## India Takes Major Leap in Global Education: Foreign Universities Get Green Light, Student Visa Concerns Rise

In a landmark move to strengthen India's global education presence, the Government of India has formally approved five foreign universities to set up campuses in the country. Backed by the University Grants Commission (UGC), this initiative aims to internationalize higher education and make world-class learning more accessible to Indian students. The selected universities—globally recognized for academic and research excellence—are expected to begin operations by the 2026–27 academic year, offering undergraduate and postgraduate programs across various disciplines.

This is seen as a major advantage for Indian students, potentially reducing costs and eliminating the need to relocate abroad for high-quality education. Meanwhile, Indian

students looking to study overseas are facing rising uncertainty. The United States has introduced stricter student visa regulations, raising concerns among Indian banks and education loan providers. Loans are typically sanctioned before visa approvals, but tighter scrutiny increases the risk of visa denial even after funding and admission are secured.

Due to growing visa uncertainties, especially in the U.S., Indian banks and NBFCs are becoming more cautious with education loans. They are revising disbursement timelines and tightening approval norms to reduce financial risk, which may delay students' preparations. This has led to calls from the education and financial sectors for clearer visa policies and stronger bilateral discussions to protect students from last-minute disruptions. Lenders are increasingly wary of funding students who may not eventually receive a visa, leading to potential financial losses. Students, in turn, face heightened stress during an already critical phase of their academic journey. Many are now rethinking their study-abroad plans or seeking alternative destinations.

## NEET-PG 2025 Admit Cards Set for June 2 Release Amidst Growing Calls for Single-Shift Exam

Medical aspirants across the nation are keenly awaiting June 2, the scheduled date for the release of NEET-PG 2025 admit cards. However, this anticipation is intertwined with a burgeoning wave of appeals from students, parents, and activist groups, all united in their demand for the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS) to reinstate a single-shift format for the crucial postgraduate medical entrance examination.

The resounding plea for "fairness, not favour" echoes a deep-seated concern among the medical community. The decision to conduct the NEET-PG exam in multiple shifts, a practice adopted by NBEMS in 2024, has reignited anxieties about potential inequities in a test that holds the key to a candidate's medical specialization, choice of institution, and ultimately, their entire career trajectory.

"It's about a level playing field," expressed an anxious parent from Mumbai, who wished to remain anonymous. "When an exam determines so much, even the slightest deviation in conditions between shifts can feel like a monumental disadvantage. Our children deserve the same opportunity, under the same

circumstances."

This sentiment has found a powerful voice in the nation's highest court. In a significant development earlier this week, the Supreme Court, on Monday, agreed to "soon" list two petitions that directly challenge the multi-shift format of NEET-PG. The petitioners argue vehemently that this practice introduces "unacceptable discrepancies" into an examination of such high stakes. Their concerns center on the potential for variations in paper difficulty, normalization processes, and the overall fairness of comparing scores from different sessions.

Until 2023, NEET-PG followed a single-shift format. In 2024, NBEMS introduced two shifts due to a past paper leak. While security is important, many argue this change affects fairness.

"Uniformity ensures equal conditions," said student activist Vikrant Jha.

With the June 2 exam nearing, pressure is rising on NBEMS to reconsider the format and uphold fairness.

## JoSAA Counselling 2025 to Begin on June 3: Detailed Schedule and Key Updates Released

In a much-anticipated announcement, the Joint Seat Allocation Authority (JoSAA) has confirmed that the counselling process for admissions to premier engineering institutions across India, including the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs), National Institutes of Technology (NITs), Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs), and other Government Funded Technical Institutes (GFTIs), will officially commence on June 3, 2025.

This year, the JoSAA counselling will follow a five-round process, designed to streamline seat allocation while ensuring transparency and fairness. As per the official schedule, candidates who have successfully cleared the JEE Advanced 2025 or JEE Main 2025 will be eligible to participate in the counselling rounds.

In a notable development, a special final round of counselling has been added exclusively for IITs and NIT+ institutes (which include NITs, IIITs, and GFTIs), allowing more flexibility for students seeking admission to top-tier programs. This is expected to benefit candidates who may require additional time or wish to switch institutes or branches based on availability after the initial rounds.

For students interested in architecture programs, those who have cleared the Architecture Aptitude Test (AAT) 2025 will

be able to start selecting architecture-specific options from June 8 onwards. These specialized options will be available only to eligible candidates and are applicable to B.Arch. courses offered by select IITs.

JoSAA will soon release the counselling schedule, including deadlines for choice filling, mock seat allocation, seat acceptance, and document verification. Students should regularly check the official website and keep documents and payments ready to avoid last-minute issues.

As a key step toward admission in top technical institutes, JoSAA counselling demands timely and careful planning due to high competition and limited seats.

## IIT Delhi Sets Precedent with New Guidelines on AI Use in Academic

Amid the rapid integration of artificial intelligence into education and research, Indian Institute of Technology Delhi (IIT Delhi) has taken a pioneering step by issuing formal guidelines on the use of AI in academic work.

According to the institute's directive, students are now required to declare any AI-assisted inputs used in assignments, research papers, or projects. This move aims to ensure ethical academic conduct and promote awareness about the capabilities—and limitations—of AI tools such as generative text models and code generators.

The guidelines emphasize that while AI can serve as a valuable aid in learning, its

unmonitored use can compromise academic integrity and intellectual development. Faculty members will now be assessing not only the content but also the declared use of technology behind the submissions.

An internal committee has been tasked with monitoring compliance and updating these norms as AI evolves. IIT Delhi has also launched workshops to educate students on responsible AI usage and its long-term academic implications.

This move is being closely observed by other institutions considering similar frameworks, as IIT Delhi sets a precedent for balanced and transparent AI integration in Indian education.





## ₹100-Crore Shalarth ID Scam Uncovered: SIT Probes Deepening Crisis in Education Payroll System

MUMBAI — In a startling revelation that has rocked the state's education administration, the Special Investigation Team (SIT) is delving into a massive fraud involving the creation of over 623 fake Shalarth IDs, which facilitated the illegal appointment of teachers and the wrongful disbursement of salaries estimated at ₹100 crore.

At the heart of the investigation is Vaishali Jamdar, former Deputy Director of Education, along with several other officials suspected of being complicit in the scam. The misuse of the Shalarth system—a digital platform introduced by the Maharashtra government to streamline salary payments for teachers—has now come under intense scrutiny for its vulnerability to manipulation.

### A Digital System Exploited

Introduced with the goal of ensuring transparency and efficiency in payroll processes, the Shalarth platform is used to manage the personal, financial, and service details of teaching and non-teaching staff across Maharashtra. However, the ongoing probe has revealed that the very system meant to uphold accountability has been exploited for large-scale embezzlement.

Sources close to the investigation report that fictitious employee profiles were created, complete with fabricated credentials and service records. These "ghost teachers" were then issued monthly salaries, which were siphoned off by those orchestrating the fraud.

The scam, which dates back several years, is believed to have slipped under the radar due to systemic oversight failures.

### Fallout:

Officials have been questioned and more suspensions or arrests are expected. "This reveals a deep failure in our digital governance," said an education official anonymously.

### Educators React:

Teachers and advocacy groups have condemned the misuse. "While real educators face delays, fake ones were drawing lakhs," said Meera Deshpande, senior teacher from Thane.

### What's Next:

The state has promised full cooperation with the SIT and launched a digital oversight committee. Salary processing for suspicious accounts has been paused pending re-verification.

### Government Response:

"This is not just a financial fraud, but a betrayal of public trust," said a government spokesperson. "Strong corrective action will follow."



## MUHS PhD Entrance Test 2025 Scheduled for June 1: Candidates Prepare for Key Academic Milestone

NASHIK — The Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS) will conduct its PhD Entrance Test (PET) for the year 2025 on Sunday, June 1, at the Mumbai Educational Trust, Bhujbal Knowledge City, Nashik. This entrance test serves as a crucial step for postgraduate students and health professionals aspiring to pursue doctoral research in various health science disciplines.

The MUHS PET 2025 is designed to evaluate the academic preparedness and research aptitude of candidates seeking admission to PhD program offered by the university. Hundreds of aspirants from across the state have registered for this significant examination.

### Structured Assessment in Two Parts

The examination will be conducted in two parts on the same day:

#### Paper 1: General Aptitude and Research Methodology

Attendance in Paper 1 is mandatory in order to be eligible to appear for Paper 2. Candidates are required to report to the examination centre by 8:00 AM to complete biometric verification and other formalities prior to the exam.

MUHS has issued clear guidelines for PhD Entrance Test (PET) candidates. They must bring their admit card, valid photo ID, and necessary stationery. ## MAH MBA/MMS CET 2025 Results Declared: Seven Candidates Secure Perfect Percentile

## BAMU Undergraduate Admissions Deferred to June 16: Students Urged to Stay Prepared Amid Schedule Shift

AURANGABAD — In a recent development, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University (BAMU) has announced a postponement of its undergraduate admission process for the 2025-26 academic year. Originally expected to begin in late May, the process will now officially commence on June 16, 2025. A senior university official, speaking on condition of anonymity, explained, "The extension gives us additional time to streamline verification procedures and seat allocation. While it may slightly compress the academic calendar, we are confident that we can manage the curriculum delivery effectively without compromising on

quality."

### Students Caught Between Uncertainty and Preparation

For thousands of prospective students, the delay has created a mix of relief and apprehension. While some welcome the extra time to complete their documentation and make informed college choices, others are concerned about prolonged academic downtime following board examinations.

### BAMU Admissions Delayed: What Students Should Know

"I had been checking the university website daily for updates. While the delay gives me more time to get my migration and caste certificates ready, I'm also worried about how late the classes will start," said Priya Jadhav, a Class 12 graduate from Latur. With the delay, many coaching centers and counselors advise students to use this time wisely. "Explore bridge courses, skill development, or begin early prep for exams like CUET or CET," suggested education consultant Aniket Deshmukh.

## RTE Lottery 2025-26 : Over 3 Lakh Children Compete for Free Seats in Maharashtra's Private Schools

## Mumbai University Admissions 2025: Affidavit Requirement Poses Challenges for Rural Students

The University of Mumbai's admission process for the academic year 2025-26 has introduced a mandatory affidavit submission for applicants, aiming to ensure compliance with institutional policies and curb fraudulent admissions. However, this requirement has inadvertently created hurdles for students from rural and remote areas.

### Affidavit Requirement and Its Implications

As part of the admission process, students are required to submit affidavits affirming the authenticity of their documents and declarations. While this measure is intended to uphold the integrity of the admissions, it has posed significant challenges for students in rural regions. Limited access to notary services, lack of awareness about affidavit procedures, and additional financial burdens have made it difficult for these students to comply with the requirement.

For instance, students from interior regions of Maharashtra have reported difficulties in obtaining the necessary affidavits due to the scarcity of legal services in their areas. The need to travel to urban centers for notarization not only incurs additional costs but also delays the application process.

### University's Response and Measures

In response to these concerns, the University of Mumbai has extended the deadline for online pre-admission registration to May 26, 2025, allowing students additional time to fulfill the affidavit requirement. Furthermore, the university has revised its admission schedule to accommodate the inclusion of previously debarred non-accredited colleges, ensuring a more inclusive admission process.

These colleges have been granted a six-month reprieve and are now required to submit an affidavit committing to apply for NAAC accreditation.

Despite these measures, student organizations and education advocates are urging the university to consider alternative solutions, such as accepting self-declaration forms or implementing digital affidavit submissions, to alleviate the challenges faced by rural applicants.

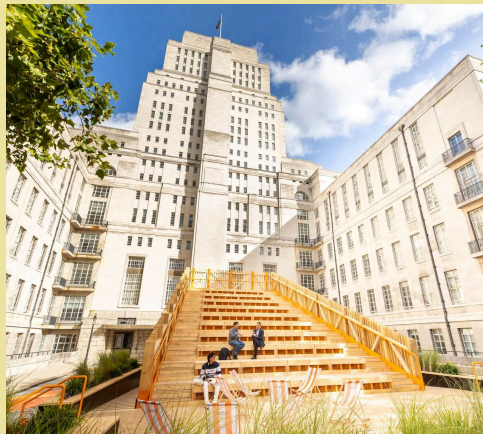

## Indian Students Rethink US Plans Amid Visa Uncertainty, Europe and Japan Emerge as Alternatives

A sharp decline of up to 25% in fresh enrolments of Indian students to the United States is likely this year, experts warn, as recent policy changes by the US administration sow confusion and concern among families and educational institutions.

With over 200,000 Indian students currently studying in the US, America has long been the top destination for Indian aspirants seeking higher education abroad. However, the latest developments—particularly the suspension of new student visa interview bookings—have disrupted the plans of thousands of students aiming for the Fall 2025 intake.

On May 27, the Trump administration announced that US embassies worldwide would halt the scheduling of any new student visa interviews. The decision, detailed in a diplomatic cable sent by Secretary of State Marco Rubio, also hinted at upcoming intensified social media screening for international students, further heightening anxiety.

Career counsellor Jitin Chawla, speaking to India Today Digital, said the sudden policy shift is already being felt across the student community. “By the end of this year, we may see a 20 to 25 percent drop in Indian students going to the US. This affects those who have applied, those waiting for interview slots, and particularly those who haven't yet applied—they're the ones hit hardest,” Chawla explained.

He added that students and parents are increasingly reaching out for guidance, worried about the implications of the visa freeze and how it might affect their future. “The U.S. has always been a trusted option, but the uncertainty now is pushing families to explore alternatives,” he noted.

Europe and Japan, in particular, are gaining traction as potential destinations for Indian students. “The Netherlands and Finland are very popular now, and Japan is also becoming an attractive option,” Chawla said. Australia is also being considered by many students affected by the current turmoil.

The Trump administration's tightening grip on immigration and student mobility has also caused apprehension around classroom attendance rules, with fears that missing classes—due to illness or administrative delays—could risk visa status.

These developments come at a time when international education is evolving rapidly, and students are increasingly seeking countries with stable, transparent visa processes and welcoming policies.

As the US navigates its internal debates around immigration and education, the global map of student migration may begin to shift—pushing more Indian students toward destinations that offer both high-quality education and peace of mind.

## 15 Foreign Universities to Launch Indian Campuses This Academic Year, Focus on STEM Fields.

In a landmark development for India's higher education landscape, Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan has announced that 15 international universities are set to open campuses in India during the current academic year. These institutions will primarily focus on STEM disciplines—Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, and Biomedical Sciences—marking a major step toward globalising Indian education.

Among the incoming institutions, the University of Liverpool has just received formal approval from the University Grants Commission (UGC) to set up its Bengaluru campus. The first LoI was granted last year to the University of Southampton, which is also expected to begin operations soon. The University of Liverpool, a prestigious member of the UK's Russell Group and founded in 1881, now becomes the fourth foreign institution to officially express intent to establish a physical presence in India.

Minister Pradhan underscored that this initiative is aligned with India's long-term vision of becoming a developed nation —“Viksit Bharat”—by 2047. He highlighted the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 as the guiding framework for this transformation, envisioning a modern, globally connected education system that nurtures world-class talent and produces global citizens.

“This is not just about opening campuses,” Pradhan said, “it's about creating an ecosystem where international knowledge, innovation, and industry come together to uplift Indian education.”

Adding to the momentum, three significant Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) were signed during the event with AstraZeneca Pharma India, YouWeCan, Dream11, and the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG). These partnerships aim to foster research, innovation, and stronger ties between academia and industry.

Vineet Joshi, Interim Chairperson of the UGC and Secretary of Higher Education, remarked that the LoI is more than a formal approval. “It represents the growing confidence of global institutions in India's educational reforms. This is a turning point, signalling India's readiness to become a global education hub,” he said.

With world-class institutions setting their sights on India, students across the country can soon look forward to earning international degrees closer to home—an exciting shift that could redefine the contours of higher education in the years to come.

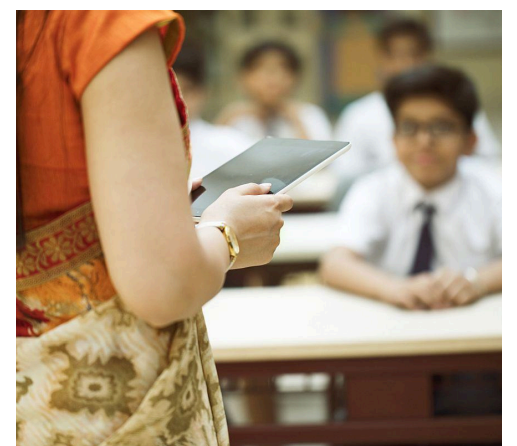

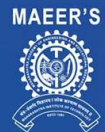
