CBSE Curriculum Pattern to Be Introduced in Maharashtra Government Schools

New Rules Issued for Maharashtra School **Admissions**

Mumbai:

The Maharashtra State School Education Department has issued a fresh circular outlining revised rules for nursery and Class 1 admissions for the 2026–27 academic year. The circular clearly defines age eligibility norms and reiterates restrictions on admission procedures at the primary level.

Revised Age Criteria

- As per the new guidelines, a child seeking admission to Class 1 must have completed six years of age on or before December 31, 2026
- The age criteria will apply uniformly across schools following the state board norms

Restrictions on Admission Process

- Schools have been strictly prohibited from conducting:
 - Entrance tests
 - Interviews of children
 - Interviews of parents
- These restrictions apply specifically to the primary admission process, including nursery and Class 1

Objective of the Circular

- To ensure a uniform and child-friendly admission process
- To prevent academic pressure and unfair screening practices at the entry
- To bring clarity and consistency in admissions for the 2026–27 academic session

Implementation

- All schools are expected to comply with the revised norms
- The rules will be applicable during the upcoming admission cycle as per the academic calendar

Education Minister Assures Free AI Tools for Students

The Andhra Pradesh government has announced plans to introduce advanced Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools into the state's education system, with the aim of providing students free access to modern technology and improving skill development across disciplines.

Proposed Global Partnerships:

- Education and IT Minister Nara Lokesh stated that the state government plans to hold high-level discussions with global technology companies
- Talks are proposed with Google to enable access to the Gemini AI model and other digital tools
- The tools are intended to be made available to students free of cost

Focus on Skill Development:

- The initiative is designed to help students develop skills aligned with current industry trends
- Emphasis will be placed on modern and emerging fields, including:
 - Digital marketing
 - Data science
- The goal is to improve students' global competitiveness and employability

Government's Broader Vision:

- The plan is part of a wider strategy outlined by Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu
- The state aims to leverage AI-driven solutions to strengthen education and learning outcomes
- The initiative seeks to ensure that students from all backgrounds have equal access to advanced technology



Divyang Candidates to Get Exam Centres of Their Choice

The Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) has decided to mandatorily allot examination centres of choice to candidates with benchmark disabilities (PwBD) who have more than 40% disability. This step has been taken to ensure greater accessibility and fairness in the examination process.

According to the decision, such candidates will be allotted the exam centre they have given priority to while filling their application form. The move aims to reduce the practical difficulties faced by Divyang candidates, particularly issues related to transport, mobility, and communication, which often arise when centres are allotted far from their preferred locations.

By guaranteeing the preferred exam centre, the UPSC seeks to make the examination environment more inclusive and to remove barriers that may otherwise affect the performance and participation of candidates with disabilities.

Purpose of the Decision

The decision focuses on improving accessibility and easing logistical challenges for Divyang candidates by ensuring they can appear for exams at centres best suited to their needs, thereby promoting equal opportunity in competitive examinations.

UGC Introduces 'Professor of Practice' Scheme in Universities

At a Glance:

- The University Grants Commission (UGC) has introduced the 'Professor of Practice' scheme in higher education institutions.
- Under the scheme, experts from industry and professional fields can be appointed as faculty members without a PhD.
- The objective is to bring practical industry experience into classrooms and strengthen skill-based and vocational education.
- Appointments will be for a fixed tenure and shall not exceed 10% of the sanctioned faculty strength of an institution.

The UGC stated that the scheme is aimed at bridging the gap between academic learning and industry requirements by allowing experienced professionals to contribute directly to teaching and mentoring. The appointments are meant to supplement existing faculty, ensuring that students gain exposure to real-world practices alongside theoretical education.

Purpose of the Initiative:

The initiative focuses on enhancing employability and practical skills in higher education through industry participation.

State Government Announces Pre-Matric Scholarship **for Minority Students**

APAAR ID Made Mandatory for SSC and HSC Board **Examinees**

Pune:

Students appearing for the Secondary School Certificate (SSC – Class 10) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC – Class 12) board examinations scheduled for February-March next year must obtain an APAAR ID, the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education has announced.

Key Points

- An APAAR ID is mandatory for all SSC and HSC students.
- The ID will be required to:
 - Check examination results on DigiLocker
 - Access official digital mark sheets

Instructions to Institutions

- 3. Reporting: Schools are required to prepare an Annual Implementation Plan and submit regular compliance reports to the District Education Officer.
- 4. Inclusivity: Activities are designed to be inclusive, ensuring students from all backgrounds and abilities can participate.



Major Reforms Planned in Higher Education from Next Academic Year

Syllabus Revision and Academic Changes

- Expert committees have been working for several months on revising degree and postgraduate (PG) syllabi
- The focus of the revision is to modernize and streamline course content
- · The final syllabus has been prepared based on expert committee
- Official approval for implementation of the revised syllabus is expected during the December 29 meeting

Objective of the Reforms

- To improve the overall quality of higher education
- To make academic programmes more skill-oriented and industry-
- To enhance students' employability at the international level
- To ensure graduates are better equipped for global job opportunities

Technology-Focused Courses to Be Introduced in Degree and PG **Programmes**

The government is planning to revamp degree and postgraduate (PG) education by shifting focus from conventional programmes to technology-driven and industry-oriented courses, in line with current and future job market requirements.

Key Academic Changes

- New specialisations will be introduced or integrated into existing programmes, including Computer Science, Data Science, and Artificial
- Mandatory technology integration will require at least 20% of the syllabus in every course, including non-technical degrees, to be computer-based

Industry and Global Collaboration

- Colleges offering emerging courses will be required to partner with relevant industries to provide practical, hands-on training
- Postgraduate courses will be upgraded through collaboration with international universities to meet global standards for Ph.D. and professional pathways

Entrance Examination Reforms

Discussions will include measures to prevent delays in joint entrance examinations for UG and PG admissions

Sector-Specific Focus

- Special emphasis will be placed on Aerospace and Defence sectors
- New courses will be designed based on international data, with focus on cybersecurity and data analytics



Canada Shifts Immigration Strategy to Prioritise High-Skill **Talent** -VidyarthiMitra News Desk

Canada has announced significant changes to its international student and immigration framework, marking a strategic shift towards attracting highly skilled and research-focused talent, particularly at the postgraduate level.

Study Permit Cap and Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL):

- The Canadian government has capped the total number of new study permits for 2025 at approximately 4.37 lakh (437,000), a reduction compared to the previous year.
- The cap mainly applies to undergraduate and college-level programmes.

Impact on Undergraduate and Taught Master's Programmes:

- Students applying to these programmes will face increased competition.
- Approval rates will depend heavily on the quota allotted to individual provinces and institutions.

Impact on Master's and PhD Programmes:

• 2025 Intake:

• Master's and PhD students were initially included under the cap, though separate spaces were reserved for them.

• From 2026 Onwards:

• Master's and PhD students enrolled in public Designated Learning Institutions (DLIs) will be exempt from the study permit cap.

• PAL Requirement (2026):

• From January 1, 2026, Provincial Attestation Letters (PALs) will no longer be required for Master's and PhD students at public DLIs.

• PhD Processing:

• PhD applicants will receive priority study permit processing within 14 days.

Changes to Dependent and Work Permit Rules:

Undergraduate and Taught Master's Students:

• Spouses and dependents are not eligible for Open Work Permits (OWP).

Master's by Research and PhD Students:

• Spouses and dependents remain eligible for Open Work Permits, retaining a key benefit for advanced research candidates.

US Proposes Fixed Visa Duration and Stricter Rules for International Students

The United States has proposed changes to its student visa framework aimed at increasing oversight and accountability. The proposals are currently under consideration by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

End of Duration of Status (D/S):

F-1 visas may shift from open-ended stay to a fixed period (around four years). Extensions would require USCIS approval.

Grace Period:

Post-study grace period may be reduced from 60 days to 30 days.

Transfer Limits:

Proposed restrictions on changing study level and transferring institutions within the first academic year for non-graduate students.

Purpose:

To increase monitoring and accountability in the student visa system.

UK Tightens Rules on Student Dependents to Curb Immigration

Numbers

The United Kingdom has introduced policy changes aimed at reducing immigration numbers, with a particular focus on restricting dependents accompanying international students.

Dependent Visa Restrictions:

- For students starting courses on or after January 1, 2024, the UK has removed the right to bring dependents for most study programmes.
- Dependents include spouses or civil partners and children.

Impact on Undergraduate and Taught Postgraduate Courses:

• Students enrolled in undergraduate and taught postgraduate programmes including MBA, MA, MSc, and PG Certificate/Diploma courses — are not permitted to bring dependents.

Impact on Research and Doctoral Programmes:

- The exemption continues for students enrolled in PhD programmes, other doctoral qualifications, or research-based higher degrees such as MRes.
- These students remain eligible to bring dependents.

Graduate Visa (Post-Study Work Route):

- For undergraduate and taught postgraduate students, the Graduate Visa currently allows a stay of two years.
- Based on recent reviews, there is a strong possibility that this duration may be reduced to 18 months starting in 2027.
- For research and PhD graduates, the Graduate Visa remains valid for three years.

Australia Tightens Student Visa Rules to Ensure **Genuine Study Intent**

Australia has introduced stricter student visa checks to ensure international students pursue education with genuine academic intent.

Genuine Student (GS) Requirement:

- Introduced in early 2024, replacing the Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) statement.
- Applies to UG, PG, and PhD applicants.
- Candidates must answer targeted questions instead of submitting a long statement.
- Assessment is based on course relevance, ties to home country, knowledge of the course and Australia, and explanations for study or work gaps.
- PhD applicants generally find it easier to meet GS criteria due to structured research proposals.

Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE):

- A mandatory CoE is required for all student visa applications.


