint review meeting with officials from the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (MSBSHSE) and the IT Department.
  - The meeting focused on addressing technical issues faced during the announcement of SSC (Class 10) and HSC (Class 12) exam results.
- Website Capacity Concerns
  - During result announcements, the official websites experience heavy traffic, leading to crashes and delays in accessing results.
  - This problem arises from the large number of students trying to log in simultaneously.
- Minister’s Directives
  - Minister Shelar directed officials to work on enhancing the load-handling capacity of the result websites
  - Regular load testing and capacity enhancements were emphasized to ensure the systems can handle peak traffic during result periods.
- Focus on Cybersecurity
  - The minister highlighted the importance of cybersecurity, stressing the need for robust measures to protect the websites from potential cyberattacks.
  - A comprehensive strategy for website security was requested.
- Seven-Day Timeline for Report
  - Officials have been given seven days to submit a detailed report addressing:
    - The required upgrades to handle high traffic.
    - Steps to bolster cybersecurity and protect the integrity of the platforms.
- Impact of the Initiative
  - These measures aim to provide a seamless and secure experience for lakhs of students awaiting their exam results.

Urgency as far as UG is concerned,’ says Delhi HC Bench on CLAT UG 2025 result;

- Background of the Issue
  - The Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2025 was conducted in December 2024 for admissions into undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) law programs at National Law Universities (NLUs).
  - After the examination, candidates raised concerns about inaccuracies in some questions and the official answer key, leading to legal petitions.
- Supreme Court Intervention
  - The Supreme Court consolidated all petitions concerning the examination and transferred them to the Delhi High Court to avoid conflicting judgments.
  - This decision ensured a uniform resolution of grievances across the country.
- Delhi High Court Proceedings
  - The Delhi High Court started hearings on these petitions.
  - The court, led by Chief Justice D. K. Upadhyaya and Justice Tushar Rao Gedela, stressed the urgency of
  - resolving issues related to the undergraduate exam to facilitate the declaration of results.
- Focus on Undergraduate Issues
  - Given the significant number of UG aspirants and the pressing need to finalize admissions, the court decided to address UG-related petitions first.
  - Postgraduate-related issues will be taken up separately.
- Errors in Examination
  - Petitioners highlighted errors in the question paper and discrepancies in the answer key.
  - A previous directive from the Delhi High Court had already instructed the Consortium of NLUs to revise results based on errors in two specific questions.
- Court's Priority
  - The Delhi High Court is working to expedite the process, aiming to reduce uncertainty for aspirants while ensuring fairness in the evaluation process.

WB Board appeals Supreme Court ruling as over 25,000 school jobs face risk

- Background of the Issue
  - The controversy revolves around alleged irregularities in the recruitment of primary school teachers in West Bengal.
  - The appointments in question were made by the West Bengal Board of Primary Education based on the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET).
- Calcutta High Court Ruling
  - The Calcutta High Court ordered the cancellation of 36,000 primary teacher appointments in government schools.
  - The court found evidence that some candidates who failed to meet eligibility criteria were still appointed.
- Impact on Students and Education
  - The removal of a large number of teachers could disrupt the education of thousands o students in government schools.
  - There are concerns about increased teacher shortages, especially in rural areas.
- Next Steps
  - The Supreme Court's decision on the appeal will determine the fate of the 36,000 appointments and potentially set a precedence for addressing recruitment irregularities.
  - If the appeal is denied, the state may need conduct fresh recruitment processes to fill the void.

SCERT files complaint against 20 online channels after PAT paper leak

- The Maharashtra State Council of Education Research and Training (SCERT) discovered on April 7, 2025, that the Performance Assessment Test (PAT) question papers for Standard IX had been leaked online.
- Question papers for three subjects were uploaded on various online channels two days before the scheduled exam on April 8, 2025.
- SCERT plans to implement stricter measures to prevent similar incidents in the future.
- Examination Logistics
  - Exam papers were sent to schools via private cargo companies, with instructions issued to education officers and principals regarding handling and scheduling
- Key Challenges:
  - Logistical constraints prevented replacing the leaked papers in time for the exams.
  - The scale of the PAT, involving millions of students, presents unique administrative and security challenges compared to smaller-scale assessments in other states.
