From 2025, Marathi to Be Graded with Marks in All Maharashtra Schools

Starting with the 2025-26 academic year, students across all schools in Maharashtra—including those following CBSE, ICSE, IB, and Cambridge boards—will now have their Marathi language skills assessed through marks instead of just grades. This change brings Marathi in line with how other core subjects like Maths, Science, and English are evaluated.

This move marks the end of the temporary grading system that was introduced during the COVID-19 pandemic, which was meant to ease students—especially those in non-state board schools—into learning Marathi, as many weren't as familiar with it.

The state government had already made Marathi compulsory for all schools in 2020, but now it's taking a step further by making the assessment more formal and rigorous. The idea is to ensure students take the subject seriously and that the language gets the importance it deserves in classrooms across the state.

Schools will need to make the necessary preparations—this includes adjusting their

syllabus, recruiting trained Marathi teachers, and even ensuring that staff members can communicate in basic Marathi. There might also be language tests for school staff in the future.

The goal is clear: to give Marathi its rightful place in every school in Maharashtra and to help students connect more deeply with the local culture and identity. Education experts believe this shift will encourage students to truly learn and appreciate the language, rather than just treating it as a formality.



UIDAI Successfully Tests Aadhaar-Based Face Authentication in NEET 2025 Exams

The success of this trial opens the door to using Aadhaar-based face authentication in future exams across the country. By embracing digital solutions like this, the government aims to make the exam process more transparent, efficient, and trustworthy for all students.



CUET-UG 2025 delayed: NTA pushes entrance test to May 13, citing lack of preparedness

According to reliable sources, the NTA has cited unpreparedness as the primary reason for the delay and is now expected to conduct the examination from May 13 onwards. A formal announcement regarding the new dates is anticipated after a key meeting between the UGC and NTA officials scheduled for Tuesday.

The NTA's decision to delay CUET-UG 2025 has reportedly been influenced by the massive logistical operations involved in conducting NEET-UG 2025, which was held last Sunday. While officials in the Ministry of Education have clarified that the test centres for NEET and CUET are different—given that NEET is a pen-and-paper exam while CUET is computer-based—the extensive effort required for the smooth execution of NEET appears to have impacted the preparations for CUET.

Adding to the uncertainty, the NTA has not released a formal date sheet for CUET-UG 2025 this year. Instead, it is relying on city intimation slips to communicate exam-related details to candidates. These slips will provide the name of the city where the candidates' examination centres are located and are also likely to contain subject-wise exam dates. Last year, the exam was conducted for approximately 13.48 lakh candidates, and this year's exam is expected to follow a similar scale.

CUET-UG 2025 will be conducted in 13 Indian languages: English, Hindi, Assamese,

Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu. Unlike previous years when the exam was held in hybrid mode, this year CUET-UG will be conducted solely as a computer-based test (CBT), similar to the 2022 and 2023 editions. The examination will cover 37 subjects, each with a duration of 60 minutes and comprising 50 multiple-choice questions. Depending on the availability of exam centres, NTA is planning two to three shifts per day to accommodate the large number of candidates.

While there is no upper age limit for candidates aspiring to appear in CUET-UG 2025, they must meet the age and eligibility criteria specified by the respective universities or institutions they wish to apply to. Candidates are strongly advised to refer to the official CUET-UG 2025 information bulletin available on the NTA website for detailed instructions. Meanwhile, students and educators across India continue to urge the NTA for prompt and transparent communication, hoping for a smooth and timely examination process in the coming weeks.

PRASHAST App for early disability screening: A step toward inclusive education under NEP

Delhi's Directorate of Education has taken a major step toward inclusive education by implementing school-level disability screenings to identify and support students with special needs. Recognizing that early detection of disabilities is crucial for timely intervention, the initiative is focused on enabling a more inclusive and supportive educational environment for neurodivergent students. A key element of this push is the use of the PRASHAST (Profile of Students with Disabilities for Holistic Support and Teachers Training) app, launched by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. This app allows teachers to identify signs of 21 disabilities recognized under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPWD) Act, 2016, and take necessary steps for further assessment and support.

Under the PRASHAST initiative, teachers are trained to observe behavioral patterns and input responses into the app, which then generates a unique ID and profile for the student. If signs of disability are indicated, the student is referred for further clinical assessment by authorized professionals. The aim is not only to identify children with disabilities but also to ensure they receive the necessary accommodations, such as special educators, modified teaching methods, assistive technology, or psychological support depending on individual needs. The screenings are carried

out annually, and all teachers are encouraged to participate, making inclusivity a collective responsibility rather than the job of special educators alone.

Delhi's initiative complements the NEP 2020 vision of ensuring equitable and inclusive education for all, especially for children from socio-economically disadvantaged backgrounds and those with disabilities. The policy emphasizes that education systems must be responsive to individual differences and create an environment where every child can thrive, regardless of their cognitive, emotional, or physical challenges. With government schools often catering to a large number of underprivileged students, the use of tools like PRASHAST ensures that no child is left behind due to undiagnosed conditions that hinder learning outcomes.

One of the biggest challenges, however, lies in the awareness and training of school staff.

With the help of the PRASHAST app, schools are beginning to bridge the gap between identification and intervention. The Delhi government's focused approach, driven by trained teachers and digital tools, is setting a strong example for other states to follow.

PM SHRI Schools in Maharashtra to Fill Vacancies with Long-Term Appointments

The Maharashtra State Primary Education Council has issued directives to fill principal and teacher vacancies in 827 PM SHRI schools across the state with long-term appointments. Appointed staff are expected to remain in the same school for four to five years to ensure continuity and quality education, making these schools model institutions that guide nearby schools with equitable and joyful learning environments.

This initiative aligns with the National Education Policy's objectives and follows a review meeting chaired by Anilkumar Singhal, Additional Secretary of the Central Ministry of Education, held in Hyderabad on April 22. The council emphasizes the crucial role of principals in fostering cooperation among parents, teachers, and students, organizing training, and facilitating smooth implementation of the PM SHRI scheme.

Additionally, the Maharashtra State Examination Council plans to conduct the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) in August-September for candidates with D.Ed and B.Ed qualifications, which is mandatory for teacher recruitment. Recently, recruitment for 11,085 teachers under Zilla Parishad and local bodies was completed, with appointments pending due to the model code of conduct for elections; these teachers will now be appointed and required to serve in the same district until retirement.

This move is part of a broader effort to replace short-term contractual appointments with permanent positions, enhancing job security and educational quality.

In a significant policy shift aimed at enhancing the quality and accountability of education in the state, the Maharashtra government has introduced a new requirement for teaching staff appointed through the ongoing teacher recruitment program. As per the latest directive issued by Education Minister, all newly recruited teachers will now be mandated to pass

an additional qualifying examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Examination Council in order to secure their permanent positions. This move replaces the earlier policy, under which teachers were automatically granted permanent status after completing a three-year probationary period.

The new examination is expected to assess the pedagogical skills, subject knowledge, and classroom effectiveness of the teachers, ensuring that only competent and qualified educators are entrusted with permanent teaching roles. According to the Education Department, this initiative is part of a broader strategy to raise teaching standards, promote meritocracy, and address long-standing concerns about the quality of education in public schools across Maharashtra.

By introducing this examination, the government aims to create a more transparent and performance-based system for teacher appointments. It also reflects a commitment to aligning with national education reforms under the PM SHRI initiative, which emphasizes the development of model schools with high academic standards, strong leadership, and robust student outcomes.

These comprehensive measures aim to strengthen consistent leadership and effective educational practices in PM SHRI schools, setting a benchmark for others to follow.

The UK's Labour Party is championing a new youth mobility scheme aimed at reconnecting young people in Britain with opportunities across the European Union. The proposal, which is expected to be formally introduced at a key summit on May 19, is designed to open up easier pathways for young people to live, study, and work in EU countries—privileges that were largely lost after Brexit.

Labour leaders say the scheme is not just about travel—it's about rebuilding relationships and giving young people a broader horizon. The initiative is intended to restore some of the freedom of movement that students and early-career professionals once enjoyed before the UK's departure from the EU. In doing so, it hopes to create new cultural, educational, and economic opportunities for the next generation.

By enabling reciprocal access for youth between the UK and EU member states, Labour is positioning the proposal as a "win-win" that can help ease post-Brexit tensions, boost cultural exchange, and support job prospects on both sides. While details of the scheme are still being finalised, it's likely to mirror similar agreements the UK already has with countries like Australia, Canada, and Japan—offering time-limited visas for young adults to work and travel abroad.

Europe Minister Nick Thomas-Symonds has described the scheme as a "smart and controlled" approach to international mobility, emphasising that it would benefit both the UK economy and the individual lives of young people. He framed it as a practical and future-focused alternative to the sweeping freedoms of EU membership, carefully designed to strike a balance between openness and control.

Although initial resistance came from the UK Home Office over concerns about migration levels, there's now cautious support from within the government—provided the scheme works on a mutual basis and doesn't reopen the door to unlimited immigration. Officials have been quick to stress that this is not a return to the old EU freedom of movement model, but rather a tailored and managed agreement.

If implemented, the youth mobility scheme could represent a meaningful step toward rekindling UK–EU ties and giving young people renewed access to the kind of cross-border experiences that many in the pre-Brexit era took for granted.

In essence, the proposed youth mobility scheme reflects a pragmatic attempt to bridge the post-Brexit divide, offering young people new avenues to grow personally and professionally while fostering goodwill between the UK and its European neighbours. If successful, it could become a model for future cooperation—balancing sovereignty with global engagement in a rapidly changing world.



UK Universities Grapple with Deepening Financial Crisis as International Enrolments Decline

Universities across England are facing an increasingly difficult financial outlook, with the situation worsening year over year. New projections reveal that nearly half of all higher education institutions in England are expected to operate at a deficit in the 2024–25 academic year. This marks a significant rise from the previous year, when just under 30% of institutions were in the red, signalling a growing crisis in the sector.

At the heart of this financial strain is a sharp and sustained drop in international student enrolments—a major revenue stream for UK universities. In the 2023–24 academic year, international student numbers fell by 15.5%, and forecasts for 2024–25 predict a further 21% decrease. This decline is largely attributed to changes in UK immigration and visa policies, which have made it harder and less attractive for overseas students to study in the UK. Restrictions such as limits on dependents and tightened visa conditions have had a chilling effect, especially on postgraduate applicants from countries that once sent large numbers of students to the UK.

International students typically pay significantly higher tuition fees than domestic students and often help subsidise teaching, research, and facilities. With their numbers falling, universities are struggling to fill the financial gap. As a result, many are being forced to take drastic action. Across the country, institutions are cutting costs by

reducing course offerings, laying off staff, merging departments, and selling off assets reportedly worth over £400 million.

These measures, while necessary in the short term, risk undermining the quality and breadth of education on offer and could damage the UK's global reputation as a top destination for higher education.

The situation is so severe that the Office for Students (OfS), the official higher education regulator in England, has warned that if the trend continues unchecked, as many as two-thirds of universities could be running deficits by 2027–28. This raises serious questions about the long-term financial sustainability of the sector.

In response to the crisis, Education Secretary Bridget Phillipson has indicated support for controversial changes, including raising domestic tuition fees—a politically sensitive topic that has long sparked debate in the UK. She also promised that further reforms would be introduced to help stabilise university finances and protect the future of the sector.

As universities navigate this increasingly challenging environment, there is growing pressure on both government and university leadership to rethink how higher education is funded, how international students are recruited, and how institutions can adapt to a rapidly changing global education market.

ACU Vice-Chancellor's Pay Hike Sparks Debate Amid Dramatic Financial Turnaround

Zlatko Skrbis, the Vice-Chancellor of Australian Catholic University (ACU), has received a substantial pay rise of \$60,000, taking his total annual salary package to \$1.1 million. The increase comes on the heels of a dramatic financial turnaround for the university, which bounced back from a significant \$35 million deficit in 2023 to post a healthy \$38 million surplus in 2024.

This impressive recovery has largely been credited to a surge in international student enrolments, which jumped by a remarkable 76%. For universities in Australia—where international students are a critical source of revenue—this rebound has provided much-needed financial breathing room after years of pandemic-related struggles and border closures.

However, the timing of Skrbis's pay raise has stirred controversy. While some view it as a reward for steering the institution back to financial health, others are questioning the optics of a salary increase at a time when the university has recently undergone staff cuts and course closures. Critics argue that while ACU's bottom line may have improved, the internal impacts of restructuring—especially on staff morale and academic offerings—should not be overlooked.

Supporters, meanwhile, note that leadership during financial crisis deserves recognition, and Skrbis played a central role in stabilising the university's finances. Still, the decision has reignited broader conversations about executive pay in higher education, especially when it contrasts

sharply with job insecurity and resource limitations elsewhere within the institution.

As ACU looks ahead, the focus will likely remain on maintaining financial stability while addressing concerns from faculty, staff, and students about priorities, transparency, and shared success.

The debate surrounding Skrbis's pay rise also raises fundamental questions about the values and direction of modern universities. As institutions balance financial performance with their core mission of education and research, leadership decisions are under increasing scrutiny from both within and outside the academic community. Many stakeholders are calling for greater accountability and more inclusive decision-making processes that reflect the shared sacrifices of all members of the university.

Moving forward, ACU will need to rebuild trust and foster a sense of unity among its staff and students. Transparent communication, reinvestment in academic programs, and meaningful support for employees will be key in ensuring that financial recovery is not achieved at the cost of educational integrity or institutional morale. Balancing recognition for leadership with broader community welfare will be essential in shaping a resilient and equitable future for the university.



Concerns Grow Over Proposed UK Student Visa Restrictions and Their Impact on Universities

Many argue that a balanced approach—one that ensures immigration controls while safeguarding the health of the higher education system—is essential for sustaining both the financial viability of institutions and the UK's appeal to global talent.

Ultimately, maintaining the UK's competitive edge in international education requires more than just academic excellence—it depends on policies that reflect openness, stability, and strategic foresight. As other countries continue to attract students with more favorable conditions, the UK must carefully weigh the risks of deterrence against the benefits of remaining a global leader in higher education.



U.S. Visa Crackdowns Prompt International Students to Rethink Summer Travel Plans

If institutions continue to lose talent—both among faculty and students—Britain could struggle to attract international collaborations, funding opportunities, and the next generation of innovators and leaders. Ensuring long-term stability is not just a domestic issue; it has global implications for the UK's academic standing and soft power.

Looking ahead, universities will need to explore more resilient strategies such as diversifying revenue streams, forming strategic global partnerships, and investing in digital transformation. At the same time, a renewed focus on access to quality education, staff wellbeing, and student support services will be critical to ensuring that short-term financial decisions don't erode the long-term value of the UK's higher education system.

5. Role of Curtin University: Curtin University's Western Australia School of Mines (WASM) brings expertise in mining education. WASM offers 17 courses, including undergraduate and postgraduate specializations, along with opportunities for advanced research in mining.

6. Objective: The partnership aims to create industry-ready professionals by combining academic and industrial expertise in mining technology and applications.

This collaboration is set to enhance technical education and research opportunities in mining, fostering skill development and industry innovation in the region.
