# Over 400 Medical Seats Still Vacant in Maharashtra After Third Round of Admissions

Mumbai: Nearly 400 medical seats remain vacant in Maharashtra after the completion of the third round of admissions, including 37 seats in government colleges. Additionally, more than 500 dental seats are available, with over 95% of them in private colleges. At the all-India level, around 1,200 seats are open for the stray vacancy round conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) for the all-India quota, central institutes, and deemed universities.

According to parent representative Sudha Shenoy, many students have already secured seats through the all-India and state rounds, leading to the remaining vacancies. She added that if the state CET cell introduces new seats in the upcoming fourth round, students should be given a chance to upgrade their options, especially those currently admitted to dental colleges.

Vacancies also exist in government medical and dental colleges in Maharashtra, including Grant Medical College and Nair Hospital Dental College.

### **IIM Ahmedabad Introduces Blended MBA in Business** Analytics and Al

The Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad (IIMA) has launched a two-year blended MBA programme in Business Analytics and Artificial Intelligence for working professionals and entrepreneurs. The course aims to equip leaders with skills to integrate business strategy, data analytics, and Albased decision-making to drive innovation and impact across industries.

### **Eligibility:**

Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification (CA, CS, ICWA, CMA) with at least 50% marks from a recognised institution and have a minimum of three years of professional experience. The programme follows a blended model with live online sessions and three oncampus modules at IIM Ahmedabad. It includes case studies, capstone projects, and 20 elective subjects such as Predictive Analytics, Product Management, Al Ethics, and Generative Al. Participants may also exit after the first year to earn a Post Graduate Diploma in Business Analytics and Al.

The curriculum is divided into three terms per year, focusing on management, analytics, and Al integration. Designed to balance flexibility and academic rigour, the course enables professionals to upgrade their skills while continuing their careers.

# Maharashtra CET to Be Conducted Twice a Year from 2026

The Maharashtra State Common Entrance Test (CET) Cell will now conduct CET examinations twice a year for three major courses — PCM (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics), PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology), and MBA — starting from the upcoming academic year.

According to the new plan, the first CET exam will be held in April 2026, followed by the second in May 2026. This decision was announced during a review meeting chaired by Higher and Technical Education Minister Chandrakant Patil. The meeting was attended by Additional Chief Secretary B. Venugopal Reddy, CET Commissioner Dilip Sardesai, Director of Higher Education Dr. Shailendra Devlankar, Director of Technical Education Dr. Vinod Mohitkar, and other officials.

The move follows the model of the JEE Main exam, conducted twice a year by the National Testing Agency (NTA), offering students two opportunities admission. Similarly, Maharashtra students will now get two chances to appear for entrance exams in engineering, pharmacy, and management.

While appearing for one exam will be mandatory, the second attempt will be optional. If a student takes both exams, the higher score will be considered for admission.

The detailed schedule for the examinations will be announced soon, according to the CET Cell.

# CTET 2026 Exam to Be Held on February 8 Across 132 Cities.

The Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) 2026 will be conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) on February 8, 2026 (Sunday). The exam will be held in two sessions — Paper I and Paper II — across 132 cities in 20 different languages. Paper I is for candidates aspiring to teach Classes I-V, while Paper II is for Classes VI-VIII. The test will be conducted in offline mode (OMR-based) with 150 questions for 150 marks, and there will be no negative marking. The CTET certificate, once earned, will remain valid for a lifetime.

The detailed information bulletin, including eligibility criteria, syllabus, exam pattern, fees, important dates, and list of exam centres, will soon be released on the official website — ctet.nic.in. Interested candidates are advised to keep their documents ready and regularly visit the website for updates. The registration process, exam schedule, and admit card release dates will be announced soon.

# IIT Bombay Launches Online Postgraduate Diploma in E-Mobility.

#### MNLU Mumbai to Begin Construction of Permanent **Goregaon Campus** -VidyarthiMitra News Desk

Nearly a decade after its establishment, Maharashtra National Law University (MNLU) Mumbai is set to begin work on its permanent 35-acre campus in Pahadi, Goregaon, near Versova metro station. Since 2015, the university has operated from a rented government building in Powai. The foundation ceremony, to be held this week, will be presided over by Chief Justice of India and University Chancellor, Justice B.R. Gavai. The new greenfield campus will be built only on land outside the Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) and is expected to be completed in three to four years. Officials shifted the project from Gorai to a site closer to the Bombay High Court for convenience. However, activist Zoru Bhathena has opposed the plan, claiming the land is part of a protected wetland and urging authorities to preserve it. The Maharashtra Chief Minister and Deputy Chief Ministers will also attend the ceremony.

### **BCI May Hold AIBE Twice a Year; NLUSA Seeks Clarity**

The National Law Universities Students' Association (NLUSA) has requested the Bar Council of India (BCI) to amend the eligibility criteria for the All India Bar Examination (AIBE) 2025. Currently, only final-semester students are eligible, which prevents many graduates from applying immediately after completing their law degrees. NLUSA highlighted that this delay disrupts their career timelines and creates uncertainty, especially since different universities follow varied academic or trimester systems.

In its representation, NLUSA urged BCI to clearly state that enrolment for practice with State Bar Councils should not depend on passing AIBE. The association also stressed that the exam schedule should align with academic timelines to ensure fair access for all students.

The BCI is reportedly considering holding the AIBE twice a year — a move that could significantly reduce waiting periods for graduates seeking to begin legal practice and improve the efficiency of the certification process. The new policy, if implemented, will bring greater flexibility and consistency for aspiring advocates across India.

### Globis University to Open First India Campus in Mumbai by 2026 -VidyarthiMitra News Desk

Japan's Globis University will open its first Indian campus at Bandra Kurla Complex (BKC), Mumbai, in 2026, marking its seventh global centre. The university will offer management courses such as pre-MBA, nano-MBA, part-time, and full-time English MBA from Tokyo. Founder Yoshito Hori said the institution's model focuses on people, capital, and knowledge. It also offers a two-year online part-time MBA for professionals with scholarships and financial aid. Globis will be registered in India as a company and has no plans to repatriate funds to Japan.

Meanwhile, over half of Maharashtra's private unaided colleges offering professional courses missed the October 31 deadline to submit fee revision proposals to the Fee Regulatory Authority (FRA). Many cited exams and Diwali holidays as reasons. Despite receiving over 3,000 applications annually, the FRA maintained its deadline but may consider a brief extension, possibly with a fine.

- The Goal: Ensure students get the right material, at the right time, and in the right manner, moving beyond simply following a syllabus.
- Curriculum Focus: Educational institutions should evaluate every piece of content to ensure it supports the intended learning outcomes and avoids duplication, confusion, and cognitive load. A smart strategy involves integrating high-quality platforms and seamlessly weaving them into existing learning plans.

#### The Role of Educators

- From Teacher to Mentor: The educator's role is shifting from simply dispensing information to mentoring.
- Mentors must provide guided support, enhancing self-directed study and connecting learning across various contexts.
- Subject Examples:
  - Language: Curated content should focus on high-frequency words and confidence in communication.
  - Maths/Science: Curation should students from basic concepts to complex problems by linking theory to applications, using simulations, and visualizing complex phenomena to make learning concrete and engaging.

#### **The Problem:**

- Focus on Grades Only: Students are primarily taught about exams, grades, and discipline, which creates a very narrow view of success.
- Neglect of Power Dynamics: Students, especially in colleges, often step into positions of privilege (e.g., student bodies, associations) without understanding the responsibilities that come with power.
- Lack of Empathy: When the focus is solely on individual achievement (grades/CGPAs), students struggle to understand interdependence, resources, and accountability to others, leading to a lack of empathy and humility.

# **Power & Empathy:**

- What Power Is: Power is not about hurting the less powerful; it is based on dependence, resources, and knowledge. We earn power through what we hold or what others value.
- Responsible Power: Awareness of power is the first step. Students must be taught to use their power (their knowledge, access, and resources) not just for themselves, but for the community and for the common good.
- The Goal: If children are taught that power comes with privilege and duty, and they are given something other than exams to measure success, they will learn to handle power with empathy and grace.

# **UGC NET December 2025 – Last Day for Registration**

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will close the registration window for the UGC NET December 2025 exam today. The exam, conducted to determine eligibility for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF), Assistant Professor, and PhD admissions, will be held in computer-based mode from December 31, 2025, to January 7, 2026, across multiple cities

Candidates can register on the official website — ugcnet.nta.ac.in before 11:50 pm. The correction window will be open from November 10 to 12, 2025, allowing candidates to edit specific details.

### **Fee Payment:**

The application fee is ₹1,150 for General, ₹600 for EWS/OBC-NCL, and ₹325 for SC/ST/PwD candidates.

The UGC NET will be conducted for 85 subjects, following the pattern of two papers

### Paper I (General Teaching and Research Aptitude).

The paper includes 50 multiplechoice questions, carrying 2 marks each, for a total of 100 marks. The duration is 3 hours (combined with Paper 2), and there is no negative marking.

 Paper 1 aims to evaluate candidates' analytical, problemsolving, and communication skills essential for academic and teaching roles.

#### Paper II (subject-specific).

The exam aims to identify qualified researchers and teachers for higher education institutions across India, ensuring quality academic standards nationwide.

It consists of 100 multiple-choice questions, worth 2 marks each, totaling 200 marks. Candidates must select their subject at the time of registration from 85 available subjects, such as English, Commerce, History, Political Science, Education, Management, Computer Science, and more.

# **CBSE Releases Final Date Sheet for Class 10 and 12 Board Exams 2026**

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has officially announced the final date sheet for the Class 10 and 12 board exams 2026. Both exams will begin on February 17, 2026, and continue until April 2, 2026. The detailed timetable is available on the official CBSE website — cbse.gov.in.

The board has ensured that the exam schedule avoids overlapping with major entrance tests like JEE Main and NEET, providing students sufficient preparation time. Practical exams for both classes are expected to be held in January 2026 at respective schools.

CBSE has urged students to prepare systematically, revise regularly, and maintain a balanced routine to reduce exam stress. Schools have also been instructed to complete the syllabus by December 2025 and focus on mock tests and doubt-clearing sessions. The board will soon release sample papers and marking schemes to help students familiarize themselves with the latest exam pattern.

# NCERT Launches Online Diploma Course for Middle School Science Teachers

# University-level examinations

University-level examinations operate on a consistent, cyclical schedule governed by the academic calendar, with the Odd Semester (1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, etc.) exams typically being conducted between October and December of any given year.

The latest wave of announcements in November 2025 confirms this cycle and focuses on four main areas of student activity: Time Tables, Practical Exams, Results, and Remedial Forms (Supplementary/Revaluation).

### 77 Key Activity Areas in University Examination Notices 1. Time Tables and Exam Schedules

The primary focus of recent notifications is the release and revision of datesheets for the ongoing Odd Semester session (typically November/December exams).

- Odd Semesters (UG/PG): Universities like Calicut University, Panjab University (PU), and Dibrugarh University have released comprehensive or revised Time Tables for 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 9th semesters across UG (BA, BSc, BCom, BBA) and PG (MA, MSc, MCom, MBA) courses.
- Special/Supplementary Exams: Datesheets often include schedules for Supplementary/Backlog papers for students who failed an earlier attempt, and sometimes "Improvement" or "Mercy Chance" exams (e.g., Calicut University's revised dates for regular, supplementary, and improvement exams).
- New Education Policy (NEP): Many universities, including Panjab University, are issuing separate or specific datesheets for courses being conducted under the new Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) or NEP structure.

### 2. Practical and Viva-Voce Examinations

# \*US News & World Report 2026: Princeton Tops Best **Colleges in the United States\***

The US News & World Report 2026 Best Colleges Rankings have placed Princeton University as the top institution in the US for the second year in a row, followed by MIT and Harvard University. The rankings evaluate universities based on graduation outcomes, faculty quality, research, and reputation.

Princeton University ranked first, with tuition fees of \$65,210 and an acceptance rate of 5%.MIT secured second place, charging \$64,730, while Harvard University ranked third with \$64,796 in fees and a 4% acceptance rate. Stanford University placed fourth, and Yale University fifth, with tuition of \$69,900.

The University of Chicago ranked sixth, followed by Duke University at seventh. Johns Hopkins University, Northwestern University, and the University of Pennsylvania tied for the seventh position, each maintaining high academic standards and global recognition.

# **Australia Caps Foreign Student Enrolments:** Impact on Indian Aspirants\*

The \*Australian government has instructed universities to ensure that domestic students make up more than 50% of total enrolments, marking a significant shift in higher education policy. The move aims to rebalance student admissions amid a sharp rise in international intake, especially at top universities such as the University of Sydney, Murdoch University, and RMIT.

This policy is expected to affect global student mobility, particularly for Indian students, who represent nearly 17% of Australia's international enrolments. In 2024, the country hosted about 800,000 international students, contributing A\$51.5 billion to the economy and supporting over 250,000 jobs across education, housing, and hospitality.

Experts believe that while this step prioritizes domestic access, sustainable infrastructure, housing, and policy stability are essential to maintain Australia's reputation as a leading global education destination.


