NTA Launches NTET 2025 for **AYUSH** and **Homoeopathy Teaching Eligibility**

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has Exam Pattern and Structure officially released the notification for NTET 2025, aimed at postgraduate professionals in the Indian systems of medicine—such as Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani—and Homoeopathy, who aspire to enter the teaching profession. The online application process began on June 4, 2025, and the examination is slated for July

Application Window and Fee Details

Candidates can submit their applications through the NTA portal (exams.nta.ac.in/ NTET) from June 4 to June 23, 2025. Payment of the application fees must be completed by June 24, 2025. A correction window has been provided from June 25 to June 27 to allow applicants to rectify any mistakes in their submitted forms.

The fee structure varies by category:

- General: ₹4,000
- OBC (NCL)/EWS: ₹3,500
- SC/ST/PwD/Third Gender: ₹3,000

Eligibility and Scope of the Exam

NTET 2025 targets postgraduates or degreeholders with qualifications such as MD/MS/ PG in Avurveda, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, etc. For Ayurveda, Siddha, and Unani, a minimum of 30 months of postgraduate study is required, while Homoeopathy mandates full completion of the PG degree.

This examination serves as a gateway for secured teaching roles—like Assistant or Associate Professors—in recognized AYUSH and Homoeopathy institutions across India. There is no upper age limit imposed, and candidates are evaluated primarily on educational credentials and relevant experience.

NTET 2025 will be conducted in a computerbased test (CBT) format. The test comprises 100 multiple-choice questions, each carrying one mark, with no penalty for incorrect answers. Test-takers will have 120 minutes to complete the examination. The languages for the test are English and Hindi. Candidates are advised to familiarize themselves with the CBT interface beforehand to ensure a smooth test experience.

Expected timeline:

- Admit cards: To be available around July 10,
- Examination date: July 17, 2025.

Importance and Future Steps

US & UK Visa Shake-Up: Impacts on Indian Families

Recent changes in the visa policies of both the United States and the United Kingdom are prompting Indian families to rethink how they plan their children's education abroad. What used to be a relatively straightforward process has now become more uncertain and complicated, especially with several key announcements made in just the last few weeks. The US and UK have traditionally been among the top choices for Indian students, but with stricter rules coming into play, families are now having to revisit their timelines, carefully review new conditions, and even consider other countries as study options.

In the US, the State Department has temporarily paused new visa interviews for categories like F, M, and J, which are typically used by students. This pause is tied to new efforts to ramp up background and social media checks, especially for first-time applicants. Authorities are now reportedly reviewing applicants' online profiles more closely to spot any warning signs. As a result, Indian students planning to start classes in Fall 2025 may face significant delays, since there's no official word yet on when new interviews will resume. For many families, this unexpected hurdle means having to consider deferring admissions or scrambling to secure places in universities in other countries.

This situation is particularly worrisome for Indian students, who make up the largest group of international students in the US over 300,000 currently. While the US continues to be a top destination, the current disruptions are making the visa process more competitive and less predictable.



Experts are now advising students to keep their digital presence clean and professional, prepare their paperwork with extra care, and, if possible, consult visa experts to improve their chances when interviews open up again.

Meanwhile, in the UK, new immigration measures are adding to the challenges. One major change is the reduction of the Graduate Route visa duration—from two years to just 18 months. This shorter window may make it harder for students to find jobs and transition to longer-term work visas after graduation. The change is part of the UK's broader push to reduce overall immigration numbers and tighten its borders.

Overall, these developments signal more than just procedural changes—they reflect a global shift in how countries approach international education and migration. For Indian students and their families, this means it's no longer just about academic scores—it's also about staying informed, planning smart, and being open to new opportunities. While the path ahead might be more challenging, with the right preparation and mindset, students can still pursue a successful education abroad.

US Visa Pause at Harvard

A recent decision by the U.S. government has left many aspiring international students stunned—especially those admitted to Harvard University. A Presidential Proclamation has temporarily halted all new F-1, M-1, and J-1 visa appointments for students enrolling at Harvard, effective until

at least June 20, 2025.

While the move is being presented as part of a broader effort to protect national security and safeguard information, it has created significant uncertainty for students around the world, including many from India, who dream of studying at one of the world's most prestigious universities.

The pause affects first-time visa applicants and those who haven't yet been approved, meaning incoming students planning to begin their studies in Fall 2025 are now left in limbo. Current students already in the U.S. on valid visas won't be affected. But for new admits, this sudden halt brings with it countless challenges ranging from the possibility of having to delay their studies, to losing money spent on travel or accommodation, or even making the difficult choice to transfer to another university. With no clear timeline on whether the pause will end or be extended beyond June 20, students are struggling to make informed decisions in a deeply uncertain environment.

Adding to the stress, the U.S. State Department has rolled out stricter background checks, with a strong focus on applicants' online activity. Visa officers are now instructed to carefully examine students' digital footprints—including social media. Surprisingly, even not having a noticeable digital presence can be seen as suspicious.

This level of scrutiny is causing many students to worry about how their online lives might impact their academic futures, prompting them to clean up or reconsider their digital activity.

This targeted restriction on Harvard has sparked strong backlash from educators, immigration experts, and human rights advocates alike. Many argue that singling out one university sets a dangerous precedent and could damage the U.S.'s reputation as a welcoming hub for global talent. Critics also warn that such actions could deter the best and brightest from choosing America for their education hurting both innovation and diversity in the long run. Harvard, for its part, has publicly stood by its international students and is said to be exploring legal action to challenge the decision.

In short, this visa freeze isn't just a bureaucratic delay—it's a reflection of larger shifts in how the U.S. is approaching immigration and higher education. For Indian students and others aiming to start their journey at Harvard, the road ahead is now filled with doubt, legal complexity, and emotional strain. Until more clarity emerges after June 20, students are being urged to stay connected with university officials, keep their options open, and prepare for possible delays in their study plans.



UK Immigration Shake-Up: Indian Students Hit Hard

Institutions will be under greater pressure to meet quality and performance benchmarks to keep their sponsorship licenses. where the chance of losing sponsor status might now be higher.

These proposed changes come at a time when the UK has been incredibly popular among Indian students, thanks to its supportive poststudy work opportunities and a relatively smooth path to skilled work visas. But now, that appeal could be fading. With uncertainty growing, students are being encouraged to aim for well-established universities with a strong track record, reassess their timelines, and think carefully about how the shorter work period might affect their career goals.

In short, while these proposals are not yet official law, they suggest a future where getting a UK education may become more competitive and less accessible. Indian students—one of the largest groups studying in the UK—may need to explore other countries that offer better post-study work options and more flexibility for dependents. These changes also reflect a larger global trend of tightening immigration rules, making it more important than ever for students and their families to plan their academic and career journeys with care.

Their survival depends on rapidly adapting to a world where flexibility and contingency planning have become essential.

Ultimately, this period is testing the resilience of India's study-abroad tech ecosystem. While short-term challenges loom large, startups that pivot swiftly—embracing a more global, flexible portfolio-could emerge stronger, offering a broader suite of services for the uncertain landscape of international education.


