## Maharashtra Government Reaffirms Marathi as a Mandatory School Subject

The Maharashtra government has re-emphasised that the subject Marathi must be taught in every school across the state — regardless of the educational board or medium of instruction. This enforcement applies to all schools including those affiliated with state, national, and international boards such as the Maharashtra State Board, CBSE, ICSE, IB, and others.

### Background and Legal Mandate

The requirement to include Marathi as a compulsory language subject originated from a government resolution issued on 9 March 2020 by the Maharashtra School Education Department. According to this resolution, Marathi must be taught and studied in all schools, irrespective of whether the school is government-managed or privately operated.

This mandate was intended to ensure that students across the state learn Marathi, the official language of Maharashtra, as part of their core education — preserving cultural heritage and linguistic identity.

### Recent Reinforcement and Compliance Check

In late January 2026, the Education Department requested a compliance report from the Education Commissioner to review whether all schools in the state are following this requirement. The action underscores concerns that some schools — particularly private ones or those following non-state boards — may not be fully implementing the Marathi language mandate.

The department had also sent reminder letters to regional education officials in September 2024 to ensure that the mandate is properly followed.

### Reasons for Reaffirmation

The recent reaffirmation came after political and public debate, including complaints from political figures about some schools allegedly not teaching Marathi, which led the government to clarify and reinforce its policy. This reaffirmation aimed to dispel confusion and reiterate that Marathi instruction is compulsory for every student enrolled in schools in Maharashtra.

### Scope of the Policy

- Applicable to all boards: The mandate covers state and national boards such as Maharashtra State Board, CBSE, ICSE, IB, and others.
- All management types: Both government and private schools must comply.
- Mandatory instruction and evaluation: From the academic year 2025-26, Marathi is expected to be taught rigorously with marks-based evaluation and not just as an optional or graded subject.

Marathi is the official language of Maharashtra and a major medium of cultural and educational expression in the state. Mandating its instruction across all schools reflects the government's effort to preserve linguistic heritage, strengthen cultural identity among youth, and maintain Marathi's relevance in an era of diverse educational boards and languages.

## Economic Survey Warns of Learning Gaps, Pushes Quality Education and Global Integration

The Economic Survey, tabled in Parliament on Thursday, highlights a key challenge confronting India's education system—retaining students beyond Class 8 and translating near-universal school enrolment into meaningful learning outcomes.

While India has built one of the world's largest school networks, with strong enrolment at the foundational level, the survey cautions that learning outcomes decline and student participation drops sharply at the secondary stage. Alongside this, it points to a renewed push to internationalise higher education, with policy reforms aimed at retaining domestic talent and positioning India as a global destination for foreign students.

Presented ahead of the Union Budget, the survey describes education as a cornerstone of human capital and a critical driver of the Viksit Bharat vision for 2047. Although it acknowledges notable progress in access, infrastructure and institutional capacity, it warns that persistently weak learning levels—particularly beyond early schooling—could pose a serious risk to India's long-term growth prospects.

### Schooling Scale but Learning Lags Behind

India runs one of the world's largest school systems, with near-universal enrolment at the primary and upper-primary levels. However, the Economic Survey flags a growing gap between enrolment and learning outcomes, with weak foundational literacy and numeracy and low early childhood participation affecting student readiness. It also highlights sharp dropouts at the secondary stage, driven by poor learning foundations, economic constraints and limited incentives to continue schooling.

### Model Schools and Tracking Students

To address quality deficits, the survey highlights PM-SHRI schools as model institutions aimed at demonstrating best practices in infrastructure, pedagogy and experiential learning. These schools are intended to serve as benchmarks for improving learning outcomes across the public education system.

The rollout of APAAR IDs has also been flagged as a structural reform. By creating a permanent academic identity for students, the system allows seamless tracking of learning journeys across school, higher education and skilling pathways, reducing friction in transitions and enabling better policy targeting.

### Higher Education Expansion and the Quality Question

India's higher education sector has grown rapidly, with over 70,000 institutions and enrolment crossing 4.4 crore, supported by NEP reforms. While expansion of IITs, IIMs and global campuses reflects rising academic reach, the Economic Survey cautions that growth without quality improvements could hurt employability and research outcomes.

### Globalising Indian Higher Education

The Economic Survey underscores a strong push to globalise Indian higher education to curb talent outflows and attract international students. Noting the rising number of Indians studying abroad and the resulting remittance drain, it highlights policy measures encouraging twinning, joint and dual degree programmes with foreign universities. Around 15 overseas institutions are expected to set up campuses in India under the eased regulatory framework. The survey also points to the potential of higher education tourism, with courses in yoga, Ayurveda, Indian languages, philosophy and culture positioned to draw students from BRICS and Global South nations.

### Vocational Education and Industry Linkages

The survey flags persistent gaps between education and employability, noting that vocational education and skilling pathways remain underdeveloped. It calls for structured skilling pathways at the secondary school level to provide early exposure to employable competencies.

Greater emphasis has been placed on apprenticeships, industry-linked learning and work-integrated education models to bridge the disconnect between classrooms and workplaces. These measures, the survey suggests, are essential to preparing students for a rapidly changing labour market.

### Shift from Access to Outcomes

Across school and higher education, the Economic Survey marks a clear shift in policy emphasis from access to outcomes. While enrollment gains are significant, the next phase of reform will hinge on improving learning quality, relevance and global integration.

The survey concludes that achieving the vision of Viksit Bharat by 2047 will depend not just on educating more Indians, but on ensuring that education equips learners with strong foundations, relevant skills and global capabilities.

## Union Budget 2026 Records Highest-Ever Education Allocation After 8.2% Increase

### Higher Education Gets a Noticeable Boost

Higher education has received the strongest push in this year's Budget, with funding for universities, technical institutions and research programmes rising by about 11 per cent. The government has proposed five university townships along key industrial and logistics corridors, bringing together academics, research, housing and industry collaboration.

The Budget also announces a new National Institute of Design in eastern India and plans to set up a girls' hostel in every district to boost female participation. In addition, measures have been indicated to reduce the financial burden on students studying abroad, including changes to tax collection at source on overseas remittances.



### What's New??

New initiatives in this year's Budget focus on widening access and inclusion, including expanded hostel facilities and policy changes to ease the financial burden on students studying abroad. To support the creative economy, content creation labs for animation, visual effects, gaming and comics (AVGC) will be set up in 15,000 schools and 500 colleges. Digital infrastructure also remains a priority, with enhanced broadband connectivity and greater support for technology-enabled learning, alongside a stronger emphasis on skilling, innovation and research.

### Greater Emphasis on Skilling, Innovation, and Research

Compared to last year, Budget 2026 places stronger emphasis on skilling and future-ready education. Focus areas include vocational training, digital learning infrastructure, STEM facilities, and teacher capacity building.

A Centre of Excellence in Artificial Intelligence in Education will be established to support AI-driven learning tools, adaptive platforms, and virtual labs across schools and higher education institutes.

### What's Still Missing?

Despite the positive measures, several expectations remain unmet. Education spending as a share of GDP has not seen a structural increase, and there is limited direct focus on strengthening foundational learning, teacher recruitment, and rural education infrastructure—areas widely regarded as critical for long-term improvement.

While the Budget marks progress in terms of funding, it stops short of delivering a fundamental shift in policy direction.

## Delhi to Roll Out Private School Fee Regulation Law Starting 2026–27

The Delhi government has informed the Supreme Court that the Private School Fee Regulation Act will be implemented from the 2026–27 academic session, after the court flagged concerns over enforcing the law during an ongoing academic year. The legislation will mandate prior government approval for any fee increase by all 1,700 private unaided schools in Delhi, significantly expanding the regulatory framework beyond the nearly 300 schools earlier covered under the Delhi School Education Act, 1973.

With the government agreeing to defer implementation, the Supreme Court has disposed of the matter, noting that its objection was limited to the timing of enforcement. However, challenges to the Act filed by private school associations will continue before the Delhi High Court.

The new law seeks to curb arbitrary and steep fee hikes by introducing a structured, multi-level approval process involving school-level, district-level and appellate committees, with penalties for unauthorised increases. The move is expected to strengthen transparency and provide parents greater oversight in private school fee fixation.

The Act also prescribes strict penalties for violations, including fines ranging from ₹1 lakh to ₹5 lakh for first-time unauthorised fee hikes, with higher penalties for repeat offences. Schools failing to refund excess fees within stipulated timelines could face escalating fines and restrictions on proposing future fee increases. The Delhi government has said the framework is intended to balance the financial autonomy of private schools with the need to protect parents from unjustified fee hikes and ensure greater accountability in school administration.







## IP University Introduces CUET as Alternative Pathway for BTech Admissions

Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU) has announced that it will adopt the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) as a secondary admission channel for its BTech programmes starting from the upcoming academic year. The decision was confirmed through an official notification issued by the university.



As per the announcement, admissions to BTech courses will continue to be primarily based on JEE Main Paper 1 scores. However, once the JEE Main merit list is exhausted, the remaining vacant seats will be filled through CUET scores. University authorities have advised aspirants to appear for the CUET examination to improve their chances of securing admission.

In its notification, IP University stated that the approval for adopting CUET as a secondary mode of admission was granted by the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of NCT of Delhi, following consent from the Lieutenant Governor of Delhi. The decision will apply to the BTech programme (Programme Code 131) from the 2025–26 academic year onwards.

The university further reiterated that students seeking admission to BTech programmes at GGSIPU must apply for and appear in the CUET examination in addition to JEE Main. Admissions to leftover seats after exhausting JEE Main ranks will be offered strictly on the basis of CUET merit and scores. For the academic session 2026–27, GGSIPU has already opened its admission process and announced the introduction of 24 new academic programmes across undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral levels. The application process for these programmes is set to begin on February 2, 2026.

The newly introduced courses focus on emerging and industry-oriented disciplines, including artificial intelligence, robotics, data science, law, healthcare, design and special education. In addition to academic expansion, the university has added nine new affiliated colleges and announced plans to establish an offshore campus in Guyana, marking a significant step in its global outreach strategy.

University officials stated that these initiatives aim to enhance accessibility, diversify academic offerings and align higher education with evolving industry and global standards..

## IIT-Ropar Collaborates With Army for Advanced Defence Technology Education

New Delhi: The Indian Institute of Technology Ropar (IIT-Ropar) has joined hands with the Indian Army to launch a specialised MTech programme in Defence Technology designed for officers of the Armoured Corps Centre & School (ACC&S).

Under this collaboration, the two institutions have signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) to jointly develop and deliver the curriculum, which emphasises applied learning, hands-on research and innovation-driven problem-solving tailored to military needs.

The programme aims to equip officers with advanced technical knowledge to lead technology modernisation projects in armoured formations and contribute to indigenous defence innovation and manufacturing. Graduates will receive an MTech (Defence Technology) degree from IIT-Ropar on successful completion.

IIT-Ropar's Director highlighted that the partnership marks a new model of defence education by combining academic rigour with military operational expertise, helping create future leaders in defence technology and supporting India's strategic goal of technological self-reliance.

## FMGE December 2025 Result Announced, Check Qualifying Status Online

The National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS) has announced the results of the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE) December 2025 session. Of the 43,933 candidates who appeared for the screening test, 10,264 candidates have successfully qualified.

Candidates who took the examination on January 17, 2026, can check their qualifying status by visiting the official website at [natboard.edu.in](http://natboard.edu.in). According to the official notification, individual scorecards will be available for download on the NBEMS website on or after February 6, 2026.

NBEMS stated that all questions in the FMGE December 2025 paper were reviewed post-examination by subject experts to ensure technical accuracy. During this review, one question was found to be technically incorrect, and full marks for that question were awarded to all candidates. Additionally, one question contained two correct answers, and candidates selecting either option were granted marks.

The board clarified that scorecards will remain available for download for only six months from the date of issuance. After this period, scorecards will no longer be hosted on the website, and requests for re-issuance will not be entertained. Candidates have been advised to retain their scorecards for future reference.

NBEMS further informed that FMGE Pass Certificates will be issued only through in-person verification of identity and credentials. Details regarding the verification schedule and distribution of pass certificates will be announced separately on the NBEMS website. The declared result remains subject to successful in-person verification.

It was also clarified that the FMGE scorecard issued by NBEMS cannot be used for registration with any State Medical Council (SMC) in place of the FMGE Pass Certificate. NBEMS will directly provide digitally signed results in MS Excel format to all State Medical Councils for verification purposes. The PDF result uploaded on the website is intended solely for candidate information.

NBEMS reiterated that candidature remains provisional and subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as outlined in the FMGE December 2025 Information Bulletin. If any ineligibility is detected at any stage, the candidature will be cancelled, even after declaration of results or issuance of pass certificates. Any use of unfair means will be dealt with strictly in accordance with NBEMS guidelines and applicable legal provisions. The results of four candidates have been withheld, and the reasons for withholding have been communicated individually via email.

## IISc Bengaluru Allows BTech Admission Through JoSAA Counselling 2026

The Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru, one of India's premier institutions with strong global standing, will begin admitting BTech students through JoSAA counselling from 2026. Admissions will be based on JEE Advanced ranks, marking a shift from the institute's earlier independent admission process.

JEE Advanced 2026, to be conducted by IIT Roorkee on May 17, will consist of two papers. Paper 1 will be held from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, followed by Paper 2 from 2:30 PM to 5:30 PM.

In 2025, as many as 2,50,236 candidates qualified for JEE Advanced. JoSAA counselling serves as the centralized online seat allocation platform for 127 top engineering institutes, including 23 IITs, 31 NITs, IIST Shibpur, 26 IIITs, and 47+ Government Funded Technical Institutes (GFTIs).

IISc Bengaluru continues to receive international recognition. In the Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject 2026, the institute ranked 96th globally in Computer Science. Domestically, IISc has consistently performed well in the NIRF rankings, holding the second position overall since 2019, and securing the top spot from 2016 to 2018.

Until 2025, IISc managed BTech admissions independently using JEE Advanced scores, requiring candidates to confirm admission in person. From 2026 onwards, the entire BTech admission process will be conducted online through JoSAA, with counselling scheduled to begin on June 2.

## BITS Pilani Exits THE Rankings Amid Questions Over Assessment Criteria

BITS Pilani has become the latest institution to opt out of the Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings. The institute announced that it will no longer submit any data to THE for evaluation purposes.

Several premier Indian institutions, including IIT Delhi, IIT Bombay, IIT Madras, IIT Kanpur, IIT Kharagpur, IIT Roorkee and IIT Guwahati, have previously withdrawn from THE rankings, citing concerns over transparency in the ranking methodology.

Joining this list, BITS Pilani issued a statement confirming its decision to discontinue sharing institutional and subject-level data with THE. The institute stated that it is committed to transparency, methodological rigor, and verifiable benchmarking in higher education assessments. Consequently, BITS Pilani will not appear in upcoming editions of the Times Higher Education rankings, including the World University Rankings, Asia University Rankings, and Subject Rankings.

The institute added that it remains open to participating in THE rankings in the future, provided improvements are made in transparency, consistency, and verifiability of the evaluation process.

BITS Pilani also noted that global rankings can serve as a useful benchmarking tool when based on credible, transparent, and verifiable evaluation standards.

The decision by BITS Pilani reflects a growing sentiment among leading Indian institutions questioning the credibility and accountability of international ranking frameworks. Academic leaders have increasingly stressed the need for ranking systems to align more closely with ground realities, institutional diversity and measurable academic outcomes.

Experts believe that such withdrawals could prompt global ranking agencies to revisit their methodologies and improve engagement with participating institutions. Meanwhile, BITS Pilani reiterated that its primary focus remains on academic excellence, research impact, innovation and student outcomes rather than ranking positions alone.

The move is also seen as part of a broader push by Indian institutions to develop more transparent and context-sensitive evaluation mechanisms that accurately reflect the strengths of higher education institutions in the country.

The National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS), along with the release of the seat matrix, has also announced the tentative examination schedule for NEET PG and NEET MDS 2026. As per the calendar, NEET MDS 2026 is scheduled to be conducted on May 2, 2026 (Saturday), and candidates appearing for the exam must complete their compulsory internship by May 31, 2026 to be eligible.

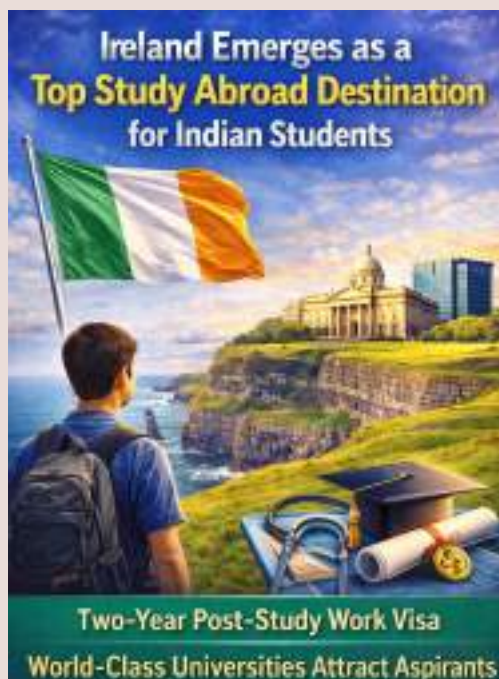

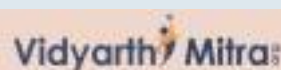

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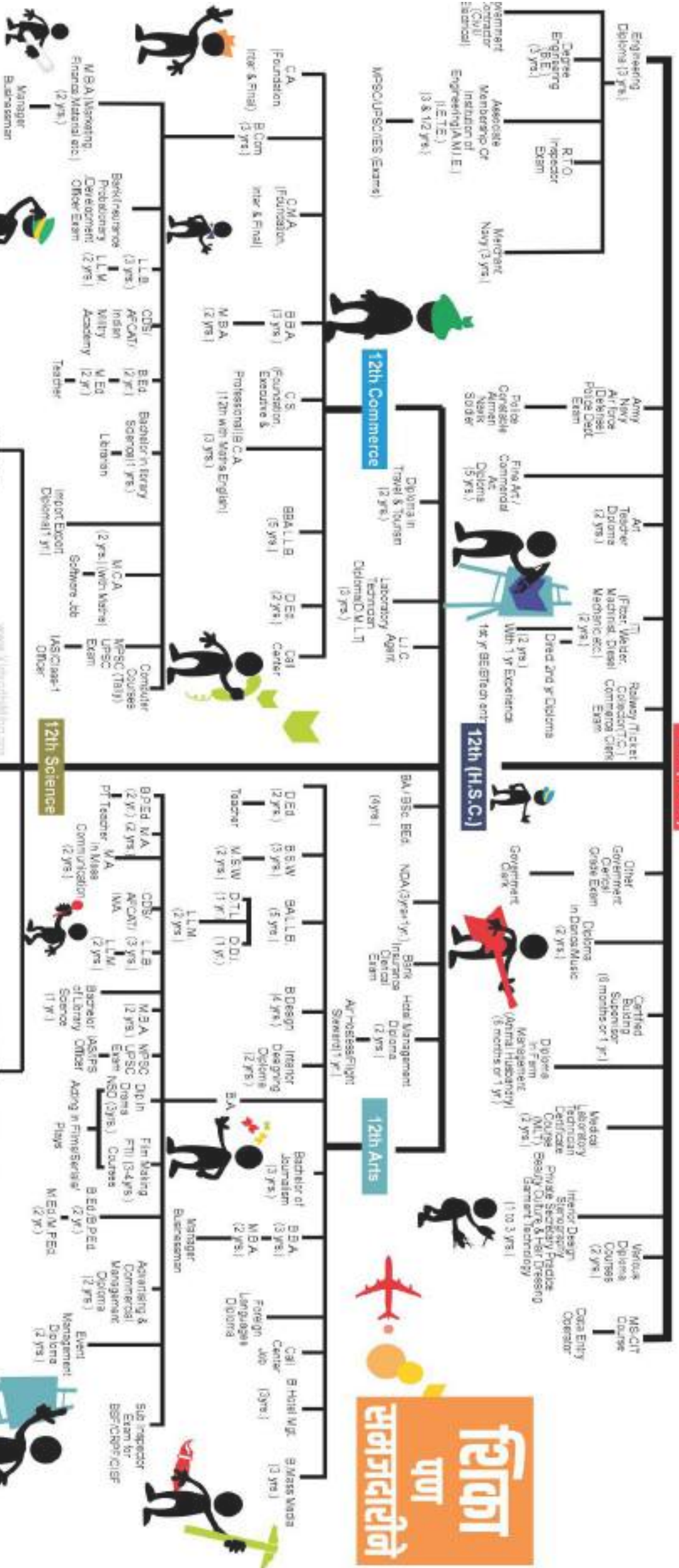


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
