Maharashtra's new policy requiring all schools to form alumni associations

The Maharashtra government has made it mandatory for all schools—government (Zilla Parishad, municipal), private aided, and unaided—to form formal alumni associations through a Government Resolution issued on October 1, 2025 by the School Education and Sports Department.

Purpose of the Policy

The policy aims to reconnect former students with their schools and create a structured system where alumni actively contribute to school development, student mentoring, and overall educational improvement.

Why the Policy Was Introduced

The initiative focuses on strengthening school infrastructure by involving alumni in improving facilities such as classrooms, libraries, laboratories, sanitation, playgrounds, and digital resources. It also seeks to enhance academic and career support through expert lectures, career guidance, mentoring, and competitive exam preparation. Additionally, the policy encourages social, cultural, and environmental engagement, while using successful alumni as role models to inspire current students and strengthen community ties.

Applicability and Structure

The directive applies to all schools from Classes 1 to 12 across Maharashtra.

Each alumni association is expected to include a President and Vice-President from among alumni, with the school headmaster or principal acting as Secretary. Members may include alumni, teachers, parents, retired officials, and education department representatives.

Meetings and Activities

Associations must hold at least two meetings annually and organise an annual alumni or cultural gathering. Schools are encouraged to create online platforms for alumni registration and engagement.

Roles and Responsibilities

Alumni are expected to support infrastructure development, provide academic and career guidance, promote community-based initiatives, and assist deserving students through mentorship, scholarships, and recognition programmes. Financial contributions, if any, must be transparent, with an emphasis on non-cash support.

Benefits

The policy is expected to improve school facilities, strengthen student mentorship, inspire learners through alumni success stories, and increase community participation in education.

Challenges

Concerns include additional administrative workload, uneven alumni participation—especially in rural areas—and the risk of over-reliance on alumni funding instead of government responsibility. Alignment with National Goals

This initiative aligns with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, which promotes community participation, stakeholder involvement, and holistic development of schools.

JEE Main 2026: AIR 1 Shares Final Preparation Tips For Aspirants

As students prepare to appear for the JEE Main 2026 Session 1 exam, scheduled between January 21 and 30, last-minute strategy has become crucial. Saksham Jindal, All India Rank 1 in JEE Main 2025 and currently pursuing BTech at IIT Bombay, has shared key insights to help aspirants maximise their performance. Jindal stressed the importance of focusing on high-weightage topics rather than revising the entire syllabus. He advised students to prioritise Calculus and Vectors in Mathematics, Rotational Motion, Fluid Mechanics, and Electromagnetic Induction in Physics, and Salt Analysis and Coordination Chemistry in Chemistry, as these chapters often contribute significantly to the overall score.

Highlighting the role of practice, he said solving previous years' question papers is essential to understand the exam pattern and manage time effectively. According to him, candidates should attempt easy and moderate questions first, leaving difficult ones for the end to avoid unnecessary pressure. Sharing his board exam preparation approach, Jindal said he began focused revision about 15 days before the exams, emphasising subjective answer writing to match board exam requirements. This disciplined strategy helped him secure 96.4 per cent in Class 12.

With JEE Main approaching, aspirants are advised to revise strategically, practise regularly, and stay calm during the examination.

CBSE Announces National Writing Competition for Students, Offers Cash Prizes and Switzerland Visit

Delhi Schools to Publish Entry-Level Admission Point Lists for Nursery and Class 1

Schools in Delhi will release the points-based candidate lists for admissions to Nursery, KG and Class 1 for the 2026–27 academic session on January 16, 2026, in line with guidelines issued by the Directorate of Education (DoE). Under the points system, children are awarded marks based on factors such as neighbourhood distance, sibling preference, alumni status, and other parameters prescribed by the DoE. Based on these criteria, the first list of shortlisted candidates will be published on January 23, 2026. Parents and guardians will be able to raise objections or seek clarification regarding the points allotted to their children between January 24 and February 3. After addressing these concerns, schools will issue the second list of selected candidates on February 9. The admission process for entry-level classes will conclude on March 19, 2026.

Age Eligibility Criteria

For the 2026–27 academic session, children must be at least three years old for Nursery, four years for KG, and five years for Class 1 as on March 31, 2026. Schools may allow an age relaxation of up to one month, subject to approval by the head of the institution.

The DoE has also clarified that children admitted to Nursery and KG during the 2025–26 session will automatically move to the next class in the upcoming academic year. Fresh admissions to Nursery in 2026–27 will therefore be open only to children who meet the prescribed age criteria.

Google Unveils Experimental AI Tool That Turns Textbooks Into Interactive Learning Experiences

Google has introduced an experimental Artificial Intelligence (AI) learning tool that aims to transform traditional textbooks into interactive, personalised digital lessons. The new research-based platform, called “Learn Your Way,” uses generative AI to convert standard PDF textbooks into engaging learning formats such as visual text, slides, audio lessons, narrated explanations, mind maps, and quizzes.

The tool has been designed to support both students and educators by offering flexible ways to learn and teach. By analysing a user’s grade level and personal interests—including areas like sports, food, or technology—the AI adapts content delivery and provides tailored feedback to improve understanding and retention.

How the Tool Works

Users begin by uploading a textbook or study material in PDF format. After selecting their grade level and areas of interest, they click on a “personalise” option. The AI then instantly generates customised lessons, allowing users to switch seamlessly between text-based explanations, audio narration, slides, and visual summaries.

Each lesson also includes interactive quizzes, helping learners assess their understanding as they progress through the topic. Currently, Learn Your Way is available only as a research experiment with limited access, though interested users can explore the tool through Google’s official research

Pre-Created Lessons Available

While full personal access is still restricted, Google has released several ready-made immersive lessons across subjects such as history, science, sociology, and computer science. These lessons are customised according to grade level and learning preferences and include topics such as:

- Overview of Economic Systems
- Early Human Evolution and Migration
- Immune System Disorders
- Atoms and Molecules

- Carbon Compounds
- Introduction to Data Structures and Algorithms
- The Ancient Roman Economy

Why “Learn Your Way” Matters

The platform is built on established learning science principles, including dual coding theory, which suggests that students understand and remember concepts better when information is presented through multiple formats such as text, visuals, and audio. Google Research says the goal is not simply to digitise textbooks, but to give learners greater control over how they study, making education more engaging, personalised, and effective.

Improved Learning and Retention Results

According to Google, early research shows promising results. In a randomised controlled study involving 60 students aged 15 to 18, participants were asked to study adolescent brain development using either a traditional digital textbook or Learn Your Way resources within a 40-minute session. When tested later, students who used Learn Your Way scored 9% higher in immediate assessments and 11% higher in long-term retention tests conducted 3–5 days later. The Learn Your Way group recorded an average score of 78%, compared to 67% among students using standard digital readers.

The Bigger Picture

Although still in the experimental phase, Learn Your Way signals a shift toward AI-driven personalised education. By combining interactive formats with learner choice, Google aims to redefine how students engage with academic content—moving beyond static textbooks to more immersive and effective learning experiences.

CBSE Issues Admit Cards for Private Candidates Appearing in Board Exams 2026

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has made available the admit cards for Class 10 and Class 12 private candidates who are set to appear for the CBSE Board Examinations 2026. Candidates can download their hall tickets through the board’s official website.

4. Download the admit card and take multiple printouts for safety

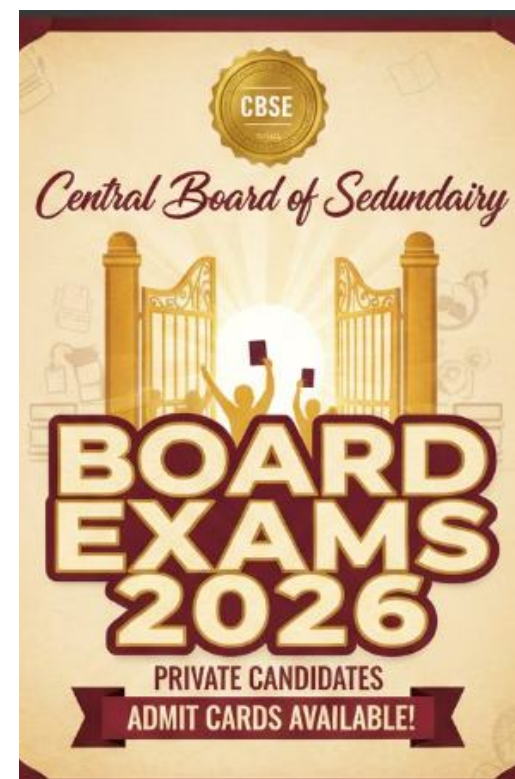

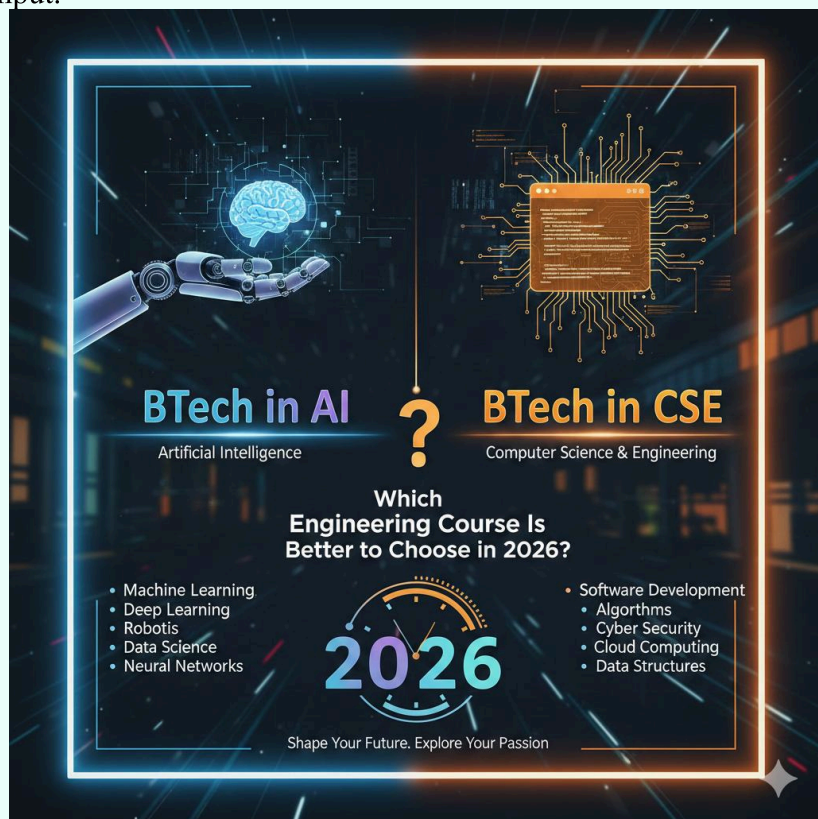

Medical Seat Paradox: Why NEET-PG Cut-Offs Are Falling Even as PG Seats Remain Vacant

Even as India struggles with a shortage of specialist doctors, thousands of postgraduate (PG) medical seats continue to remain vacant each year. To tackle this imbalance, authorities have once again lowered NEET-PG qualifying cut-offs, allowing candidates with very low—and in some reserved categories, even negative—scores to participate in later rounds of counselling. The latest relaxation permits candidates scoring up to minus 40 marks in certain categories to appear for the third round, reigniting debate over affordability, quality, and long-standing flaws in India's medical education system.

Why Are PG Seats Still Vacant?

Experts stress that the problem is not a lack of aspirants, but systemic issues in postgraduate medical education.

Dr Rohan Krishnan, Chief Patron of the Federation of All India Medical Associations (FAIMA), says recurring vacancies reflect a policy failure rather than student disinterest. Most unfilled seats are in private medical colleges, where MD and MS course fees range from ₹25 lakh to over ₹1 crore, putting them beyond the reach of many doctors. India has over 67,000 PG medical seats, including MD, MS, and diploma programmes. Despite the addition of more than 20,000 seats since 2014, counselling data shows that nearly 18,000 seats remain vacant, especially in non-clinical branches and less preferred regions.

Cost and Infrastructure Concerns

High fees are only part of the issue. Doctors' bodies cite other deterrents such as:

- Inadequate infrastructure in newer colleges
- Low or irregular stipends
- Limited clinical exposure
- Colleges located in remote or underserved areas

As a result, many aspirants prefer waiting for government seats rather than taking on heavy financial burdens, making PG education increasingly unsustainable for middle-class students.

Falling Cut-Offs: A Repeated Pattern

Lowering eligibility criteria has become a recurring strategy to fill seats:

- 2023: Zero percentile across categories
- 2024: Cut-off lowered to the 5th percentile
- 2025 cycle: Category-wise reductions, including negative marks

According to experts, this approach addresses symptoms, not causes. Dr Krishnan calls it a short-term solution that avoids tackling fee regulation, irrational bonding rules, and uneven seat distribution.

Debate Over Negative Scores

Allowing candidates with negative scores into counselling has raised concerns about academic standards. Dr Aqsa Shaikh of Jamia Hamdard Medical College said the trend highlights gaps in undergraduate training and assessment. She also pointed to commercial pressures, noting that private institutions rely heavily on PG admissions, influencing repeated cut-off relaxations.

Aspirants Speak Out

Reactions among NEET-PG candidates remain mixed. While some welcome the relaxation, others feel their years of preparation have been devalued. Many stress that eligibility means little when private seats cost ₹80 lakh or more, arguing that affordability remains the real barrier.

Impact on Healthcare Quality

Medical professionals warn that continuously lowering entry thresholds could weaken academic standards and eventually affect patient care. Critics fear that this may result in degree dilution, rather than producing well-trained specialists.

The Way Forward

Medical associations are urging structural reforms instead of repeated cut-off reductions, including:

- Regulation of PG fees in private colleges
- Expansion of government PG seats
- Uniform bonding policies
- Affordable financing options

As counselling continues under relaxed norms, the larger question persists: Is filling seats at any cost the answer, or does India need a fundamental overhaul of its medical education system?

CUET PG 2026 Registration Deadline Extended to January 20

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has announced an extension for the submission of online applications for the Common University Entrance Test for Postgraduate Programs (CUET PG) 2026. Candidates can now register for the exam until January 20, 2026, 11:50 PM, giving aspirants additional time to complete their applications. The previous deadline was January 14, 2026, and the extension comes after several requests from candidates seeking more time. The last date to pay the examination fee has also been extended to January 20, 2026.

Applicants who have already submitted their forms will have the opportunity to correct any details in their applications from January 23 to January 25, 2026, ensuring that all information is accurate and complete before the exam.

This year, the number of exam cities has been slightly reduced, from 312 to 292, with 272 cities in India and 16 abroad. While there have been changes in the exam locations, the CUET PG 2026 exam pattern and the number of subjects remain unchanged. The test will be conducted for 157 subjects, with each paper lasting 90 minutes.

The CUET PG 2026 exam is scheduled to be held in March 2026, and successful candidates will become eligible for postgraduate programs at Central, State, private, Deemed, and other participating universities for the 2026–27 academic session. This extension provides candidates ample time to prepare their documents, review their application details, and ensure they do not miss out on this important opportunity.

MAHA TET 2025 Results Announced by Maharashtra State Council of Examination

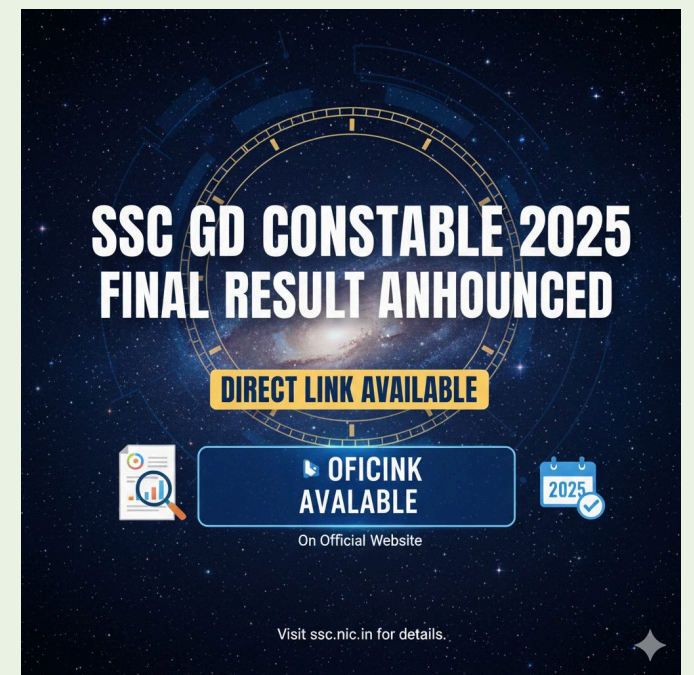

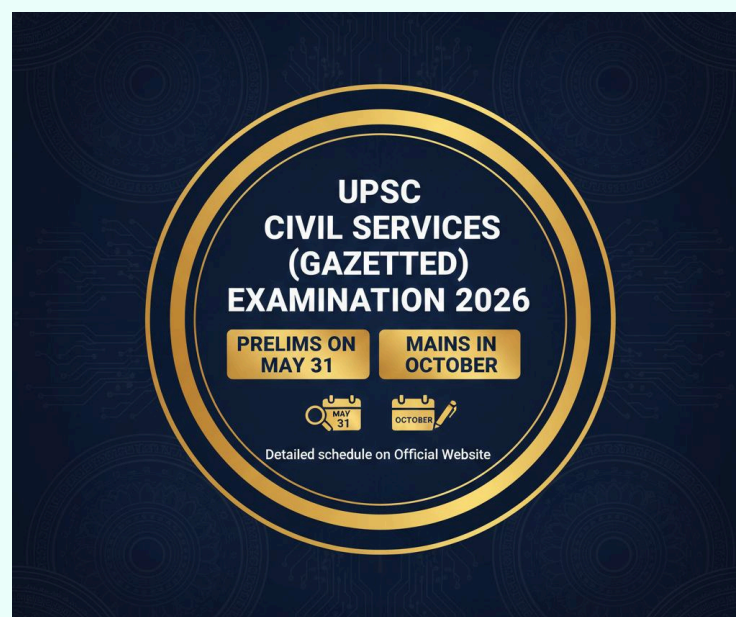

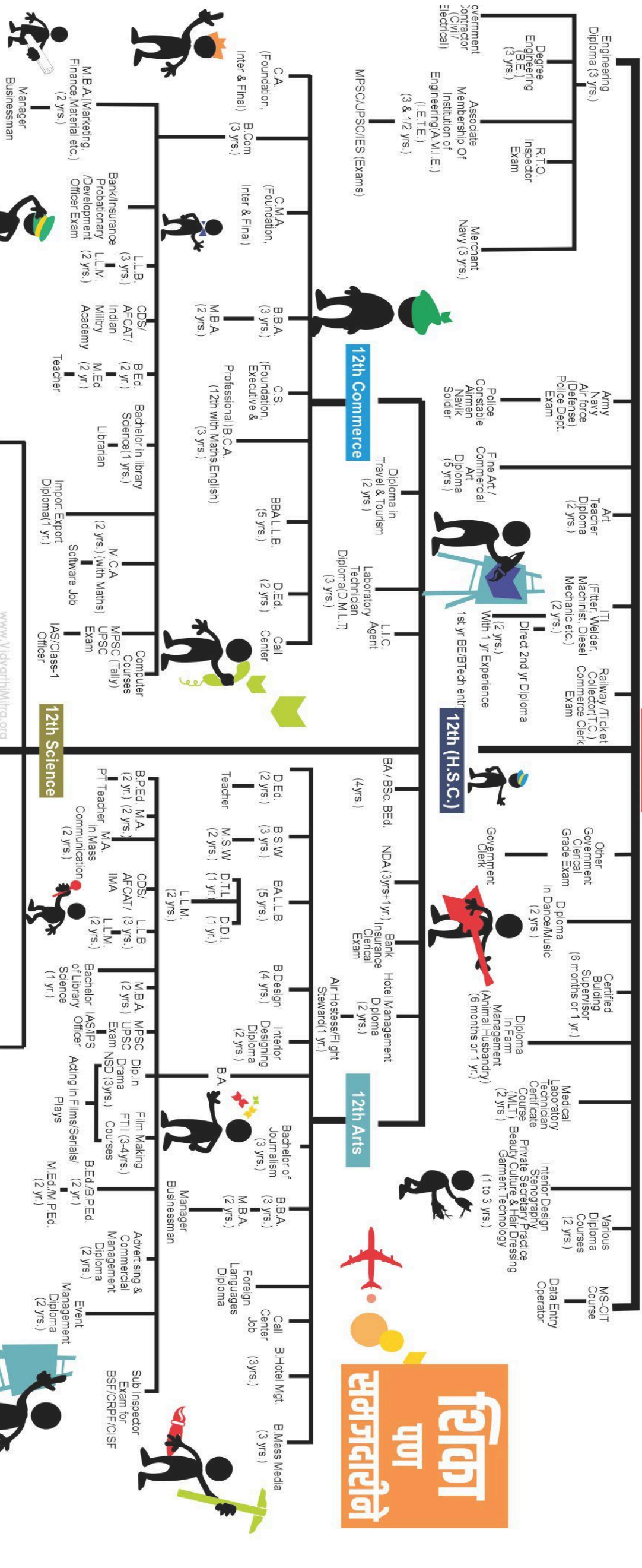
