Underrepresentation of SC and ST Students in Top Private Universities

A recent report by the Parliamentary Standing Committee has shed light on the significant disparities in the enrollment of Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) students in India's top 30 private universities. The findings indicate that only 5% of enrolled students belong to the SC category, while less than 1% are from the ST category. These figures highlight persistent challenges in achieving equitable access to higher education for marginalized communities.

The report attributes this disparity to multiple factors, including financial constraints, lack of awareness about available scholarships, and insufficient institutional support. Despite various affirmative action policies and scholarship programs, students from SC and ST backgrounds continue to face systemic barriers that hinder their educational aspirations. The high tuition fees of private universities often act as a deterrent, making it difficult for students from underprivileged backgrounds to afford quality education in these institutions.

Another major concern highlighted in the report is the inadequate representation of SC and ST faculty members in private universities, which further affects the inclusivity of these institutions. The absence of diverse role models and mentors may discourage students from marginalized communities from pursuing higher education in these institutions. Additionally, socio-cultural biases and lack of support networks within campuses contribute to feelings of alienation among these students, impacting their academic performance and overall experience.

To address these disparities, the committee has recommended implementing targeted policies such as increasing financial aid and scholarship opportunities for SC and ST students, enforcing quotas in private universities, and ensuring better representation of marginalized communities in faculty positions.

The report also suggests establishing dedicated support cells within universities to assist students from disadvantaged backgrounds in navigating academic and financial challenges.

With the increasing role of private universities in India's higher education landscape, the issue of equitable access has become more pressing than ever. Ensuring greater inclusion of SC and ST students in these institutions is not just a matter of social justice but also a critical step toward fostering diversity and equal opportunities in education. As policymakers and educational institutions work toward bridging these gaps, sustained efforts and systemic reforms will be crucial in creating a more inclusive and accessible higher education system in India.

The underrepresentation of SC and ST students in top private universities reflects deep-rooted inequalities in access to quality education, financial resources, and social mobility. Without stronger policies, financial support, and awareness efforts, this gap will continue to persist, limiting opportunities for historically marginalized communities. Ensuring inclusive and equitable education in private institutions is crucial for a more just and progressive society.

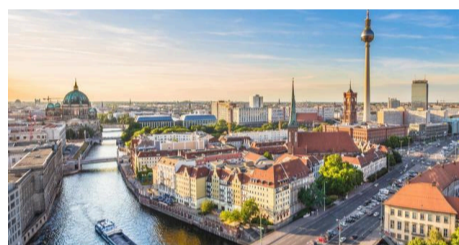

Maharashtra Government Revises School Timings Due To Heatwave

Additional Precautionary Measures: Beyond altering school hours, the Directorate of Education has mandated several measures to protect students from heat-related illnesses:

- **Limiting Outdoor Activities:** Suspension of outdoor sports and physical exercises during school hours; classes should not be conducted in open areas.

- **Health Awareness:** Teachers are to educate students on precautions to prevent heat-related illnesses.
- **Classroom Ventilation:** Ensuring all classrooms are equipped with functional fans to maintain adequate ventilation.
- **Hydration:** Provision of sufficient cold drinking water for students.
- **Dietary Recommendations:** Encouraging consumption of seasonal fruits and vegetables with high water content, such as watermelon, muskmelon, oranges, grapes, pineapple, cucumber, and salads.
- **Appropriate Clothing:** Advising students to wear loose, light-colored cotton clothing to stay cool.
- **Protective Accessories:** Promoting the use of hats, umbrellas, or traditional cloth coverings for the head while commuting.
- **Footwear:** Recommending students wear shoes or sandals to avoid walking barefoot in the heat.

Background and Rationale:

The decision follows reports of temperatures exceeding 40 degrees Celsius in regions like Vidarbha and Kalyan Rural. These extreme conditions have led to decreased attendance in afternoon sessions in affected areas.

CBSE releases parenting calendar; family bonding through storytelling, music key features

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has launched a Parenting Calendar for the academic session 2025-26. This initiative aims to foster collaboration between parents and educators to promote student well-being and holistic development.

Framework and Objectives

The calendar is divided into four sections, each designed for specific grade levels, offering age-appropriate activities. The goal is to encourage shared responsibility in education among parents, schools, and students, fostering a supportive environment for children's growth. CBSE has recommended that schools implement these guidelines flexibly to suit their specific needs.

Grade-Specific Activities

- **Nursery & Kindergarten:** Activities include storytelling, music sessions, simple puzzles, and DIY science experiments. These are aimed at strengthening family bonds and stimulating cognitive development.
- **Classes 1-2:** Outdoor learning experiences, traditional games, and introductory STEM challenges are suggested to promote curiosity and physical activity.
- **Classes 3-5:** Activities include science experiments, cultural explorations, and

role-reversal days where children teach parents new skills, fostering mutual learning.

- **Classes 6-8:** Skill-swap sessions, collaborative projects, and sustainability challenges are recommended to develop critical thinking and teamwork skills.
- **Classes 9-10:** Focus on career mentoring, digital detox practices, and art-based activities to encourage self-expression and future planning.
- **Classes 11-12:** Activities revolve around career guidance, financial literacy challenges, and exercises emphasizing family values and independence.

Implementation and Customization

Schools are encouraged to adapt the Parenting Calendar to their academic schedules and local requirements. The activities are designed to bridge learning gaps, strengthen family relationships, and provide parents with deeper insights into their children's educational experiences.

School enrollments decline in last 2 years, elementary level sees 8% drop: Govt

Recent government data has revealed an 8% decline in school enrollments across the country, signaling a pressing education crisis. The decline is more pronounced in rural areas and among economically weaker sections, highlighting socio-economic disparities. The pandemic has further exacerbated the issue, as many children were forced to drop out due to economic hardships and lack of access to digital learning tools. Gender disparities also persist, with a significant number of girls leaving school due to financial and societal constraints.

 - School enrollments have dropped by 8%, raising concerns about the education system.
2. **Regional and Socio-Economic Disparities:**
 - Higher dropout rates are observed in rural areas and among economically weaker communities.

State allocates 10 cr for periodic assessment test in schools

Increased Allocation:

- The Maharashtra government has approved an additional ₹10 crore for the Periodic Assessment Test (PAT) to address increased costs associated with its expanded scope.

Expansion of PAT:

- For the first time, Standard IX has been included in PAT, leading to a rise in the number of students, subjects, and question paper requirements.
- Two separate question papers for Mathematics (Part 1 and Part 2) were introduced for Standard IX, further adding to the costs.

Rationale for Additional Funds:

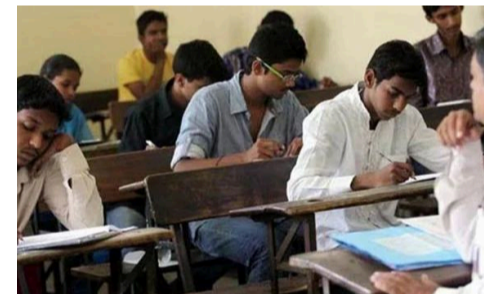
- Increased paper procurement, printing, and transportation costs due to the larger volume and weight of question papers necessitated higher funding.
- Previously approved provisions were deemed insufficient to meet these expanded requirements.

Exam Schedule:

- The State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT) has announced a uniform schedule for annual exams, summative assessment tests, and PAT for Standards I to IX.
- The exams are scheduled to run from April 8 to April 25, 2025.

Funding Source:

- ₹10 crore has been allocated from the state's share of the World Bank-funded STARS (Strengthening Teaching-Learning and Results for States) scheme.
- The funds are drawn from the state treasury and managed by the Maharashtra Primary Education Council.



Implementation and Oversight:

- The joint/deputy secretary of the State School Education and Sports Department, Mumbai, has been appointed as the controlling officer for fund allocation.
- Funds will be used for paper procurement, printing, distribution, and other logistical requirements under PAT.

Objective of the STARS Scheme:

- Launched in March 2021, the STARS project aims to enhance the quality of teaching and learning, improving overall educational outcomes in Maharashtra.

Budgetary Provisions:

- The ₹10 crore allocation will be accommodated within the financial budget for the fiscal year 2024-25 to ensure smooth implementation of PAT across the state.

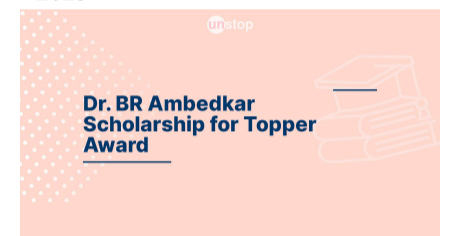

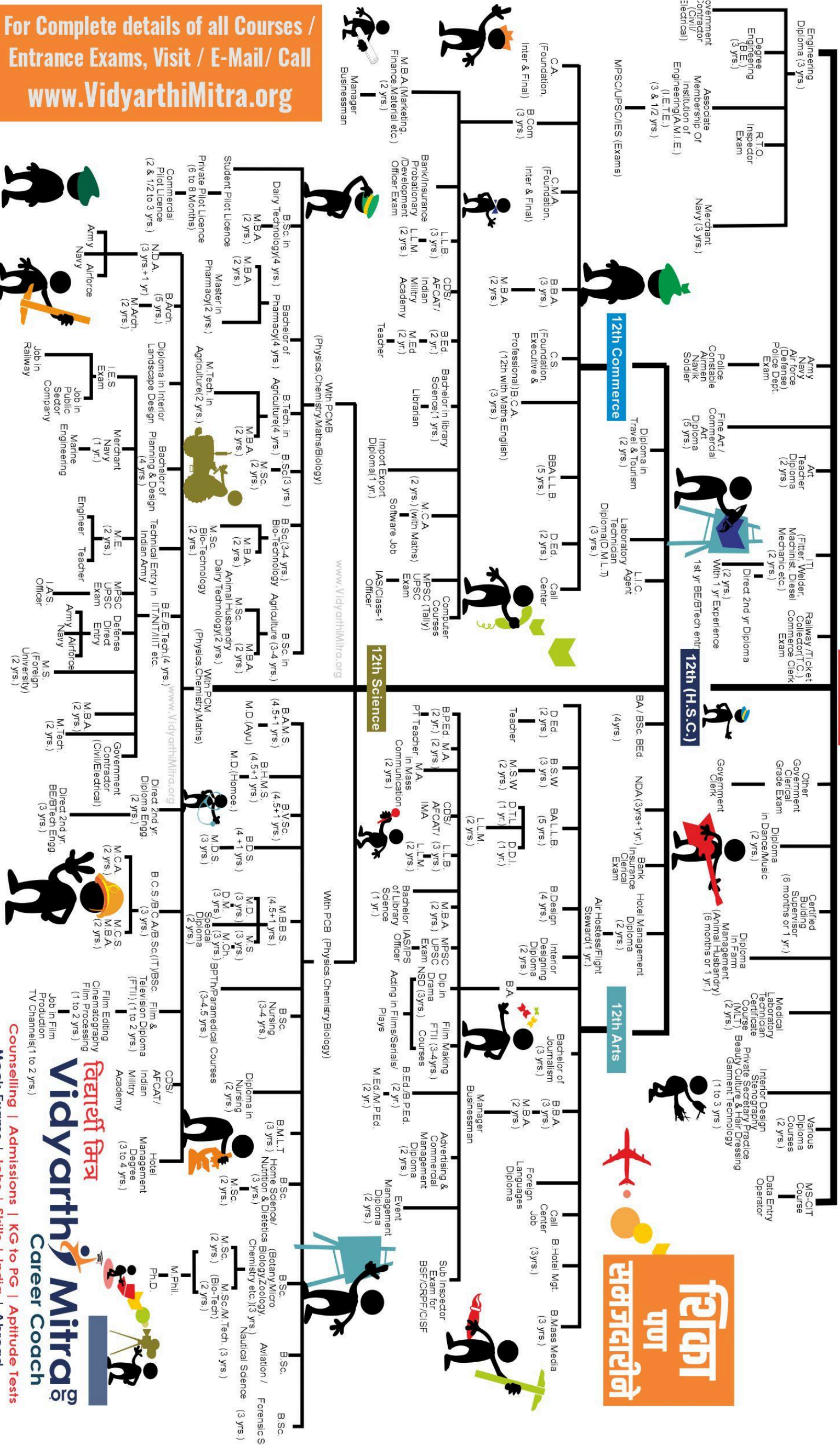
