Delhi Engineer Aces GRE with 338: Shares Battle-Tested Study Tips for Aspirants

Delhi-based engineer Ishita Gupta has achieved an outstanding 338 out of 340 in the GRE Focus Edition—scoring 170 in Quantitative and 168 in Verbal Reasoning. Preparing while managing a full-time job, Ishita followed a focused three-month plan, taking the test from Gurgaon.

Her success lies in disciplined study, flexible timelines, and strategic preparation. Rather than registering early, she waited until her mock scores consistently exceeded 327, then booked the test one month in advance.

Resources & Strategies

She credits GregMat for structured verbal prep and ETS Official Guide (4th ed.) for practice. For reading comprehension, she used the Big Book, studying under strict timed conditions to simulate real test

pressure.

On weekdays, Ishita studied 3 hours daily, increasing to 4-5 hours on weekends, and took a week off before the exam for final revision. Her vocabulary boost came from GregMat's Vocab Mountain and reading The Economist, NYT, and WSJ.

Mock Tests & Time Management

Starting with a 317, her scores rose steadily—328, 330, 333—through repeated mock tests and analysis. A technical glitch in her first attempt led to a three-week retake window, which she used for deeper review.

Her Quant prep focused on eliminating silly mistakes, spotting patterns, and mastering concepts like recognizing when option 'D' (insufficient data) is correct. She emphasizes time-bound practice and advises: "Don't infer beyond what's stated in RC. Stick to what's written."

In her final weeks, Ishita practiced under real exam conditions and used GregMat's anxiety videos. Her mantra: "Prep your way—preparation, not panic, wins."

Trump's Executive Order Sparks Global Concern Over International Student Access

In a move that has triggered both international outrage and mounting domestic legal challenges, U.S. President Donald Trump has taken a contradictory stance on international education. While publicly expressing support for international students and their role in American academia, his recent executive order tells a different story—one that could significantly hinder access to institutions like Harvard University for students and scholars from abroad.

The executive order, signed under the guise of national interest and legal compliance, places strict limitations on the entry of foreign students, researchers, and academic professionals. Though framed as a protective measure to uphold federal law, critics argue that the policy undermines America's long-standing tradition of academic openness and intellectual exchange.

"Admission into the United States to attend, conduct research, or teach at our Nation's institutions of higher education is a privilege granted by our Government, not a guarantee," President Trump stated. "That privilege is necessarily tied to the host institution's compliance and commitment to following

Federal law."

The recent order has sparked concern, seen by many as a push for political control over institutions like Harvard that opposed past Trump-era policies. Critics warn it could harm the global reputation of U.S. universities, threatening international enrollment and research ties.

Legal teams and civil rights groups argue it disrupts education and may violate constitutional rights. Globally, allies have expressed disappointment, viewing it as a step back from U.S. educational openness. As debates continue, academic freedom faces growing pressure—and for many international students, the path to top U.S. universities now looks more uncertain.



CET 2nd Round for UG Courses Triggers Worry Over Admission Delays

The Maharashtra government's recent decision to conduct a second round of the Common Entrance Test (CET) for admissions to popular undergraduate courses such as BBA, BMS, BCA, and BBM has sparked growing concerns among students, parents, and educationists over potential delays in the overall academic calendar.

This move, intended to ensure more students get a fair opportunity for admission, is being seen as a double-edged sword. On one hand, it opens the doors for aspirants who missed out in the first CET round or are now considering switching their career paths to professional programs. On the other, it may significantly disrupt the academic schedule for the year 2025-26, leading to anxiety and confusion among thousands of students.

Officials from the state's higher and technical education department confirmed that the decision to conduct another CET was influenced by the large number of vacant seats in professional courses across Maharashtra. For instance, the first CET held in April saw over 6.16 lakh students register for the test. However, many professional courses still reported large-scale vacancies. This has prompted the authorities to re-open admissions to these programs.

Despite the good intentions, educational experts are warning that the added round will inevitably delay the start of academic sessions. "Students who opt for the second CET will need time to register, appear for the exam, and wait for results, which could push admissions deep into the new academic year," said an official from the centralized admission process (CAP) cell.

The shift to CET scores for BBA, BMS, and BCA admissions—now in its second year under AICTE—has added complexity to the admission season. Courses like B.Com, still based on Class 12 marks, may see mass withdrawals as students switch to CET-based options, leading to vacant seats and disrupted planning.

While the move aims to streamline and standardize admissions, it brings immediate challenges: longer wait times, academic uncertainty, and pressure on colleges. Many now urge the state to ensure faster processing and minimal disruption.



FYJC First Seat Allotment Delayed to June 26; Over 12.7 Lakh Students Await Admission Results

FYJC Admissions: First Round Allotment Begins June 26

In a major update for FYJC aspirants across Maharashtra, the first round of seat allotment under the Common Admission Process (CAP) will begin on June 26, as per the revised schedule. This change offers relief amid a highly competitive season.

Over 12.71 lakh students have registered statewide, with Mumbai (2,92,603) and Pune (2,19,154) leading in applications. Other regions like Nashik, Nagpur, and Kolhapur also report strong numbers.

The cut-off list for junior colleges will be released the same day. Students can log in to the FYJC portal to check allotments and

confirm admissions online.

Officials advise checking only official portals to avoid misinformation.

Meanwhile, the academic calendar for CET-based BBA, BMS, and BCA programs may face delays due to a second CET round. The delay is causing uncertainty for both colleges and students waiting to plan their semesters.

Authorities are expected to issue a clarified schedule soon to reduce confusion and ensure timely course commencement.

The revised timeline aims to ensure a smooth, merit-based admission for lakhs of FYJC students.

NEET-PG 2025 Rescheduled to August 3 Following Supreme Court Directive

The National Eligibility cum Entrance Test for Postgraduate (NEET-PG) 2025 has been officially rescheduled and will now be conducted on August 3, 2025, in a single shift. This significant change comes after a directive from the Supreme Court of India, which mandated the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS) to hold the high-stakes medical entrance exam in a single session to ensure fairness and uniformity for all candidates.

The examination was initially scheduled for June 15, 2025. However, the Supreme Court, while hearing a plea challenging NBEMS's earlier plan to conduct the exam in two shifts, termed the proposal as "arbitrary." The apex court emphasized that question papers across different shifts can never guarantee equal difficulty, potentially disadvantaging some candidates. A bench of Justices Prashant Kumar Mishra and Augustine George Masih firmly directed NBEMS to ensure a level playing field by conducting the exam in one shift only.

Despite NBEMS citing infrastructural and logistical challenges, including the need to significantly increase the number of exam centers and ensure enhanced security arrangements, the Supreme Court remained steadfast in its decision. The court acknowledged India's technological capabilities, asserting that the examining

body should be able to accommodate the demands for a single-shift examination.

Following the Supreme Court's order, NBEMS filed an application seeking an extension of time to make the necessary arrangements. The Supreme Court granted the extension, approving August 3, 2025, as the new exam date, while explicitly stating that no further time would be granted.

UPSC Civil Services Prelims 2025 Results Anticipated Shortly

Aspirants across the country who appeared for the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) Civil Services Preliminary Examination 2025 are eagerly awaiting the release of their results. The Mains examination is scheduled to be held a few months after the Prelims, allowing selected candidates limited but focused preparation time. Hence, most serious aspirants begin preparing for the Mains in parallel with

waiting for the Prelims results. This proactive approach is often considered a key strategy in succeeding in the highly competitive exam.

The UPSC CSE is not just an exam—it's a multi-stage journey that tests candidates on their intellectual depth, ethical grounding, administrative aptitude, and emotional resilience. Every stage of this examination serves as a filter to identify the most suitable individuals for public service roles that shape the nation's governance and policymaking.

As the result announcement approaches, candidates are advised to frequently check the official UPSC website for updates. Relying on verified sources helps avoid misinformation and unnecessary anxiety. Additionally, aspirants should keep their Prelims admit card and roll number handy, as they will be needed to check results and proceed with future formalities.

China came to a virtual halt on Saturday as over 13 million high school students sat for the Gaokao — the country's pivotal university entrance exam that plays a key role in shaping young futures. This year, approximately 13.35 million candidates participated in the exam, slightly fewer than last year's record of 13.42 million, according to state media reports.

The Gaokao, officially known as the National Higher Education Entrance Examination, is considered one of the most challenging academic assessments in the world. Its outcome determines admission to Chinese universities, making it a life-defining moment for many students and their families.

As is tradition, scenes of nervous excitement unfolded across the nation. Parents gathered outside exam centres bearing flowers, snacks, and handwritten notes of encouragement, waiting patiently for their children to emerge. Many were seen whispering prayers and sharing anxious glances with other families.

To maintain order and ensure fairness, authorities stepped up security measures. Local police deployed drones and advanced surveillance tools, while some test centres

were equipped with AI-powered monitoring systems designed to detect unusual behaviour in real time a move aimed at preventing cheating and safeguarding the exam's integrity.

In a show of nationwide support, traffic controls were temporarily put in place around examination venues to ease student access, and in several cities, free rides were provided to those facing transportation difficulties.

Highlighting the significance of the event, Chinese Vice Premier Ding Xuexiang visited a school in Shanxi Province to oversee preparations and underscore the government's commitment to fairness and safety in the examination process.

"Since its return in 1977, the Gaokao has been a gateway to opportunity for millions, serving as a merit-based platform for educational advancement," said state news agency Xinhua. "It remains a powerful symbol of social mobility — reinforcing the belief that with hard work and perseverance, students can secure a brighter future."

China's higher education system continues to expand. By 2023, the gross enrolment rate surpassed 60%, with over 47 million students enrolled in colleges and universities across the country. However, challenges remain. Each year, more than 12 million graduates enter a job market that is becoming increasingly competitive due to a slowing economy.

For now, though, the nation holds its breath awaiting the results that will determine the next chapter for millions of young hopefuls.

However, this global openness has drawn the ire of former President Donald Trump, who has frequently accused elite universities of fostering liberal ideologies and defying federal authority. His administration took a dramatic turn when it issued a proclamation barring foreign students from entering the U.S. to attend Harvard — a move that prompted immediate legal action from the university.

Harvard called the order "an illegal retaliatory step" and claimed it violated the institution's First Amendment rights. Legal experts and civil liberties advocates echoed those concerns, arguing that it set a dangerous precedent by weaponizing immigration policy to punish academic institutions.

While the order specifically targets Harvard, its impact reverberates across the entire higher education system. At Columbia University, where international students make up 40% of the student body, fears are mounting over what this might mean for future enrolments, research programs, and academic freedom.

Faculty members and alumni have begun speaking out, warning that policies like these could deter global talent, erode U.S. leadership in higher education, and damage the country's long-standing reputation as a destination for intellectual and cultural exchange.

Trump's stricter student visa policies and his targeting of liberal-leaning universities signify a larger political struggle concerning both immigration and the future of American education. International students are now at the center of a culture war, and universities' resistance to federal involvement could significantly impact U.S. education policy and campus diversity for years ahead, with institutions like Harvard defending their students and the principle of education's transcendence.

This suggests that while companies are cautious about adding new staff, they are largely retaining their current workforce for now. This trend indicates resilience in the labor market, even as broader economic uncertainties mount.

The recent hiring slowdown highlights the complex challenges facing the US economy as trade conflicts continue to reverberate through markets. Many businesses are taking a cautious "wait-and-see" approach, delaying expansion plans and new recruitment until there is greater clarity on the direction of trade policy.

Moving forward, the evolving trade environment and its ripple effects on industries, consumer spending, and investment will be closely monitored by policymakers, businesses, and investors alike. The coming months will be critical in determining whether the labor market can maintain its strength or if further weakening could push the economy closer to recession territory.

Maharashtra Revises FYJC 2025 Admission Timeline Following Technical Glitch

Mumbai, June 11, 2025 – In a significant move to ensure a smooth and transparent admission process, the Maharashtra School Education and Sports Department has revised the admission schedule for the First-Year Junior College (FYJC) for the academic year 2025–26. The decision comes in response to widespread technical glitches faced by students during the initial registration phase on the centralized admission portal.

As per the revised timeline, the general merit list, which was initially set to be released on June 8, has now been rescheduled to June 11, 2025. Additionally, the registration deadline was earlier extended to June 3 to give affected candidates more time to complete their applications.

The FYJC admissions are open to all students who have successfully cleared their SSC (Class 10) examinations in 2025. Applications are being accepted only through the official online portal mahafyjcadmissions.in, which serves as the centralized platform for junior college admissions across the state.

The admission process caters to a wide array of academic streams including Arts, Science, and Commerce, as well as several vocational and skill-based courses. The entire process—from form submission and merit listing to seat allotment—is being conducted online, with additional support offered through an official WhatsApp helpline for real-time grievance redressal.

Upon completion of the process, students who are allotted seats will receive provisional admission letters from their respective colleges, marking the formal beginning of their junior college journey.

According to a senior official from the department, the key objective behind revising the timeline is to “ensure fairness, reduce anxiety among students, and maintain transparency in the admission process.” The department has reiterated its commitment to making the process as inclusive and glitch-free as possible.

The revised schedule has been welcomed by both students and parents, who had raised concerns over the earlier system delays and server crashes. With over 12.7 lakh students expected to enroll in FYJC this year, the revised plan aims to streamline operations and provide equal opportunities for all applicants.

Maharashtra Launches PPP Initiative to Modernize 418 ITIs for Industry-Ready Skills

Mumbai, June 12, 2025 – In a landmark step to revamp vocational education and enhance youth employability, the Government of Maharashtra has launched a major Public-Private Partnership (PPP) programme to upgrade 418 state-run Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) across the state. This ambitious initiative is aimed at equipping students with future-ready skills aligned with emerging industry demands.

Unveiled in early June 2025, the policy invites private firms, public sector undertakings (PSUs), NGOs, and registered skill development organizations to adopt ITIs for either 10 or 20 years. These partners will play a key role in infrastructural upgrades, curriculum modernization, and bridging the gap between education and employment.

The revamped ITIs will offer industry-aligned courses in cutting-edge domains such as electric vehicles, solar technology, advanced electronics, and more. A renewed emphasis on soft skills and digital literacy is also part of the reform plan to make graduates adaptable to diverse work environments.

Training will continue within existing ITI campuses, but with enhanced learning formats that include practical, hands-on exposure, internships, and industry mentorship. The curriculum will be designed in collaboration with sector-specific experts to ensure relevance and quality.

Upon successful completion, trainees will be awarded nationally recognized trade certificates, making them eligible for a broad range of job opportunities. The state has

already begun organizing job fairs, with over 300 placement offers made to students from pilot centres in the initial phase.

According to a senior official from the Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Department, the goal is to “transform traditional ITIs into centres of excellence” by leveraging the expertise and investment potential of the private sector. This initiative is seen as a strategic move to address Maharashtra’s growing industry-skill mismatch, especially in emerging sectors.

The PPP model not only ensures accountability but also promotes collaborative governance in the field of vocational education. By aligning educational infrastructure with market needs, the Maharashtra government hopes to create a robust talent pipeline for both domestic and global industries.

Stakeholders have welcomed the move, noting its potential to empower youth, especially in semi-urban and rural regions, with career-oriented technical training that meets 21st-century industry standards.

Maharashtra Schools Reopen Post Summer Break with Staggered Schedules

Schools across Maharashtra reopened this week for the 2025–26 academic year, following a well-coordinated, staggered schedule. While Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) affiliated schools welcomed students back on June 9, state board schools are set to resume from June 16, allowing for smoother transitions and better infrastructure readiness after the summer vacation.

According to officials from the state education department, the staggered reopening aims to ensure a structured and uninterrupted academic resumption. Most schools completed essential repairs, sanitation work, and teacher training during the summer holidays, preparing campuses to handle full-capacity classroom teaching.

This reopening applies to all grades under both CBSE and Maharashtra State Board curricula. The schools will resume their academic calendar with renewed focus on curricular goals, including readiness for SSC and HSC board preparations later in the year.

The learning format will return to full-fledged in-person classroom teaching, as per standard operating procedures. Academic continuity and student engagement remain at the heart of this initiative, as schools roll out timetables, distribute textbooks, and initiate foundational sessions.

The education department emphasized that the reopening marks a return to routine educational operations after a short summer recess, with the broader objective of facilitating uninterrupted learning, maintaining academic momentum, and ensuring timely board exam readiness for higher grades.



MNS Chief Raj Thackeray Demands Reversal of Maharashtra Govt’s Hindi Mandate in Schools

The contentious issue of language instruction in Maharashtra's schools has been thrust back into the spotlight with renewed intensity, following a firm stance taken by Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) leader Raj Thackeray.

In a strongly worded letter, dated June 2, addressed directly to School Education Minister Dada Bhuse, Thackeray unequivocally demanded an official government order that would limit early education exclusively to Marathi and English. He further issued a potent warning, threatening to initiate widespread statewide protests if the controversial mandate making Hindi compulsory is not promptly rescinded.

1. Programme Overview:

Thackeray's recent letter serves to underline the MNS's staunch opposition to a significant decision made by the state in April. This decision had made Hindi a compulsory subject for students in Classes 1 through 5 in all Marathi and English-medium schools. This move was introduced as part of the new three-language formula, aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, and had immediately sparked considerable backlash from various quarters.

2. Eligibility Criteria:

The contentious policy directly affects a large segment of young students within the state's education system. Specifically, it impacts those enrolled in Classes 1 to 5 across all state board schools, irrespective of whether their primary medium of instruction is Marathi or English.

3. Programme Commencement:

The initial announcement regarding the compulsory Hindi mandate was made in April 2025. Following the immediate wave of protests and public outcry, the government had indicated a pause in its implementation. A promise was made to issue a fresh Government Resolution (GR) to clarify the situation, but as of now, this new directive has yet to be released, leaving considerable ambiguity.

4. Curriculum Focus Areas:

Should the original mandate be reinstated, the proposed curriculum adjustment would formally integrate Hindi as the mandatory third language from Class 1 onwards. Thackeray has expressed concern that, despite the government's pause, the preparation of new textbooks may still be proceeding based on the earlier, un-recalled directive, potentially leading to further complications.

5. Learning Format:

If this policy is fully implemented, students in primary classes would receive formal, structured instruction in Hindi, alongside their existing lessons in English and Marathi. This addition is projected to significantly increase the academic workload for young learners during their crucial foundational years of schooling.

6. Certification and Career Support:

At present, the direct impact on academic certifications is not anticipated. However, the added demands of learning a third language at such an early stage could potentially strain the foundational learning process, affecting overall comprehension and proficiency in core subjects.

7. Programme Objective:

Raj Thackeray's core insistence is on the state's imperative to preserve its linguistic identity. He vehemently stated, "Hindi is not our national language. It is one of many," countering the common misconception. He is vehemently urging the government to revert to a two-language policy for early education and to issue a clear, written directive to formally confirm this change, thus bringing an end to the current linguistic uncertainty in schools.
