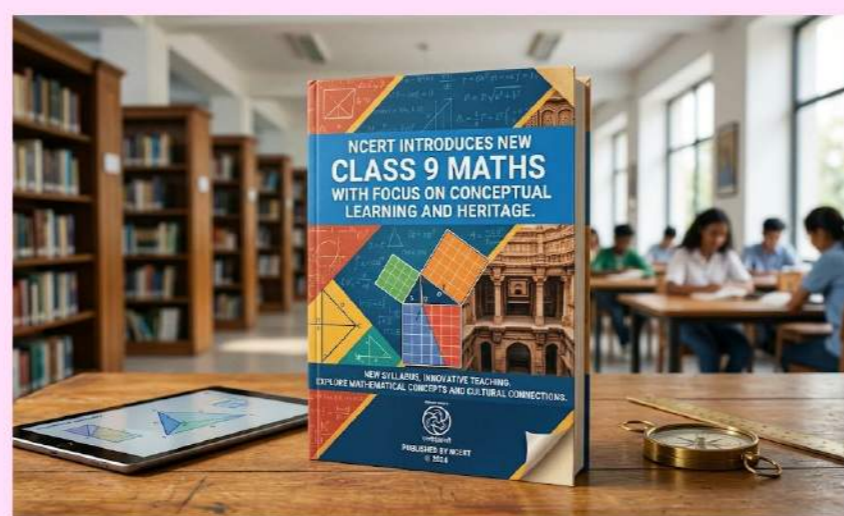

## CISCE Expected to Announce ICSE & ISC 2026 Results by Early May: Trends and Updates

## UGC Opens Portals for ODL and Online Program Applications for 2026-27 Session

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has officially set the wheels in motion for the next academic cycle by inviting fresh applications from Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) nationwide. The notification, released today, calls for institutions to seek recognition for offering Open and Distance Learning (ODL) and Online Programs for the 2026-27 academic session, starting August 2026.

This move is part of the Commission's ongoing mission to democratize higher education and reach the ambitious Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) targets set by the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

### Key Deadlines and Portal Details

The UGC has clarified that the entire application process will be hosted on a dedicated online portal to ensure transparency and speed. HEIs are required to submit their proposals within the following strict timeframe:

- Online Portal Activation: April 27, 2026
- Final Date for Online Submission: May 11, 2026 (Midnight)
- Deadline for Submission of Hard Copies: May 20, 2026

Institutions failing to meet the digital deadline will be barred from submitting physical documents. The UGC has emphasized that no extensions will be granted, as the review process must be completed before the August 2026 intake begins.

### Eligibility and Compliance Framework

Under the UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, institutions must meet specific quality benchmarks to qualify for recognition.

### Core Requirements for HEIs:

1. Accreditation Standards: Only institutions with a valid NAAC score of 3.26 or above (on a 4-point scale) or those ranked in the Top 100 of the NIRF (National Institutional Ranking Framework) for at least two of the last three years are eligible for automated or "category-1" status.

2. Course Mapping: HEIs must demonstrate that the proposed ODL or Online courses are already being offered in "conventional mode" (offline) and have seen at least one batch graduate.
3. Prohibited Programs: The UGC reiterated that professional programs in fields such as Medicine, Engineering, Law, and Architecture remain strictly prohibited under the ODL and Online modes.

### Impact on the Student Ecosystem

The expansion of recognized ODL programs is expected to benefit millions of working professionals and students in rural areas. By allowing prestigious universities to scale their digital offerings, the UGC aims to bridge the gap between high-demand degree programs and physical seat limitations in traditional classrooms.

"This is not just about adding more seats," a senior UGC official stated. "It is about ensuring that a student in a remote village receives the same quality of digital courseware as someone sitting in a metro city."

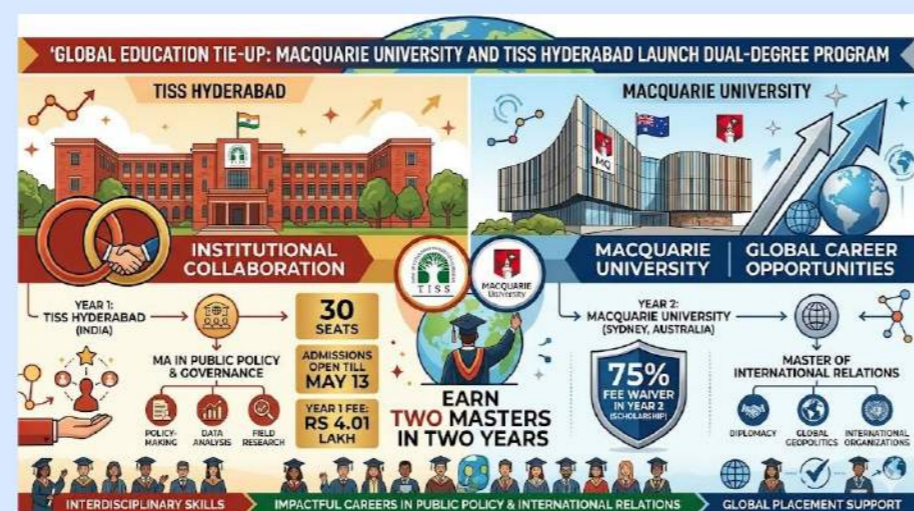

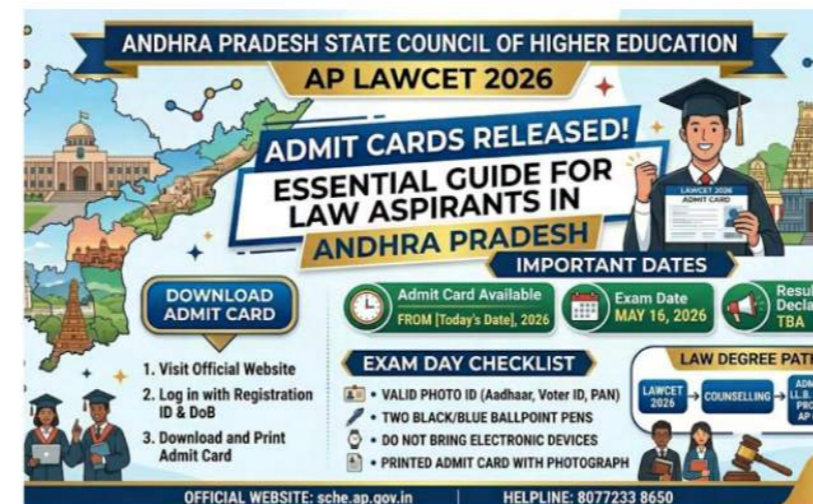

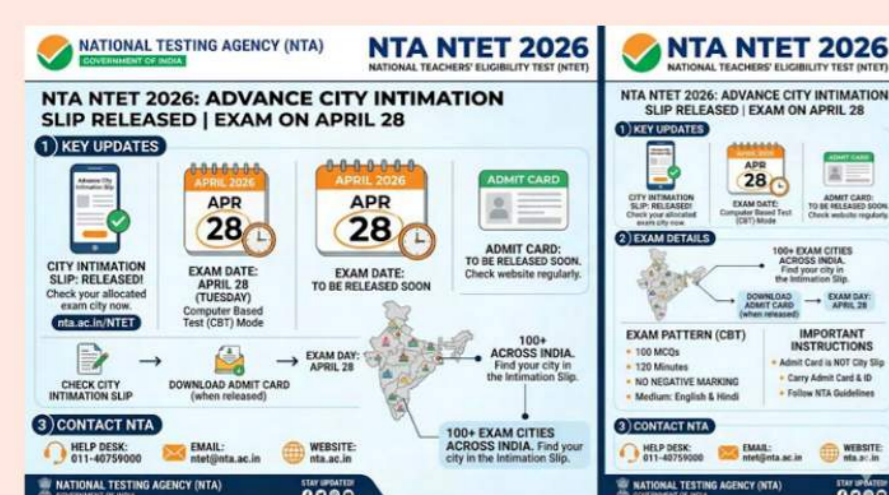

# 11 SCHOLARSHIPS

## Govt Opens 125 Fully Funded Overseas Scholarships for SC and Marginalized Students

The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment in India has officially invited applications for the National Overseas Scholarship (NOS) for the 2026-27 academic year. This prestigious initiative is designed to provide financial empowerment to students from marginalized communities, enabling them to pursue Master's degrees or Ph.D. programs at top-tier international universities.

For this selection cycle, a total of 125 scholarship slots have been authorized. These are distributed among specific categories to ensure targeted support: 115 seats are reserved for students from Scheduled Castes (SC), six for Denotified, Nomadic, and Semi-Nomadic Tribes, and four for landless agricultural laborers and traditional artisans. Notably, the government has mandated a 30% reservation for women applicants across these categories to promote gender equity in higher education.

### Financial Support and Coverage

The scholarship is "fully funded," meaning it covers nearly every expense associated with studying abroad. Selected scholars receive:

- Full tuition fee reimbursement.
- A maintenance allowance for living expenses.
- Coverage for visa fees and mandatory medical insurance.
- Airfare for travel to and from the host country.
- Incidental journey allowances and equipment grants.

The funds are managed and disbursed through Indian diplomatic missions located in the respective foreign countries.

### Eligibility and Selection Criteria

To be eligible, candidates must be under 35 years of age as of April 1 of the selection year. Academic excellence is a prerequisite, with a minimum requirement of 60% marks (or an equivalent grade) in the qualifying degree—a

Bachelor's degree for Master's applicants and a Master's degree for Ph.D. seekers. Additionally, the annual family income of the applicant must not exceed ₹8 lakh.

The selection process is rigorous and merit-based. A critical requirement is that the applicant must have secured an unconditional offer of admission from a foreign university ranked within the top 500 of the QS World University Rankings. Preference is given to those admitted to higher-ranked institutions. If two candidates are tied based on university ranking, their marks in the qualifying Indian examination serve as the tie-breaker.

### Terms and Conditions

The scholarship supports Master's programs for up to three years and Ph.D. research for up to four years. It is important to note that undergraduate courses are not covered under this scheme. Furthermore, the program carries a "return to India" clause, requiring recipients to return to their home country after completing their studies to contribute their global expertise locally. Applicants must submit their documentation—including caste certificates, income proof, and admission offers—electronically through the official portal. This initiative serves as a vital bridge for talented students who possess the academic drive but lack the financial means to compete on a global stage.



## Delhi Government Opens Scholarship Applications for SC, ST, and OBC Students for the 2025-26 Session

In a comprehensive effort to bridge the educational divide and foster academic excellence among marginalized communities, the Delhi government has officially launched the application process for its suite of scholarship schemes for the 2025-26 academic year. The announcement, released via an official notice on Monday, invites students belonging to the Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), and Other Backward Classes (OBC) categories to apply for financial assistance across various levels of study.

The government has streamlined the process by hosting several state-funded and centrally sponsored programs under a single umbrella. Students currently enrolled in recognized schools, colleges, and universities within the National Capital Territory of Delhi are eligible to participate. Furthermore, the government has tied these benefits to academic discipline, requiring students to maintain consistent attendance and satisfactory performance in their examinations.

Additionally, the 'Mukhyamantri Vidyarthi Pratibha Yojana' continues to provide direct cash incentives to high-performing students in the secondary and senior secondary stages. Under this plan, students in Classes 9 and 10 receive an annual grant of ₹5,000, while those in Classes 11 and 12 are awarded ₹10,000. These funds are intended to cover supplementary educational costs, such as books and specialized coaching.

### Higher Education, Merit, and Global Opportunities

For those pursuing higher education, the government has announced a merit-based scholarship for students in professional and technical courses. Depending on the course level and whether the student is a day scholar or a hosteller, the financial aid ranges from ₹8,000 to ₹24,000 per annum. Eligibility for this particular grant requires the student to have secured at least 60% marks in the preceding academic year.

In a push for global exposure, the department is also providing specialized financial backing for SC students pursuing Master's and Ph.D. degrees at international universities. This prestigious overseas scholarship offers up to ₹5 lakh per year, with a total cap of ₹10 lakh for Master's candidates and ₹20 lakh for doctoral scholars.

To conclude the incentive structure, the Dr. B.R. Ambedkar State Topper Award will grant ₹25,000 to the top-performing students in every discipline across Delhi's universities, celebrating the intellectual achievements of students from disadvantaged backgrounds. These initiatives collectively aim to ensure that financial constraints never stand in the way of a student's aspirations, whether they are studying in a local classroom or a global laboratory.

## Uttar Pradesh Government Announces Comprehensive Scholarship Schemes for UP Board Students Following 2026 Results

With the Uttar Pradesh Madhyamik Shiksha Parishad (UPMSP) officially declaring the 2026 board results for Class 10 and Class 12, millions of students are now at a pivotal stage of their academic journey. ## Kerala Sets Global Benchmark with Free Undergraduate Education for 2026-27

### The "Global School" and Vocational Shift

Complementing the free degree initiative, the Kerala Education Department has launched the "Global School" project. Under this scheme, select government schools are being upgraded with international-standard laboratories and digital hubs. The curriculum for the 2026-27 session has been revised to include:

- Future Tech Integration: Mandatory modules on Artificial Intelligence, Data Analytics, and Cyber Security at the undergraduate level.
- Vocational Excellence: A shift toward "applied learning" where degree students spend 20% of their credit hours in industry-linked internships.

### Impact on Admissions and Enrollment

With the admission season for 2026 beginning in May, the Directorate of Collegiate Education expects a 15-20% surge in applications for state-run institutions. To accommodate this, the government has sanctioned the commencement of additional batches in high-demand streams such as Computer Science, Psychology, and Applied Economics.

These reforms are expected to significantly enhance the state's Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) and the employability of its graduates in the emerging technology sector.

## Tamil Nadu: New Environmental Diploma and "Industry Partner" Guidelines for 2026

Tamil Nadu is significantly modernizing its higher education landscape for the 2026–27 academic session, prioritizing environmental sustainability and industry-aligned skill development. The state's recent initiatives, led by premier institutions and the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation (TNSDC), aim to bridge the gap between traditional academics and the demands of the modern global workforce.

### 1. University of Madras: Launch of New Environmental Diploma

The Department of Geology at the University of Madras officially introduced a specialized one-year program on April 22, 2026: the Diploma in Geoscientific Methods for Sustainable Resource Planning and Management. Offered under the "Self-Supportive Mode," this course is a direct response to the rising global demand for professionals skilled in environmental conservation and urban resource planning.

- Eligibility: The program is open to graduates and postgraduates from any Science stream, as well as B.Tech holders in Civil, Environmental, and Geoinformatics Engineering.
- Curriculum: The 18-credit course includes 120 hours of lectures complemented by mandatory field and practical work. It focuses on using geoscientific data for sustainable development, a critical skill as cities face climate and resource challenges.

### 2. Revamped "Industry Partner" Norms for Skill Training

In March 2026, the state government rolled out fresh guidelines for appointing industry partners under the flagship Naan Mudhalvan scheme. This initiative, funded by the TNSDC, provides free, employment-linked training to youth aged 18–35 across Arts, Science, Engineering, and Polytechnic colleges.

### Key features of the 2026 reforms include:

- Mandatory Placement Benchmarks: Industry partners must now demonstrate active placement tie-ups with at least 10 companies and furnish measurable success data.
- Standardized Training Hours: Course durations are now fixed at 45 hours for degree students and 60 hours for polytechnic students to ensure a uniform high standard of learning.
- Faculty Development: Partners are required to conduct "Training of Trainers" (ToT) programs, ensuring that college faculty members are upskilled alongside their students.

### 3. Strategic Financial and Social Reforms

Beyond specific courses, the state has implemented broader institutional reforms:

- Performance-Based Grants: In February 2026, the government announced a composite grant of ₹767 crore for state universities, supplemented by a ₹175 crore Performance Fund. This fund incentivizes better fiscal management and academic excellence.
- Equity Regulations: Chief Minister M.K. Stalin has formally endorsed the UGC (Promotion of Equity in Higher Education Institutions) Regulations, 2026, directing all state universities to strictly implement these social inclusion measures to combat campus discrimination.

By integrating niche environmental research with a robust, industry-backed skill framework and performance-linked funding, Tamil Nadu is positioning its higher education system as a model for "job-ready" and socially inclusive learning in 2026.

## Telangana: Major Launch of "Emerging Area" Degree Courses for 2026-27

The Telangana Council of Higher Education (TGCHE) has officially rolled out a transformative plan to introduce specialized undergraduate and postgraduate courses in "New and Emerging Areas" for the 2026–27 academic session. This initiative, designed in collaboration with state universities like Osmania, Kakatiya, and JNTU-Hyderabad, aims to modernize traditional degrees and align them with the shifting demands of the global job market.

As part of this shift, the state is encouraging colleges to move away from conventional curricula and adopt multidisciplinary tracks that prioritize high-growth sectors.

### New Courses and Specialized Tracks

The redesigned academic framework introduces a wide array of new subjects that were previously restricted to professional or engineering streams. For the first time, even BA, B.Sc, and B.Com students will have access to:

- Security & Defense: A first-of-its-kind BA in Defense and Security Studies and an M.Sc in Cyber Security and Narcotics (planned in coordination with the state police department).
- High-Tech & Science: New programs in Aerospace, Maritime Technology, Fintech, and Climate Science.
- Medical Technology: Vocational M.Sc programs in Medical Microbiology, Medical Immunology, and Medical Imaging to bridge the gap between pure science and healthcare diagnostics.
- Tech-Integration: Upgraded 4-year formats for B.Sc in Data Science, Artificial Intelligence, and Bioinformatics.

### The "Four Compulsory Strands" Policy

To ensure holistic development, TGCHE Chairman Prof. V. Balakista Reddy announced that every new course, regardless of the stream, must now integrate four core pillars:

1. Technology: No course will remain purely non-technical; basic digital literacy and sectoral tech are mandatory.
2. Management & Commerce: To provide students with foundational business and financial acumen.
3. Law & Governance: Awareness of the legal frameworks and policies governing their specific sector.
4. Life Skills: Focus on communication, ethics, and emotional intelligence.

### "Earn While You Learn": Apprenticeship Integration

A standout feature for 2026 is the Apprenticeship Embedded Degree Programme (AEDP). Under this model, students can spend a significant portion of their degree—up to one full year in some cases—working in industry-linked internships. This "earn while you learn" provision allows students to gain professional experience and potential stipends while completing their academic requirements.

### Admission through DOST 2026

Admissions for these new-age programs are being conducted through the Degree Online Services Telangana (DOST) platform.

- Phase 1 Registration: Started on April 15 and will close on May 7, 2026.
- Phase 1 Seat Allotment: Scheduled for May 14, 2026.
- Eligibility: Any student who has cleared the Intermediate exams or an equivalent 10+2 qualification is eligible to apply for these courses based on merit.

By diversifying the academic portfolio and integrating compulsory technical and management training, Telangana is positioning its graduates to be competitive in emerging industries such as aviation, agri-tech, and robotics, ensuring they are "industry-ready" upon graduation.

## Karnataka's Higher Education Transformation: The "Campus to Career" Summit 2026

Karnataka's Higher Education Transformation: The "Campus to Career" Summit 2026

In a significant move to bridge the gap between academic graduation and professional employment, the Karnataka Department of Higher Education has officially launched the "Campus to Career" (C2C) Summit 2026. Following a high-profile curtain-raiser event held at Vidhana Soudha on April 8, 2026, the state government has announced a major strategic shift toward "outcome-based learning" and "industry-linked curriculum design" for all state universities and colleges.

The initiative is designed to address the growing concern of graduate employability in an era dominated by Artificial Intelligence (AI) and automation.

### The Vision: From Degrees to Real-World Skills


