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## Debate Over FYJC Social Quota Intensifies: Bombay HC Urges State to Find Middle Ground

**Mumbai:** The ongoing dispute over social reservations in First Year Junior College (FYJC) admissions took a new turn on Wednesday, as the Maharashtra government informed the Bombay High Court that while it may not fully withdraw the controversial May 6 government resolution (GR), Clause 11—a key contentious point—could be removed. This clause mandates applying social and parallel reservations to seats left vacant after minority admissions in minority-run institutions.

Government pleader Neha Bhide told the court she would consult senior officials and the advocate general for a solution. Justice Makarand Karnik urged the state to “solve the problem.”

The hearing by Justices Karnik and Nitin Borkar came in response to two petitions—one by Shri APD Jain Pathashala (Solapur) and another by top South Mumbai colleges (including St. Xavier's, KC, HR, Jai Hind, and Maharashtra College) along with the Maharashtra Association of Minority Educational Institutions.

Advocate S.C. Naidu, representing Solapur colleges, noted that the FYJC merit list was due Wednesday. However, the court ruled that its release will be subject to the final verdict.

Senior advocate Milind Sathe, for Mumbai colleges, argued that applying social reservations to minority institutions violates protections under Article 30 of the Constitution, which allows minorities to run their educational institutions autonomously—a right upheld in prior court rulings.

Bhide noted that FYJC admissions are fully online for the first time, adding complexity. The Bombay High Court will begin Maratha quota hearings on July 18 under the SEBC Act, 2024, which provides 10% reservation.

## Uttar Pradesh Launches ‘Sugamya Worksheets’ to Empower 2.96 Lakh Children with Special Needs

In a landmark move to promote inclusive education, the Uttar Pradesh government, in collaboration with UNICEF, has launched the 'Sugamya Worksheets' initiative aimed at supporting around 2.96 lakh differently-abled children across the state. The program is designed to ensure academic support and help children learn alongside their peers with confidence and dignity.

The worksheets aim to build foundational skills and self-esteem, making classrooms more inclusive and accessible. A total of 1,900 worksheets have been created—1,300 for Classes 1–5 and 600 for Classes 6–8—covering key subjects like Hindi and Mathematics. Using simple language, colorful visuals, and interactive formats, the content caters to various disabilities, except for children who are completely visually impaired.

With printing completed, the distribution of worksheets has already begun in all districts. The delivery is being carried out in a phased manner, with one set distributed at a time. After teacher assessment, the next set is issued, ensuring continuous monitoring of each student's learning progress.

Teachers have been instructed to actively integrate the worksheets into daily classroom activities through individual, paired, and group assignments, promoting both learning and social interaction. This approach helps children better understand concepts while encouraging peer support and collaboration.

The initiative is being hailed as a significant step toward educational equity. By tailoring resources to the unique needs of differently-abled children, Uttar Pradesh is setting a strong precedent for inclusive education. The partnership with UNICEF reinforces the global commitment to ensuring no child is left behind.

Experts believe this model could inspire similar efforts in other states across India.

As the new academic tools reach classrooms, thousands of children across the state are gaining access to a more inclusive and supportive learning environment, paving the way for a brighter and more equitable future.



## Bombay HC to Resume Hearing on Maratha Quota Petitions from July 18

In a significant development, the Bombay High Court has announced that it will restart hearings on a series of petitions challenging the constitutional validity of the 2024 Maratha reservation law from July 18. A newly constituted three-judge bench will preside over the hearings to decide the fate of the law, which grants a 10% reservation in education and government jobs to the Maratha community.

The court's decision comes after months of legal delays and shifting judicial benches. The Supreme Court had earlier directed the Bombay HC on May 13 to expedite the process, especially as students preparing for crucial entrance exams like NEET 2025 had approached the court, expressing concern over the delays affecting their futures.

The Supreme Court's directive was rooted in the fact that an interim order, issued by the Bombay HC in April 2024, had stayed the application of the Maratha quota to admissions and government job recruitments until further hearings were conducted. Since then, the matter has remained pending, primarily due to the transfer of then Chief Justice Devendra Kumar Upadhyaya to the Delhi High Court, which disrupted the

composition of the full bench hearing the case.

A new bench led by Justices Ravindra V Ghuge, N J Jamadar, and Sandeep V Marne will hear the Maratha quota case. Petitioners, including students and advocacy groups, argue that delays in the verdict are affecting admissions and job recruitment, urging scrutiny of the 2024 SEBC Act for fairness and constitutional validity.

Senior advocate Pradeep Sancheti highlighted the impact on NEET candidates, requesting interim relief. Advocate General Birendra Saraf, for the state, noted that the April 16, 2024 interim relief remains active and is being extended, stating no new stay orders are needed.

The 2024 law grants 10% reservation to the Maratha community, which makes up nearly a third of Maharashtra's population. The issue remains politically sensitive.

Final arguments will begin on July 18, with the bench ready to proceed.

## Maharashtra Tightens Polytechnic Admission Rules to Ensure Fair Play

### Mumbai:

In a major move to boost transparency in polytechnic admissions, Maharashtra's Directorate of Technical Education (DTE) has mandated that institutional-round admissions can begin only after all CAP rounds are completed.

The revised policy addresses long-standing concerns about irregularities in admissions, such as seat blocking and capitation fees, by ensuring the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) handles most seat allotments transparently.

Only students unallocated or ineligible after CAP rounds can participate in institutional rounds, ending parallel or early admissions by

colleges. The DTE warns that any violations may lead to penalties, including suspension of admission rights.

Education experts have welcomed the reform, calling it a long-overdue step to ensure merit-based, fair admissions. Institutions must now update procedures and maintain proper records for compliance.

This move is expected to enhance trust among students and parents in the admission system.

As the academic year nears, the DTE has assured full guidance to all stakeholders to ensure a smooth transition.





## Delhi University Expands Support for Single Girl Child Candidates at Postgraduate Level

In a significant step towards promoting gender inclusivity in higher education, Delhi University has announced an extension of its Single Girl Child Quota to the postgraduate level. Beginning with the 2025–26 academic session, the university will offer one supernumerary seat in each of its 77 postgraduate programmes exclusively for female candidates who are the only girl child in their families.

This decision comes as an expansion of an existing policy already implemented at the undergraduate level since the 2023–24 session. By extending the policy to postgraduate courses, the university reaffirms its commitment to empowering girls and supporting families that have chosen to educate their daughters as their sole children.

The quota will be implemented after the CUET-PG results are declared and during the Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS) counselling process. According to university officials, this special provision is aimed at recognizing the unique challenges often faced by single girl children, especially in families where access to higher education for girls may still face social or financial hurdles.

While the seat is supernumerary—meaning it does not affect the regular seat matrix—it represents a meaningful attempt to encourage more women to pursue advanced education. University administrators believe that small but targeted incentives like this can have a

significant impact on long-term gender balance and access to academic opportunities.

Educationists have welcomed the move, describing it as a thoughtful initiative that aligns with national efforts to improve the female Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher education. Parents and students alike are expected to benefit from the added motivation and recognition this policy provides. This step is also seen as a way to strengthen the message that higher education is a right, not a privilege, especially for girls in traditionally underserved communities.

Overall, this expanded quota reflects Delhi University's broader vision of inclusive growth, ensuring that higher education becomes more accessible and equitable for women across India—especially those whose educational journeys might otherwise be limited by their circumstances. It reinforces the idea that institutions must actively create opportunities to address social imbalances and empower the next generation of women scholars.

## Maharashtra Govt Revises Diploma Admissions Rules for Engineering, Pharmacy & Architecture

From 2025–26, the Maharashtra DTE has revamped diploma admissions in engineering, pharmacy, and architecture. Direct institutional admissions are banned until the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) concludes.

Only students unallocated or absent in CAP can join institutional rounds. Government institutes must adhere strictly to CAP, ensuring transparency, preventing unofficial entries, and promoting fair seat allocation.

### Four CAP Rounds Introduced for Engineering, Pharmacy & Polytechnic

Building on recent reforms, Maharashtra's DTE will now conduct four CAP rounds—up from three—for engineering and pharmacy diploma admissions starting 2025–26. The move increases student opportunities and boosts central seat allocation, reducing reliance on institute-level management quota admissions.

### Mandatory Seat Confirmation to Prevent Seat Locking

A stricter policy mandates that students must confirm their allotted seats in earlier CAP rounds:

Round 1: Must confirm seat if allotted the first-choice college.

Round 2: Must confirm seat if allotted one of their top three choices.

Round 3: Must confirm seat if allotted one of their top six choices.

Round 4: Must confirm any seat allocated.

This step is designed to discourage seat “floating” and free up seats earlier for candidates with lower ranks.

### Implications for Students & Institutions

- Students: Benefit from multiple chances to refine choices and lock in preferred seats without risking options later. CAP participation becomes compulsory.
- Institutions: Must fill seats through the CAP rounds, reducing institutional quota admissions and boosting transparency.
- Regulatory oversight: The DTE will strictly enforce compliance, barring unauthorized admissions

### Architecture Diplomas — PCI Norms & CAP Clarity

Architecture courses now adhere to Council of Architecture and PCI regulations, though no specific enrolment changes were detailed.

### Maharashtra's Broader Educational Reforms

The state has introduced four compulsory CAP rounds for polytechnic, expanded CAP to engineering and pharmacy, and limited backdoor admissions.

### What Students Should Do

- Track the CAP schedule—expected post MHT-CET results.
- Submit options and confirm allotted seats on time.
- Take part in all four CAP rounds for better chances.
- Only those without seats should opt for institutional rounds.

These reforms aim to make diploma admissions in engineering, pharmacy, and architecture more transparent, merit-driven, and accessible.



NEET UG 2025 Result Expected to Be Declared by June 14: Over 22 Lakh Students Await Outcome

NEET UG 2025 Result Likely by June 14: Key Details for Medical Aspirants

The National Testing Agency (NTA) is expected to declare the NEET UG 2025 results by June 14, 2025. Held on May 4, the exam saw participation from over 22 lakh candidates, reaffirming its status as India’s largest medical entrance test. NEET UG is the sole gateway for admission to MBBS, BDS, AYUSH, BSc Nursing, and allied health science programs across the country.

Examination Overview

The exam was conducted in pen-and-paper mode across thousands of centers in India and abroad. Candidates attempted 180 out of 200 multiple-choice questions from Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (Botany and Zoology). NTA released the provisional answer key, scanned OMR sheets, and recorded responses shortly after the exam. A limited window was provided to challenge discrepancies by submitting valid proof and a fee.

After reviewing objections, NTA will publish the final answer key, which will be used to prepare the results—ensuring fairness and transparency.

Despite the challenges, students highlight a growing sense of solidarity and praise Harvard’s support for its international community. Still, for many, the “American dream” now feels distant and uncertain — a stark contrast to what it was just a few years ago.

## Tougher Times: UK Job Market Slump Hits International Graduates Hard

Building a career in the UK is becoming tougher for international students as the job market contracts. Unemployment rose to 4.6% (Feb–Apr 2025), the highest since 2021, with over 109,000 payroll jobs lost in May — the sharpest monthly drop in five years. Job vacancies have also declined for the 35th straight quarter, down by 63,000 to 736,000, as economic uncertainty curbs hiring.

### A Shrinking Window for International Talent

The UK’s tightening job market is hitting international students hard, especially those relying on the Graduate Route visa’s two-year window to find work. With fewer openings and tougher competition, securing a Skilled Worker visa is becoming more difficult. “Employers that were once open to hiring international graduates are pulling back,” says a university career advisor in Manchester. “Cost pressures are making them reconsider their commitments to visa sponsorship.”

### Cost Pressures Fuel Hiring Freeze

New UK policies have made hiring more expensive for employers, with National Insurance contributions rising to 15% and increased minimum wages from April 2025. While intended to boost worker income, these changes have slowed recruitment—especially in sectors like retail, hospitality, and small businesses where profit margins are tight.



### Graduates Feeling the Squeeze

Traditionally strong sectors like finance, tech, and media are slowing graduate hiring. Wage growth has dipped to 5.2%, the weakest in seven months, making it harder for international students to afford life in cities like London. Many are accepting underqualified roles to retain visa status, while others consider leaving the UK or changing career paths. “It’s not just about getting a job now—it’s about navigating a system that feels more uncertain by the day,” says Riya Sharma, an Indian marketing graduate.

### Looking Ahead: A Need for Adaptability

Despite inflation easing to 3.4%, offering hope for potential interest rate cuts by the Bank of England, employers remain cautious. Career advisors are urging international students to engage early with recruiters, explore emerging sectors, and diversify their skillsets to stay competitive.

While the UK continues to attract students with its world-class universities, the path from classroom to career is becoming more complex.

“The degree still holds value,” says a senior consultant at an international education firm. “But students need to be more strategic than ever before—academically, professionally, and financially.”

As thousands of international students prepare to graduate this summer, they face not just final exams, but a rapidly shifting job landscape that demands resilience, adaptability, and a proactive approach. With rising visa hurdles and limited job openings, the post-study path is now more uncertain than ever. Many are rethinking their future plans amid growing economic and immigration challenges.

## Bombay High Court Alters FYJC Admission Rule for Minority-Run Colleges

Mumbai, June 2025 – The Bombay High Court today intervened in the ongoing controversy over admissions in First Year Junior Colleges (FYJCs), urging the Maharashtra government to revisit its May 6, 2025 circular (Clause 11), which mandates that SC/ST/OBC/SEBC reservation applies to minority-run junior colleges only after their own minority seats have been filled.

The case was brought by a coalition of minority educational institutions—including APD Jain Pathshala of Solapur, Mumbai’s prestigious St Xavier’s, KC College, HR College, Jai Hind College, and the Maharashtra Association of Minority Educational Institutions. They argue that this reservation clause is unconstitutional and infringes on Article 30(1) and Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution, which guarantees minority institutions the right to administer themselves.

During today’s hearing, the Division Bench comprising Justices Karnik and Borkar observed that the recently introduced clause—added earlier this year—stands in clear contradiction to a previous government order that had been explicitly withdrawn in 2019. The judges highlighted the inconsistency between the two administrative directives, suggesting that the new clause reintroduces a policy that had already been rescinded, thereby creating unnecessary confusion and potential conflict in implementation.

The Bench further remarked that the matter does not warrant judicial interference at this stage, as it can be effectively resolved through internal administrative measures. They urged the concerned government department to take

prompt corrective action by withdrawing the conflicting clause. Such a move, the judges implied, would restore clarity, uphold administrative consistency, and avoid the need for prolonged litigation.

As a consequence, merit lists for FYJC admissions across the state are currently on hold. Schools and students have been left in limbo, uncertain about seat allocation as the authorities await either court direction or executive action.

Advocate Shailesh Patel, representing the petitioner institutions, stated, “Minority-run colleges should enjoy autonomy in admissions as guaranteed by the Constitution. This circular overrides that right under the guise of social justice.” Meanwhile, State Counsel acknowledged that Clause 11 may have been introduced inadvertently and assured the court of governmental contemplation.

This case has significant implications for FYJC aspirants across Maharashtra. A ruling in favour of the petitioners may reaffirm minority institution autonomy and reset state policies on reservation. Conversely, upholding the clause would expand reservation benefits into minority institutions, fundamentally reshaping junior college admissions.
