JEE Main 2026 Session 1: Morning Shift on January 23 Sees Moderate Difficulty, Mathematics Emerges as the Toughest Section

New Delhi, January 23, 2026: The JEE Main 2026 Session 1 examination continued across India on January 23, with the completion of the morning shift (Shift 1). According to feedback from students and experts, the overall difficulty level of the paper ranged from easy to moderate, consistent with the trend observed in the ongoing session. While the exam was well-balanced across subjects, Mathematics emerged as the most challenging and time-consuming section.

Mathematics Analysis:

Students reported that the Mathematics section was moderate to difficult, featuring lengthy and calculation-intensive questions. Key topics included Integral Calculus, Conic Sections, and Algebra, which required careful problem-solving and time management. Many candidates spent 80–90 minutes on this section alone, reflecting the high level of conceptual application required rather than simple formula recall.

Physics and Chemistry Analysis:

The Physics section was rated moderate, primarily formula-based, with higher weightage given to Magnetism. Additional questions appeared from Thermodynamics and Modern Physics, demanding analytical thinking and conceptual clarity. Chemistry, on the other hand, was considered the most scoring section, largely NCERT-based, and comprised statement-type questions and simple numericals, especially in Organic and Physical Chemistry. This allowed students to secure maximum marks if they had thoroughly revised the NCERT syllabus.

Expert Observations:

Experts noted that the exam emphasized conceptual understanding over rote memorization, favouring candidates with strong fundamentals. The distribution of questions aligned closely with the official syllabus, and no major out-of-syllabus surprises were reported. Coaching institutes anticipate that, based on the difficulty level, the cut-off percentile for this shift may remain similar to, or slightly higher than, the previous session. Students who managed time efficiently in Mathematics and maximized scores in Chemistry are expected to achieve higher overall percentiles.

Advice for Upcoming Shifts:

Candidates are now advised to analyze their performance, identify weak areas, and plan strategically for the remaining shifts. With several sessions still pending, experts recommend focusing on high-weightage topics, revising core concepts, and practicing mock tests to improve speed, accuracy, and time management.

Overall, the morning shift of JEE Main 2026 on January 23 maintained the trend of a balanced and fair examination, testing not just knowledge, but also problem-solving ability and conceptual clarity, setting the stage for students to perform optimally in the upcoming shifts.

JEE Mains 2026 Expected Cutoff and Results Update

The National Testing Agency (NTA) is currently conducting the JEE Main 2026 Session 1 examinations from January 21 to 29, 2026. Based on initial student feedback and previous year trends, coaching institutes have released tentative cutoff percentiles for qualifying JEE Advanced 2026.

As per early estimates, the expected qualifying cutoff for the General category may range between 93.3 and 95 percentile, slightly higher than last year's 93.10. For Gen-EWS, the cutoff is likely to be around 80.5–82.5 percentile, while OBC-NCL candidates may need 79.5–81.5 percentile. The expected cutoffs for SC and ST categories are 61–63 percentile and 47.5–50 percentile, respectively.

Experts report that Mathematics continues to be the toughest section, acting as the main rank-deciding subject, while Physics and Chemistry remain easy to moderate and largely NCERT-based. With nearly 15 lakh candidates appearing this year, competition is expected to remain intense.

The provisional answer key is expected in the first week of February, while the Session 1 results will be declared by February 12, 2026. The official qualifying cutoff will be announced by NTA after the completion of Session 2 in April 2026.

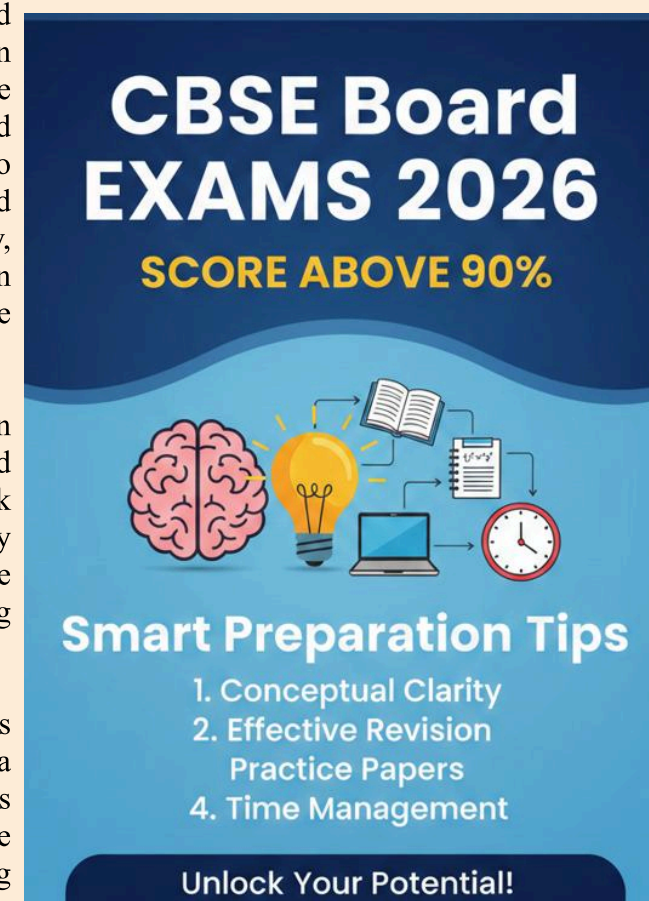

CBSE Revises Affiliation Norms to Strengthen Student Counselling and Well-Being

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has updated its affiliation norms to further strengthen students' mental health, socio-emotional development, and career guidance in schools. The revised norms were approved during the CBSE meeting held on November 26, 2025.

Under the existing regulations, as per Clause 2.4.12, every CBSE-affiliated Secondary and Senior Secondary school is required to appoint a Counselling and Wellness Teacher on a full-time basis. The eligible qualification for the post includes a Graduate or Postgraduate degree in Psychology, a Postgraduate degree in Child Development, or a Graduate/Postgraduate degree with a Diploma in Career

Guidance and Counselling. Schools with an enrolment of fewer than 300 students in Classes 9 to 12 are permitted to appoint such professionals on a part-time basis.

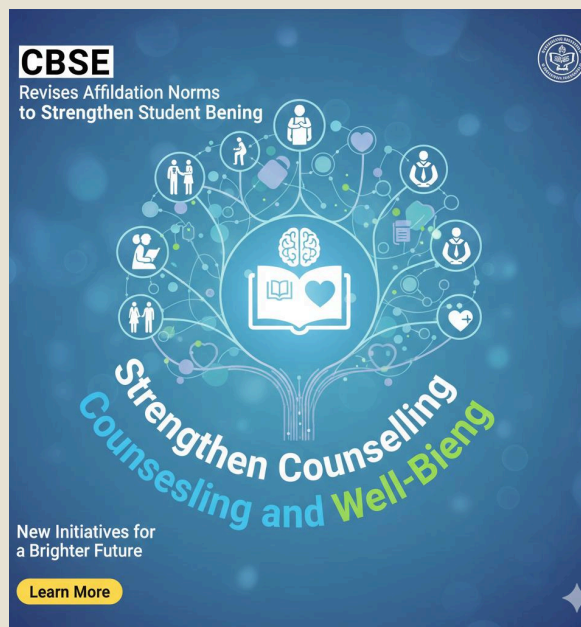
Amended Norms

With the revised guidelines, CBSE has made it mandatory for all affiliated Secondary and Senior Secondary schools to appoint qualified counselling professionals to support students' overall well-being and career planning. As per the amended clause:

- Schools must appoint a Counselling and Wellness Teacher (Socio-Emotional Counsellor) at a ratio of one counsellor for every 500 students enrolled.
- In addition, schools are required to appoint Career Counsellors to guide students in academic choices and career planning.

The updated norms aim to ensure a structured support system for students, promoting mental health awareness, emotional resilience, holistic development, and informed decision-making. CBSE has emphasised that the presence of trained counsellors in schools is essential to address the growing academic pressure and emotional challenges faced by students.

The move is expected to significantly enhance student well-being and create a more supportive and guidance-oriented school environment across CBSE-affiliated institutions.

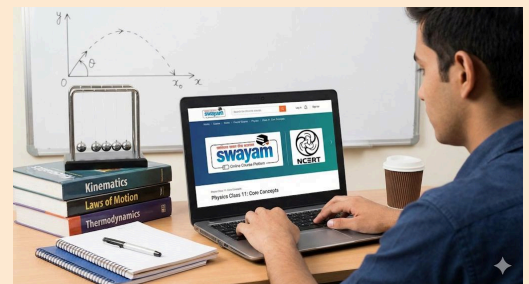

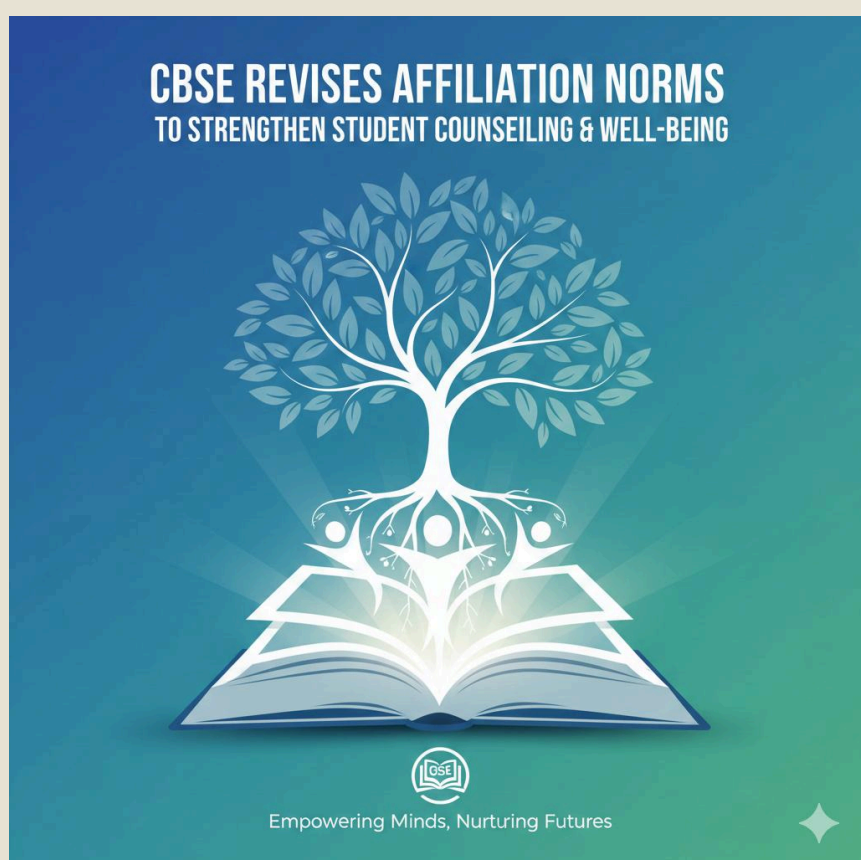

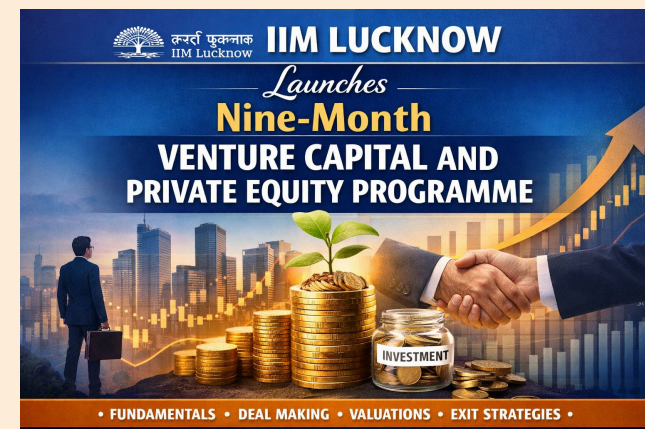

Experts stress that AI-based learning should enhance—not replace—traditional degree programmes. A balanced educational approach is essential to ensure sustainable employability in the long term.

Making AI-Focused Education Effective

For AI-driven education to deliver meaningful outcomes, it must integrate strong subject fundamentals with AI competencies, provide hands-on exposure through internships, and foster close collaboration with industry partners.

AI-focused learning is emerging as a possible bridge between India's growing demand for skilled professionals and the employability of graduates, offering a promising pathway to address the widening skills gap.

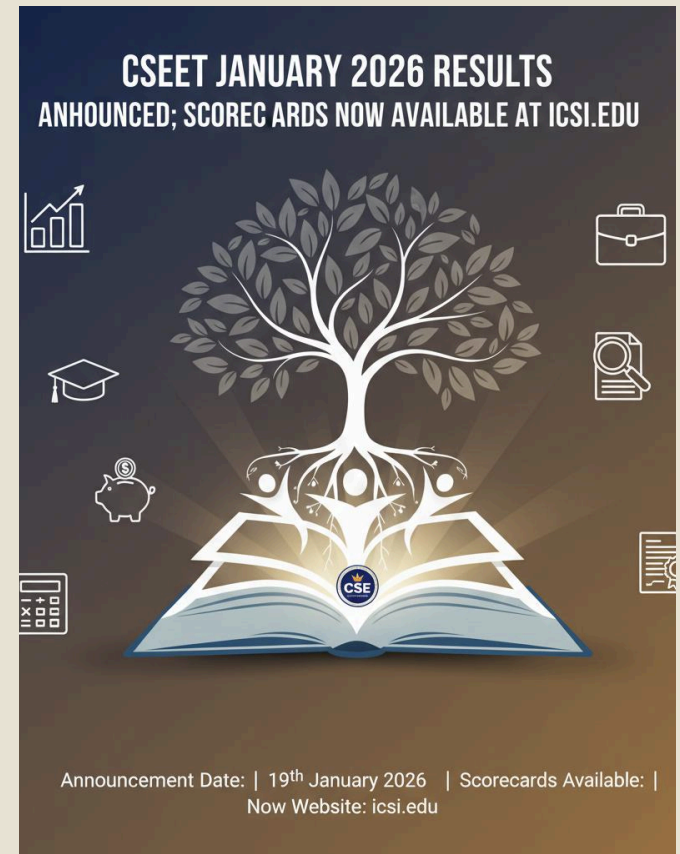

**AIBE Exam To Be Held Twice A Year, Final-Year LLB Students Eligible To Appear**

The All India Bar Examination (AIBE) will now be conducted twice a year, and final-semester LLB students will be allowed to appear for the exam. The decision comes after the Bar Council of India (BCI) informed the Supreme Court about changes made to the examination rules.

A bench comprising Justices Vikram Nath and Sandeep Mehta recorded the development while hearing a writ petition filed in 2024 seeking permission for final-year law students to take the AIBE. Following the submission by the BCI, the court disposed of the plea.

During the hearing, BCI's counsel stated that the AIBE will be held twice annually and final-semester students can appear subject to clearing their final LLB examinations. To implement this, the BCI has framed new regulations titled BCI Rules, 2026.

Earlier, the Supreme Court had passed interim orders in 2024 allowing final-year students to appear in the AIBE. In 2023, the apex court had directed the BCI to frame formal rules on the matter, noting that students should not lose a year of their professional careers due to procedural restrictions.

Background And Supreme Court Observations

The issue gained prominence after several law students approached the Supreme Court in 2023 and 2024, challenging a BCI notification that barred final-year students from appearing in the AIBE. The petitioners argued that the restriction caused an unnecessary delay of one full year in starting their legal careers.

Earlier, in February 2023, the Supreme Court had upheld the constitutional validity of the AIBE and confirmed BCI's authority to conduct the exam. The court had also accepted the recommendation of an amicus curiae to allow final-semester students to appear upon producing proof of eligibility.

Why This Change Is Important

The move to conduct the AIBE twice a year is expected to:

- Reduce waiting time for law graduates to begin practice
- Provide greater flexibility and opportunities for candidates
- Align the Indian legal system with international professional standards
- Address long-standing concerns raised by law students and institutions

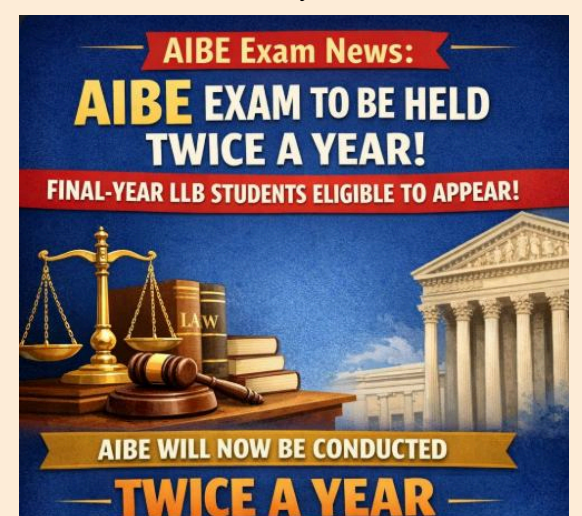
Legal education experts believe the reform will streamline the transition from academic study to professional practice and help address delays in enrolment across State Bar Councils.

The court had also upheld BCI's authority to conduct the AIBE and accepted recommendations allowing final-semester students to appear upon submitting valid proof of eligibility.

Clearing the AIBE is mandatory for law graduates to enrol as advocates with their respective State Bar Councils.

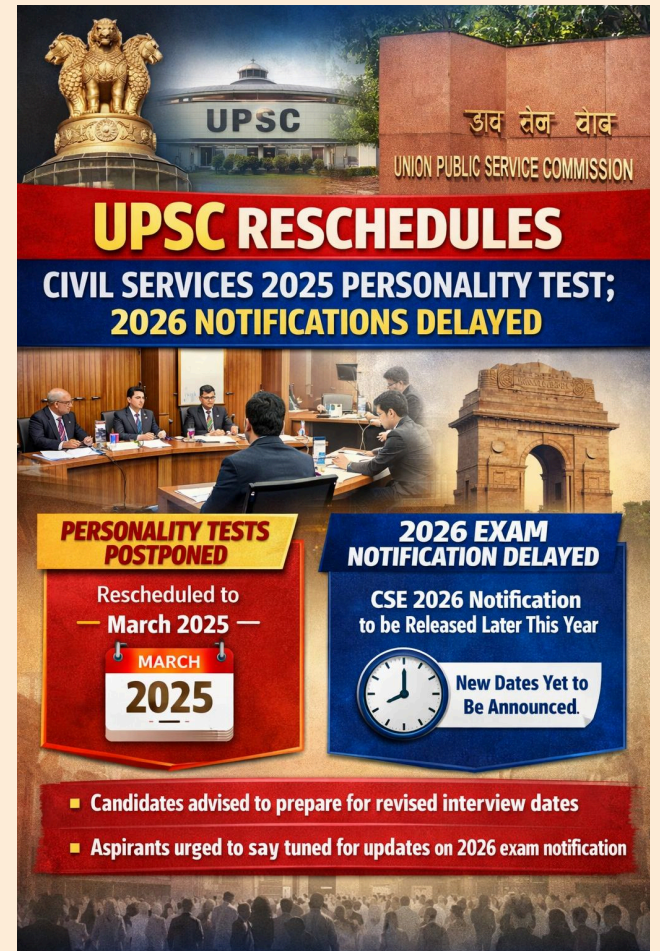

In a major policy update on January 15, 2026, Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) announced a freeze on the list of eligible academic programs, ensuring stability and predictability for students throughout the year. Graduates of bachelor's, master's, and doctoral programs remain eligible for a work permit of up to three years, regardless of their field of study. The PGWP also acts as a vital bridge toward Permanent Residency, as it allows international graduates to gain valuable Canadian work experience required under most PR pathways.

Canada's research-intensive universities continue to attract global attention, particularly the elite U15 institutions. Universities such as the University of Toronto, McGill University, the University of British Columbia, and the University of Waterloo are known for their excellence in areas like artificial intelligence, medicine, sustainability, business, and technology. These institutions offer strong industry connections, high research funding, and globally recognized degrees, making them highly desirable for international students seeking both academic and professional growth.

Strengthening bilateral relations between India and Canada have further boosted educational cooperation. The year 2025 marked a diplomatic reset between the two nations, with education emerging as a key area of collaboration. During the G7 Summit in June 2025, Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit led to the announcement of a New Roadmap for Canada-India Relations. As part of this initiative, a major academic delegation consisting of 21 Canadian university presidents is scheduled to visit India from February 2 to 6, 2026, with planned engagements in New Delhi, Goa, and GIFT City to promote research partnerships and student exchange programs.

Recent policy reforms introduced in 2026 have also improved the overall student experience in Canada. 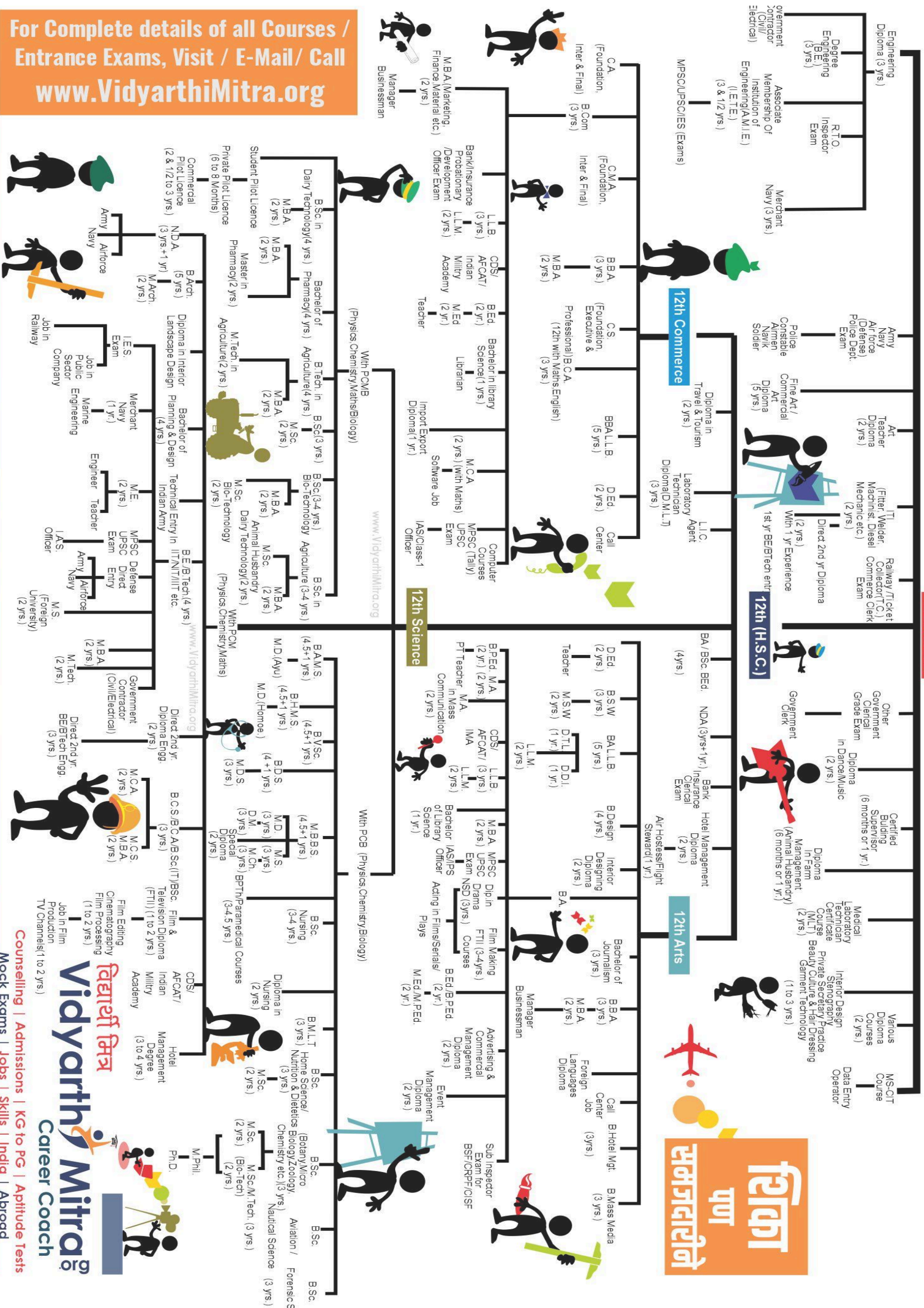
