Maharashtra's New "34 Student Clubs" Mandate: At a Glance

The Maharashtra government, led by SCERT, has introduced a mandatory holistic learning initiative for Class 1 to 12. Aligned with NEP 2020, the goal is to shift education from rote learning to experiential skill building.

Key Highlights

Mandatory Participation: Every student must join at least one club based on their interest.

Student-Led Model: The goal is for students to eventually plan and lead activities, fostering leadership and responsibility, while teachers act as mentors.

Certification: Schools will award certificates to active participants to validate their extracurricular growth.

Community Tie-in: Parents are encouraged to participate, bridging the gap between home and school.

The 34 Clubs Cover These Core Areas:

Skill & Career: Vocational skills, Technology, Competitive Exam Prep.

Creativity & Culture: Arts, Languages, Reading, Culture.

Well-being: Health, Sports, Environment.

Academics: Subject-specific clubs to deepen knowledge.

Why This Matters

While some educators cite resource constraints, the primary value lies in democratizing access to soft skills. By institutionalizing these clubs, the state ensures that leadership, critical thinking, and problem-solving are not just for elite schools but for every student in the state.

Policy Updates (Classes 1-10 for Current Academic Year)

Recent policy changes that are relevant for Classes 1-10 in the current academic year (2025-26):

- School Timing Change (Pre-Primary to Class 4): Classes for pre-primary and primary students (up to Class 4) were directed to start from 9:00 AM onwards from the 2024-2025 academic year for health reasons.
- Minimum Age for Nursery: The minimum age for Nursery admission was altered to 3 years to align with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, ensuring a child is 6 years old upon entering Class 1.
- New Curriculum for Std 1 & 2 (Revised Timetable): A revised timetable structure for Standards 1 and 2 was announced for the 2025-26 academic year, which excludes Hindi as the third language for English and Marathi medium schools.

77 Phased Implementation Schedule (Maharashtra)

The Maharashtra government is rapidly implementing the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, replacing the old 10+2 structure with the 5+3+3+4 model. The transition is scheduled to be completed by the academic year 2028-29.

The state is rolling out the new curriculum gradually:

- 2025–26: Starting with Class 1.
- 2026–27: Classes 2, 3, 4, and 6.
- 2027–28: Classes 5, 7, 9, and 11.
- 2028–29: Completes with Classes 8, 10, and 12 (Board Exam years).

III Key Structural Changes

1. New Educational Structure (5+3+3+4):

- Foundational (Ages 3-8, Classes 1-2): Focus on play-based learning.
- Preparatory (Ages 8-11, Classes 3-5): Introduces subjects like science, math, and languages.
- Middle (Ages 11-14, Classes 6-8): Introduces abstract concepts and vocational education.
- Secondary (Ages 14-18, Classes 9-12): Focuses on multidisciplinary study and subject flexibility.
- 2. Curriculum Pattern: The state aims to adopt the CBSE curriculum pattern by 2028 to standardize learning and improve national competitive exam performance. Crucially, the history, geography, and Marathi language of Maharashtra will be integrated and preserved within this framework.
- **3.** Assessment: The state is shifting away from rote learning and final exams. It will introduce the Holistic Progress Card (HPC), which assesses students' skills, activities, and overall development.
- **4. Language Policy:** While the NEP emphasizes multilingualism, the specific mandate for a compulsory third language (Hindi) in Classes 1-5 was withdrawn/revised following expert concerns about the burden on young
- 5. Teacher Training: Training educators in new pedagogical methods and digital tools is a high priority to ensure effective implementation.

New MBBS Seats Spark Demand for Relaxation in Round 4 Rules

Parents of medical aspirants have urged the State CET Cell to allow students already admitted to BDS courses to participate in the upcoming stray vacancy round for MBBS admissions. They say that the recent approval of 100 additional MBBS seats in two medical colleges including 50 seats at Ashwini Rural Medical College, Solapur — has put earlier admitted students at a disadvantage, as many had accepted BDS or lower-ranked MBBS colleges before these seats were added.

Under current rules, students admitted up to Round 3 in MBBS or BDS cannot participate in Round 4, the stray vacancy round. Parents have called this rule unfair and a "gross injustice," especially to high-scoring students. One parent noted that although the Supreme Court has barred upgrades after Round 3, authorities previously allowed one exception for a student from Sindhudurg Medical College, and similar consideration should be extended to others.

The parents suggested a solution: permit already admitted students to choose only two preferred colleges during the stray round. Activist Sudha Shenoy said that although NMC approved the new seats before Round 3, the CET Cell did not allot them due to pending approvals. Now that these seats are included in Round 4, she argues that BDS students should be allowed to upgrade to MBBS.

Parents are awaiting a quick decision, as November 13 is the last day for choice filling, but CET officials insist that such relaxation is not possible under existing rules. Shenoy also reminded that in 2016, students were allowed to participate in Round 4 after a college received additional seats post Round 3.

Bombay HC Challenges CET Cell's MBBS **Admission Rule**

The Bombay High Court (HC) has allowed a medical aspirant, Purva Wagh, to challenge a State CET Cell rule concerning NEET-UG 2025 admissions that allegedly favors lower-scoring candidates in the final rounds.

***** The Issue

The challenged rule, Clause II.2.9.I of the State CET Cell's Information Brochure, bars candidates who confirmed admission in CAP Round III from participating in subsequent online stray vacancy rounds.

The Petitioner's Argument

- · Wagh, a higher-scoring candidate, was forced to accept a seat in a lower-ranking/private college during CAP Round III.
- Due to a scheduling error, non-MBBS rounds (II & III) were completed before the final MBBS round.
- This caused many top-ranking BAMS/BUMS/etc. seats to become vacant after those candidates secured MBBS seats and surrendered their original admissions.
- The petitioner argues that Clause II.2.9.I is unfair because it prevents high-scorers like her from upgrading to these newly vacant, highdemand seats in the stray vacancy round, while lower-scoring candidates benefit from them.

III Court's Observation

A bench of Justices Ghuge and Bhobe noted that the case raises a "strong arguable challenge" to the rule, acknowledging the "peculiar situation" created by the admission schedule mismatch.

CMAT 2026: Registration Extended, Exam Details Confirmed

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has officially extended the registration deadline for the Common Management Admission Test (CMAT) 2026, which is the national-level entrance exam for admission into various AICTE-approved management programmes across the country. The final date for application submission has been moved to November 24, 2025 (11:50 pm), with the fee payment window closing the following day, November 25, 2025. A correction window will subsequently open from November 26 to November 28, 2025, allowing candidates to rectify errors in their forms, which must be submitted exclusively through the official website, cmat.nta.nic.in.

CMAT 2026 will be conducted as a Computer-Based Test (CBT) lasting three hours (180 minutes). The exam features 100 Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs), distributed equally across five sections, with no individual sectional time limits. Each question carries 4 marks, and a penalty of 1 mark is deducted for every incorrect response. The total score is 400.

The exam syllabus is designed to assess comprehensive aptitude for management studies, covering:

- 1. Quantitative Techniques & Data Interpretation (covering Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry, etc.)
- 2.Logical Reasoning (including Analytical and Verbal Reasoning)
- 3.Language Comprehension(focusing on Reading Comprehension, Grammar, and Vocabulary)
- 4. General Awareness (Current Affairs and Static GK)
- 5.Innovation & Entrepreneurship (a key distinguishing section focusing on start-ups and business models).

The application fee is ₹2,500 for General male candidates, while a reduced fee of ₹1,250 applies to females and reserved categories (Gen-EWS, SC/ST, OBC-NCL, PwD, and third gender). Candidates are strongly advised to complete the online application process well ahead of the revised deadline to avoid last-minute technical difficulties.

Maharashtra Halts All Continuing Nursing Education Sessions Amid Fake Certificate Probe

The Maharashtra Nursing Council (MNC) has temporarily suspended all Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) sessions across the state following serious complaints about unauthorized programmes and fraudulent activities. The decision comes after multiple reports alleged that certain CNE sessions—some even held in government hospitals—were being conducted without proper approval, and nurses were being charged money in exchange for certificates.

According to MNC President Dr. Ramling B. Mali, an official inquiry was launched after receiving repeated complaints about bogus sessions and irregular practices. Although the investigation report was initially expected within five days, it has been delayed due to administrative bottlenecks. The findings are now likely to be submitted within the next 7–10 days.

While many welcomed the crackdown, several nurses are concerned about how the suspension may affect their licence renewal process. They fear that previously earned certificates may be declared invalid, making it harder to complete the required 150 credit points within the five-year cycle. Nurses hope that valid certificates will still be honoured so that their professional standing remains unaffected.

India Needs 86 Million New Higher Education Enrolments by 2035 to Meet NEP Targets

India needs to add approximately 86 million more students to its higher education system by 2035 to achieve the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 target of a 50% Gross Enrollment Ratio, according to a CII—Grant Thornton report.

The report warns that traditional campuses alone cannot handle this scale, highlighting the urgent need for digital universities, flexible online programs, modular credits, and workintegrated learning.

Achieving this goal requires a sustained annual capacity growth of 5.3%, alongside significant investments in infrastructure, faculty recruitment, technology adoption, and governance reforms. Stronger industry–academia partnerships are also critical to ensure graduate employability.

The report identifies three major pressures on institutions: upgrading technology, improving governance, and meeting rising student expectations.

While rapid expansion is necessary, the report cautions that it must not compromise quality, equity, or affordability. Digital and hybrid education models can help absorb the increasing student population, but equitable access and rigorous quality standards must be maintained.

Embedding employability into curricula through modular courses, internships, and micro-credentials is essential to prepare students for evolving job markets. Policymakers and institutions must act decisively to scale up capacity while safeguarding educational

standards.



"Maharashtra Mandates Digital Dashboards for All **Universities by Nov 30 to Boost Transparency**"

Maharashtra's Higher and Technical 3. Implementation Education Minister, Chandrakant Control Patil, has issued a strict directive to all state universities to modernize their governance systems immediately.

1. The Core Directive

- Mandate: All state universities operationalize comprehensive digital dashboard.
- Deadline: The system must be live by November 30, 2025 (11 days from now).
- Objective: To enforce real-time transparency, accountability, and the higher education sector.

2. What the Dashboard Will Track

The dashboard acts as a "health CET or university admissions): monitor" for universities, tracking four critical areas:

- Faculty Recruitment: Live updates on vacancies and hiring processes to ensure no positions remain empty for long.
- Academic Performance: Monitoring syllabus completion, exam schedules, and results.
- Administrative Work: Tracking delays.
- Governance: Overall institutional management and compliance.

& Quality

- Verification Teams: To prevent data fudging, a dedicated twomember will team universities to verify that the data uploaded to the dashboard matches reality.
- SIRF Integration: The data from this dashboard will directly feed into the Maharashtra State Institutional Ranking Framework (SIRF), influencing how universities are ranked within the state.

Maharashtra Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) Act, 2025

Education (ECCE) Act, 2025, is set to be the first comprehensive law by a state government to regulate the largely unorganized pre-primary sector.

Key Mandates of the ECCE Act, 2025

The Act is highly significant as it aligns Maharashtra's education system with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and the Right to Education (RTE) Act by formalizing the 3-6 age group.

- Mandatory Registration: All existing nursery schools, play-schools, and kindergartens must register with the School Education Department within six months of the law's enactment. New centers require prior approval before opening.
- Zero-Tolerance for Non-Compliance: Unregistered institutions or those that violate the prescribed norms may face heavy fines of up to ₹50,000 and continuous daily penalties continued operation.

- Maharashtra Early Childhood Care and Regulated Admission: The draft explicitly aims to increase transparency by prohibiting interviews or screening processes for both children and their parents during admission.
 - Fee Control: Institutions will not be allowed to charge a fee higher than the one prescribed by the government and will be barred from collecting any capitation (additional) fees.
 - Exemptions: Institutions under the government's Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) scheme, such Anganwadis and Balwadis, are exempt from the registration mandate.

CBSE Class 10 Internal Assessment

CBSE Class 10 Science (Total 100 Marks) Science follows a 70 Marks (Theory) + 30 Marks (Practical) scheme. The 30 marks for Practical Assessment are broken down into three main areas conducted throughout the year:

1. Practical Lab Work (15 Marks):

 This includes marks based on the record of practicals conducted by the student in the lab, their viva-voce (oral) examination during the practical sessions, and project work

2. Periodic Assessment (5 Marks):

 Marks awarded based on performance in written periodic tests conducted by the school throughout the academic session.

3. Subject Enrichment Activities (5 Marks):

 Marks based on specific activities related to the subject, such as model making, presentations, or innovative science club activities.

4. Portfolio (5 Marks):

Marks awarded for maintaining a portfolio—
 a collection of the student's best work, self assessment sheets, and reflection sheets from
 the year.

The 30-mark component is supervised and evaluated by the school's internal science teachers, ensuring continuous evaluation over the academic year. -VidyarthiMitra News Desk

CBSE Class 10 Mathematics (Total 100 Marks)

Mathematics follows an 80 Marks (Theory) + 20 Marks (Internal Assessment) scheme. The 20 marks for Internal Assessment are generally broken down into three equal parts:

1. Periodic Tests / Assessment (10 Marks):

• This is the largest component of the internal assessment. Schools must conduct a minimum of three periodic tests throughout the year. The average of the best two or three is typically taken for the final internal score.

2. Mathematics Activity / Practical Work (5 Marks):

 Marks are awarded based on activities listed in the CBSE Mathematics Lab Manual. This involves documenting specific mathematical models, practical applications, or geometrical constructions.

3. Portfolio (5 Marks):

 Similar to Science, this score is based on the student's classwork record, subject notebooks, and journal entries, demonstrating consistency and effort throughout the year.

India Plans Unified Higher Education Commission to Overhaul Regulation Under NEP 2020

The government is in the advanced stages of drafting a bill to establish a single unified Higher Education Commission that will regulate universities and colleges across India under one umbrella framework. This new body will merge the roles of existing agencies like UGC, AICTE, and NAAC, bringing regulation, accreditation, funding decisions, curriculum standards, and institutional evaluation under one authority.

The move aims to reduce bureaucratic overlap, speed up policy implementation, and make higher education governance more transparent and accountable. Under NEP 2020, the commission will promote multidisciplinary universities, flexible course structures, internationalisation of Indian campuses, and digital learning ecosystems.

It will also set clearer quality benchmarks, monitor institutional performance through data-driven dashboards, and support innovation in teaching and research. Additionally, the commission is expected to simplify approvals for new programs, enable faster accreditation cycles, and ensure that colleges receive timely funding support based on performance indicators.

By replacing a fragmented regulatory system with a modern, integrated framework, the proposed Higher Education Commission is positioned to strengthen academic quality, expand access, and help India build world-class universities capable of competing globally.

NCC-Inspired Training from Class 1

This move represents a major effort by the state government to integrate elements of the National Cadet Corps (NCC) training into the mainstream school curriculum, targeting students from Class 1 onwards.

- Training Mandate: Basic parade drills and physical training, drawing inspiration from the NCC regimen, will be made part of the students' school activities.
- Instructors: The training will be provided by former servicemen, leveraging their disciplinary experience to impart structure and physical fitness to young children.
- NCC Expansion: The state plans to expand 10 existing NCC training centres to accommodate an additional 20,000 students, indicating a long-term commitment to strengthening the formal NCC program as well

Enrollment Criteria (High School Level)

For students currently in high school (Class 8 to 12) looking to join the formal NCC program, the following criteria generally apply for enrollment into the Junior Division (JD) / Senior Division (SD):

- Nationality: Must be an Indian national or a citizen of Nepal or Bhutan.
- Educational Institution: Must be a bona fide student of an educational institution (School or College) that is affiliated with an NCC unit.
- Age Limit: For the Junior Division (JD), the student must be between 12 and 18 years of age.
- Physical Fitness: Candidates must meet the prescribed standards of physical fitness, which include height and weight requirements. They often have to pass a medical examination to ensure they are fit to undergo the required physical training and attend camps.

Duration of Enrollment: A candidate must be willing to undergo two years of training in the Junior Division and a minimum of three years for the Senior Division (though two years is the minimum requirement for the 'B' **certificate**).

The Core Debate: Readiness vs. Discipline

The introduction of parade training for children as young as six or seven (primary-aged kids) has sparked a pedagogical debate among education experts:

- Concerns (Against): Experts argue that young children in Class 1 are still developing fine motor skills and require learning environments centered on play, creativity, and exploration (as per NEP 2020 guidelines for the foundational stage). Rigid, uniform parade drills may hinder natural development and creativity and may not be developmentally appropriate for this age group.
- Advocates (For): Proponents of the policy emphasize that the training promotes early development of essential values such as discipline, patriotism, teamwork, and physical fitness. They argue that the training is inspired by the NCC but will be adapted to be age-appropriate.

This policy reflects a tension between the goals of structural discipline and the principles of modern, child-centric pedagogy.

Maharashtra Launches Massive Faculty Recruitment Drive to Strengthen Higher Education Under NEP 2020

Maharashtra CM Devendra Fadnavis has approved a major recruitment drive in higher education — clearing 5,012 assistant professor posts in grant-in-aid (non-government) colleges, along with 788 teaching and 2,242 non-teaching posts in state public universities. addition, there's approval for 100% hiring in government-aided engineering colleges like VJTI Mumbai and Guru Gobind Singh Engineering College, which is especially significant for technical education. For the newly established Lakshminarayan Innovation Technological University (LITU), 105 faculty-equivalent teaching posts have been sanctioned, along with an ₹8 crore operational grant.

In a related announcement, Maharashtra's Higher & Technical Education Minister Chandrakant Patil said the government plans to recruit 5,500 assistant professors in senior (degree) colleges by March 2026, plus 2,900 non-teaching staff. This hiring push is being framed as a way to strengthen higher education capacity and significantly support NEP (National Education Policy) implementation.

However, this comes in the backdrop of a severe faculty shortage: an RTI revealed that as of December 2024, about 38% of sanctioned teaching posts (over 11,900) in Maharashtra universities and colleges were vacant.

So, while the recruitment drive is very aggressive, it's also a response to a deep, long-standing staffing crisis.

There are also process reforms: to make recruitment more merit-based and transparent, the Higher Education Department has advertised 659 faculty posts using a new scoring system that gives more weight to academic and research credentials, while cutting down interview weight.

That said, not everyone is happy: some professor associations have raised objections to aspects of the recruitment procedure, questioning its transparency and fairness.

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has released multiple key guidelines today regarding national frameworks:

1. NCrF: The End of "Wasted Learning"

The National Credit Framework is the engine that drives the flexibility of the NEP. The new guidelines confirm the standardization of credit recognition across all forms of learning:

- Seamless Mobility (MEE): This confirms the Multiple Entry/Exit (MEE) system is fully operational. If a student leaves a 4-year UG course after 2 years with a Diploma, the credits earned are stored in the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC). They can return years later, redeem those credits, and continue their studies from where they left off.
- Creditization of All Learning: This is the biggest change. Credits are now awarded for:
 - Academic Courses: Lectures, Tutorials, Lab work.
 - Vocational/Skill Courses: Practical training, certificate courses.
 - Experiential Learning: Internships, field projects, and even recognized work experience gained outside the classroom.
- Equivalence: The framework establishes academic equivalence between general education (B.A., B.Sc.) and vocational education/skills, removing the rigid separation that existed before.

2. NHEQF: Ensuring Global Recognition

The National Higher Education Qualification Framework defines what a student must know and be able to do at every stage of their academic journey (UG, PG, PhD).

- Global Comparability: By defining qualifications based on objective Learning Outcomes rather than just hours spent in a classroom, the NHEQF directly aligns Indian degrees (certificates, diplomas, degrees) with international quality standards.
- Facilitating Student Mobility: This will make it significantly easier for Indian students to have their degrees recognized by foreign universities for higher studies (Masters/PhD) and easier for foreign students to transfer credits to Indian institutions.
- Standardized Quality: It serves as a national benchmark, ensuring that a degree awarded by any HEI in India meets the same minimum expected standards and learning attributes.

Implications for the 4-Year UG Programme (FYUP)

The adoption of the Curriculum and Credit

Framework means universities must now finalize:

- The 160+ total credits required for the 4-Year UG (Honors with Research) degree.
- The mandatory breakdown of these credits into Major/Minor disciplines, Skill Courses, Value-Added Courses, and Research/Internship components.
- The specific credit requirements for intermediate exit points:
 - Certificate: Exit after 1 year (approx. 40 credits).
 - Diploma: Exit after 2 years (approx. 80 credits).
 - Bachelor's Degree: Exit after 3 years (approx. 120 credits).

LL.M. & LLB Admissions

1. 2025-2026 Admissions (Concluding)

The Centralized Admission Process (CAP) rounds for both MAH LLB 3-Year CET and MAH LLB 5-Year CET are officially complete for the 2025-26 academic year.

- Status: The State CET Cell notifications show that the final Institute Level Rounds (ILR) concluded recently. Most seats are filled, with admissions formally closed or closing shortly.

Eligibility criteria for JEE Main 2026 for the B.E./B.Tech. program:

1. Year of Passing Class 12

Candidates must have passed their Class 12 or equivalent examination in either 2024 or 2025. Those who are appearing for their Class 12 board examinations in 2026 are also eligible to apply. If you passed before 2024, you are ineligible.

2. Mandatory Subjects (For B.E./B.Tech)

For admission to the B.E./B.Tech. course (Paper 1), you must have passed your Class 12 examination with the following subjects:

- Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects.
- One subject from the following options: Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, or a Technical Vocational Subject.

3. Class 12 Percentage Rule (The 75% Barrier)

This is the most misunderstood criterion. There is no minimum percentage required in Class 12 just to appear for the JEE Main 2026 exam itself.

However, to gain admission to the NITs, IIITs, GFTIs, and IITs (via JEE Advanced), you must satisfy one of the following two conditions in your Class 12 or equivalent examination:

- You must have secured at least 75% aggregate marks (for General, EWS, and OBC-NCL categories).
- You must have secured at least 65% aggregate marks (for SC/ST categories).
- OR You must be in the Top 20 Percentile of successful candidates in your respective Class 12 Board examination.



Australia Implements New Student Visa Rule for Fairer Distribution.

The Australian government is introducing Ministerial Direction 115 on November 14, 2025, to overhaul how international student visa (subclass 500) applications are managed. This new rule replaces Ministerial Direction 111 and aims to ensure a fairer and more sustainable distribution of international students across all education providers, including both major city universities and smaller vocational and training (VET) institutes.

The change is a direct result of the government's recent efforts to curb the high volume of applications, which caused stress on housing and local resources (leading to a 26% drop in applications). Under Direction 115, visa processing will prioritize education providers demonstrate responsible and compliant management of their international student enrolments.

For Indian students, this new policy signifies a move toward a more balanced and transparent visa process. Institutions that follow government guidelines will likely receive faster visa decisions for their applicants, ensuring that the focus remains on quality, integrity, and sustainable growth within the Australian international education sector. government will hold information sessions throughout November and December to guide institutions on compliance.

New UK Rule Lets Indian Graduates Launch Startups -VidyarthiMitra News Desk Without Leaving the Country

The UK has introduced a streamlined and direct route for Indian students with entrepreneurial aspirations. From November 25, 2025, international students will be able to switch directly from a valid Student Visa to the Innovator Founder Visa without leaving the country. This major policy shift removes the need for costly travel and long application delays, enabling graduates to begin building their startups immediately after completing their studies. The visa supports innovative and scalable business ideas, giving Indian founders access to the UK's strong startup ecosystem, including mentorship, and global accelerators, incubators, investment opportunities. It also provides a long-term pathway to settlement, encouraging students to convert academic research or final-year projects into viable companies. The simplified process reduces administrative barriers and strengthens India-UK collaboration in business and innovation. With growing demand for technology, AI, healthcare, sustainability, and digital ventures, the new rule offers a significant advantage to Indian graduates aiming to launch global businesses from the UK.

Major Study Abroad Developments Benefiting Indian Students...

Indian students planning overseas education are set to gain from three important developments shaping the global study landscape. First, Indian insurers have launched advanced student travel insurance plans that now cover visa cancellations, university withdrawal, sponsor insolvency, job loss abroad, medical emergencies, and travel disruptions. These upgraded policies provide a strong financial shield for families facing rising uncertainties in international education.

Secondly, the UK is expanding its academic presence in India. The University of Lancaster is preparing to open a campus in GIFT City, Gujarat, while the University of Surrey is planning a campus in Bengaluru. These international branch campuses will offer UK-aligned programs, global teaching standards, and industry-driven courses without the need for visas or high overseas fees, making foreign-quality education significantly more accessible for Indian students.

H-1B Visa Scrutiny to Reshape Global Tech Hiring -VidyarthiMitra News Desk

This policy shift forces US tech employers to expand offshore and hybrid teams, primarily in cost-effective regions like India and Southeast Asia, where operational costs are significantly lower. This simultaneously helps regulate "brain drain" from countries like India, potentially making them major innovation centers.

Furthermore, the demand for any remaining H-1B visas will be highly specialized, focusing intensely on talent possessing strong Al, Data, Cloud, or Cybersecurity capabilities, rather than general IT skills. Companies will also increase investment in training local US talent to reduce reliance on imported skills. While the policy signals a tough stance, US officials acknowledge that some skilled foreign talent remains essential for highly complex roles.


