Government Exams 2025–26: SSC, UPSC, Banking, Railways & Defence Recruitments Begin

As the 2025–26 government recruitment season begins, major exam bodies such as the Staff Selection Commission (SSC), Union Public Service Commission (UPSC), Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS), and Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs) have released their exam calendars and application windows.

The SSC CGL 2025 application process is underway and will remain open until July 4, offering over 14,000 vacancies across Group B and C positions. The Tier I exam is scheduled between August 13 and 30, 2025. Meanwhile, the SSC recruitment calendar includes upcoming notifications for CHSL, MTS, Stenographer, and Delhi Police SI (CPO) posts.

In the banking sector, IBPS has updated its

recruitment timeline for PO, Clerk, SO, and RRB positions, with exams expected in the third and fourth quarters of 2025.

For defence aspirants, UPSC has extended the application deadline for NDA II and CDS II 2025 to June 20. It also released the UPSC 2026 exam calendar, setting the CSE Prelims for May 24, 2026, and Mains from August 21, 2026.

Railway exams for ALP, Technician, NTPC, and JE posts are expected to be announced soon, along with updates for TET and the Common Eligibility Test (CET) for Group B and C posts under the National Recruitment Agency.

Karnataka to Launch Facial Recognition Attendance in Schools This Year

The Karnataka government is set to introduce a facial recognition-based attendance system in all government and aided schools starting this academic year, as part of its ambitious 'Niranthara' initiative aimed at modernizing school administration and improving transparency in public education. This transformative step will replace the traditional manual attendance system with a digital solution powered by artificial intelligence.

Under the new system, a dedicated mobile application will be provided to school staff, enabling teachers to capture real-time photographs of students during attendance. These images will be automatically processed and attendance will be recorded digitally, significantly reducing the time and errors associated with manual entries.

The app is fully integrated with the Student Achievement Tracking System (SATS), which already serves as a centralized database for tracking student performance, enrolment, and other academic metrics. This integration ensures seamless updating of attendance records directly into the state's education monitoring infrastructure.

This initiative will cover over 5.2 million students across 52,686 government and aided schools in the state. All data collected

through the app will be securely uploaded to the State Data Centre and monitored in real-time from a centralized command centre in Bengaluru, allowing education authorities to track trends, flag anomalies, and take prompt action where needed.

The Karnataka government has allocated ₹5 crore to implement a facial recognition-based attendance system under its 'Niranthara' initiative, aiming to improve transparency, eliminate fake attendance, and ensure welfare schemes like mid-day meals and scholarships reach only eligible students. Integrated with SATS, the system will also enhance administrative efficiency by reducing paperwork.

Despite being praised for its innovation, concerns remain around teacher training, data privacy, and technical challenges in rural areas. Still, Karnataka will be among the first states in India to roll out AI-driven attendance at such a large scale, marking a major step in public education reform.



Odisha Launches Apprenticeship-Embedded Degree Programs for 2025–26

In a progressive move aimed at bridging the gap between academics and industry, the Odisha Higher Education Department has launched Apprenticeship-Embedded Degree Programs (AEDPs) for the academic session 2025–26. These programs will be offered in 22 government and aided colleges, along with Ravenshaw University and Rama Devi Women's University.

Blending Education with Employment

The AEDPs offer six specialized undergraduate courses designed to integrate classroom learning with hands-on industry training. These include:

- B.Com in Logistics
- B.Com in BFSI (Banking, Financial Services & Insurance)
- B.Com in Retail Operations
- B.Com in Human Resource Operations
- B.Com in E-commerce Operations
- B.Sc/BA in Food Science & Hospitality Operations

Each course includes an apprenticeship module, through which students gain on-the-job experience and earn academic credits for practical training.

The initiative aligns with the UGC's national rollout of apprenticeship-integrated education, effective July 2025.

The program is supported by the Board of Practical Training (BOPT) and industry partners, aiming to make graduates more job-ready and industry-relevant.

Admissions are open via the Student Academic Management System (SAMS) portal, which has already received over 2.57 lakh applications statewide. The new academic session starts on July 10, 2025, post the second round of admissions.

Introduced on a pilot basis, the program represents a shift towards skill-based undergraduate education. Depending on its success, it may be expanded in the coming years to reach more institutions and students.



UGC NET 2025 Admit Card Released for June 26 Exam

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has released the UGC NET Admit Card 2025 for candidates appearing in the examination scheduled on June 26, 2025. The hall tickets are now available for download on the official website, ugcnet.nta.ac.in.

Candidates can access their admit cards by entering their Application Number and Date of Birth on the login portal. The City Intimation Slips for exams scheduled on June 26 and 27 have also been issued, allowing candidates to check their exam city in advance.

Results of MH CET 3-Year LLB 2025: Five Candidates Achieve 100 Percentile

In a significant milestone for Maharashtra's legal education aspirants, five candidates have secured a perfect 100 percentile in the MH CET 3-Year LLB 2025 entrance exam. The Maharashtra State CET Cell officially released the results, marking a key step in the state's legal admission process. With over 74,000 candidates participating, this year's test has reaffirmed its importance as a major gateway to prestigious law colleges across Maharashtra.

Students can now check their individual results and download scorecards by visiting the official website: cetcell.mahacet.org. In the next phase, the CET Cell is expected to initiate the Centralised Admission Process (CAP), allowing candidates to lock in their college and course preferences based on rank and category. Detailed CAP schedules and counseling dates will be released soon on the official portal.

The 2025 MH CET 3-Year LLB exam was considered to be of moderate difficulty, with many test-takers finding the General Knowledge and Legal Aptitude sections particularly challenging. These sections required not only a solid understanding of current affairs and legal concepts but also quick analytical thinking and time management. As a result, many students struggled to complete these sections within the allotted time, leading to varying performance levels across the board.

According to education experts and coaching

institutes, the competition for top law colleges in Maharashtra—especially those in Mumbai and Pune—is expected to be fierce. These cities house some of the state's most sought-after legal institutions, such as Government Law College, ILS Law College, and others, which consistently attract high-performing candidates. Given the limited number of seats and the high volume of applicants, even candidates with strong percentile scores will face intense competition during the Centralised Admission Process (CAP).

As the MH CET 3-Year LLB results are out, candidates must prepare for the upcoming CAP rounds by keeping all essential documents—Class 10 & 12 mark sheets, graduation certificates, photo ID (Aadhaar/passport), and caste/domicile certificates (if applicable)—ready for verification. Proper documentation will help avoid delays during admissions.

With CAP schedules to be announced soon, students should regularly visit the official CET Cell website (cetcell.mahacet.org) for updates on choice filling, document verification, seat allotment, and college reporting. As the admission process enters a crucial phase, staying organized and alert is key to securing a preferred seat.

In a move aimed at expanding opportunities for aspiring architects, the Council of Architecture (CoA) has officially extended the National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) 2025 until August 9, 2025. This decision was taken in light of the availability of vacant seats in architecture programs across various institutions in India, and to ensure that no deserving candidate misses out due to a limited testing window.

As per the revised schedule, NATA 2025 will now be conducted on Fridays and Saturdays until the new deadline. This flexible approach allows candidates to choose from multiple test dates based on their convenience, helping them plan better around other academic or personal commitments. The extension also ensures that students applying late or facing delays due to other entrance exams can still participate in the architecture admission process.

It is important to note that state-level centralized counseling processes for architecture admissions will continue independently on their respective timelines. Hence, candidates are advised to stay updated with both national and state-level admission notifications.

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates can apply if they have:

- Passed a 10+3 diploma with mathematics as a compulsory subject, securing a minimum of 45%,
- Or are currently enrolled in or have passed Class 11 or 12 with physics, mathematics, and one additional subject recognized by the CoA.

Registration for NATA 2025 closes on August 5, 2025, and students can apply or get more details by visiting the official websites: www.nata.in or www.coa.gov.in.

A key advantage for students is that the NATA 2025 score will remain valid for two academic years, offering them extended flexibility in planning their higher education and application cycles. The CoA has emphasized that the goal of this extension is to increase accessibility, ensure equity in opportunities, and support students with varied academic timelines.

By extending the NATA testing window, the CoA reaffirms its commitment to an inclusive, student-friendly admission process for architecture aspirants across the country.

Engineering Admissions 2025: Students Can Now Apply for Institutional Quota Through CAP Portal

In a welcome move for engineering aspirants across Maharashtra, the State Common Entrance Test (CET) Cell has announced that students can now apply for the 20% Institutional Quota seats through the official CAP (Centralized Admission Process) portal. This development is expected to make the admission process fairer, more transparent, and more accessible for all.

What's New? A Parallel Route for Institutional Quota

Previously, students applying under the institutional quota had to approach colleges directly, often facing issues like unclear deadlines and lack of response.

To address this, the CET Cell has introduced an optional pathway allowing students to apply for institutional quota seats through the CAP portal. This offers a safer alternative for those unable to reach colleges directly.

"These applications will be shared with colleges after CAP Round IV and must be considered for Inter-Se-Merit lists," said Vinod Mohitkar, Director of the Directorate of Technical Education (DTE).

Key Changes in the 2025 Engineering Admission Process

- **New Option for Institutional Quota:** Students can now apply via the CAP portal if they are unable to apply directly to colleges.
- **Increased Transparency:** The move addresses student grievances about being denied the opportunity to apply due to communication gaps or non-responsive colleges.
- **No Interference with College Autonomy:** Colleges retain the authority to conduct their own merit-based selection process.

- **Fourth CAP Round Introduced:** Unlike earlier years that had only three CAP rounds, a fourth round has been added for 2025, giving students an extra opportunity to secure a seat before institutional admissions begin.

Stricter Confirmation Rules:

- Round 2: Seat confirmation is mandatory if the allotted college is among a student's top 3 choices.
- Round 3: Mandatory if it falls within the top 6 choices.

Previously, confirmation was only required for the first-choice allotment.

Eligibility & Fee Structure:

- Institutional Quota: 20% of total seats; Regular CAP seats: 80%.
- NRI Quota: 5% of institutional seats reserved for Non-Resident Indians.
- Fee Limits: Colleges may charge up to 3x the regular fee for management quota and 5x for NRI quota seats.

All fees are governed by the Fee Regulation Authority to prevent overcharging.

EXAM ALERT | UGC NET June 2025 – City Slips to Be Released This Week

The National Testing Agency (NTA) is expected to release the UGC NET 2025 city intimation slips shortly. Candidates appearing for the June session, scheduled from June 25 to June 29, 2025, will soon be able to download their slips from the official website: ugcnet.nta.ac.in.

The city intimation slip provides candidates with information about the city in which their exam centre is located. It is important to note that this slip does not include the exact exam venue address, reporting time, or exam shift. These specific details will be mentioned in the admit card, which is expected to be released 2–3 days before the examination dates.

Why UGC NET is Important

The University Grants Commission – National Eligibility Test (UGC NET) is a prestigious national-level examination conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA). Its primary objective is to assess the eligibility of Indian candidates for roles in academia and research. UGC NET serves as a qualifying benchmark for the following:

- Junior Research Fellowship (JRF): Candidates who qualify under this category are eligible to receive fellowships for pursuing advanced research in their respective disciplines, typically at the

MPhil/PhD level. These fellowships are granted by the UGC and are highly competitive.

- Assistant Professorship: Candidates qualifying for this category are eligible for direct recruitment as Assistant Professors in Indian universities and colleges, depending on institutional vacancies and recruitment processes.
- PhD Admissions: Many higher education institutions consider UGC NET scores during the selection process for PhD programs, particularly when evaluating a candidate's research aptitude and academic readiness.

The UGC NET is designed to test a candidate's depth of knowledge in their chosen subject, as well as their general teaching and reasoning aptitude. Based on performance, candidates may be eligible for:

Nepal to Offer Free Student Visas in Bid to Attract International Learners

Nepal will offer free study visas to international students and multiple-entry visas for their parents, as announced in the 2025/26 budget by Deputy Prime Minister Bishnu Prasad Paudel. Aiming to become a global education hub, Nepal plans to reform its higher education system with better governance, updated curricula, and more English instruction. While currently hosting few international students—mainly from India, Bangladesh, and China—Nepal hopes to attract more by leveraging its strengths in fields like medical sciences, Buddhist studies, Himalayan research, tourism, and climate change.

“Nepal has a lot to offer – it’s culturally rich, peaceful, and affordable,” said Surya Pokhrel, Executive Director of Educable Consultancy Nepal. “This visa move could reshape perceptions and open new doors for international engagement.”

Prabha Thapa, who manages international recruitment for ApplyBoard’s Nepal division, echoed this, adding, “Many programs are offered in English, and for students interested in topics like Buddhism or environmental studies, Nepal provides immersive experiences that are hard to match.”

Despite these efforts, the government acknowledges the challenge of reducing the number of Nepali students going abroad over 112,000 did so in the 2023/24 academic year, seeking better infrastructure, global exposure, and job opportunities.

“Nepal understands it can’t completely stop students from going abroad, especially in today’s globalized world,” said Pokhrel. “But it can also be a destination, not just a departure point.”

Economically, the policy has potential. International students contribute to local economies through tuition, housing, food, transport, and services. “Just like Nepali students abroad boost foreign economies and send back remittances, inbound students can energize Nepal’s own economy,” said Thapa. In 2023, remittances from Nepali migrants accounted for 26.6% of GDP, or around \$11 billion—a sign of high student and labor mobility.

Experts see potential beyond South Asia. “Nepal could attract students from Central Asia, East Africa, and Southeast Asia—regions where affordable education and cultural compatibility matter,” said Pokhrel. Still, challenges persist. Public education funding remains below global averages, many universities are unranked, and services like housing, digital visa systems, and student support are underdeveloped. “There’s promise, but also a lot of groundwork to cover,” said Pokhrel. “Things like language barriers, slow administrative processes, and lack of global recognition for degrees could hold Nepal back unless addressed.”

Thapa emphasized the need for quality and support: “If Nepal wants this policy to succeed, it must ensure that international students not only come here—but also thrive here.”

Wales Emerges as a Rising Star for International Students, With Surging Interest from India and the US

Wales is rapidly becoming one of the UK’s most attractive study destinations, with international student interest surging particularly from India and the US. Many students also praise the inclusive and welcoming atmosphere that makes them feel at home from day one.

HESA data confirms Wales had the highest growth in international enrolments across the UK between 2020/21 and 2023/24. Universities like Wrexham have gained international visibility—partly boosted by the Disney+ series Welcome to Wrexham, spotlighting the town’s football club owned by actors Ryan Reynolds and Rob McElhenney.

Additionally, Welsh institutions are actively building new academic partnerships across Asia, North America, and Africa. These collaborations are opening up pathways for joint degrees, research exchange, and faculty development. Such initiatives are not only enhancing academic standards but also making Wales a globally connected education hub.

Another unique advantage is the inclusive cultural experience that Wales offers. With its bilingual environment, vibrant arts scene, and strong community values, students find an enriching blend of heritage and modernity. This mix helps create a distinctive identity that sets Welsh education apart in the global arena. With its quality education, affordability, and rising global profile, Wales is redefining UK education beyond just Oxford and London.



Uzbekistan Becomes Rising Hub for Indian Medical Students Amid Shifting Trends

Delegates from both nations emphasized the potential for co-developing healthcare infrastructure and digital solutions. The event served as a platform to deepen academic and industrial synergies, encouraging long-term partnerships.

The lack of clear communication around the changes has further compounded the confusion and frustration among applicants.

As Canada attempts to strike a balance between economic protection and educational openness, the coming months may see a recalibrated policy—one that better reflects the needs of both international students and the country’s workforce. Policymakers are under pressure to find solutions that protect domestic jobs without compromising Canada’s global reputation for quality education. There is also a push to include more stakeholder consultation in future reforms. Ensuring predictability and transparency in the visa process is now being viewed as essential to rebuilding trust in the system.



JU UG Admissions Open with 7% OBC Quota

Jadavpur University (JU) officially opened its undergraduate admission portal for the 2025–26 academic session on Thursday, introducing a 7% reservation for Other Backward Classes (OBCs) for the first time. The move follows a recent Calcutta High Court directive mandating the implementation of OBC quota in all state-run higher education institutions that had previously not enforced it.

The university has clarified that the quota applies only to candidates belonging to the 66 OBC categories recognized by the West Bengal government before 2010. Eligible applicants must also present a valid non-creamy layer certificate dated June 19, 2025, or later.

Admission Details and Key Dates

Admissions have opened for both Faculty of Arts and Faculty of Science programs. While most science departments will admit students via entrance exams scheduled from July 11 to July 14, some, like geology, will use board marks. Entrance tests for arts subjects are set for July 14 to 18.

The application window will remain open until July 3, and provisional merit lists will be published by the end of July. The admission process is expected to conclude by mid-August, in time for classes to begin by the last week of August. Applicants are advised to regularly check the university website for updates and entrance test-related notifications.

A Milestone for Inclusive Access

This implementation marks a significant shift for JU, one of the most prestigious universities in eastern India, which until now had not enforced OBC reservations in UG programs. University officials stated that additional faculty and infrastructural planning are underway to accommodate the expanded intake under the reservation system.

Student groups and education activists have welcomed the move, calling it “a long-overdue step toward social justice in elite public education.”

Jadavpur University's introduction of OBC reservation in undergraduate admissions marks a pivotal moment in its journey toward greater inclusivity and equity in higher education. As the institution aligns with state policy and judicial directives, it opens its doors wider to historically underrepresented communities. With necessary academic and infrastructural preparations underway, JU's step signals a broader shift in Indian academia—where excellence and access can go hand in hand.



Over 45,000 Students Selected in 2nd Round of UG Admissions.

In a major update to the 2025–26 undergraduate admissions process, the Department of Higher Education, Odisha, announced that 45,502 students have been allotted seats in the second selection round under the state's Student Academic Management System (SAMS).

Of the selected candidates, 25,468 are female, 20,031 are male, and 3 identify as third gender—reflecting the department's continued commitment to inclusive and merit-based education.

The allotment list was published on June 28 and is available on the official SAMS portal. Students allotted seats in this round must confirm their admissions between June 28 and July 2, following which colleges will begin document verification and onboarding.

SAMS UG Admission Process Gathers Pace

The SAMS portal is Odisha's centralized admission system for +3 (undergraduate) programs across government and aided colleges. The platform simplifies and streamlines the application, selection, and allotment process.

Officials reported that the first-round admissions saw a strong response, and the second list aimed to cover students who were waitlisted or had updated their preferences.



The third selection list is scheduled to be released in early July, depending on vacancy positions.

Next Steps for Candidates

Candidates selected in the second round must take the following steps:

- Log in to the SAMS Odisha Portal: Visit the official portal using your login details to access your admission status and documents.
- Download Allotment Letter: Download and print the allotment letter, which serves as proof of seat allocation and is required for reporting.
- Report to Allotted College: Go to the allotted college in person with original documents like certificates, ID proof, and allotment letter for verification.
- Complete Fee Payment & Verification by July 2: Pay the admission fee at the college and finish the document verification process before the deadline to confirm your seat.

The final admission and cut-off report for the second round will be published by July 3, providing clarity to thousands of applicants awaiting confirmation of their seats. This report will outline department-wise cut-offs and remaining seat availability, helping students make informed decisions ahead of the final admission round.

According to a senior official, “The process is on track, and with over 45,000 seats now filled, we are optimistic about full enrollment by the final round.” The official further noted that the university has witnessed a strong response across both traditional and newly introduced programs, reflecting students' trust in the institution's academic reputation. Additional support measures, such as extended helpline hours and on-campus assistance desks, have also been put in place to ensure a smooth and transparent admission process.

SAMS Odisha +3 Second Round Allotment Out.

The Department of Higher Education, Odisha, on Saturday released the second-round seat allotment list for +3 undergraduate admissions through the Student Academic Management System (SAMS) portal. The allotment covers admissions to Arts, Science, and Commerce streams across government and aided colleges in the state for the 2025–26 academic year.

Students can now check their allotment status on the official website samsodisha.gov.in, and download their intimation letters. To do this, candidates must log in using their registered credentials and navigate to the ‘Allotment Status’ section to view their assigned college details. The intimation letter, which confirms the allotment, must be downloaded and presented at the time of admission.

Those selected in this round must complete admission formalities by July 2, including fee payment, document verification, and reporting to the allotted college. Failure to complete these steps within the given timeframe will result in the cancellation of the allotted seat. Students are advised to carry original certificates, allotment letter, photo ID, and required documents while visiting the college and to make the fee payment as per the institution's guidelines to confirm their admission.

Admission Process in Full Swing

This is the second phase of the SAMS centralised +3 admission process, which ensures a transparent and merit-based seat allocation system. The first round saw high participation, with over 45,000 students admitted. The second round continues to build on this momentum, filling vacant seats from the previous cycle. The process aims to streamline college admissions across Odisha, making the system fair, accessible, and efficient for all applicants.

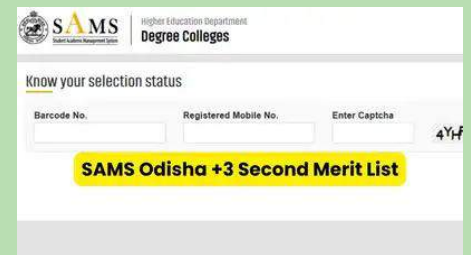
According to education officials, the process has been smooth, with minimal technical complaints. Help desks have also been set up in key districts to assist students with portal access and documentation.

Key Deadlines & Instructions

- Admission reporting: June 29 to July 2
- Document verification at colleges: During the same window
- Publication of updated cut-offs and vacancy lists: July 3
- Third-round application window: Tentatively opening July 4

Authorities have advised students to act within the deadlines to secure their admissions, as no extensions will be granted beyond the allotted period. Students are urged to follow the schedule strictly, as any delay in fee payment, document verification, or reporting to the allotted college will result in automatic cancellation of the seat. Authorities have also emphasized that no grievances related to missed deadlines will be entertained, reinforcing the importance of timely action in the admission process.

A senior official stated, “We are aiming for maximum enrollment before the final round, and the second allotment has helped many eligible candidates secure their preferred colleges.”



HAU Student Agitation Enters Critical Phase.

The ongoing student agitation at Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University (HAU) in Hisar has entered a critical phase, as protestors reject the state-appointed committee's proposal to resolve their demands over a two-year timeline. The students, many of whom have been demonstrating since early June, allege threats, administrative pressure, and inaction on key grievances.

The movement, which initially began over issues of fee hikes, hostel shortages, delayed fellowships, and academic transparency, has since evolved into a larger protest seeking structural reforms within the university. The students have also cited the June 10 baton charge by security personnel as a turning point, demanding accountability for the use of force.

Government Panel vs Student Protestors

The state government recently appointed a five-member committee to engage with student representatives. However, the committee's recommendation to implement solutions over the next two years has sparked outrage among protestors.

“We are not asking for luxury—just our basic rights as students,” said one agitating postgraduate student. “Two years is too long. We will graduate before any change reaches us.”

The protestors have called for immediate intervention, accusing the university of delaying tactics and threatening students with academic consequences.

Mahapanchayat and Next Steps

In response, student leaders have announced a “Student Justice Mahapanchayat” to be held on July 1, inviting support from farmers' unions, civil rights groups, and political leaders. The event is expected to escalate pressure on the university administration and government authorities.

A representative of the protesting group stated, “This is no longer just a university issue. It's about justice, dignity, and democratic rights inside academic spaces.”

University officials, meanwhile, have appealed for calm and reassured students that a long-term framework for reforms is underway. They emphasized that upcoming changes will aim to improve transparency, inclusivity, and academic support across all programs.
