## Maharashtra CET 2026 Exam Schedule Announced for MBA, Engineering, Pharmacy & Agriculture Admissions

The Government of Maharashtra has announced the Maharashtra CET 2026 exam schedule for admissions to professional courses for the academic year 2026–27.

The examinations will be conducted by the State Common Entrance Test Cell at centers across the state and are mandatory for admission to courses such as MBA/MMS, Engineering, Pharmacy, and Agriculture in government, aided, and private colleges.

As per the official notice, CET 2026 exams will be held from April 6 to May 17, 2026. The online registration window for all major CET exams will remain open from January 10 to February 12, 2026, and candidates are advised to apply within this period.

For MAH-MBA/MMS CET 2026, the first attempt is scheduled from April 6 to April 8, 2026, while the second attempt will be held on May 9, 2026. This exam is required for MBA and MMS admissions across Maharashtra. The MAH-MHT CET 2026 for Engineering and Pharmacy will be conducted for PCM and PCB groups. The first attempt will take place from April 11 to April 26, 2026, followed by the second attempt from May 10 to May 17, 2026.

A key requirement for CET 2026 registration is that candidates must have a valid Aadhaar ID and APAAR ID. Students who have not yet created their APAAR ID must do so through DigiLocker, as registration will not be accepted without it.

Candidates should regularly visit the official CET Cell website for updates on admit cards, exam centres, results, and counselling. Timely registration and proper documentation will play a crucial role in securing admission to preferred courses and colleges.

**CBSE Launches Budding Authors Programme**

New Delhi: The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has launched a new Budding Authors Programme to encourage creative writing and storytelling among students of Classes 5 to 10. The initiative gives young learners a platform to express their imagination and develop original writing skills by submitting their own unpublished short stories in English or Hindi.

Under the programme, stories must follow specific word limits by class: 500–600 words for Classes 5–6, 600–900 words for Classes 7–8, and 1,000–1,500 words for Classes 9–10

The schedule of activities begins with the first round at the school level from January 6 to 31, 2026, during which each school will nominate a teacher as a Nodal Officer to coordinate student participation and conduct the initial round. Shortlisted entries will advance to the second round from February 3 to 27, 2026. Schools can nominate up to 12 top entries from the first round for submission in this stage.

In the final evaluation, a panel of academic experts will review the shortlisted stories, and the best ones will be e-published by CBSE as a collection of short stories for each category. There is no fee for participation, and all submitted works must be original and unpublished

**CBSE Issues Reminder On Class 10, 12 Practical Exams 2026, Shares Key Instructions**

**CBSE Practical Exams 2026:** Schools have been instructed to strictly follow the Board's guidelines to ensure smooth and timely execution of all assessments. Schools must conduct CBSE practical, project, and internal assessments between 1 Jan and 14 Feb 2026.

**CBSE Practical Exams 2026:**

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has issued a reminder to all affiliated schools regarding the conduct of Class 10 and 12 practical examinations, projects, and internal assessments for the academic session 2025-26. Schools have been instructed to strictly follow the Board's guidelines to ensure smooth and timely execution of all assessments.

**The Board has outlined several key directives for schools:**

- Schools must ensure sufficient practical answer books are available before the scheduled exams. Any shortage should be reported to the respective Regional Office.
- Parents and students should be informed in advance about the schedule of practicals, projects, and internal assessments for strict compliance.
- Laboratories must be fully equipped with the necessary infrastructure, materials, and equipment to facilitate experiments and practical work.
- Schools should coordinate with CBSE-appointed external examiners well ahead of the assessments to avoid delays.
- Arrangements must be made for Children with Special Needs (CWSN) so they can comfortably participate in the practical exams.
- Students will appear for assessments as per the schedule fixed by the school. Marks must be uploaded on the same day of the assessment. Corrections after upload will not be allowed.
- Schools, internal examiners, and external examiners must ensure that marks are awarded based solely on student performance and correspond to the maximum marks allocated.
- No exemptions will be granted for students participating in national or international level sports, and separate practicals will not be conducted for them.
- For Class 12, only CBSE-appointed external examiners are authorised to conduct practical assessments. Use of any other examiner will render the assessment null and void.
- Non-compliance with CBSE instructions may lead to cancellation of the practical examination.
- Practical assessments must be conducted strictly between 1 January 2026 and 14 February 2026. From 1 February, school principals must closely monitor the conduct of practicals and daily mark uploads.
- Any clarifications can be sought from the respective CBSE Regional Office. Additionally, CBSE has revised the remuneration rates for all exam functionaries for the 2025-26 practical examinations.



## CBSE Directs Schools to Use PM eVidya Channel 15, Shares 67 Educational Videos

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has instructed all its affiliated schools to make effective and regular use of PM eVidya CBSE Channel 15 to enhance classroom teaching, improve conceptual understanding, and support student learning. As part of this initiative, CBSE has shared a curated list of 67 educational e-videos developed for students of Classes 9 to 11.

These videos cover key academic subjects such as Mathematics, Science, and Social Science, and also include important teacher-oriented modules focusing on experiential learning techniques, storytelling-based pedagogy, innovative assessment strategies, cyber safety awareness, and the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The content is designed to align with the CBSE curriculum and promote activity-based and student-centric learning.

The PM eVidya programme, launched in 2024 under the Ministry of Education, aims to bridge learning gaps and ensure inclusive education by delivering quality digital content through 200 DTH television channels across the country. To further widen reach and accessibility, CBSE's Channel 15 content is also available on YouTube, enabling students to revisit lessons anytime and learn at their own pace, especially in areas with limited internet connectivity.

CBSE has advised schools to ensure the availability of basic digital infrastructure such as smart classrooms or DTH facilities, inform teachers and students about the channel, and actively integrate these e-videos into daily teaching practices. Schools are encouraged to use the content not only for regular instruction but also for revision, remedial teaching, and enrichment activities, particularly to support students who need additional academic help.



### Overall Theory Paper: 70 marks (combined from Sections A-E)

The remaining 30 marks in the final board score come from the practical examination, which includes experiments, viva, and record work.

- In two questions in Section B
- In one question in Section C
- In all three questions in Section E

Students need to answer only one option where choices are given.

Experts recommend that students practice the official sample question papers under timed conditions (3 hours) at least three times before the exam. Regular practice helps improve writing speed, familiarity with the exam format, and time management, which boosts confidence during the actual board test.

## NMC Approves 171 Additional PG Medical Seats for Academic Year 2025–26

The National Medical Commission (NMC) has granted approval for 171 additional postgraduate (PG) medical seats for the 2025–26 academic session, providing a significant boost to postgraduate medical education in the country. The decision follows recommendations made by the Commission's First Appeal Committee and was officially communicated through a public notice dated December 31, 2025.

The approval comes after several medical colleges challenged earlier decisions taken by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) under the provisions of Section 28(5) of the NMC Act, 2019. These appeals were carefully reviewed during meetings of the First Appeal Committee held on December 22 and 23, 2025. After examining the submissions, the Committee approved additional PG seats across multiple medical colleges and specialties.



In its public notice, the NMC clarified that the detailed list of newly sanctioned seats has been attached for the information of all stakeholders. The Commission further stated that this list will be treated as a valid and official document for the ongoing and upcoming PG medical counselling process.

Importantly, the NMC has directed counselling authorities not to delay the admission process due to procedural or administrative formalities. The Commission noted that counselling bodies need not wait for the issuance of Letters of Permission (LoPs) from the concerned institutions before including these additional seats in counselling. At the same time, it assured that the LoPs for the newly approved PG seats will be issued shortly.

The additional PG seats have been sanctioned across a wide range of clinical and academic disciplines. These include General Medicine, General Surgery, Anaesthesiology, Radiodiagnosis, Pediatrics, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Orthopaedics, Psychiatry, Dermatology, Emergency Medicine, as well as several pre-clinical and para-clinical subjects.

Medical colleges from various states and Union Territories have benefited from the approval. Institutions located in Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Odisha, Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan, Haryana, Chhattisgarh, and Arunachal Pradesh are among those featured in the approved list.

The move is expected to help address the growing demand for postgraduate medical training seats and ensure timely admissions for the PG Medical Counselling 2025–26 cycle.



## NTA Asks JEE Main 2026 Applicants to Re-Verify Identity Using Certified Document

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has issued an important notice for candidates appearing in JEE Main 2026, directing them to re-verify their identity proof documents submitted during the application process. Affected candidates have been asked to complete the verification process by January 15, 2026.

According to the official notification, discrepancies were found in the identity documents uploaded by some applicants. In several cases, candidates had used identity proofs other than Aadhaar, while in others, the live photographs captured during registration did not match the photographs available in the records of the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI).

To address this issue, NTA has provided such candidates with a one-time opportunity to verify their identity. Candidates are required to upload a signed and attested certificate, along with a recent photograph, certified by their school or college principal/headmaster. However, considering the grievances received from candidates regarding the difficulty in accessing school or college authorities, NTA has expanded the list of acceptable verifying authorities.

Candidates may now obtain attestation from a Class-I Gazetted Officer, including officials such as Tehsildar, Revenue Officer, Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM), District Magistrate (DM), or a Class-I Gazetted Officer of the Indian Embassy in case of NRI candidates.


The National Testing Agency has advised all affected candidates to complete the verification process within the stipulated deadline to avoid any complications in the examination process.




